#### THE STARTING FIVE

▶ No. 16 Oklahoma (20-6, 8-5 SEC) looks to extend its winning streak to five games on Sunday when it faces Arkansas at Bud Walton Arena. The Sooners are two games behind Kentucky for the No. 4 spot in the SEC standings with three to play, with the top four seeds earning a bye into the quarterfinals in Greenville. Sunday's tip in Fayetteville against the Razorbacks (9-19, 2-11 SEC) is set for 2 p.m. CT on SEC Network+.

▶The Sooners have been dominant against unranked opponents this season, **outscoring teams outside the AP Top 25 by an average of 27.8 points per game**, with seven wins of 30+ points. Against unranked SEC foes, Oklahoma is 7-1 with the lone loss coming on the road at Mississippi State.

▶ The Sooners head into Sunday night ranked 16th in the AP poll and WBCA Coaches poll but 15th in the NET ranking. Oklahoma has appeared in every AP poll this season, opening at No. 10 and climbing as high as No. 8. The team is currently on a 24-week streak appearing in the AP poll — the fourth longest in program history and the longest since a 40-week run from 2015 to 2017.

▶ Oklahoma has navigated the 22nd-toughest schedule in the nation this season, facing eight top-25 opponents and three more matchups against teams receiving votes in the AP poll. **The Sooners have secured five Quad 1 wins, the seventh most in the country,** with one more Quad 1 contest on the docket (March 2 vs. Alabama).

▶ The NCAA Selection Committee ranked Oklahoma No. 15 in its first NCAA Top 16 reveal on Feb. 16. If the NCAA Tournament started today, the Sooners would be a No. 4 seed, hosting first- and second-round games at Lloyd Noble Center for the first time since 2022. Oklahoma has faced six teams within the top 16, as the SEC leads all conferences with six teams above the cut.

#### **NOTE OF THE NIGHT**

►The Sooners have officially hit their stride offensively, eclipsing 100 points for a program-record fifth time in a single season with Thursday night's win over Vanderbilt in Norman. Under head coach Jennie Baranczyk (2021—present), Oklahoma has reached triple digits 12 times, fourth most in the country during that span. The Sooners' three McDonald's All-Americans — Raegan Beers (17.0 PPG), Payton Verhulst (15.1 PPG), and Sahara Williams (10.5 PPG) — all score in double figures, while 2024 Big 12 Player of the Year Skylar Vann adds 9.9 PPG. Oklahoma is averaging a program record 86.1 points per game this season.

▶ Playing in the SEC/Big 12 Challenge in North Little Rock, Ark., the Oklahoma women's basketball team dropped a 71-64 decision to Arkansas Sunday at the Verizon Arena. The setback was the third-straight for the Sooners, who fell to 5-5 on the season. The Razorbacks improved to 9-2 with the victory.

### LAST TIME OUT: #16 OKLAHOMA 101, VANDERBILT 81

▶ Raegan Beers scored a career-high 30 points shooting 11 for 13 and grabbed a season-high 14 rebounds and 16th-ranked Oklahoma beat Vanderbilt 101-81 on Thursday night for the Sooners' fourth straight win. Payton Verhulst and freshman Zya Vann scored 16 points each for the Sooners (20-6, 8-5 SEC), who shot 52.2% (36 for 69). Vanderbilt stayed within close proximity and faced just a 43-37 deficit at halftime. But Oklahoma all but sealed it in the third quarter when it took a 55-51 advantage and grew it to a 77-54 lead. Vanderbilt went scoreless for 2:09 and 3:51 in the quarter.

### A WIN WOULD...

▶ Improve the Sooners to 44-7 against unranked conference teams under Baranczyk and 8-1 this season.

► Mark Oklahoma's first five-game winning streak in SEC play and the longest streak since the Sooners won six in a row in December.

► Secure Oklahoma's ninth conference victory, guaranteeing a winning record for the fourth season under Baranczyk. Entering the season OU had finished .500 or better in 24 of the last 26 seasons.

### **NEW CONFERENCE, SAME GOALS**

▶The 2024-25 season marks Oklahoma's inaugural campaign in the Southeastern Conference (SEC), officially joining the league on July 1, 2024.

▶ Oklahoma was **picked to finish fourth in both the SEC media and coaches' preseason polls**. In Coach Baranczyk's three seasons at OU, her teams have outperformed their preseason projections each time. Across her 12-year head coaching career (nine seasons at Drake and three at OU), Baranczyk's teams have met or exceeded preseason expectations in 10 seasons.

- ► Entering the season, under Baranczyk, Oklahoma was 7-4 vs. teams in the SEC, and 4-1 vs. SEC teams that were in the league prior to this season.
- ►In Oklahoma's 28 years in the Big 12 Conference, Oklahoma won 12 conference championships, reaching the NCAA Tournament 21 times. All-time, Oklahoma posted a 367-269 record vs. Big 12 teams.
- ► For Oklahoma to meet or exceed conference expectations this year, they must win out (at Arkansas, at Florida, vs. Alabama) and hope Kentucky loses its next three (vs. LSU, vs. USC, at Tennessee).

#### 50 YEARS AT LLOYD NOBLE CENTER

▶ This season marks Oklahoma's 50th at Lloyd Noble Center, where the Sooners got their first home win on Jan. 31, 1976, with a 44-38 win over East Central (Okla.), In total, the Sooners have amassed a 473-174 (.731) record at the LNC, welcoming over 1.99 million fans through its doors. The program set a historic milestone by winning 25

consecutive games at the arena from 1984 to 1986.



- OU is 52-10 at Lloyd Noble Center under Baranczyk (2021-present).

- ▶The program will welcome its two-millionth fan to the LNC on March 2 against Alabama.
- ► In the Baranczyk era, Oklahoma has posted a 52-10 (12-2 this season) home record, including a 27-7 mark in home conference play and a 25-3 record in home nonconference matchups.

### **PULSE OF THE POLLS**

- Oklahoma is the No. 16 team in the AP Poll for the second straight week. OU rose as high as No. 8 in the Nov. 25 poll. The Sooners checked in at 16th in the WBCA Coaches Poll on Feb. 11.
- ► OU opened the 2024-25 season ranked 10th in both the AP and WBCA Coaches polls, marking the team's highest preseason ranking since 2010. It was also Oklahoma's first top-10 appearance in the AP poll since Nov. 18, 2013, when the team was similarly ranked at No. 10.
- ► Oklahoma currently boasts an active streak of 24 consecutive weeks in the AP poll, the fourth longest in program history. The active streak is the longest stretch since a 40-week period between 2015-17.

#### THE MARCH TO MADNESS

► In the latest ESPN bracketology by Charlie Creme on Feb. 21. Oklahoma was tabbed as a No. 4 seed, which

would provide hosting duties in the tournament for the second time of the Baranczyk era (2022).

- ▶The NCAA Selection Committee ranked Oklahoma No. 15 in its first NCAA Top 16 reveal on Feb. 16. If the NCAA Tournament started today, the Sooners would be a No. 4 seed, hosting first- and second-round games at Lloyd Noble Center for the first time since 2022. Oklahoma has faced six teams within the top 16, as the SEC leads all conferences with six teams above the cut.
- A staple of the NCAA postseason, Oklahoma has appeared in 24 NCAA Tournaments, including 22 since the turn of the century and three straight under Baranczyk.
- ▶ Of Oklahoma's 29 regular season opponents, 13 are in the latest bracket on ESPN, including four from its nonconference slate (UNLV [W], Duke [L], Louisville [W] and Michigan [W]).

### **BUILDING THE RÉSUMÉ**

- ▶The Sooners are ranked 15th in the latest NET rankings and have maintained a spot in the top-16 since the first ranking was released in December.
- ▶ OU's non-conference slate featured four projected NCAA Tournament teams Duke, Louisville, Michigan and UNLV (78-27 combined record). The Sooners won at Louisville, a feat matched only by No. 2 Notre Dame and No. 10 NC State. They also routed UNLV by 30 in Vegas, snapping a 13-game home winning streak and beat then-No. 20 Michigan by double digits on a neutral floor.
- ▶ 0U has played the nation's 22nd-toughest schedule and ranks seventh nationally in Quad 1 wins with five. The Sooners are 12-6 vs. top-100 teams (13th most wins nationally) and unbeaten in Quad 2-4 games (14-0), one of just 13 teams with a perfect record in such matchups.
- ▶ OU has been battle-tested against elite competition, with five of its six losses coming against teams in the NCAA selection committee's Top 16, including four against top-10 teams. Outside of the game at South Carolina, every OU loss has come by 10 points or less.

### **EXPERIENCE PAYING DIVIDENDS**

- ▶The Sooners returned a nation-leading 98% of their scoring from last season's Big 12 championship team, including all five starters and 11 letterwinners. Leading the way are 2024 Big 12 Co-Player of the Year Skylar Vann and last year's Big 12 Newcomer of the Year Payton Verhulst. They're joined by standout transfer and All-American 6'4" center Raegan Beers, along with All-Big 12 honorees Sahara Williams and Nevaeh Tot.
- ▶ Oklahoma doesn't just return talent it returns experienced talent. The Sooners have combined to play over 1,250 games in their careers. The 14-player roster has amassed 561 combined starts.
- ▶ The Sooners' projected starting five, with Reyna Scott replacing Nevaeh Tot (124 career starts), combines for 250 career starts. Scott, who debuted as a starter against Georgia, joins a seasoned lineup led by Skylar Vann (65 starts), Raegan Beers (61), Sahara Williams (59), and Payton Verhulst (58).
- ▶ Off the bench, Oklahoma boasts two players with over 100 career starts in Tot (124) and Lexy Keys (104), as well as Liz Scott who has 63 (started in place of Beers at Ole Miss and vs. Auburn). Five different Sooners have played in over 100 career games.
- Six Sooners have graduated with undergraduate degrees and are pursuing their graduate degrees.

#### **ROSTER LOADED WITH TALENT**

- ▶ Oklahoma's experienced roster draws plenty of attention, but it's no secret that the Sooners are also one of the most talented teams in the nation. The Sooners' starting five features three McDonald's All-Americans (Beers, Verhulst, Williams) while OU's remaining two starters include Skylar Vann, the 2024 Big 12 Player of the Year, and Reyna Scott.
- ► Five Oklahoma players were five-star recruits in high school: Sahara Williams, Payton Verhulst, Aubrey Joens, Liz Scott, and Raegan Beers.
- ► Eight members of the 14-player roster were ranked as top-100 players in their class by ESPN: Raegan Beers (#10), Payton Verhulst (#12), Sahara Williams (#23), Zya Vann (#46), Aubrey Joens (#52), Caya Smith (#72), Liz Scott (#76), and Beatrice Culliton (#96).

### **SCORING STAMPEDE**

- ►If you want to see one of the fastest and most prolific offenses in the country, then watch OU basketball. The Sooners are one of four teams (lowa, LSU and S. Carolina) to average 80.0 PPG three times since 2021-22. Since Baranczyk arrived in Norman, OU has averaged 81.7 points per game and the Sooners lead the nation in pace (79.4) this season.
- ▶ Oklahoma's 86.1 points per game in 2024-25 rank fifth nationally and the Sooners' FG% of 47.3% is the 13th highest in Division I. Additionally, OU's 21.7 assists per game rank second in Division I. OU's program record for PPG in a season is 84.5 PPG in 1984-85.
- ► Baranczyk's teams are known for prolific offense and the head coach has delivered in Norman. In her Oklahoma tenure, the Sooners have **posted 90+ points 37 times** (2nd in NCAA since start of 2021-22 season).
- ► Since the start of the 2021-22 season, Oklahoma has eclipsed 100 points 12 times, the fourth most in Division I. The 2025 Sooners have reached 100 points a program record five times, including a school record 122 points vs. Western Carolina and two 100-point outputs in SEC play (at LSU, vs. Vandy).
- ► The Sooners opened this season by scoring 70+ points in a program-record-tying 18 straight games and have scored 70 points 24 times this season (4th NCAA).

- ▶ **Nevaeh Tot** is poised to break the program record for career games played (151), set by Taylor Robertson (2019-23), as the fifth-year guard has appeared in 149 games for OU entering the contest.
- ▶OU has already etched its name in the record books this season, setting program highs for points in a game (122 vs. WCU), points in a half (68 vs. ASU) and 100-point games with five.

#### **CLEANING UP ON THE GLASS**

- ▶The Sooners rank third nationally in rebounds per game (46.58) and rebounding margin (+12.8).
- ▶ Oklahoma has outrebounded nine of its SEC opponents and is +7.4 on the glass in conference play.
- ▶ Oklahoma is 29-1 (only loss is vs. Kentucky on Feb. 2, 2025) under Baranczyk when grabbing 50 or more rebounds and is 73-15 over the last four seasons when winning the rebounding battle.
- ▶This season, OU is 18-3 when outrebounding its opponent and 2-3 when losing on the glass.

- ▶While Oklahoma's offense often steals the spotlight, the Sooners' defense is equally impressive. The Sooners have held 21 of their 25 opponents below their average FG% and under their average points per game. On average, Oklahoma limits opponents to 6.1 fewer points per game while forcing them to shoot 6.7% worse from the field. OU has held 11 opponents to 10+ points under their average, including five times in SEC play.
- ► OU's defensive rating of 86.6 (pts/100 poss.) would be the program's best since the 2015-16 team produced a 84.0 DTRG.
- ► Transfer center Raegan Beers has been a difference maker in the interior. When she's on the floor, Oklahoma's defense ranks in the 99th percentile and teams shoot just 31.6% in the paint.
- ►The Sooners are undefeated (18-0) when holding their opponent under 80 points and just 2-6 when allowing 80.

- ▶ Oklahoma ranks second nationally in assists per game (21.7) and has dished out 20 dimes 16 different times this season and seven times in conference play.
- ▶ Oklahoma's 33 assists in the OT loss to #13 Duke (Nov. 27) were the second-most against a top-25 team since 1999 trailing only Duke's 38 in the same game. The Sooners are the only team with multiple 30-assist games vs. D1 opponents this season, recording four, while the rest of D1 has combined for 12. OU's four 30-assist games are the most in a season since Baylor's five in 2019-20.
- ▶ Nine different Sooners have at least one career game with five or more assists: Nevaeh Tot (49), Payton Verhulst (21), Skylar Vann (7), Reyna Scott (7), Lexy Keys (4), Zya Vann (2), Sahara Williams (2), Aubrey Joens (1), Beatrice Culliton (2).

- ▶The Sooners have used Sooner Magic to **come back from double-digit deficits and win 16 times** in the Baranczyk era, including six times vs. ranked opponents.
- ▶ Oklahoma is no stranger to winning close games it is **16-1** in games decided by one possession (3 pts or less) under Baranczyk, winning on a last-possession shot five times.
- ► Since the beginning of the 2021-22 season, Oklahoma has a 31-12 record in contests decided by single digits.
- ▶The Sooners nearly completed the second-largest comeback in program history at No. 7 LSU on Jan. 30, getting within one-point in the fourth quarter after trailing by 24 points in the second half. The Sooners fell 107-100 the only time in SEC history that both teams reached 100 points in regulation.

#### **NUMBERS NEVER LIE**

▶ Over the last four years, Oklahoma is 51-2 under Baranczyk when holding opponents under 70 points. On the flip side, the Sooners are 65-5 under Baranczyk (13-3 in 24-25) when scoring 80 points or more. OU is just .500 (28-28) since 2021 when scoring less than 80. This season, the Sooners are undefeated (18-0) when holding their opponent under 80 points and just 2-6 when allowing 80.

▶ Perhaps the most indicative recipe for success is that Oklahoma is **79-4 (.952) under Baranczyk when shooting a better percentage from the floor than the opponent**. OU is 74-9 when holding its opponent under 42% from the floor and 17-1 this season. When OU's opponent shoots 40% or worse, the Sooners are 62-4 in the JB era. Since 2021-22. Oklahoma is 72-15 when winning the rebounding battle.

▶This season, OU is undefeated (17-0) when leading at half and 18-0 when ahead after three quarters.

#### RAEGAN BEERS: THE BEST CENTER IN THE COUNTRY. PERIOD.

▶ Raegan Beers has been unstoppoable for the Sooners and is making a case for All-America honors, along with SEC POTY and Lisa Leslie Center of the Year accolades. The dominant center averages 17.0 points on 66.3% shooting (5th NCAA) and adds 9.0 rebounds per game. She has secured 10 double-doubles and has scored 10+ points in 28 of her last 30.

▶ Beers is on pace to make history as the only player in the country since at least 1999-00 to average 17.0+ points and 9.0+ rebounds in under 22.0 minutes per game – an unprecedented level of efficiency never seen in the sport.

Against ranked teams, the two-time All-American who transferred from Oregon State, is averaging 18.0 points on 69.6% shooting, 9.0 rebounds, 1.4 assists and 1.1 blocks per game. **Beers is one of**

two posts with seven or more games of 10 points and five boards against ranked teams.

▶ Beers would be just the second SEC player since 1999 (Teaira McCowan, 2019) to average 16.0 PPG, 8.0 RPG and shoot 65% in a season. McCowan was the league's player of the year in 2019.

► Her player efficiency rating (PER) of 37.1 ranks ninth nationally. When stats are adjusted to per/40 minutes, Beers is the only player in the country to average 31.0 PPG and 16.0 RPG.

► In Oklahoma's win vs. DePaul (Nov. 25) Beers became the first Sooner and third player since 1999 to post 15+ points, 8+ rebounds and shoot 100% from the floor with six FGM in less than 15 minutes of action.

▶In a loss at No. 7 LSU (1/30), Beers tallied 20 points on a perfect 8-for-8 shooting performance. She became one of only two players since at least 1999 – joining Ruthy Hebard (Oregon) – to record multiple career games against top-25 teams with at least 20 points while making at least eight field goals without a miss. Beers previously accomplished the feat against Utah last season while at Oregon State.

►The 6'4" post from Littleton, Colo. (Valor Christian HS) made her way to Norman via the transfer portal after two illustrious seasons at Oregon State. **Multiple publications named her the No. 1 player in the transfer portal.** 

▶ Beers swept national and SEC honors on Nov. 11 after averaging 23.5 points and 14.0 rebounds per game in the opening week of the season. The junior All-American was named AP National Player of the Week, SEC Player of the Week, and to the USBWA National Starting Five. Beers is the first Sooner to win an SEC weekly award and the first since Courtney Paris in 2009 to win a national player of the week honor.

► She had a career night against Vanderbilt on Feb. 20, scoring a career high 30 points on 11 of 13 shooting. She also corralled a season high 14 rebounds and dished out a career best four assists, along with adding two blocks in a dominant win.

▶In his postgame press conference after the Oklahoma-Kentucky game, **Kentucky head coach Kenny Brooks** said that **Raegan Beers was "one of the best post players in the country, if not the best,"** and that she was **"the hardest player to guard in the country."**

### **PAYTON THE PLAYMAKER**

▶ Payton Verhulst enters her senior season after a strong junior campaign that saw her win Big 12 Newcomer of the Year honors and collect All-America honors. Verhulst has received a waiver to return to the Sooners for the 2025-26 season.

► The do-it-all guard posts 15.1 points, 5.9 rebounds, 3.8 assists and 1.2 steals per game, and is the **only player in the country** averaging 15.0 PPG, 5.9 RPG and 3.8 APG in under 30.0 MPG. She has scored 10+ points in her last seven games and 15+ in five of her last seven and four straight.

► Verhulst exploded for a career-high 38 points vs. Missouri, tied for the fifth-most in OU history. She shot 13 of 19, hit six threes and went a perfect 6 of 6 at the line. Her 20-point third guarter

outscored Missouri 20-15 and set a Baranczyk-era record for points in a single frame. Verhulst became just the second high-major player since 1999 to record 38 points with six threes in 31 minutes or less.

► She has been on an offensive tear, hitting multiple 3-pointers 18 times this season and making three or more in 13 games - the 18th most in the country. Her 63 made 3-pointers this season rank third in the league.

Verhulst posted Oklahoma's fourth triple-double (29 points, 10 rebounds, 10 assists) in program history vs. No. 13 Duke on Nov. 27. She became one of two players (joining Caitlin Clark) since 1999 to post a 25-point tripledouble against a top-25 team. Since 1999, just seven players have achieved the 13-6-5-1 line, with only two from high-major conferences. Verhulst was named SEC Co-Player of the Week for her effort.

▶The former five-star prospect that spent two years at Louisville before transferring to OU in December 2022 averaged 12.6 points, 5.8 rebounds, 3.9 assists, 1.2 steals and 1.0 blocks per game last season. She was the only Division I player to average 12.5 PPG, 5.8 RPG and 3.9 APG in under 30 MPG in 2023-24.

▶The 6'1" guard was tabbed as the No. 12 recruit in the 2021 class and was a McDonald's All-American. A finalist for the 2021 USA Today National Female Athlete of the Year award, the Naismith second-team high school All-American was named to the 2022 ACC All-Freshman team after posting 3.3 points and 1.9 rebounds as a freshman at Louisville.

#### **SKY IS THE LIMIT**

> Skylar Vann is back at Oklahoma for her final season in 2024-25. The fifth-year senior entered the year as a preseason All-SEC second-team selection and a Naismith Trophy POTY watch listee. The reigning Big 12 Player of the Year and All-America honorable mention last season was also the Big 12's only two-time Sixth Player of the Year (2022, 2023) and averaged career highs in points (15.1) and rebounds (7.0) last season.



- Skylar Vann earned Big 12 Co-Player of the Year honors in 2024,

►The forward has been steady in 2024-25, averaging 9.9 points. 4.6 rebounds and shoots 43% from the floor. She scored a season-high 20 points in OU's win over Auburn on Feb. 10.

Over her last five games she's averaging 13.0 PPG on 45.3% shooting, 5.0 RPG and 3.0 APG.

► She scored 13 points on the road at No. 2 South Carolina, her first double-digit game of conference play. Since the USC game, Vann has reached double figures four more times.

► An experienced veteran, Vann is on pace to finish second in career games played in an Oklahoma uniform.

► In the last 16 years of women's college basketball, there have only been two seasons in which a player with one or fewer starts and at least 15 games played has averaged 11.5 points, 5.5 rebounds and 1.5 assists per game - Vann is responsible for both (2022 and 2023).

► She is one of six Sooners ever to score 1,600 career points and notch 800 career rebounds joining Courtney Paris, Caton Hill, Madi Williams, Molly McGuire and Phylesha Whaley.

### **SOPHOMORE SENSATION SAHARA WILLIAMS**

- ► An All-Big 12 honorable mention last season as a freshman, **Sahara Williams** is having a breakout sophomore season for the Sooners. A **preseason watch listee for the Cheryl Miller Award**, the Waterloo, lowa, product has carried the momentum from a strong close to last season into 2024-25.
- ► She averages 10.5 points per game on 43% shooting this season and adds 4.4 RPG and 2.4 APG. The wing has scored in double figures 14 times this season (five of last seven), **including a career high 27-point outing against No. 12 Kentucky on Feb. 2.**
- ▶The five-star prospect who was a McDonald's All-America prep star, started all 33 games for the Sooners last year, averaging 10.3 points, 5.4 rebounds and 1.5 assists. Her three double-doubles were the third most all-time for an OU freshman behind Courtney Paris and Madi Williams.
- ► Her 19 games in double figures last year were the fifth-most at Oklahoma in the last 15 years as the forward shot 46.3% from the floor.
- ► Williams played alongside LSU standout Mikaylah Williams, helping lead Team USA to back-to-back gold medals at the 2022 and 2023 FIBA 3x3 U18 World Cups. UConn's KK Arnold and Sarah Strong were part of the 2022 squad, while Oregon's Katie Fiso joined the team in 2023, replacing Arnold.

### WE LETTIN' THE SCOTTS OUTSIDE, WE RUNNIN' THE SCOUTS

- ▶ Reyna Scott has emerged as a breakout player over the last month, moving into the starting lineup for the Sooners at point guard. The New York City product made her first career start on Jan. 26 against Georgia.
- ► Scott is averaging 5.5 points (.490 FG%) and 2.7 assists per game in SEC play and posted a career high eight dimes on the road at LSU on Jan. 30. Three of her four double-figure scoring performances this season have come in SEC play (11 vs. Tennessee, 11 vs. Texas A&M, 10 vs. South Carolina).
- ▶The change in the starting lineup marked the first game since Jan. 12, 2022, that Nevaeh Tot hadn't started at point guard, snapping a 103-game starting streak.

# ENNIE BARANCZYK

ennie Baranczyk was named the ninth head coach of the Oklahoma women's basketball program on April 10. 2021. She will enter her fourth season at the helm in 2024-25 and usher the program into a new chapter in the Southeastern Conference.

Baranczyk (pronounced buh-RON-check), a 13-year head coach, spent nine seasons at Drake before starting her Oklahoma tenure in 2021-22. In each of her first three seasons in Norman, Baranczyk was a National Coach of the Year semifinalist and was named the 2024 Big 12 Coach of the Year. Her 74-26 (.740) record through three seasons is the best three-year start in program history.

Her teams have reached 20 wins in nine of the last 10 seasons, including three consecutive 23-plus wins at Oklahoma. She's led her teams to six NCAA Tournaments and produced 34 all-conference honorees over the previous 12 seasons.

Baranczyk delivered the program's second-straight Big 12 Conference regular season championship during her third campaign as the Sooners' head coach. Her efforts earned her Big 12 Coach of the Year honors, and she was a semifinalist for the Naismith National Coach of the Year award. The conference title was OU's first outright conference title since 2009, as OU compiled a 15-3 league record and a 23-10 overall record. Oklahoma was tabbed as a fifth seed in the program's third consecutive NCAA Tournament, where Baranczyk led OU to the second round.

Baranczyk and her staff saw Skylar Vann claim OU's first Big 12 Player of the Year honor in 15 years, while Payton Verhulst was named the league's Newcomer of the Year. Four Oklahoma players received All-Big 12 honors, with Vann and Verhulst making the first team and Nevaeh Tot and Sahara Williams receiving honorable mentions. Vann and Verhulst both earned All-America honors, pushing Baranczyk's All-America total to five as the Oklahoma head

In her second season, Baranczyk guided the Sooners to their first Big 12 championship since 2009, sharing the regular season title with a 14-4 record in league play and a 26-7 overall record. OU also made its second consecutive NCAA Tournament appearance under Baranczyk. The Sooners secured a program-record six sweeps in league play and secured the most conference wins in 13 seasons.

Baranczyk's coaching saw Madi Williams selected unanimously to the All-Big 12 First Team, while Taylor Robertson and Ana Llanusa received second-team honors, and Skylar Vann received an honorable mention. Vann also won the Sixth Player Award for the second year in a row, and freshman Beatrice Culliton was named to the All-Freshman team. Additionally, Williams became OU's first WNBA Draft Pick since 2013 and earned WBCA and AP All-America honors along with Robertson.

In her debut season, Baranczyk orchestrated one of the greatest turnarounds in the country, guiding the Sooners to a 25-9 record and into the second round of the NCAA Tournament. The 13-win improvement from the season before Baranczyk's arrival was the second-largest turnaround in program history. The Des Moines, lowa, product was named a WBCA National Coach of the Year finalist for her efforts. In addition, the team reached 20 wins faster than all but two teams in program history, rising to No. 12 in the AP Poll midway through the season. Madi Williams and Taylor Robertson earned unanimous All-Big 12 first-team selections, while Skylar Vann was named the league's Sixth Player of the Year.

She coached two Sooners, Taylor Robertson and Madi Williams, to unanimous first-team All-Big 12 selections, the first Sooner pair to do so since 2012. Under Baranczyk's watch, Skylar Vann was named the 2022 Big 12 Sixth Player of the Year and a league honorable mention, and Kelbie Washington earned All-Big 12 Freshman Team honors. Robertson became OU's first All-America selection since Aaryn Ellenberg in 2014, earning an honorable mention.

Baranczyk came to OU after amassing a 192-96 (.667) record at Drake and leading the Bulldogs to six consecutive 20-win seasons (2014-15 through 2019-20) and three NCAA tournament berths (2017-19). A two-time Missouri Valley Conference Coach of the Year, Baranczyk's .667 winning percentage ranks fifth in the league's history.

Baranczyk won back-to-back MVC Coach of the Year awards after her team's historic 2016-17 and 2017-18 campaigns. She led the Bulldogs to an 18-0 regular-season conference record both years and won both MVC Tournaments. After the 2018-19 squad posted a 17-1 league record, the Bulldogs had amassed a near-perfect three-year MVC mark of 53-1 (.981).

Baranczyk began her coaching career in the Big 12 Conference, serving first as an assistant coach at Kansas State during the 2005-06 season (the Wildcats won the WNIT) and returning to the league as an assistant coach at Colorado from 2010-12. Between her Big 12 stints, Baranczyk was an assistant coach at Marquette from 2006-10, helping the Golden Eagles to an 81-53 record and four postseason appearances. The 2007-08 squad won the WNIT title.

Formerly Jennie Lillis. Baranczyk spent her collegiate career at the University of Iowa (2000-04) and is regarded as one of the best all-around players in Hawkeye women's basketball history.

Baranczyk, who obtained a master's degree in counseling and student development from Kansas State in 2006, is married. She and her husband, Scott, have a son, Eli, and two daughters, Jordi and Hone.




