## BILLINGSLEY TENNIS CENTER

One of the newer additions to Arkansas' athletic facilities was completed with the dedication of George M. Billingsley Tennis Center on April 15, 2008.

The \$2.8 million expansion and renovation gives the Razorback men's and women's tennis teams a complete facility combining the outdoor courts of Billingsley Tennis Center with the indoor courts of Dills Indoor Stadium.

The outdoor facility includes bleacher seating between the two sets of six courts. Fans can sit in the bleachers and watch matches on either side, or stand on top and view matches on both sides.

The renovation includes locker rooms, offices and an indoor club area attached to Dills Indoor Stadium and connecting the indoor facility with the outdoor facility. The club area includes chair back seats on one side overlooking the Dills Indoor courts and chair back seats on the other overlooking the Billingsley Center outdoor courts.

Other additions include scoreboards for the individual courts and a larger scoreboard on the west end of the north set of outdoor courts which will display the scores from outdoor courts one through six.

Unlike many other programs across the country, Arkansas' tennis teams take advantage of facilities which give the Razorbacks an opportunity to play and practice 365 days a year, regardless of the weather.

Billingsley Tennis Center has been home to top collegiate tennis tournaments including the ITA Central Regional Championships and the SEC Tennis Tournament.



## HEAD COACH JAY UDWADIA

Former Razorback men's tennis standout Jay Udwardia was named the Head Coach of the Arkansas men's tennis team on June 7, 2022. Udwardia returns to his alma mater to lead the men's program after successful head coaching stints at Oklahoma State, Fresno State and Drake.

In just his second season at the helm, Udwardia led the Razorbacks to a historical 2023-24 season, including a nine-win improvement from the 2022-23 season, the program's first NCAA Tournament berth since 2021 and the most wins in a season since 1986 (21). The Hogs achieved a season-high ITA team ranking of No. 28 and defeated 11 teams that finished inside the final ITA top-75 team rankings. Arkansas concluded the year with its highest year-end ITA team ranking since 2016 (No. 31). The Razorbacks notched five SEC victories in 2024 after none the previous season and recorded top-25 wins over No. 25 Auburn and No. 25 Florida. The Hogs also secured their first victory at Texas A&M since 1994 after a 4-3 comeback victory over the No. 8 Aggies.

In his return to Fayetteville, Arkansas ended the 2022-23 season with a 12-15 record. The Razorbacks jumped out to an impressive 12-1 start to open the year while defeating two teams that finished inside the final ITA top-75 team rankings (Washington and Tulsa). The Hogs attained a season-high ITA team ranking of No. 31 and concluded the year at No. 75.

Udwardia has produced All-SEC Second Team honoree Gerard Planelles Ripoll in addition to the program's first All-Americans since 2018 with Božo Barun and Jared Horwood earning ITA Doubles All-American honors after advancing to the quarterfinals of the 2024 NCAA Doubles Championship. Under Udwardia, Planelles Ripoll also received SEC Player of the Week honors in April 2024 and finished this season with a year-end singles ranking of No. 96. Barun and Horwood concluded the season with a season-high doubles ranking of No. 28. Udwardia has played a vital role in the development of Connor Smillie, who earned SEC Freshman of the Week honors in February 2024.

In his most recent head coaching tenure at Oklahoma State, Udwardia posted a record of 137-71 in nine seasons and led the Cowboys to seven NCAA Tournament appearances, including a NCAA Tournament Sweet Sixteen appearance in 2016. During his tenure, OSU was ranked inside the top 25 Division I rankings for eight years in a row, including three years inside the top 10. OSU reached as high as No. 4 in the national rankings in his tenure.

Oklahoma State posted seven consecutive winning campaigns and was selected to compete in the NCAA Tournament in the final full six seasons under Udwardia's tutelage. In his time at OSU, nine players achieved ITA All-American status, while four singles players and six doubles tandems achieved All-Big 12 honors.

Prior to beginning the turnaround at Oklahoma State, Udwardia served eight seasons as the Fresno State men's tennis coach, and spent the year before as the head coach at Drake. His overall record of 257-132 includes a 2004 Missouri Valley Championship and consecutive Western Athletic Conference titles in 2011 and 2012.

After kicking off his coaching career at Drake with a 17-6 season in 2004, Udwardia took over the program at Fresno State. He led the Bulldogs from a 10-11 record in his first year to seven consecutive winning seasons from



2006-12. Udwardia took Fresno State to the conference championship match in six of those seven years and won the league title twice in that span. His teams were consistently well regarded in the ITA National Rankings, reaching as high as No. 14 in 2012.

Before beginning his career as a college tennis coach, Udwardia spent one year on the ATP Tour, earning 26 ATP doubles points and capturing an ITF doubles title. He competed in tournaments run by the French Tennis Federation, and also played club tennis in Australia.

Udwardia, a native of Williamsville, N.Y., was a four-year letterwinner under Arkansas head coach Robert Cox at the University of Arkansas and was team captain during his senior year.

While at Arkansas, he helped lead the Razorbacks to three NCAA tournament appearances and a spot in the Top 25 of the national rankings before graduating from the university in 1997 with a bachelor's degree in sociology. Udwardia and his wife, Jennifer, have two sons, Dash (10) and Fynn (8), and a daughter, Raya (3).

Udwardia becomes the fourth former Razorback tennis letterwinner to be named head coach of the men's tennis program, joining Jay Dickey, Jr. (1962-63), Ron Hightower (1985-86) and Robert Cox (1988-2013).
