- The two teams have split the last six meetings, winning every other game.

KENNY BROOKS' TALKING POINTS

- Here are three talking points that head coach Kenny Brooks preaches to his team every day:
 - We are going to put out a good brand of basketball that people want to watch
 - What you do today is what you do every day
 - All you can control is your energy, effort and attitude

THE SPREAD

- 15 of our 16 wins have come by at least 10 points, while 12 of our 16 wins have come by at least 16 points.
 - UK recorded its most wins by at least 10 points prior to New Year's Day (10) since 2018-19 (12).
- All five of Kentucky's Southeastern Conference wins have come by at least 14 points.
 - UK has had at least a five-point lead at halftime in all six league games this season.
 - UK has had at least an 11-point lead at halftime in five of six league games this season.
 - UK has had at least a 10-point lead in all six league games this season.
 - UK has had at least a 21-point lead in five of six league games this season.

BUT WE ALSO PLAY DEFENSE...

- Kentucky has held 13-of-its-17 opponents under 40.0 percent shooting from the field, including 5-of-its-6 league opponents.
 - The Wildcats have held all but one opponent under 45.0 percent shooting from the field (North Carolina on its home court on Dec. 5 - 47.5 percent).
- Not to mention our shot blocking (see New Team on the Block note).

IN THE RECORD BOOK

If the season ended today, her 7.333 assists per game would break the more-than-four-decade-old, single-season school record, which is held by Pam Browning who logged 7.14 assists per game in 1982-83. The Wildcat needs just 29 more assists to crack into the single-season, top-10 leaders list. No Cat has cracked into that list since Amber Smith in 2009-10.

G'S 20+ POINTS IN 8-OF-LAST-10 GAMES

- Georgia Amoore, All-American graduate guard, has scored at least 20 points in eight of the last 10 games (Dec. 9 - present).
 - The two games she didn't score 20+ points in that stretch, she scored 18 points at Florida on Jan. 9 and 15 points at Texas A&M on Jan. 23.
- That stretch included a six-game streak of 20+ points from Dec. 9-Jan. 5, averaging 22.7 points per game over that time.
 - The last UK player to log a streak as great as that was Rhyne Howard during her sophomore season in Spring 2020 (eight straight).
- Fun Fact:** Amoore is the only player in the league since 2002-03 to have four regular-season conference games with at least 20 points and eight assists in a single season, and she cracked that benchmark through her first five SEC games.
 - Moreover, Amoore surpassed UK great Makayla epps for the most games with at least 15 points and five assists in a single season in program history since 2002-03 (10).

OUR CENTER POINT

- Clara Strack, 6-5 sophomore center, can do it all.
- She has scored in double digits in 15-of-18 games this season, including 10 15+ point games and five 20+ point games.
 - She also has logged eight double-doubles this season.
- We think she is one of the best center passers in the nation, too, dishing out at least three assists in 10-of-18 games in 2024-25.
 - She set a career-high eight assists against NKU on Nov. 7.
 - She has dished out at least one assist in all 18 games this season.
- Strack also can shoot from the arc with seven 3-pointers this season.
 - She has had at least one 3-pointer in three of six league games this season.
- Not to mention, she is still leading the league with 2.3 bpg and third in the league with 9.6 rpg.
- Fun Fact:** Clara Strack even played point guard in high school.

THE TRIPLETS

- Clara Strack, Amelia Hassett and Teonni Key became just the fifth trio in NCAA DI history to each average more than 9.0 rebounds per game, when they held that benchmark through December and early January.
 - They also were the only trio in NCAA DI to each average more than 9.0 rebounds per game at the time.
 - Key just dropped below 9.0 (8.5) after the game at Florida on Jan. 9.*
- “The Triplets,” or otherwise known as the CATS (Clara, Amelia, Teonni), are all nearing a double-double.
 - Clara Strack (15.3 ppg, 9.6 rpg)
 - Amelia Hassett (10.5 ppg, 9.2 rpg)
 - Teonni Key (12.2 ppg, 8.5 rpg)
- In his postgame press conference after defeating Western Kentucky on Dec. 28 to conclude the nonconference schedule, head coach Kenny Brooks said:
 - “I think it’s really neat. We were starting to call them the triplets, those three, because they can get into a situation where they can switch, when they’re involved in anything, they can switch ... Those three have formed a bond where they can be so versatile and do a lot of different things that help us out.”

ONE OF TWO TEAMS IN NCAA DI

- Kentucky is currently one of two teams in NCAA DI to have three players with at least 39 3-pointers (Georgia Amoores - 44, Dazia Lawrence - 43, Amelia Hassett - 39).

OUR 5-0 START IN THE SOUTHEASTERN CONFERENCE

STRIKING START

- The Wildcats scored at least 91 points in each of their first two Southeastern Conference games of the season for the first time in program history.
 - The Cats scored at least 91 points in any consecutive SEC games for the first time since Jan. 17 and 20, 2013.
- The Wildcats won each of their first two SEC games of the season by at least 18 points for the second time in program history (also did so in 1992-93).
 - The Cats won any consecutive SEC games by at least 18 points each for the first time since Jan. 12 and 16, 2020.

KEEP ON KEEPING ON

- Kentucky stacked on three more wins at Florida (71-55), against Auburn (80-61) and at Georgia (78-64) to improve to 16-1 overall and 5-0 in the league.
 - UK’s 16-1 start to the season was the third-best start in program history.
 - UK’s 5-0 start to SEC action was the third-best start in league action in program history.
- The Wildcats won each of their first five SEC games of the season by at least 14 points for the first time in program history.
 - The Cats also scored at least 71 points in each of their first five SEC games of a season for the first time in program history.

THE NINE-GAME WIN STREAK

- Kentucky had a nine-game win streak this season (Dec. 9-Jan. 19), including a five-game win streak in the Southeastern Conference (Jan. 2-Jan. 19).
 - It marked the 14th time in program history that Kentucky has gone on at least a 9-0 run.

A COUPLE OF DAWGS

- A pair of players set some pretty cool benchmarks in Kentucky's win at Georgia on Jan. 19.
 - Clara Strack became the only UK player since at least 2002-03 to have at least 25 points, 12 rebounds and four assists in an SEC road game.
 - Clara Strack and Georgia Amoore became the first pair of UK players to score at least 24 points each in an SEC road game since SeSe Helm and Sara Potts did so at Ole Miss on Feb. 1, 2004.

GOING CRAZZY FROM 3

SCHOOL RECORD 18 3-POINTERS AGAINST RV/RV MISSISSIPPI STATE

- Kentucky drained a school record 18 3-pointers against RV/RV Mississippi State in its Southeastern Conference opener on Jan. 2.
- The backcourt, Georgia Amoore and Dazia Lawrence, were responsible for 14 of those 18, sinking seven 3-pointers apiece.
 - It marked the first time in program history that two players knocked down at least seven 3-pointers in the same game.
 - Moreover, they were each just one make shy of tying the individual single-game school record (8).
- The Wildcats went 18-of-33 from the arc, both values a season high at the time, for 54.4 percent from long range, also a season high at the time.

KNOCKED DOWN 15 MORE AT RV/RV VANDERBILT

- In the Wildcats' very next game, Kentucky hit 15 3-pointers at RV/RV Vanderbilt in its Southeastern Conference road opener on Jan. 5.
 - This time, Amelia Hassett, junior forward, led the team with six 3-pointers.
 - **Fun Fact:** All five starters made at least one 3-pointer in the game. Yes, even 6-5 center Clara Strack (1-of-2) and 6-4 forward Teonni Key (2-of-3).
- It marked the first time in program history that UK has hit at least 15 3-pointers in back-to-back games.

GEORGIA AMOORE JOINS RHYNE HOWARD

- Georgia Amoore joined Rhyne Howard as the only players in UK's 51-year program history to have made seven 3-pointers in two different games in the same season.

THE BEST SEC OPENER IN PROGRAM HISTORY

- Kentucky dominated RV/RV Mississippi State, 91-69, in the league opener on Jan. 2.
 - It marked the most points scored in a league opener in program history (91).
 - It marked the largest margin of victory in a league opener in program history (22).
- The Wildcats broke the single-game school record for 3-pointers (18) on a season-high 54.4 percent from the arc (18-of-33).
- Kentucky went 26-of-55 from the field altogether, while 88.5 percent of those makes were assisted (23 assists).
- On defense, UK swatted at 10 blocks, maintaining their nation-leading blocks per game.

NATIONAL & SEC PLAYER OF THE WEEK: GEORGIA AMOORE

- Georgia Amooore, All-American graduate guard, was named an Ann Meyers Drysdale National Player of the Week and the Southeastern Conference Player on the Week, after the first round of games in league action, Jan. 7.
- In dominant wins over RV/RV Mississippi State and at RV/RV Vanderbilt, she scored a combined 51 points and made 10 3-pointers, shooting over 47.0 percent from the field and over 50.0 percent from the arc. She also assisted on 18 other baskets.
 - She also went a combined 7-of-7 from the line in those games, also maintaining her SEC lead in free-throw percentage (93.0).

NEW TEAM ON THE BLOCK

- Keep an eye on the team block record in 2024-25.
 - The season record is 181 set in 2012-13, while the Cats have 121 through 18 games.
 - The Cats have had at least nine blocks in seven of 18 games this season.
 - The single-game record is 19 against North Carolina A&T set on Dec. 6, 2006, while the Cats have threatened it with a 16 block performance against Northern Kentucky on Nov. 7, which became the second most in a single game in program history.

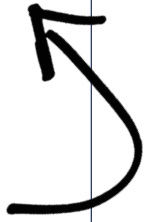

IT JUST MEANS A-MOORE

- Kenny Brooks affectionately refers to All-American Georgia Amoore, a Ballarat, Australia, native, as his mini-me and an extension of him on the court.
- The nationally recognized point guard, who played with the Australian National Team and was invited to Kelsey Plum's Dawg Class for the second straight summer in 2024, averaged 18.8 ppg and 6.8 apg as a senior at Virginia Tech in 2023-24.
 - Just a season before that, she averaged 16.3 ppg and 4.9 apg, taking her team to the Final Four in 2023.
- Amoore, who is plenty decorated from her time at Virginia Tech, is already receiving some early praise, this time in Blue and White, including the following:

THE KEY

- In high school, Teonni Key was ranked ninth overall in the ESPNW Class of 2021, and was named to the:
 - 2021 McDonald's All-American Girls Team
 - 2021 Jordan Brand Classic Girls National Team
- She missed her entire freshman season at North Carolina in 2021-22, because of an ACL tear.
- Coming off that ACL tear, she really never hit her full potential in her redshirt freshman and redshirt sophomore seasons.
 - She averaged 2.5 ppg and 2.5 rpg in just 9.9 minutes per game in those two seasons at UNC.
- Through 18 games in 2024-25, Key has already reset her career highs in points three times (last 20), rebounds four times (last 13), assists (5), field-goal makes five times (last 8), field-goal attempts four times (last 16), three-point field-goal makes twice (2), three-point field-goal attempts three times (4) and blocks three times (last 6).
 - She also recorded the first double-double of her career on 11 points and 13 rebounds against Wofford on Nov. 12, while she now has six total through 18 games.

BEEN-AROUND BACKCOURT

- Kentucky boasts one of the oldest backcourts in the country in graduate student Georgia Amoore and redshirt senior Dazia Lawrence, who are both 23-years-old.
 - Through 18 games in 2024-25, they have combined for 253 career games and 221 career starts.
- Amoore and Lawrence also both are 1,000-point scorers, while they're coming off their most productive seasons yet, scoring 602 points and 565 points last season, respectively.
 - They also combine for three conference championships - Amoore (2) and Lawrence (1).

10 THINGS ABOUT #10

- Dazia Lawrence, a redshirt senior from Greenville, North Carolina, won the 3-point contest at Big Blue Madness on Oct. 11.
- She was named to the American Athletic Conference First Team as a senior in 2023-24, and she was named to the Conference-USA First Team as a junior in 2022-23.
- She describes her game as aggressive, observant and smooth.
- Following five years at Charlotte (2020-24), including one red-shirt season, she wasn't the lone Niner to make their way to Lexington. So did Charlotte assistant coach Ciara Gregory, who is now a Kentucky assistant coach.
- Lawrence is passionate about giving back to her community, talking to young, aspiring basketball players at her hometown gym and donating her gently used basketball shoes and gear to young girls as well.
- One day, the current master's student in business administration, hopes to become a successful entrepreneur.
- Outside of basketball, the 23-year-old enjoys reading and doing puzzles.
- Lawrence grew up playing basketball with her cousins, which included mostly boys.
- The gym that they played basketball in was carpeted, which is why she has a lot of scars on her knees from carpet burn!
- As she got a little older and more serious about basketball, she began working out at a hometown place called "The Dungeon." The facility looks like the name sounds – whatever the temperature is outside, it also is inside, especially in the summer!

ALL-AMERICAN AUSTRALIANS WITH AN "S"

- Kentucky has not one but two All-American Aussies.
- In addition to Georgia Amoore's All-America recognition the last two seasons, Amelia Hassett, a transfer out of Eastern Florida State College, was named to the National Junior College Athletic Association Division I All-America Third Team in 2023-24.
 - **Fun Fact:** Amoore is from Ballarat, Victoria, Australia, while Hassett is from Albury, New South Wales, Australia. That is about a 4.5 hour drive on the National Highway between the two hometowns.

SIX STRAIGHT 80+ POINTS GAMES (TEAM)

- While Georgia Amoore paced the team with six straight 20+ point games, UK also put together six straight 80+ point games from Dec. 9-Jan. 5.
 - The last UK team to log such a streak was Nov. 10-Nov. 27, 2013 (six straight).

POUNDED PURDUE

- Five starters scored in double digits, including two that scored 20+ points, as Kentucky overcame a slow start to beat Purdue, 82-52, at Mackey Arena in West Lafayette, Indiana, on Dec. 14.
- The 30-point triumph marked UK's largest margin of victory in a nonconference road game since defeating Wagner by 39 points on Nov. 10, 2013.
- UK recorded its second-best, field-goal percentage of the season on 47.6 percent (30-of-63).
 - Ironically, UK had to overcome its lowest first-quarter, field-goal percentage of the season on 28.6 percent (4-of-14).
- Kentucky tied the school record for single-game, free-throw percentage (with at least 10 attempts) with 100.0 percent (12-of-12).

A NOVEMBER TO REMEMBER

- UK began the season 7-0 for the first time since 2019-20.
 - UK defeated its first seven opponents of the season by at least 10 points for the first time since 2013-14.
- UK began the season 2-0 against ranked opponents.
 - UK defeated each of its first two ranked opponents of the season for the first time since 2016-17, when UK defeated No. 14 Miami and No. 12 Oklahoma.
 - It also marked the first time in program history that UK defeated two AP-ranked opponents in November.
- Kenny Brooks became just the second head coach in program history to begin their first season at UK undefeated through seven games.
 - Terry Hall went undefeated through her first nine games in 1980-81.

BROADWAY GIRLS

- The Wildcats broke some hearts in the Music City Classic over Thanksgiving week.
- Kentucky defeated Arizona State, 77-61, on Nov. 26, before taking down No. 19/19 Illinois, 76-53, on Nov. 27.
 - Kentucky's 23-point triumph over Illinois marked its largest margin of victory against an AP-ranked opponent since March 4, 2016 against Florida (23 points).
 - The Wildcats shot 47.3 percent (35-of-74) from the field compared to the Fighting Illini's 26.7 percent (16-of-60) from the field.
 - The Cats also held the Fighting Illini to just 1-of-16 from the arc.
 - Kentucky went 1-of-2 from the line, while Illinois went 20-of-27 from the line.
 - UK outscored Illinois, 48-25, in the second half.
 - UK went on a season-high 18-0 run in the middle of the fourth quarter.

NATIONAL PLAYER OF THE WEEK: CLARA STRACK

- For her performances in the Music City Classic, Clara Strack, sophomore center, was named one of five Ann Meyers Drysdale National Players of the Week on Dec. 3.
- In two wins during the Thanksgiving tournament, including UK's second top-25 win of the season over No. 19/19 Illinois, she averaged 24.5 ppg, 60.0 FG%, 12.5 rpg, 3.0 apg and 2.0 bpg.
 - Oh, and the 6-5 center drained three 3-pointers.
- The Wildcat reset her career high in points twice, scoring 24 against Arizona State and 25 against No. 19/19 Illinois.
 - She also tied her career high in rebounds with 15 against the Fighting Illini.

GEORGIA AMOORE IN THE VIRGINIA TECH RECORD BOOK

In four years at Virginia Tech (2021-24), Georgia Amoore made her mark in Hokies' history, setting a combined 10 school records across her career, single seasons and single games.

TALL BALL

- This is Kentucky's tallest team in program history and Kenny Brooks' tallest team in his 22 seasons as a head coach.
- Eight of UK's players, more than half of the team, are 6'1 or taller, including four players that are 6'3 or taller.
- In fact, 6'7 center Clara Silva ties 6'7 center Anna Cole (2009-10) as UK's tallest player in program history.

THE PERFECT FIT

- Lexington, Kentucky, the Horse Capital of the World, is the perfect place for Georgia Amoore to spend her last year of college basketball. Georgia grew up on a horse farm and her grandfather and mother worked in the horse industry in Australia.

HOW IT GOT STARTED

- Georgia Amoore's first basketball game was actually played in flip flops.
 - She was at her cousin's basketball game as a spectator at five-years-old, and a player fouled out, so Amoore, wearing flip flops, was called in.
- Amoore actually grew up playing and was passionate about the game of footie. She played with the boys until they turned into teenagers, and she was so fast, boys would even attempt pulling her ponytail to bring her down.

QB1

- Georgia Amoore requested a football helmet and football gloves to her preseason photoshoot.
- Coach Brooks posted a photo on his Instagram with the caption, "That's my quarterback."
 - That adds up for the All-American point guard. Coach Brooks often refers to her as an extension of him on the court.

INTERNATIONAL FLAVOR

- The Wildcats have five international players on their team - two from Australia in Georgia Amoore and Amelia Hassett, one from Canada in Tanah Becker, one from Portugal in Clara Silva and one from the Czech Republic in Dominika Paurová.
- The Cats also have one international coach in assistant coach and recruiting coordinator Radvile Autukaite (pronounced like O-to-Kay-ta), who goes by Coach Rad, who is from Lithuania.

OUR STATE

- No. 20/19 Kentucky snapped a seven-game losing streak to No. 18/18 Louisville in overtime, 71-61, in front of a sold out arena at Historic Memorial Coliseum on Saturday, Nov. 16.
 - It marked UK's largest margin of victory in 32 overtime wins in program history.
 - It marked UK's first triumph over UofL since Dec. 20, 2015.
 - It marked UK's first ranked win since defeating No. 1/1 South Carolina, 64-62, to win the 2022 Southeastern Conference Championship on March 6, 2022.
- For the first time this season, UK won from behind.
 - UK trailed UofL by three points at halftime and by as many as seven points in both the first half and the second half.
 - UK outscored UofL by 17 points in the final 16 minutes of the game (32-15).
 - UK held UofL without a field goal in overtime and outscored UofL, 13-3, in overtime.

START ME UP

- This season marks just the second time in program history that UK has allowed 43 points or less in each of its first three games, with the first instance occurring in 1974-75.
- This season marks just the third time in program history that UK has won each of its first three games of a season by at least 29 points (2011-12, 2017-2018, 2024-25).

KENTUCKY KENNY

- Kenny Brooks, who recently took Virginia Tech to the 2023 NCAA Final Four and won the 2024 Atlantic Coast Conference regular-season championship, was named the ninth head coach of the University of Kentucky women's basketball program on March 26, 2024.
 - Prior to his arrival in Lexington, he boasted a 517-204 (.717) career record through 22 seasons as a head coach.
 - In that time he had just one losing season and that was all the way back in 2003-04.
- Brooks has combined for 11 conference championships, including six tournament championships and five regular-season championships, and 10 NCAA Tournament appearances during his head coaching career.
 - He also has had six players picked in WNBA Drafts since 2015.

FIRST OF ALL...

- The University of Kentucky women's basketball program played its first game under head coach Kenny Brooks and its first game in the \$82 million renovated Historic Memorial Coliseum on Nov. 4, as UK defeated USC Upstate, 98-43.
 - It marked UK's second largest margin of victory in a season opener (55 points), with the record going to UK's triumph over Kentucky State, 121-44, in 1989-90.
 - It also marked a UK head coach's largest margin of victory in their debut.
 - UK's 12 blocks tied for the second most in a single game in program history, and the first since UK had 12 blocks against Wright State on March 22, 2014.
 - It marked just the fourth game in program history that UK had 12-or-more blocks.
 - Clara Silva, 6-7 freshman center, went 6-of-6 from the field and made six blocks.
 - She became the first player since Makayla Epps in 2014 to go perfect from the field (with at least five FGM).
 - She was one block shy of the single-game individual and freshman program record.

\$82 MILLION RENOVATION

- UK Athletics is near the finish line of its largest investment in women's sports with the \$82 million renovation of Historic Memorial Coliseum.
- The project, which is open and playable for 2024-25 and scheduled for full completion in Spring 2025, ensures the Kentucky women's basketball, volleyball, gymnastics and STUNT teams can call home a state-of-the-art facility that honors Kentucky's historic past.
- The capacity is approximately 6,250, with the addition of a new, modernized club area.
- Included in that \$82 million renovation, the women's basketball program also opened a completely remodeled locker room, lounge and film room during Summer 2024.

WALK IT, LIKE I TALK IT

- Kentucky Basketball - both the men's and the women's teams - were given an exclusive set of NOCTA gear.
- Kentucky Basketball - both the men's and the women's teams - were gifted a Kentucky player exclusive shoe to begin the season, Devin Booker's Nike Book 1, which feature a blue and white colorway and retro UK logos.
- The Wildcats also received two pairs of the Sabrina 2s, one pair in blue and one pair in white, also featuring the UK logos.
- Earlier this summer, both head coaches - Kenny Brooks and Mark Pope - also received the Nike Kobe 4 Proto "Girl Dad" kicks, courtesy of the Mamba and Mambacita Sports Foundation.

LOWER LEG INJURIES, OUT INDEFINITELY

- University of Kentucky women's basketball graduate guard Jordan Obi and sophomore guard Dominika Paurová sustained lower leg injuries during the summer, and they are both out indefinitely.

RESERVED SEASON TICKETS SOLD OUT

- Excitement abounded for the University of Kentucky women's basketball team, as reserved season tickets sold out for 2024-25, it was announced Oct. 25.
 - It is the first time in program history that reserved seating has sold out.
- More than 3,200 season tickets have sold for the upcoming season, over half of the approximate capacity within the new configuration of the renovated Historic Memorial Coliseum.

RHYNE HOWARD WINS OLYMPIC MEDAL

- Rhyné Howard, University of Kentucky alumna and Atlanta Dream guard, claimed a bronze medal for Team USA at the 2024 Olympic Games.
- Through nine games in Paris, she scored 34 points, grabbed 15 rebounds and had a team-lead four blocks.

606 STRONG

- Cassidy Rowe's family and community were directly affected by the Eastern Kentucky floods in Summer 2022.
 - The Virgie, Kentucky, native and junior guard tells a great story about how her parents had to trudge through knee-deep water to evacuate to their neighbor's house on higher ground.
 - Meanwhile, Rowe texted her father to see if her childhood basketball goal was ok. He told her it wasn't, it had been washed away. He ended up finding it floating down the flood stream.
 - Her home ended up being ok, just some property damage. However, many, many folks around neighborhood were not so fortunate.
 - Rowe and her family were and continue to be very active in their community in the aftermath of the flooding, handing out meals and cleaning.
- Rowe and alumnae Emma King, Blair Green and Maci Morris - all natives of Eastern Kentucky or otherwise known as the 606 - hosted a "606 Camp" for 606 residents at North Laurel High School in August 2022.
 - The cost to attend was \$40 per player or \$60 for two in a family, while all proceeds from the camp went directly to the Foundation for Appalachian Kentucky Crisis Fund.

“KENTUCKY’S FAVORITE CHILD”

- Cassidy Rowe, the Virgie, Kentucky, native, who often draws big fan sections of folks from back home, was referred to as “Kentucky’s favorite child,” by head coach Kenny Brooks in a postgame press conference after defeating Purdue Fort Wayne on Nov. 18.

WILDCATS SHINE IN THE CLASSROOM

- The Wildcats have had a 3.0 team GPA or better each of the last 23 semesters, including a decade-high 3.593 in Fall 2024.

THE MAGIC “80”

- UK holds a remarkable 391-26 (.938) record when scoring 80 points or more since 1974.
 - UK is 8-0 in 2024-25, when scoring 80+ points.
- The last loss came when UK fell to DePaul on Dec. 9, 2021, 94-85.

UK IN OVERTIME

- UK is 32-29 all-time in overtime games.
 - Kentucky defeated Louisville, 71-61, in one overtime at home on Nov. 16, UK’s largest margin of victory in 32 overtime wins in program history.

KENTUCKY ALL-TIME

- Kentucky is 922-610 (.602) in its 51st season of varsity competition.

KENTUCKY ALL-TIME AT HOME

- Kentucky is 538-199 (.729) all-time at home, including:
 - 498-172 (.743) all-time in Memorial Coliseum
 - 36-28 (.563) all-time in Rupp Arena
 - 4-0 (1.000) at the Clive M. Beck Center

- If you do the math, you will notice UK’s losses in Memorial Coliseum, Rupp Arena, Clive M. Beck Center (Transylvania) and the Davis-Reid Alumni Gym are two more than UK has home losses.
 - That reason is UK’s NCAA Tournament Sweet 16 game vs. Washington at Rupp Arena on March 25, 2016 and its NCAA Tournament game vs. Indiana on March 18, 1983 at Memorial Coliseum cannot count towards UK’s home record.

About Kenny Brooks:

- Kenny Brooks, who took Virginia Tech to the 2023 NCAA Final Four and won the 2024 Atlantic Coast Conference regular-season championship, was named the ninth head coach of the University of Kentucky women's basketball program on March 26, 2024.
- Prior to Lexington, Brooks boasted a 517-204 (.717) career record through 22 seasons as a head coach. He has compiled five Colonial Athletic Association Tournament titles, four CAA regular-season titles, one ACC Tournament title, one ACC regular-season title, 10 NCAA Tournament appearances and one Final Four.
- Brooks arrived in Lexington after serving eight seasons as the head coach at Virginia Tech. Under his guidance, the Hokies enjoyed eight consecutive winning seasons (2017-24) and made four straight appearances in the NCAA Tournament (2021-24). He also produced a record amount of ACC win totals, ranked wins and postseason accolades in that time.
- Most recently, Virginia Tech is coming off the program's first ACC regular-season championship and a four seed in the NCAA Tournament in 2024. Just a season before that, he led Tech to the program's first ACC Tournament title and earned a one seed in the NCAA Tournament. That same season, the Hokies defeated Chattanooga, South Dakota State, Tennessee and Ohio State to advance to the program's first Final Four.
- A 1992 graduate of James Madison, Brooks played for three seasons under coach Lefty Driesell and made two NIT appearances, while also earning a degree in business management. He began his coaching career as a part-time assistant for the 1993-94 JMU men's squad that won the CAA Tournament and advanced to the NCAA Tournament. Then, after four seasons as an assistant for the men's program at Virginia Military Institute (1994-98), he moved back to his alma mater as a men's assistant from 1998-2002. He was named interim women's head coach on Dec. 6, 2002 before taking over those duties on a full-time basis on March 21, 2003.
- Brooks and his wife, Chrissy, have four children, Kendyl, Chloe, Gabby and Nicholas.
