## CONFERENCE NOTES

### Player of the Week

• During Alabama's 47-point victory over Jacksonville (93-46) on Sunday, Aaliyah Nye led the Crimson Tide with a career-high 30 points which included shooting 75 percent (9-of-12) from the field, 80 percent (8-of-10) from deep and 80 percent (4-of-5) from the free-throw line. The guard tied her own school record with most three-pointers made in a single game with eight, while moving into fifth on the program's career three-point field goals made list with 240. Nye currently ranks first in the Southeastern Conference in three-point field goals made this season with 52 with also ranking third in the country.

### Co-Freshmen of the Week

• Miyah Verse recorded her first career double-double and set new career-high marks in points (15), rebounds (11) and steals (3) during Georgia's 83-50 win against Ohio. She was perfect from the field on the day, knocking in 5-of-5 shots, setting a new career best with five made field goals. She played her best in the second half, totaling 10 points and seven boards in the final 20 minutes. Verse is part of a talented freshman class that scored 53 of Georgia's points on Saturday with three rookies scoring in double figures. Verse and the Georgia freshmen have helped the Lady Bulldogs win three of their last four games during non-conference action.

• Tennessee's Kaniya Boyd enjoyed the finest performance of her career by far on Sunday vs. Winthrop, firing in a career-best 15 points on 5-of-5 accuracy from the field and matching career highs with four assists and three rebounds as Tennessee improved to 12-0 for the first time since 2017-18 and the seventh time in school history. She ended up four of five from the free-throw line, improving her percentage on the season to 82.4 percent. Her five field goals were more than the four total she amassed in her past five games, and her 15 points were more than the 11 combined over the past six contests.

### Around the League

• South Carolina's Joyce Edwards led the team in scoring for the third-straight game with her 16 points against Wofford. She was efficient, hitting 7-of-10 from the field while

grabbing four rebounds and handing out a career-high three assists.

• In just 25 minutes of action, Beers notched her sixth double-double of the season behind a 19-point, 12-rebound performance in which the center added a career-high four blocks.

• Kyla Oldacre tied her career-high with 21 points on 6-of-6 shooting from the field and 9-of-10 from the free-throw line to help the Longhorns to a 94-35 win over UTRGV. Oldacre is shooting over 66 percent from the field for the season. Oldacre also tallied seven rebounds and three steals in the contest.

• Georgia Amoore became the team's leading scorer on the season after recording her fourth straight 20+ point game on Saturday. She put up 21 points on 8-of-15 (53.3 percent) to help Kentucky defeat Western Kentucky for the first time since 2003. Amoore has now been the leading scorer in snapping two big in-state losing streaks, also including her 19 points to take down Louisville for the first time since 2015.

• Florida's Ra Shaya Kyle secured another double-double in week eight of non-conference action. Kyle tallied 16 points and snagged 11 rebounds during her 19 minutes on the hardwood versus Alabama State. Kyle had 30 percent of UF's rebounds to lead the Gators on the boards.

## 2025 SEC TOURNAMENT

Beginning with its inception and through 1986, the tournament was held at campus sites. The tournament was then sent to Albany, Ga., which served as the site for six years from 1987-92. The tournament then moved to Chattanooga, Tenn., where it was held from 1993-2000, with the exception of 1998 when the tournament moved to Columbus, Ga.

Since 2001 the tournament has enjoyed many new sites, including Memphis (2001), Nashville (2002, 2004, 2008, 2011, 2012, 2018, 2022), Little Rock, Ark. (2003, 2006, 2009, 2015), Greenville, S.C. (2005, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021, 2023, 2024, 2025), Duluth, Ga. (2007, 2010, 2013, 2014) and Jacksonville, Fla. (2016).

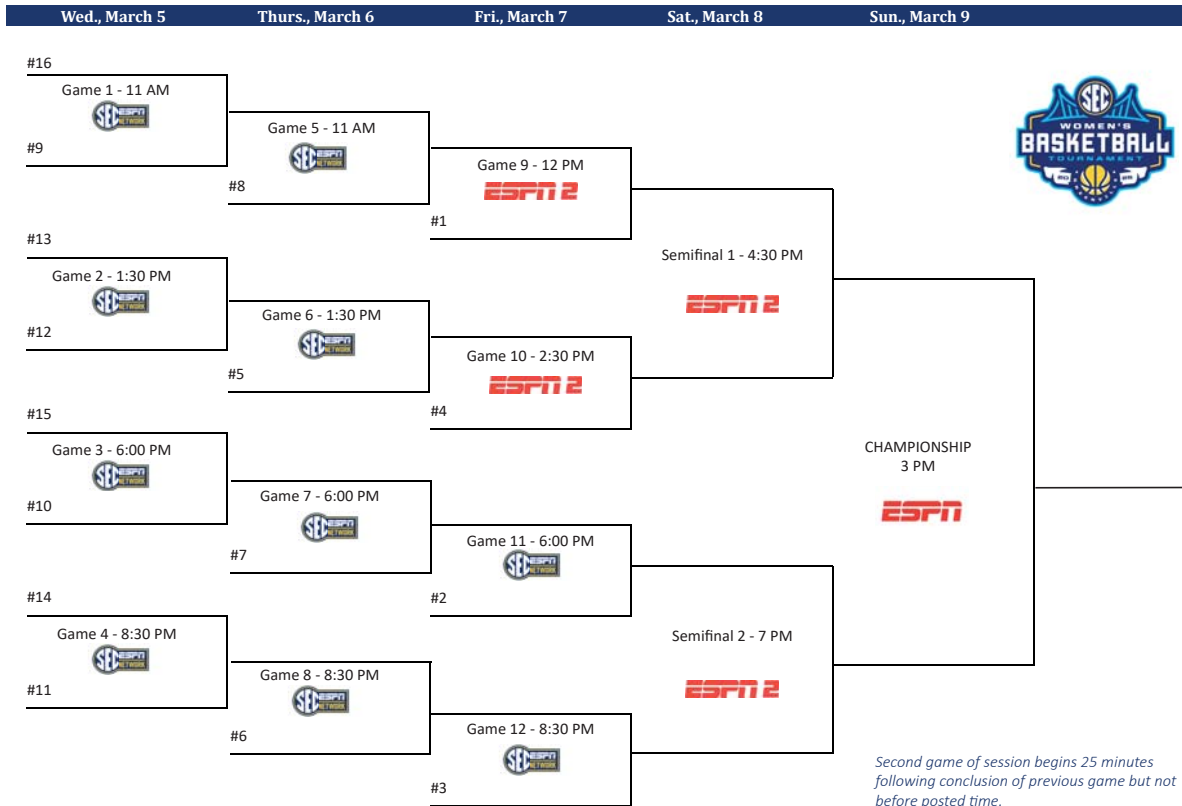
The conference announced a three-year extension with Greenville, S.C. to host the SEC Women's Basketball Tournament in 2026, 2027 and 2028.

The winner of the tournament receives the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament.

The event has helped set the stage for SEC teams in the NCAA Tournament, as 31 of the conference tournament champions have advanced to at least the Sweet 16. Four of the last 14 SEC Tournament champions have gone on to win the national championship. The SEC Tournament Champion has failed to win at least one NCAA Tournament game only twice.

Tennessee leads the league with 17 SEC Tournament titles. South Carolina is second with eight, Vanderbilt has six, while Auburn, Georgia, each have four. LSU has two with Kentucky, Mississippi State and Texas A&M having each won one SEC Tournament championship.

### BY THE NUMBERS

- In regular season games, the SEC has compiled a 6174-1789 (.775) record against other conferences. In the postseason, SEC teams are 560-293 (.657) against non-conference teams. Overall, teams are 6734-2082 (.764).
- The league has recorded 150+ wins in 29 seasons and has recorded a non-conference winning percentage below .700 only once.
- Since the SEC began to sponsor women's basketball in 1982, it has failed only six times to place at least four members in each of the final polls (the USA Today/ESPN poll began in 1986).
- The most SEC teams in the final AP poll is seven, which the league has done four times (1996, 1997, 2003, and 2018).
- Overall, the league teams have been ranked every week except for the very first poll in 1976.
- The league has had the top three teams in the AP Poll twice. In week three in 2005 and in week eight in 1989.
- SEC schools have produced 53 Team USA Olympians since 1976, with 49 coming since the SEC began sponsoring women's basketball. In addition, 10 have played for other countries in the Olympics.
- In 2023, a total of 1,146,341 fans passed through SEC turnstiles during home games and conference tournament action. Overall, the league has five of the Top 10 total attendance seasons.
