OPENING TIP

■ Oklahoma (14-4, 0-4) and Arkansas (12-7, 1-4) each go for their second consecutive win when they meet in Fayetteville, Ark., on Saturday at 7:30 p.m. CT inside Bud Walton Arena. The Sooners are 0-2 in true road games while the Razorbacks are 9-2 at home.

■ Saturday's game will be televised by ESPN2 with **Brian Custer** (play-by-play) and **Richard Hendrix** (analyst) announcing. It will air on the Sooner Sports Radio Network (KRXX 107.7 FM The Franchise in Oklahoma City; KTBS 1430 AM in Tulsa; Varsity Radio App) with **Toby Rowland** (play-by-play) and **Kevin Henry** (analyst) on the call.

■ Arkansas holds a 17-14 all-time series lead against Oklahoma, but the Sooners are 9-5 in the last 14 matchups. See page 2 for more series information.

■ Each of the Sooners' next five opponents after Arkansas are ranked or receiving votes in this week's AP poll (No. 13 Texas A&M, RV Vanderbilt, No. 1 Auburn, No. 6 Tennessee and No. 22 Missouri). Ten of OU's last 12 games are against teams in this week's AP top 25 (seven vs. top-16 teams).

■ The Sooners have showcased their individual offensive depth this season, with a nation-leading four players who have scored at least 29 points in a game and an SEC-high six players who have scored 20-plus points.

■ OU leads the SEC and ranks fifth nationally with its .803 season free throw percentage, which would smash the single-season school record of .767 set by the 2001-02 Final Four team. The SEC squad with the second-best free throw percentage is LSU at .769.

■ First-year Sooner **Brycen Goodine** was 9 for 11 from 3-point range Jan. 8 vs. Texas A&M and scored OU's most points (34) since **Trae Young** in 2017-18. The nine treys tied for fourth most in OU history.

■ Guard **Jeremiah Fears** was named to the Wooden Award Midseason Top 25 Watch List on Jan. 7. Fears' 4-point play with 11 seconds left vs. No. 24 Michigan in the Jumpman Invitational Dec. 18 marked the final points in an 87-86 OU win. The two-time SEC Freshman of the Week finished with a career-high 30 points that night and has scored in double figures in 17 of 18 games.

■ OU won the 2024 Battle 4 Atlantis by beating Providence, Arizona and Louisville in consecutive days in November. Senior **Jalon Moore** was named tournament MVP after scoring 24 points each in the semifinals and title game. Fears joined Moore on the all-tournament team (18.7 points, 5.3 assists, 3.3 rebounds, 2.7 steals).

RECAPPING SATURDAY'S WIN OVER SOUTH CAROLINA

NORMAN — Oklahoma rode a 23-8 run over the game's final 7:11 on Saturday to upend South Carolina 82-62 and pick up its first-ever SEC win. The Sooners, who committed 11 turnovers in the first half but just one in the second, outscored the Gamecocks 19-3 off turnovers.

Senior forward **Jalon Moore** logged his team-leading 10th 20-point game of the season, finishing with a game-high 22 points on 6-of-10 field goal and 10-of-11 free throw shooting. The 10 free throw makes tied a career high. Freshman guard **Jeremiah Fears** registered 16 points and career highs of nine rebounds and eight assists, becoming just the second Sooner in the last 29 years and fifth SEC player over the last eight seasons with at least 16/9/8 in a game. Senior guard **Kobe Elvis** came off the bench to go 4 for 6 from 3-point range and finished with 12 points.

OU shot over 50% from the field for the third time in four games, turning in a .560 figure for the its second-best performance of the season. It also shot .471 from 3-point range (8 for 17) and .857 from the free throw line (18 for 21).

SETTING THE SCENE

- Saturday's game marks the first of two straight road contests for the Sooners, who play at No. 13/13 Texas A&M on Tuesday, Jan. 28.
- Oklahoma is the only team with two players who rank in the top 10 in the SEC in scoring. Senior forward **Jalon Moore** ranks third (18.3 ppg) and freshman guard **Jeremiah Fears** ranks ninth (16.8 ppg).

▪ Over the last six contests, Moore is averaging team highs of 20.2 points and 7.0 rebounds per game while shooting a gaudy .612 from the field, .588 (10 for 17) from 3-point distance and .853 (29 for 34) from the free throw line. On the year, Moore ranks in the top 10 in the league in scoring (3rd at 18.3 ppg), field goal percentage (5th at .529) and free throw percentage (8th at .851).

▪ Moore is coming off a two-game week in which he averaged 25.5 points (led SEC) and 8.0 rebounds vs. Texas and South Carolina while shooting .652 from the field, .500 from 3-point range (3-6) and .900 from the free throw line (18-20). He scored a career-high 29 points against Texas (previous high was 24), including 26 in the second half when he was 8 for 8 from the floor.

▪ Freshman guard **Dayton Forsythe** has provided a spark off the bench the last two games, combining for 23 minutes against Texas and South Carolina after totaling five minutes over the previous four outings.

▪ Oklahoma switched up its starting lineup two games ago vs. Texas for the first time since Nov. 21, as guard **Brycen Goodine** replaced **Kobe Elvis**. The previous 13 games, the Sooners started guards Elvis, Fears and **Duke Miles**, and forwards Moore and **Sam Godwin**. Goodine's start was his first since the season opener, while the non-start for Elvis was his first since the 2022-23 season at Dayton.

▪ After posting four straight 20-win seasons, Arkansas went 16-17 in 2023-24 and tied for 11th in the SEC with a 6-12 league mark. The Razorbacks are in their first year under head coach **John Calipari**, who spent the previous 15 seasons at Kentucky and led the Wildcats to three Final Fours (2011, '12 and '15) and the 2012 national title.

▪ Arkansas was picked fourth out of 16 teams in the SEC preseason media poll while OU was picked 15th.

▪ OU entered its Jan. 4 game at No. 5/6 Alabama as one of two undefeated teams nationally (No. 1-ranked Tennessee was the other). This is the second year in a row the Sooners posted double-digit wins to start a season. They won their first 10 games in 2023-24 and began 13-0 this season. It is the only time in program history OU started 10-0 or better in consecutive seasons.

OU-ARKANSAS SERIES NOTES

▪ Although it trails the overall series 17-14, Oklahoma has won nine of its last 14 matchups against Arkansas. The Razorbacks hold a 9-3 advantage in games played in Fayetteville and have won the last three meetings there.

▪ All 14 of Oklahoma's wins over Arkansas have been by at least nine points, 12 have been by double digits, seven have been by at least 15 points and three have been by at least 20 points. OU's average victory margin is 15.1 points. Arkansas' average victory margin in the series is 7.5 points (only four wins have been by double digits and only one by more than 11 points).

▪ Oklahoma and Arkansas met each of the last three seasons in the Crimson and Cardinal Classic at the BOK Center in Tulsa, Okla. The Sooners won in 2021-22 (88-66) and 2023-24 (79-70), while the Razorbacks were victors in 2022-23 (88-78). The three games represent the only times OU's **Porter Moser** has faced Arkansas as a head coach.

▪ In last year's meeting on Dec. 9, guard **Javian McCollum** was one of four Sooners who scored in double figures, netting game highs of 20 points and four assists. OU shot .510 from the field and .389 (7 for 18) from 3-point range, while holding Arkansas to .400 and .222 (4 for 18) marks. The Sooners also posted a 33-25 rebounding advantage.

▪ Oklahoma's last win at Bud Walton Arena came on Nov. 30, 2001, when **Kelvin Sampson's** Sooners posted a 69-54 victory over **Nolan Richardson's** Hogs. It was OU's fourth win in four seasons against Arkansas. Wing **Ebi Ere** made 10 of 14 field goal attempts and hit all eight of his free throws en route to a 29-point night. Guard **Hollis Price** contributed 15 points and forward **Aaron McGhee** 11 points and seven boards, while West Memphis, Ark., native **Daryan Selvy** registered 13 rebounds off the bench. OU held Arkansas to .388 field goal and .133 (2 for 15) 3-point shooting, as no

Razorback scored in double figures. The Sooners, who also posted a 42-24 rebounding advantage, finished that season 31-5 and advanced to the Final Four.

- OU also won in Fayetteville in the 1938-39 season (49-36) and the 1999-00 campaign (66-52).

SOONERS CAN SHOOT

- Oklahoma and Texas are the only teams that rank in the SEC's top five in field goal, 3-point and free throw shooting. OU ranks second in the league in field goal percentage (.486), third in 3-point percentage (.370) and first in free throw shooting (.803).
- OU's top three scorers and four of its top five are shooting over 80% from the free throw line. **Jalon Moore** is shooting .851, **Jeremiah Fears** .833, **Duke Miles** .892 and **Brycen Goodine** .813.

LIVING AT THE LINE

- Freshman guard **Jeremiah Fears** and senior forward **Jalon Moore** rank second and fourth in the SEC in free throw makes with 90 and 86, respectively. They both rank in the top 12 in free throw percentage, with Moore shooting .851 (8th) and Fears shooting .833 (12th).

PICK YOUR POISON

- OU is the only team in the country with four players who have each scored at least 29 points in at least one game this season (**Jeremiah Fears** vs. Michigan [30], **Duke Miles** vs. Central Arkansas [29], **Brycen Goodine** vs. Texas A&M [34]) and **Jalon Moore** vs. Texas [29]). Only four programs have had three different players score at least 29 points in a game this season (Missouri, Texas, Louisville and East Tennessee State).
- OU leads the SEC with six players who have scored 20 or more points in at least one game this season: Moore (10 times), Fears (five times), Elvis (twice) and Godwin, Goodine and Miles (once each).

BREAKER, BREAKER

- Oklahoma has outscored 15 of its 18 opponents in fastbreak points and has tied twice (Georgia and Texas). The only team to outscore OU on the break this season was Oklahoma State, and that was by one point (8-7). The Sooners won, 80-65.

THE 3 IS KEY

- Oklahoma ranks 13th nationally and fourth in the 16-team SEC in 3-point field goal percentage defense, allowing opponents to shoot just .284 from behind the arc. The OU single-season record for 3-point field goal percentage defense is .292 in 2004-05. The Sooners have held opponents to a sub-33% 3-point shooting mark in 13 of 18 contests this season.
- On the other side of the court, OU ranks third in the SEC in 3-point field goal percentage offense (.370) and has shot over 30% from 3-point range in 14 games. It turned in a season-high .583 (14 for 24) effort against Texas A&M on Jan. 8.
- Arkansas ranks 14th in the SEC in 3-point field goal percentage offense (.325) and 11th in 3-point defense (.314).

STACKED SEC

- The SEC leads the country with an impressive nine teams ranked in this week's AP Top 25 (including five in the top nine and eight in the top 16): No. 1 Auburn, No. 4 Alabama, No. 5 Florida, No. 6 Tennessee, No. 9 Kentucky, No. 13 Texas A&M, No. 14 Mississippi State, No. 16 Ole Miss and No. 22 Missouri. Two more teams (Vanderbilt is 29th and Georgia is 30th) are receiving votes.
- The other three power conferences have a combined 12 teams ranked in this week's AP top 25. The Big Ten has six, the Big 12 four and the ACC two.
- Oklahoma plays 11 games (five home, six road) against the other nine ranked SEC teams this season, with Texas A&M and Missouri the only programs the Sooners will face twice. OU plays nine games against teams ranked in this week's top 16.

GOODINE'S GREAT NIGHT

- Oklahoma guard **Brycen Goodine** turned in one of the best 3-point shooting performances in school history Jan. 8 against Texas A&M in Norman, going 9 for 11 from deep and finishing with 34 points. It marked the most points by a Sooner since **Trae Young** scored 44 vs. Baylor on Jan. 30, 2018. Goodine's previous season high was 12 points. His career high of 40 came last year with Fairfield, against Siena.

▪ Goodine's nine 3-pointers tied for the fourth most in school history. **Brent Price** set the OU record of 11 treys (on 19 attempts) vs. Loyola Marymount in a 172-112 win on Dec. 15, 1990. **Trae Young** made 10 in a game during the 2017-18 season, as did **Calvin Curry** during the 1993-94 campaign. **Mookie Blaylock** (1988-89) and **Hollis Price** (2002-03) made nine in a contest.

▪ Goodine's nine triples were the most by an SEC player since Alabama's John Petty Jr. went 10 for 13 against Samford on Dec. 18, 2019.

▪ Among Sooners since 1997-98 who made at least seven 3-pointers in a game, Goodine's .818 conversion percentage against Texas A&M ranks as the second best. **Buddy Hield** went 7 for 7 against Southeastern Louisiana in the 2014-15 season.

▪ Goodine scored his first 20 points in a span of 6:06, helping the Sooners make a 25-10 run from the 15:11 to the 9:05 marks (from down 6-5 to up 30-16).

▪ His first 11 points came in a span of 1:55 and his first 17 came in a span of 4:07.

▪ In his eight home games, Goodine is averaging 10.6 points with the help of .489 3-point (22 for 45) and .917 free throw (11 for 12) shooting.

SUCCESS AGAINST THE SEC

▪ Including fellow first-year Southeastern Conference member Texas, Oklahoma is 243-198 all-time against SEC programs. OU has played all 15 other SEC programs and has winning records against eight of them.

▪ Since the start of the 2018-19 season, OU is 14-6 against SEC teams at the time of competition, including 3-0 in 2018-19, 2-0 in 2019-20 and 2-0 in 2020-21.

▪ OU's lone game against an SEC opponent last year was a 79-70 victory over Arkansas in Tulsa. It marked the second time in three seasons OU beat the Razorbacks in the Crimson and Cardinal Classic at BOK Center.

NO PLACE LIKE HOME

▪ Oklahoma has posted an 87-31 record at Lloyd Noble Center since 2017, including a 14-4 mark in 2023-24 and a 9-2 ledger this season. OU has won 82.6% of its games at LNC since it opened in 1975 (620-131 record).

▪ The 2024-25 campaign marks the 50th season of men's basketball at Lloyd Noble Center. The venue opened before the 1975-76 season and OU played its first game on Dec. 1, 1975, against Texas. The Sooners earned their first victory in the building on Jan. 31, 1976, beating Oklahoma State 57-42.

POLLING DATA

▪ After not being ranked in either of **Porter Moser's** first two seasons as head coach, Oklahoma has been ranked a total of 17 weeks over the past two seasons (high of No. 7 on Dec. 18, 2023). This season, OU climbed to as high as No. 12 in the AP poll (Dec. 23 and 30) and as high as No. 10 in the coaches poll (Dec. 30). The Sooners were ranked six straight ranked weeks this season (Dec. 2-Jan. 6) and received votes in both polls last week.

20 OR MOORE

▪ Senior forward **Jalon Moore** has scored at least 20 points a team-leading 10 times this season, including four times in the last six games. That also includes then-

career-high efforts of 24 points in the Battle 4 Atlantis semifinals against No. 24 Arizona and the championship game against Louisville.

▪ The Birmingham, Ala., product became the first Sooner since **Buddy Hield** in 2015-16 to open a season with three consecutive 20-plus point outings. Moore scored 22 points in the opener against Lindenwood and followed with 23 against Northwestern State and 21 against Stetson.

FEARS THE PHENOM

▪ Freshman guard **Jeremiah Fears** ranks second on OU, ninth overall in the SEC and eighth nationally among freshmen with his 16.8 points per game. He became the first OU freshman to score in double figures in each of his first 15 games since point guard **Trae Young** scored 10 or more in all 32 games in 2017-18 when he was national freshman of the year.

▪ Fears, who has been named SEC Freshman of the Week twice this season and on Jan. 7 was named to the Wooden Award Midseason Top 25 Watch List, is also averaging 4.0 rebounds and team highs of 4.4 assists and 1.9 steals per outing. He ranks second in the SEC in free throw makes (90) and fourth in attempts (108).

▪ Against Michigan at the Jumpman Invitational, Fears finished with a season-high 30 points on 8-for-12 shooting with four 3-pointers. He became the first OU true freshman since Young against West Virginia on Feb. 5, 2018, to score 30-plus points in a game.

▪ Fears made his first career start against East Texas A&M in the season's fourth game (has started every game since), finishing with 20 points, five assists, four rebounds and three steals.

GODWIN ON THE GLASS

▪ Super senior **Sam Godwin** ranks second on OU with his 5.9 rebounds per game and first with his 2.6 offensive boards per contest (ranks eighth in the SEC). Last season, he led the Big 12 with his 3.1 offensive rebounds per game. Interestingly, Godwin had more offensive rebounds than defensive boards in three of his first four collegiate seasons, including 97 offensive to 65 defensive last year.

▪ Godwin became the first Sooner since **Brady Manek** in 2018 to record 10-plus boards in the first three games of a season when he tallied 10-plus rebounds in the first three games of 2024-25 (career-high 15 vs. Lindenwood and 10 each vs. Northwestern State and Stetson). He registered 14 caroms in Oklahoma's Dec. 14 win over Oklahoma State.

2024 BATTLE 4 ATLANTIS CHAMPIONS

▪ Oklahoma won the 2024 Battle 4 Atlantis after beating Providence, then-No. 24 Arizona and Louisville on consecutive days (Nov. 27-29) in the Bahamas. Senior **Jalon Moore** was named tournament MVP and was joined by freshman **Jeremiah Fears** on the all-tournament team. Moore averaged 18.0 points and 5.3 rebounds per outing, recording back-to-back games of 24 points against the Wildcats and Cardinals. Fears averaged 18.7 points, 5.3 assists, 3.3 rebounds and 2.7 steals per outing. He scored 20 points against Providence and a then-career-high 26 against Arizona.

2025 RECRUITING CLASS

Oklahoma head coach **Porter Moser** announced the addition of three top-100 signees to the program's 2025 recruiting class on Nov. 13. **Kai Rogers** (6-10, F, Wauwatosa, Wis.), **Andreas Holst** (7-0, F, Aarhus, Denmark) and **Alec Blair** (6-7, G, Lafayette, Calif.) will join the Sooners as freshmen for the 2025-26 season.

KAI ROGERS (6-7, F, Wauwatosa, Wis.)

Ranked No. 77 in the 2025 class by On3 and No. 79 by ESPN ... Labeled a four-star prospect by On3, 247Sports, Rivals and ESPN ... Competed for Cold Hearts with Overtime Elite, averaging 12.0 points, 8.7 rebounds and 1.7 blocks in 25.9 minutes per outing ... Averaged 16.6 points per game on 66% shooting from the floor on the Under Armour Association (UAA) circuit, ranking as the second most efficient player (minimum of 12 positions per game) via Synergy Basketball ... Prepped at Wauwatosa West High School and averaged 20.0 points, 13.6 rebounds, 4.3 blocks, 3.5 assists and 1.4 steals per game as a junior ... Finished his time in Wisconsin with 1,000-plus career points.

- ANDREAS HOLST (7-0, F, Aarhus, Denmark)

Ranked No. 68 in the 2025 class by On3 ... Labeled a four-star prospect by On3 ... Played for Denmark at the FIBA U18 Championship, averaging 8.9 points, 2.6 rebounds and 1.4 blocks per outing over seven games ... Competed for the Bakken Bears in the Basketligeen (highest basketball league in Denmark) and averaged 6.2 points and 1.6 rebounds in 16 games ... Averaged 9.3 points and 3.4 rebounds in 23 outings for Bears Academy, an affiliate of the Bakken Bears.

- ALEC BLAIR (6-7, G, Lafayette, Calif.)

Plans to play both basketball and baseball (outfielder) at Oklahoma ... Labeled a four-star basketball prospect by 247Sports, ESPN and Rivals, and a three-star by On3 ... Ranked No. 49 nationally by 247Sports ... 2023-24 North Coast Section Player of the Year, EBAL League MVP and Cal-Hi Sports Player of the Year ... 2023-24 Cal-Hi Sports All-State Team selection ... Averaged 19.3 points, 6.7 rebounds and 4.3 assists per game as a junior at De La Salle High School (Concord, Calif.), guiding the Spartans to 25-6 and the Northern California Open Division playoffs ... Named 2024 San Francisco Chronicle's Contra Costa/Tri-Valley Regional Player of the Year ... West Coast Prep All-Bay Area First Team honoree in basketball and baseball ... Led De La Salle in points and rebounds since he was a freshman ... Rated as the No. 6 outfielder and No. 19 overall prospect in California and the No. 17 outfielder and No. 85 overall prospect nationally by Perfect Game ... Hit .373 with three home runs and 18 RBIs in limited action on the diamond his junior campaign ... Named to the 2024 PG Preseason Underclassmen All-America First Team and 2023 PG Preseason Underclassmen All-America Second Team ... It was the Sooners' third consecutive pre-conference multi-team event title under head coach **Porter Moser**, as they also won the 2022 ESPN Events Invitational and 2023 Rady Children's Invitational. OU beat Nebraska, Seton Hall, Ole Miss, Iowa, USC, Providence, Arizona and Louisville for an 8-0 combined record in those events.

OU 5-0 AGAINST ACC/BIG 12/BIG TEN

Oklahoma is 2-0 each against members of the ACC (beat Louisville and Georgia Tech in back-to-back games) and the Big 12 Conference (topped No. 24 Arizona in the Battle 4 Atlantis semifinals and Oklahoma State in Oklahoma City), and 1-0 against the Big Ten (beat No. 24 Michigan in the Jumpman Invitational). Through Wednesday, Louisville is in second place in the ACC (8-1), Arizona is in second place in the Big 12 (6-1) and Michigan is in second place in the Big Ten (6-1).

BEDLAM BOUT GOES TO SOONERS

Oklahoma and Oklahoma State met at Oklahoma City's Paycom Center on Saturday, Dec. 14, for the first time as non-league foes since the 1957-58 season, which was the year before OSU joined the Big Eight Conference. The Sooners posted an 80-65 victory in the 250th all-time Bedlam meeting on the hardwood.

Super senior **Sam Godwin** recorded a career-high 20 points and added 14 rebounds, three steals and two blocks in the win, becoming the first Sooner since **Blake Griffin** on Jan. 5, 2009, to reach those totals (Griffin had 20 points, 16 rebounds, 4 blocks, 3 steals vs. Maryland-Eastern Shore). Griffin and Godwin are the only two since 1996-97.

MAKE SHOTS, WIN GAMES

Under **Porter Moser**, Oklahoma is 35-5 when shooting 50% or better from the field, including 4-2 this season. OU finished 8-1 under the circumstance in 2023-24, 9-1 in 2022-23 and 14-1 in 2021-22.

REPLACING PRODUCTION

Eight players from last season's 20-win team are no longer with the program due to exhausted eligibility or the transfer portal, including starting guards Milos Uzan, Otega Oweh and Javian McCollum (all transferred), and key reserves Rivaldo Soares and Le'Tre Darthard (both exhausted eligibility).

The eight departed players combined for 73.4% of the team's points, 62.6% of its rebounds and 87.6% of its assists. McCollum averaged a team-high 13.3 points and made a team-leading 54 3-pointers. Uzan dished out a team-high 4.3 assists per outing and added 9.0 points and 3.4 rebounds a contest. Oweh averaged 11.4 points, 3.8 rebounds and 1.5 steals per outing.

10 NEW PLAYERS

Oklahoma welcomed six players from the transfer portal since the end of last season: graduate guards **Kobe Elvis** (Dayton/DePaul), **Brycen Goodine** (Syracuse/Providence/Fairfield) and **Jadon Jones** (Long Beach State), graduate forward/center **Mohamed Wague** (Harcum College/West Virginia/Alabama), redshirt senior guard **Duke Miles** (Troy/High Point) and senior guard **Glenn Taylor Jr.** (Oregon State/St. John's). They also brought in a junior college transfer in junior

guard **Jeff Nwankwo** (Tulane/Cowley College) and three high schoolers in guards **Jeremiah Fears** and **Dayton Forsythe** and forward **Kuol Atak**.

ELVIS HITS 1,000

Graduate guard **Kobe Elvis** entered the SEC opener at Alabama with 993 career points and scored 13 on the day to boost him to 1,006 (he now has 1,039). Elvis, who played one season at DePaul and the last three at Dayton (started 80 of his 86 games with the Flyers), has been a model of scoring consistency. He averaged between 8.5 and 9.4 points each of his three seasons at Dayton and is averaging 9.2 with the Sooners.

GRAD SCHOOL

Five players on the 2024-25 Oklahoma roster — four of them first-year Sooners — are working on their master's degrees. **Kobe Elvis** (Dayton), **Brycen Goodine** (Fairfield), **Jadon Jones** (Long Beach State) and **Mohamed Wague** (Alabama) graduated from their previous schools, while **Sam Godwin** graduated from OU in December.

SOONERS IN THE NBA

Three Sooners are on NBA rosters for the 2024-25 season: **Trae Young** (Atlanta Hawks), **Buddy Hield** (Golden State Warriors) and **Austin Reaves** (Los Angeles Lakers).

NEW STAFF MEMBERS

Oklahoma added **Josh Oppenheimer** as an assistant coach in the offseason. Oppenheimer brings 15-plus years of NBA and NCAA DI experience to the program, including time with the Milwaukee Bucks, Brooklyn Nets and Houston Rockets. Oppenheimer most recently finished his second stint as an assistant coach with the Bucks, helping the team win the 2021 NBA championship and four Central Division titles.

In addition to Oppenheimer, **Ty Terrell** joined the staff as director of men's basketball strength and conditioning and **Tom Fox** as director of analytics and video coordinator.

Praised for his ability to create culture and his never-tiring energy, University of Oklahoma head men's basketball coach Porter Moser enters his fourth season leading the Sooners in 2024-25. Moser was hired on April 3, 2021, becoming the 15th head coach in program history.

In his third season leading the program in 2023-24, Moser guided the Sooners to a 20-12 mark, ranking as high as seventh in the AP Poll. Oklahoma reached 20 regular season wins for the first time since 2015-16 and began the season 10-0, tying the 1991-92 and 2003-04 seasons for the seventh-best start in program history. OU bested Iowa and USC at the Rady Children's Invitational, claiming its second consecutive midseason tournament title. In addition to team success, Javian McCollum and Jalon Moore earned All-Big 12 honorable mention accolades.

Moser completed his second season in Norman in 2022-23, recording four AP Top-25 victories and winning the 2022 ESPN Events Invitational. Tanner Groves became only the second two-time College Sports Communicators (formerly CoSIDA) Academic All-American in program history, receiving third-team honors in 2023 and first-team accolades in 2022. In addition to the Sooners' success in the classroom, Milos Uzan was named to the Big 12 All-Freshman Team. Grant Sherfield and Jalen Hill received All-Big 12 Honorable Mention acclaim.

In 2021-22, Moser led the Sooners to a 19-16 mark and five victories over teams ranked in the top 25 at the time of competition. Oklahoma was selected as a No. 1 seed in the National Invitation Tournament, earning an opening-round victory over Missouri State at Lloyd Noble Center.

Umoja Gibson, Jordan Goldwire, Groves and Elijah Harkless earned All-Big 12 honorable mention honors, and C.J. Noland earned a spot on the Big 12 All-Freshman Team. In addition to the on-court success, Groves was tabbed a Senior CLASS Award Finalist and named to the CoSIDA Academic All-America First Team.

Moser received the keys to the Oklahoma men's basketball program as one of the most successful coaches of the prior half-decade. He has been entrenched in creating and developing team culture at all his stops.

Before his time in Norman, Moser led the Loyola Ramblers to remarkable success during his 10-year run as head coach, including a run to the Final Four in 2018 and Sweet Sixteen in 2021.

He amassed 188 wins (188-141, .571), including five seasons with 20-plus victories. He led Loyola to the postseason every year it was available from 2017-21, winning the 2017 CBI title and qualifying for the 2019 NIT. The 2020 postseason was canceled due to COVID-19.

In addition to his team success, he coached 12 all-conference selections, two Missouri Valley Player of the Year honorees, two Associated Press Honorable Mention All-Americans, two Academic All-Americans, a MVC Defensive Player of the Year, two MVC Sixth Man of the Year honorees and a pair of MVC Freshman of the Year selections.

Moser was one of three coaches in Loyola's history to record 150-plus wins. He guided the 2017-18 squad to a school record 32 victories and an appearance in the Final Four – Loyola's first appearance since winning the 1963 NCAA Championship.

After assembling a 25-5 regular season record (15-3 in MVC play), Moser guided Loyola to seven straight postseason wins, claiming the 2018 Missouri Valley tournament title and making a historic run to the pinnacle event of college basketball as a No. 11 seed.

The Ramblers were just the fourth No. 11 seed to advance to the Final Four, earning wins over Miami, Tennessee, Nevada and Kansas State.

Loyola finished the 2017-18 season ranked No. 7 in the final USA Today Coaches Poll. Moser was named the Missouri Valley Conference (MVC) Coach of the Year and the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) District 16 Coach of the Year.

The 2017-18 squad ranked second in the nation in fewest personal fouls per game (13.9), third in field goal percentage (.507) and sixth in scoring defense (62.6 ppg).

During the 2017-18 season, Rambler guard Clayton Custer was named MVC Player of the Year and earned Associated Press (AP) Honorable Mention All-America honors, becoming the first player in Loyola history to receive both in the same season.

Cameron Krutwig earned MVC Freshman of the Year honors and Ben Richardson was named MVC Defensive Player of the Year. In addition to his on-court success, Custer was named CoSIDA Academic All-District. He is in his fourth year working with the Sooners and second as an assistant coach in 2024-25 after two seasons as the director of video operations and player development from 2021-23

Moser boasts six NCAA Tournament wins from 2018-21 – tied for the seventh most nationally in that time frame. Loyola, Gonzaga and Houston were the only teams outside major conferences to reach two Sweet 16s during the three-year run.

In his final season at Loyola, Moser led the Ramblers to a 26-5 record and Missouri Valley Conference regular season and tournament titles in the 2020-21 season. As an eighth seed in the NCAA Tournament, his squad upset No. 1-seed Illinois in the second round to advance to the Sweet 16 for the second time since 2018.

The 2020-21 Rambler squad ranked second in adjusted defensive efficiency (KenPom.com), allowing only 87.0 points per 100 possessions. Loyola's 16-2 record in MVC play set a program record for most wins in conference action.

After 19 wins during the 2014-15 season, the Ramblers earned a bid to the College Basketball Invitational (CBI), advancing to Loyola's first postseason appearance since the 1985 season. Loyola made the most of its chance at postseason play, winning the CBI Championship over Louisiana-Monroe with back-to-back victories in the best-of-three championship series.

After rebuilding during the 2013-14 season, Moser led the Ramblers to a 24-13 mark next season. The 24 victories were the most by a Moser led team and the most for Loyola since 1985.

In the early stages of building Loyola to a mid-major powerhouse, Moser led the Ramblers to an eight-game improvement in the win column from his first season at the helm to his second in 2012-13. The improvement was the most by a coach from his first year to his second in program history.

Owner of a 359-287 (.556) career record, Moser was hired for his first head coaching job in 2000 at Arkansas-Little Rock. In three seasons with the Trojans, Moser took over a program that went 4-24 during the season before his hiring and went 18-11 just one year later.

The Trojans ranked last in the conference in several defensive categories before his tenure. Moser turned the program around in one season, finishing with the Sun Belt's best field goal percentage defense and second-best scoring defense.

He steered the Trojans to a 54-34 overall record before heading to Illinois State in 2003.

After his 2003-04 squad notched a 10-19 record, Moser improved to 17-13 in 2004-05 despite being picked to finish last in the league in the preseason poll.

Following four years at Illinois State, Moser worked under legendary coach Rick Majerus at Saint Louis as an assistant coach from 2007 through 2011. He returned to a head coaching role by being named Loyola's head coach before the 2011-12 season.

A Chicago area native, Moser grew up in Naperville, Ill. He was a two-year starter at Creighton and helped lead the Jays to the 1989 Missouri Valley Conference title and a berth in the NCAA Tournament. He graduated in 1990 with a degree in business management.

Immediately following his collegiate playing career, Moser began his path in coaching at his alma mater as a graduate assistant. He left Creighton for an assistant coach role at Texas A&M for four seasons followed by a year at Wisconsin-Milwaukee. Moser returned to Texas A&M for two more seasons (1996-98) on the Aggies' bench, then served as an assistant coach at Little Rock for two years before his promotion to head coach.

Moser and his wife, Megan, have four children – Jordan, a former OU's women's basketball player and current member of the staff, Jake, a senior on the men's basketball team, and Max and Ben.
