## CONFERENCE NOTES

### Player of the Week

• Madison Booker scored 28 points on 13-of-19 shooting from the field to lead Texas to an 89-51 victory over No. 8 Maryland in the Coretta Scott King Classic in Newark, N.J. Booker had 20 point at the half of the game. It was her eighth game of the season scoring 20 or more points and it helped Texas to their largest margin of victory over a top-10 team in program history. Booker scored 22 points to help Texas to a road win at Auburn earlier in the week. For the week Booker averaged 25 points per game and shot 19-of-31 (.613) from the field and 50 percent from 3-point range, while hitting 9-of-11 (.818) from the charity stripe.

### Freshman of the Week

• South Carolina's Joyce Edwards led the Gamecocks in scoring in a pair of commanding wins over ranked opponents last week. Her 19.0 points per game came on a team-best 75.0 percent shooting from the field and 80.0 percent accuracy from the free throw line. She scored 11 of her career-high 21 points at Alabama in the fourth quarter, including nine during the late rally after the Tide had pulled within five points. She hit 3-of-3 free throws in that stretch, including a finishing a traditional three-point play that made it a 16-point game. Edward posted a team-high 17 points against Oklahoma, leading the team in scoring for the seventh time this season. Seven of those points game in the second quarter, accounting for a third of the team's points in the period. For the season, Edwards' 13 games in double-figure points is tied for the team lead.

### Around the League

- South Carolina's Milaysia Fulwiley poured in 15.5 points, 4.0 assists and 1.5 blocks per game over the Gamecocks' two commanding wins over ranked opponents last week.
- Since the beginning of conference play, Ole Miss freshman Sira Thienou has recorded 29 steals for an average of 4.8 per game. Thienou led all SEC freshmen in points with 39 and her eight steals per game was the most by any mens or womens player in the nation during last week's competitions.
- The Crimson Tide made 12 three-pointers against Ole

Miss, with Aaliyah Nye leading the way with seven. With those seven made three-pointers, Nye is tied at the top of the NCAA for the most games with seven-plus made three-pointers during the 2024-25 season (3).

- Georgia freshman forward Miyah Verse recorded 27 total rebounds this week, including a career and game high 17 boards at Texas A&M. The 17 rebounds against the Aggies marked the third-most for a Georgia freshman in program history and was the best single-game performance by a Lady Bulldog rookie since 2017.
- Clara Strack led Kentucky with a career-high-tying 25 points and 12 rebounds for her seventh double-double of the season (and her second straight). It marked her fifth 20+ point game and her ninth 10+ rebound game.
- Vanderbilt's victory over the No. 15/15-ranked Lady Vols marks the Commodores' first win against a ranked team since knocking off No. 15/21-ranked Florida, 63-59, back on Feb. 24, 2022, at Memorial Gymnasium. It is also the second time the Dores have beaten a ranked opponent in the Ralph era.

## 2025 SEC TOURNAMENT

Beginning with its inception and through 1986, the tournament was held at campus sites. The tournament was then sent to Albany, Ga., which served as the site for six years from 1987-92. The tournament then moved to Chattanooga, Tenn., where it was held from 1993-2000, with the exception of 1998 when the tournament moved to Columbus, Ga.

Since 2001 the tournament has enjoyed many new sites, including Memphis (2001), Nashville (2002, 2004, 2008, 2011, 2012, 2018, 2022), Little Rock, Ark. (2003, 2006, 2009, 2015), Greenville, S.C. (2005, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021, 2023, 2024, 2025), Duluth, Ga. (2007, 2010, 2013, 2014) and Jacksonville, Fla. (2016).

The conference announced a three-year extension with Greenville, S.C. to host the SEC Women's Basketball Tournament in 2026, 2027 and 2028.

The winner of the tournament receives the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament.

The event has helped set the stage for SEC teams in the NCAA Tournament, as 31 of the conference tournament champions have advanced to at least the Sweet 16. Four of the last 14 SEC Tournament champions have gone on to win the national championship. The SEC Tournament Champion has failed to win at least one NCAA Tournament game only twice.

Tennessee leads the league with 17 SEC Tournament titles. South Carolina is second with eight, Vanderbilt has six, while Auburn, Georgia, each have four. LSU has two with Kentucky, Mississippi State and Texas A&M having each won one SEC Tournament championship.

BY THE NUMBERS

- In regular season games, the SEC has compiled a 6175-1789 (.775) record against other conferences. In the postseason, SEC teams are 560-293 (.657) against non-conference teams. Overall, teams are 6735-2082 (.764).
- The league has recorded 150+ wins in 29 seasons and has recorded a non-conference winning percentage below .700 only once.
- Since the SEC began to sponsor women's basketball in the 1981-82 season, it has failed only six times to place at least five members in each of the final polls (the USA Today/ESPN poll began in the 1985-1986 season).
- The most SEC teams in the final AP poll is seven, which the league has done five times (1995, 1996, 1997, 2003, and 2018).
- Overall, the league teams have been ranked every week except for the very first poll in 1976.
- The league has had the top three teams in the AP Poll twice. In week three in 2005 and in week eight in 1989.
- SEC schools have produced 53 Team USA Olympians since 1976, with 49 coming since the SEC began sponsoring women's basketball. In addition, 10 have played for other countries in the Olympics.
- In 2023, a total of 1,146,341 fans passed through SEC turnstiles during home games and conference tournament action. Overall, the league has five of the Top 10 total attendance seasons.
