✓ **THE SERIES:** The Bears and Razorbacks will be playing for the 9th time Saturday, with Arkansas leading the series 8-0.

The long-dormant series resumed in 2020, with the Razorbacks winning 100-75 at Bud Walton Arena. The teams met again in 2021, with Arkansas taking a 97-60 victory, also in Fayetteville.

The first four games of the series were played between 1923 and 1947.

✓ **GAME 9 - UAPB:** The Bears overcame a 21-point deficit but could not come all the way back in an 84-78 loss to the UAPB Golden Lions in Pine Bluff.

UCA got a career-high 25 from freshman guard Layne Taylor (Farmington, Ark.), who hit 6 of 12 from three-point range. Senior Elias Cato was the only other UCA player in double figures with 11 points. Taylor also had a team-high 6 assists. UCA was just 10 of 41 (24.4%) from three-point range while UAPB was 15 of 32 (46.9%).

✓ **GAME 8 - Little Rock:** The Trojans held off the Bears 63-57 on Wednesday night at the Jack Stephens Center. UCA shot just 31.1 percent from the field and made 6 of 26 (23.1%) from three-point range. The Bears overcame deficits of 15 points in the 1st half and 13 points in the second to get within three points twice in the later stages.

UCA got 13 points each from senior Elias Cato and freshman Layne Taylor, and 12 points, 9 rebounds and 3 blocked shots from freshman Nehemiah

Turner. Freshman Cole McCormick was 3 of 4 from beyond the arc and had 11 points.

✓ **GAME 7 - Georgia Tech:** The Yellow Jackets scored the first 10 points of the game and recorded an 87-68 over the Bears on Bobby Cremins Court at McCamish at McCamish Pavilion on Saturday in Atlanta.

Freshman Layne Taylor had 20 points and five three-pointers for the Bears, while senior Elias Cato added 17 points (3 threes) and sophomore Brayden Fagbemi had 15 points (3 threes). UCA was 14 of 32 (43.8%) from beyond the arc. UCA lost the rebound battle to the ACC foe 41-28 and points in the paint 30-12.

✓ **GAME 6 - UNC Asheville:** The Bears dominated the second overtime period Sunday, outscoring UNC Asheville 13-4 to grab a hard-fought 92-83 win at the Farris Center, in their second straight overtime game.

UCA had four in double figures, led by a career-high 23 points from senior Elias Cato. Brayden Fagbemi and Layne Taylor had 19 points each, while Mike Evbargharu added 18. Cato had a game-high 9 rebounds, while Taylor and Fagbemi had 7 assists and 5 assists apiece.

UCA shot 48.5 percent from the field and 75 percent from the foul line. UNCA made 15 three-pointers but UCA outscored them 40-26 in the paint and made 21 free throws to the Bulldogs' 8.

√ **GAME 5 - SEMO:** The Bears battled the Redhawks to overtime Thursday before falling 77-73 at the Farris Center. Senior Elias Cato and sophomore Brayden Fagbemi had 20 points each for UCA, which shot an uncharacteristic 3 of 21 (14.3 percent) from three-point range. UCA was 22 of 32 at the foul line while SEMO was 11 of 17. UCA also won the rebound battle 43-42 and the points in the paint margin by 36-22. FR guard Layne Taylor added 17 points and 9 rebounds.

√ **GAME 4 - WESTERN ILLINOIS:** The Leathernecks made two free throws with :01 on the clock Saturday to squeeze past the Bears 63-61 in Macomb, Ill.

UCA led by 10 points with six minutes remaining but was outscored 14-2 down the stretch. Freshman guard Layne Taylor made five three-pointers and had a career-high 21 points and 6 rebounds. SO Brayden Fagbemi had 13 points, 5 rebounds and 4 assists. UCA was 8 of 24 from three-point range, one game after hitting 16 threes against Randall.

√ **GAME 3 - RANDALL:** The Bears hit a season-high 16 three-pointers and rolled past the Randall Saints 108-49 in their home opener at the Farris Center. UCA got 19 points from lone senior Elias Cato and 18 from freshman guard Layne Taylor. Eight different players hit at least one three-pointer for the Bears, led by Taylor with 5 and Ben Fox with 4.

UCA outrebounded Randall 58-34, including 19 offensive boards. UCA also had 23 assists and just 5 turnovers against the NCCAA foe. The Bears led 56-22 after tying their season high with 11 three-pointers before halftime. UCA played all 14 available players.

√ **GAME 2 - UTAH:** The Utes tied their school record for three-pointers that was set in the season opener as they made 19 in a 98-63 win over the Bears on Thursday at the Jon M. Huntsman Center in Salt Lake City, Utah.

Utah was 19 of 50 from beyond the arc and had four players in double figures. Six different players made at least one three. Utah leads the nation in made three-pointers with 38.

UCA made 11 of 40 from three-point range, with freshman Layne Taylor hitting three. UCA got 15 points from Taylor and 13 from SO Brayden Fagbemi. UCA was out-rebounded 51-35 by the much taller Utes.

√ **GAME 1 - BYU:** The BYU Cougars hit 15 three-pointers and outrebounded the Bears 49-31 in taking an 88-50 win on Tuesday night at the Marriott Center.

UCA got 21 points from senior Elias Cato, who was the only Bear in double figures. UCA was just 7 of 31 (22.6%) from three-point range. Freshman Nehemiah Turner had a game-high 11 rebounds in his debut, while sophomore guard Brayden Fagbemi had seven assists in his first game at UCA. UCA got 29 points from newcomers on a team that features 12 new faces.

√ **MISSING TIME:** The Bears have battled injuries since Day 1 this season, with four players currently out of the lineup. Two of those injured players were projected to be starters in freshmen Tyler Lee (Chicago, Ill.) and Ty Robinson (Lake Hamilton HS). Lee has not played after knee surgery. Robinson is out with a leg injury after playing sparingly in UCA's first two games at BYU and Utah.

Sophomore transfer Jabari West has missed the last four games after breaking a bone in his hand. Freshman Cole McCormick has missed a game with a turf toe. Junior returnee Javion Guy-King, who was also penciled in as a starter, is ineligible this season due to an NCAA infraction.

√ **THE SQUAD:** The Bears will have a new look for 2024-25, with a new coaching staff and 12 new players on the roster. UCA has five returnees on the roster, three scholarship players and two walk-ons.

Coach John Shulman takes the reins of the program after a five-year run at Alabama-Huntsville, where he put together a 112-39 mark. The only returnee on the coaching staff is Associate Head Coach Brock Widders, in his eighth season with the Bears. Widders served as UCA's interim head coach during the last half of the 2022-23 season after head coach Anthony Boone had a heart procedure in early January.

Shulman brought two coaches with him from UAH, including his son Max and Ezra Pinzur. Max had a stellar playing career under his father at UAH, finishing as the career three-point leader for the Chargers.

Pinzur coached with Shulman for three seasons at UAH. Ryan Montgomery played at Lee University _ where he played against UAH _ and also professionally.

UCA senior Elias Cato (6-9, 220) is the top returnee for the Bears, after averaging 11.9 points and 6.1 rebounds a year ago, while shooting 41.8 percent from three-point range and 46.4 overall. Center Glory Etim (6-9, 230) started 28 of 31 games last season and averaged a team-high 7.5 rebounds and 1.0 blocked shots per game.

The third scholarship returnee is Javion Guy-King (6-6, 205), who played in 27 games and averaged 7.2 points, 3.2 rebounds and 1.9 assists. However, Guy-King is ineligible for the 2024-25 season.

Top newcomers include a pair of highly-touted freshman from the state of Arkansas in point guard Layne Taylor (Farmington, Ark.) and guard Ty Robinson (Hot Springs, Ark.).

Robinson was named the Most Valuable Player at last summer's Arkansas High School All-Star Game, played at UCA's Farris Center. Robinson, a 6-foot-4 guard, who finished his career with the Wolves as the school's all-time leading scorer, averaged 26 points, 8 rebounds and 3 assists as a senior while shooting 42 percent from three-point range and 86 percent at the free-throw line.

Robinson was a three-time All-State selection, a two-time All-State Tournament selection and a two-time member of the Arkansas Democrat-Gazette All-Arkansas team. He is a three-star prospect, the fourth-ranked prospect in Arkansas and the third-highest ranked recruit in UCA history, according to 24/7 Sports.

Taylor, a 5-11, 180-pound point guard for the Cardinals, is the No. 3 all-time scorer in Arkansas high school history with 3,372 career points. He was the Arkansas Democrat-Gazette All-Arkansas Preps Player of the Year last season.

Taylor, who led the Cardinals to a runnerup finish at the Class 4A State Tournament last month, averaged 25.3 points, 6 rebounds and 6 assists while shooting 39 percent from three-point range as a senior. His Farmington teams had an record of 124-12 in his four seasons.

√ **THE SCHEDULE:** UCA will play five Power 4 schools this season, including opening against BYU (Nov. 5) and Utah (Nov. 7), both in the Big 12. The Bears will also play Georgia Tech (ACC) on Nov. 30 in Atlanta,, against Arkansas (SEC) on Dec. 14 at Simmons Bank Arena

in North Little Rock, Ark., at Oklahoma (SEC) in Norman on Dec. 22.

For the third consecutive year, UCA will host an MTE featuring Southeast Missouri (Nov. 21) and UNC-Ashville (Nov. 24) at the Farris Center. UCA's home opener will be Wednesday, Nov. 13 against Randall University on Scottie Pippen Court. Other non-conference opponents include Western Illinois, The Citadel and Southwestern Christian.

UCA opens its fourth season in the ASUN Conference on Jan. 2 when it hosts Eastern Kentucky, followed by a Jan. 4 matchup with Bellarmine. The Bears will play 18 ASUN games, concluding on Feb. 26 at Lipscomb in Nashville, Tenn. The ASUN Tournament, played on campus sites, is set for March 2, 3, 6, 9.

√ **IN-STATE COMPETITION:** The Bears will face three consecutive in-state schools during the first semester, with none of the games being played in Conway. UCA faces Little Rock on Dec. 4 in Little Rock, UA-Pine Bluff on Dec. 7 in Pine Bluff and Arkansas in North Little Rock on Dec. 14.

UCA played four in-state games last season, with all four being played at the Farris Center, and went 3-1.

√ **FLORIDA SWINGS:**

The Bears will face rare back-to-back swings to Florida during ASUN play this season. UCA will play at Stetson in DeLand, Fla., on Jan. 9 and at Florida Gulf Coast in Fort Myers, Fla., on Jan. 11. They will then turn around and return the next week to play North Florida on Jan. 16 and Jacksonville on Jan. 18. Both of those programs are located in Jacksonville, approximately 10 miles apart.

√ **FOR THREE:** The Bears connected on 256 three-pointers last season, a total which should increase considerably this season under head coach John Shulman. Alabama-Huntsville, where Shulman coached the previous five seasons, made 356 shots from beyond the arc last season. The previous season, the Chargers hit 384 threes.

UCA returns just 31 three-pointers from a year ago, but several of the newcomers are projected to be solid perimeter shooters.

√ **WHO'S WHO:** Since moving to NCAA Division I in 2006-07, the Bears have played a Who's Who of college basketball. The Bears have played the No. 1 and No. 2 teams in the nation since moving up to NCAA Division I in 2006-07. UCA lost 94-44 to the No. 1 Kansas Jayhawks on Nov. 19, 2009 at historic Allen Fieldhouse. The Bears then dropped a 105-54 decision to the No. 2 Duke Blue Devils on Nov. 12, 2019 at equally historic Cameron Indoor Stadium, and lost to No. 2 Baylor in the 2021-22 season.

UCA played four Top 25 teams (Duke, Baylor, Wichita State, Marquette) two years ago, with Baylor also at No. 1 in the country.

Other notable opponents for the Bears include Kansas, Kentucky, UCLA, Butler, Indiana, Oregon, UNLV, Michigan, Connecticut, Oklahoma, Oklahoma State, Missouri, Arizona State, Iowa, TCU, Creighton, Memphis, New Mexico State, Pittsburgh, Arkansas, Baylor, Wisconsin and Mississippi State, among others.

√ **VS. THE POWER FIVE:** UCA's 96-69 victory over Cal on Dec. 6, 2018 in Berkeley was the first for the Bears over a Power 5 program since moving to NCAA Division I in 2006-07. UCA almost had another one earlier in the season, ironically against another Pac-12 team, when it lost 106-101 in overtime at No. 20 UCLA on Nov. 15 at Pauley Pavilion. The closest losses previously to Power 5 teams were a 76-73 loss at Oklahoma (Big 12) in 2010, an 87-84 loss to Rutgers (Big Ten) in 2015, a 79-72 loss at Mississippi State (SEC) in 2012.

√ **NOTABLES:**

- UCA lost its top scorer and three-point threat in Tucker Anderson, who transferred to Utah State after last season. He averaged 14.5 points per game and made a team-high 75 three-pointers while earning ASUN Freshman of the Year honors.

- Ironically, the ASUN FOY in 2021-22 was also a Bear and also transferred after last season. Camren Hunter missed last season with a foot injury but was UCA's leading scorer as a freshman and sophomore before the preseason injury last fall. He transferred to Wisconsin after the season.

- UCA returns just 24.5 points, 16.8 rebounds and 3.5 assists per game, along with 31 three-pointers, 63 blocked shots and 68 steals. The Bears return 54 starts among the current roster.

- The Bears have an international flair to their roster this season. Senior Elias Cato is from Queensland, Australia. Sophomore guard Michael Evbargharu is from Scarborough, Ontario, Canada. Diogo Seixas is from Albufeira, Portugal. Glory Etim has a family background in Nigeria.

- A year ago, the Bears did not shoot their first FT of the game at UNF until the 12:21 mark of the 2nd half.

- The Bears hit double figure three-pointers seven times last season and went 4-3 in those games. The high was 19 against Lipscomb (Jan. 18).

- The Bears had eight different leading scorers last season, but the only one returning is senior Elias Cato.

- UCA made a school-record 19 three-pointers at Lipscomb (Jan. 18), breaking the old mark of 18 set at UCLA in 2017 in an overtime loss at Pauley Pavilion.

- The 96 points at Lipscomb was the most against a Division I opponent last season.

- UCA's first postseason victory in the NCAA Division I era was a 92-90 overtime win over Seattle in the College Basketball Invitational (CBI) on March 14, 2018 in Seattle. The Bears then returned home and hosted Jacksonville State, losing 80-59.

- UCA's first ASUN Tournament victory was 74-73 over Stetson on March 1, 2022 in the first round of the ASUN Tournament at the Farris Center. The Bears advanced to the quarterfinals and played at Jacksonville, losing 79-69 at Swisher Gymnasium.

√ **NEW ARENA?:** The Bears celebrated the 50th year of the Farris Center during the 2022-23 season (Dec. 6) vs. Arkansas State. The first game in the Farris Center was played on Dec. 7, 1972, an 87-85 victory over cross-town rival Hendrix.

Prior to the opening of the Farris Center, the Bears played in what was then called the Old Gym and is now called the Prince Center, located across the street from Farris. The Prince Center is now home the exclusive home to UCA volleyball.

Numerous renovations have taken place at the Farris Center, including recent additions of floor seating, videoboard, wooden playing surface (Scottie Pippen Court), practice gym and renovated locker rooms.

The UCA Board of Trustees voted in October to explore building a new arena due to the condition of much of the infrastructure of the current Farris Center.

Head Coach JOHN SHULMAN

John Shulman was named to head the UCA men's basketball program on March 18, 2024.

Shulman brings to UCA an extensive career as a collegiate head coach, most recently at NCAA Division II University of Alabama-Huntsville. He was previously the head coach at Chattanooga and served as an assistant at Wofford, Tennessee Tech and East Tennessee State.

Shulman was named the ninth head coach in UAH men's basketball program history ahead of the 2019-20 season. He put together an impressive 112-39 record with the Chargers, leading them to five consecutive NCAA Division II Tournament berths and three Gulf South Conference titles.

Shulman, a two-time graduate of East Tennessee State University, coached at Chattanooga from 2004-13 and took the Mocs to two NCAA Tournaments in 2004-05 and 2008-09. Shulman had 18 players who would eventually play professionally, and his squads also featured 11 All-Southern Conference performers and 10 Southern Conference All-Tournament selections. He brought to campus four of the top 10 all-time scorers, three of the top 10 shot blockers, four of the top 10 rebounders, five of the top 15 in field goals, and each of the top five best 3-point shooters in program history.

At UAH, Shulman had two Gulf South Conference Players of the Year, three All-South District selections and five All-GSC players. Sam Orf became the school's ninth All-American and first-ever CoSIDA Academic All-America selection after being named the GSC West Division Player of the Year. In 2022-23, Shulman led the Chargers to the GSC regular season championship and the No. 1 seed in the GSC Tournament behind Player of the Year Chaney Johnson.

While at Chattanooga, the Mocs earned two NCAA tournament appearances following a pair of Southern Conference championships, and his team finished as the tournament runners-up in a third title game appearance. The second winningest coach in Chattanooga history, Shulman also won four SoCon North Division championships.

In 2005, he was named as the top collegiate coach in Tennessee thanks to a season that included a NCAA tournament berth and Chattanooga's first win in 80 years over in-state foe Tennessee.

During his nine-year tenure at Chattanooga, Shulman mentored 18 players who would eventually play professionally, and his squads also featured 11 All-Southern Conference performers and 10 Southern Conference All-Tournament selections.

Prior to taking over the top spot at Chattanooga, Shulman served as the team's associate head coach from 2002 to 2004, and that came after stints as an assistant at each of Wofford, Tennessee Tech, and East Tennessee State.

Shulman earned both his bachelor's and master's in physical education from ETSU in 1989 and 1992, respectively.

He is married to the former Amy Engle, a Hall of Fame basketball player at Chattanooga, and they have three sons, Max, Tanner, and JC. Max is an assistant coach at UCA.

BEAR BASKETBALL HISTORY...

RAGS TO RICHES - UCA's most famous athletic alumnus is **SCOTTIE PIPPEN** of Chicago Bulls fame. Pippen may have one of the greatest rags-to-riches stories in the history of sports.

The youngest of 12 children, Pippen was an average high school player (6-1, 145) at tiny Class B Hamburg (Ark.) High School in the southeast corner of Arkansas. He was allowed to walk on as a manager at UCA as a favor to his high school coach Donald Wayne, who had played for UCA Coach Don Dyer.

He earned a scholarship as a player early in his freshman year when the team lost several team members. He quickly grew to 6-7 by his sophomore year and earned first-team NAIA All-America honors as a junior and senior, averaging 24 points and 11 rebounds as a senior.

After two stunning pre-draft camps, he was taken as the No. 5 lottery pick in the 1987 NBA Draft by the Seattle SuperSonics, who turned around and traded his rights to the Chicago Bulls.

The rest is history as Pippen, teaming with the immortal Michael Jordan, won three consecutive NBA championships from 1991-93, and three more from 1996-98. He was an NBA All-Star 11 times and was named one of the NBA's 50 Greatest Players of all time in 1997.

He was a member of the original Dream Team which dominated the 1992 Summer Olympic Games and was also a member of the 1996 Olympic gold medal squad. His UCA jersey was retired in 2010. He was also inducted into the UCA Sports Hall of Fame, the Arkansas Sports Hall of Fame and the Naismith Basketball Hall of Fame.

THE MOVE TO D-I - The University of Central Arkansas made the four-year transition from NCAA Division II to NCAA Division I, beginning in 2006-07.

The NCAA requires programs making the move up to Division I to go through a four-year waiting period where no athletic teams are eligible for postseason play. UCA men's basketball became eligible for postseason competition on the conference and national levels beginning with the 2010-11 season.

The Bears were eligible to win the Southland Conference regular season divisional title during the transition period but could not advance to the SLC postseason tournament because of the automatic qualifier stipulation that the tournament enjoys.

AFFILIATION - UCA, a former member of the Gulf South Conference at the D-II level, became an official member of the Southland Conference on July 1, 2006. UCA was the only conference university from a state other than Texas or Louisiana until Oral Roberts joined the conference in 2012-13. ORU has since returned to the Summit League. The other 12 schools in the SLC are spread throughout those two states, leaving UCA on the extreme northern end of the league geographically.

UCA officially joined the 12-team ASUN Conference on July 1, 2021, joining a league spread over eight southeastern states.

IN THE PAST - The UCA Bears have a rich postseason history dating back to their NAIA days.

The Bears played in back-to-back NAIA national championship games in 1990-91 and 1991-92 against the same Oklahoma City University team. OCU, featuring former Kentucky player Eric Manuel, got the best of the Bears both times.

The first year was a 74-71 win for OCU; the second was an 82-73 overtime win. Both games were played at Kansas City's Kemper Arena.

UCA made one national tournament appearance during its NCAA D-II years. The Bears made the 2005 NCAA South Regional and advanced to the second round before losing to Lynn University.
