- ^ Auburn entered the game second in the NCAA in assist-to-turnover ratio but only had 11 assists with 12 turnovers.
- ^ Auburn entered the game first in the NCAA in blocked shots (6.9 avg.) but had a season-low two versus Arkansas. Arkansas entered the game third in the NCAA in blocked shots (5.8 avg) and had five.
- ^ Auburn entered the game making 37.3% from 3-point range but was just 4-of-24 (16.7%) including 0-of-10 from deep in the second half. Arkansas lost for the first time (4-1) this season when holding teams below 20% from 3-point range.

## Block Party; Hogs #4 in NCAA

- Arkansas has blocked at least five shots 17 times this season, including 12 of the last 16 games and **ranks 4th nationally / 2nd SEC in blocked shots**, averaging 5.8 per game.
- ^ Arkansas had 11 rejections vs Troy, 10 each versus Oakland and Tennessee, and nine each versus both UCA and NC A&T.
- ^ **Arkansas has 103 blocked shots in the last 15 games for an average of 6.87 per contest, including highs of: 9 vs UCA • 9 vs NC A&T • 9 vs OAK • 10 at TN • 8 vs Fla • 8 at Mizzou • 7 at TX • 7 vs Bama • 7 vs LSU • 8 at A&M**
- ^ **Arkansas has 34 blocked shots (6.8 avg.) over the last 5 games (7 vs TX, Bama, LSU, 8 at A&M & 5 at AUB)**
- ^ **Arkansas only had one blocked shot in the Georgia win. Adou Thiero swatted a layup attempt with 1:34 left and it played a huge role in the Hogs' win.**
- ^ At Tennessee, Jonas Aidoo and Zvonimir Ivisic each had three blocked shots while Adou Thiero had two.
- ^ At Missouri, Adou Thiero and Zvonimir Ivisic each had three rejections. Ivisic added three rejections vs Oklahoma.
- ^ at Texas, Ivisic had four blocked shots
- ^ vs Alabama, Ivisic had three blocked shots and Trevon Brazile added two
- ^ vs LSU, Ivisic had four blocked shots
- ^ at Texas A&M, Ivisic once again had four blocked shots
- ^ at Auburn, Ivisic had three blocked shots
- **Zvonimir Ivisic** has blocked at least one shot in 19 of his 25 games
- ^ **He ranks 2nd in the SEC / 21st NCAA in blocked shots (2.08 avg).**
- ^ Had **five blocked shots ONCE:** vs Troy
- ^ Had **four 3x:** at Texas, vs LSU and at Texas A&M
- ^ Had **three 8x:** vs Lipscomb, Pacific, UMEs, at Tennessee, at Missouri, vs Oklahoma, vs Alabama and at Auburn
- **Trevon Brazile** has **24 blocked shots over the last 16 games (1.5 avg) including a career-high 6 vs Oakland and 5 vs UCA**
- ^ **Brazile ranks 13th in the SEC in blocked shots (1.25 avg)**
- **Jonas Aidoo** has **25 blocked shots over the last 18 games.**
- ^ Despite playing limited minutes in the first five games and missing three games (GMS 6-8) due to injury, **Aidoo ranks 19th in the SEC in blocked shots with an average of 1.09 per game**

## Strong 2nd Halves Defending the 3

- In each of the last nine games, Arkansas has been excellent defending the 3-point arc in the second half. Those efforts have led to four Razorback wins and five strong second halves that gave Arkansas a chance to win.
- Kentucky, which entered the game 38th in the NCAA in 3PT% (.374), was just 3-of-13 (.231) from deep in the second half.
- Alabama, which entered the game 20th in the NCAA in 3's made (10.2), made just five triples for the game.

## Taking Advantage of Charity ... the Last 12 vs the 1st 14

- **A Look Inside the Numbers**
- ^ After going 6-of-13 at UT Arkansas has made more FT in the last 12 games than they made in the first 14
- ^ Including Ole Miss and beyond Arkansas is 73.8% (186-252) in the last 12 games at the line
- **A key factor in the team's free throw success can be attributed to Adou Thiero's success.**
- ^ After going 0-of-4 at UT Thiero was 66.7% (54-81) in the first 14 games at the line
- ^ Including Ole Miss and beyond Thiero is 73.3% (63-86) in the last 12 games at the line

## Pretty Good Inside the Arc

- **Prior to SEC play, Arkansas ranked 4th in the NCAA in field goal percentage at 50.8%.**
- ^ In SEC games, Arkansas is shooting just 41.3% from the field (15th in SEC games) and has fallen to 91st in the NCAA at 46.5% overall.
- ^ **HOWEVER, at Kentucky, Arkansas shot 55.2% from the field, the team's best performance in an SEC game this season,**
- ^ Arkansas has had four other good shooting games since that Kentucky game:
  - 44% at Texas
  - 43.1% vs Alabama
  - 51.9% vs LSU
  - 45.5% at Auburn
- **Arkansas is 221st in the NCAA in 3-pt shooting for the season to bring down its overall FG% BUT Arkansas is shooting 54.2% (524-of-966) from 2-point range for the season.**

## Fland Has Thumb Surgery

- Arkansas freshman guard Boogie Fland had successful surgery on Jan. 22 to repair an injury to his Ulnar Collateral Ligament (UCL) on his right thumb, performed by Dr. Bob Hotchkiss at Hospital for Special Surgery in New York City.
- The injury originally occurred in Arkansas' game against Florida (Jan. 11) and he attempted to play through it over the Razorbacks' past two games (at LSU and at Missouri).
- After consulting with team physicians and multiple hand specialists, surgery was selected as the best option for full recovery.
- There is no timetable for his return. Fland will begin his rehab immediately and will continue to work with the training staff at the University of Arkansas.
- Fland started the first 18 games of the season for the Razorbacks and was **leading the SEC in minutes played per game (34:07). As of Jan. 20, Fland:**
- ^ was second on the team in scoring (15.1).
- ^ **led all NCAA freshmen in assist-turnover ratio (3.68).**
- ^ **ranked eighth overall in the NCAA and first in the SEC in assist-turnover ratio.**
- ^ **led all NCAA freshmen in assists per game (5.72)**
- ^ ranked 29th overall in the NCAA in assists per game.
- ^ tallied 103 total assists with just 28 turnovers.
- ^ was shooting 36.5% from 3-point range and 83.9% from the free throw line.
- ^ led the team in scoring six times (second-best on the team) and led the team in assists in 16 of his 18 games.





- ^ Scored 16 of his 19 points in the second half.
- ^ Was 5-of-6 from the field - all 3-pointers in the period.
- ^ Four of his blocked shots and two of his steals came in the second half.

### Ivistic Had Double-Double at Mizzou

- Zvonimir Ivistic had his first career double-double at Missouri while leading the team in scoring, rebounds, blocked shots and steals.
- ^ **His first career double-double (14 pts and 10 rebs).**
- ^ **A then career-high 10 rebounds.**
- ^ **A then career-high 29:30.**

### Fort Knox

- Razorback freshman Karter Knox was good as gold in the win over Georgia and was really good at Texas A&M at Auburn as well.
- **VS GEORGIA**
- ^ Played **a career-high 33:56** ... including **ALL 20 MINUTES OF THE SECOND HALF**
- ^ Was a team-best +11, in fact, he was the only Hog better than +5 in the 3-point win
- ^ Was a **career-best 11-of-13 from the line** en route to an SEC-best 13 points
- ^ Scored 12 of his 13 points in the second half and **a team-best 10 in the final 35-17 run to close the game**
- ^ **Tied his then career-high with six rebounds**
- **Down four with 7:51 left**, Knox grabbed an offensive rebound and converted an old-fashion, 3-point play to get the Hogs to within one.
- **With 6:36 left**, he made two free throws to once again get the Hogs to within one.
- **With 4:40 left**, made two free throws, the first tying the game for the first time and the second giving Arkansas' its first lead of the game.
- **With 2:51 left**, he made two free throws to tie the game at 61.
- **NOTE: Knox entered the Georgia game just 20-of-25 from the free throw line for the season (18 games).**
- ^ **In the Georgia game (GM19), Knox was 11-of-13 at the free throw line.**
- **AT TEXAS A&M**
- ^ Scored 17 points, **his best in an SEC game** and second-best effort of his career.
- ^ Was 7-of-9 from the field, including 2-of-3 from 3-point range.
- ^ Added five rebounds
- **OTHER GOOD GAMES OF LATE:**
- ^ **Versus Oklahoma**, Knox played 35:21 and joined Johnell Davis as the only Razorbacks with a positive plus/minus (+1).
- ^ **At Kentucky**, Knox scored 10 points, including 8 in the first half with a 3-pointer to put the Hogs up one at halftime.
- ^ **At Texas**, Knox scored 9 points, going 6-of-6 at the line, but was a team-best +10 in the win while playing 35:51.
- ^ **Versus LSU**, Knox scored nine points and grabbed a **career-high eight rebounds** ... Played all 20 minutes of the 2nd half
- ^ **At Auburn**, Knox scored 11 points, going 5-of-6 from the field (1-of-1 3PT) with two steals.

### Much Adou About Something

- Adou Thiero may be the most improved player in the SEC this season.
- He tied or set career highs in every stat (but rebounding and blocked shots) 10 times this year.
- ^ **Set or Tied Career highs in:**
- **POINTS:** Set career high with 26 points vs Illinois and tied that vs UTSA
- **FIELD GOALS:** Set career highs with 10 FG made and 15 FGA vs Baylor
- **3-POINTERS:** Tied career highs with 2 3FG and 4 3FGA vs Troy and Baylor
- **FREE THROWS:** Set career highs with 12 FT made and 21 FTA vs Illinois
- **ASSISTS:** Set career high with 5 assists vs UMES and backed it up with five at Miami only to set a new high of six vs Oakland
- **STEALS:** Set career high with 6 steals vs Little Rock
- **MINUTES:** Set career high with 37:41 minutes played at Miami
- In 25 games at Arkansas, he is destroying what he did in 45 games over two years at Kentucky.

### Adou is #3

- Adou Thiero ranks **3rd in the SEC / 47th in the NCAA in field goal percentage at 55.1%.**
- ^ He has shot over 60% from the field nine times this season.
- ^ He was 4-of-5 from the field at Texas with the four makes coming on the highest percentage shots ... dunks.
- ^ **He is shooting an impressive 60.9% (123-of-202) from inside the 3-point arc.**
- Thiero led the team (and posted then SEC career highs) with 17 points vs Ole Miss, Florida and Georgia. **THEN**, he led the team with an SEC career-best 21 points at Kentucky. He bettered that with an **SEC-best 22 points versus Alabama.**
- ^ **Thiero has led the team in scoring a team-best 11 times, led the team in rebounding a team-best 11 times and led the team in steals a team-best nine times.**

### Davis on the Offensive; 15.2 PPG Over the Last Seven Games

- In the last seven games, Johnell Davis has scored a then season-best 18 points versus Oklahoma, 18 at Kentucky, a season-high 24 points at Texas.
- ^ For the first time this season, Davis led the team with 18 points vs Oklahoma. He then led the team with 24 points at Texas.
- ^ Had 18 points at Kentucky, going 7-of-14 from the field and 3-of-6 from 3-point while tying a season-high with six assists
- ^ While scoring a season-best 24 points at Texas, Davis added five rebounds.
- Not to go under the radar, Davis is getting 36 rebounds (25 total) over the last seven games with a high of five at Texas.

## Davis on the Defensive; 22 Steals Last 8 Games

- Johnell Davis, who had 10 steals in his first 16 games of the season, has 22 in the last eight games.
- **GEORGIA:** Davis was just 1-of-10 from 3-point range in the win over Georgia but he was still praised for his overall contributions.
  - ^ Specifically, he had a **then season-high three steals**, including one critical theft, while being credited with several deflections that resulted in turnovers as well.
  - ^ **His biggest steal came with 53 seconds left and the game tied. It led to a Thiero basket with 30 ticks left.**
  - ^ He scored seven points with four rebounds and two assists.
  - ^ He was +15 in the second half, playing 17:38 ... the same plus/minus as two Hogs that played all 20 minutes of the half).
- **OKLAHOMA:** Davis had a season-best four steals.
  - ^ Also had season-highs in free throws made and attempted (5-of-6)
- **AT KENTUCKY:** Davis had two steals
- **AT TEXAS:** Tied his season-high with four steals, including one after Texas cut its deficit to five with 35 seconds left.
- **ALABAMA:** Had one steal and it came during Arkansas' 19-4 run. He made two free throws after getting the steal.
- **LSU:** Had a team-best three steals and was a team-best +16, playing 36:03, in the 12-point win.
- **AT TEXAS A&M:** Had two steals and was a team-best +5 in the 8-point loss while playing 28:03.
- **AT AUBURN:** Had three steals with four assists and zero turnovers in 36:15 minutes.

## Wagner Picking Up Slack

- With Boogie Fland's injury, D.J. Wagner has moved to the point guard spot.
  - ^ In his eight games at the point, Wagner has led the team in assists seven times .... Including 43 over the span (5.4 avg)
  - ^ Big games over the span include getting 9 assists vs Alabama, 8 at Kentucky and 7 vs LSU
  - ^ Has only committed 18 turnovers in the eight games while averaging 33.9 minutes per game.
- **In addition to his assists numbers going way up over the last eight games:**
  - ^ **his scoring average has improved slightly, going from 10.1 ppg to 10.5**
  - ^ **his rebounding average has improved slightly, going from 2.4 rpg to 2.5**
  - ^ **his free throws went from 17-22 in the first 22 games to 17-of-21 in the last eight**
- Versus Oklahoma, Wagner had 13 points and led the team with five assists, **both were his bests in an SEC game this season.**
  - ^ Added four rebounds, which tied his career SEC high.
- At Kentucky, he **bettered his season SEC bests with 17 points and 8 assists.**
  - ^ Scored all 17 of his points in the second half, going 7-of-8 from the field including 2-of-2 from 3-point.
- At Texas, he had a team-best four assists with 13 points. He scored Arkansas' first six points and sank to free throws to put the Hogs up seven with 30 seconds left.
- Versus Alabama, he dished out nine assists (with just two turnovers). The **nine helpers were an SEC career high** and one shy of his overall career best.
- Versus LSU, dished out seven assists
- **In addition to being a leader on the offensive end, Wagner's ball pressure on defense has somewhat been overlooked.** He isn't getting steals, but his pressure on the ball has disrupted team's offense, especially at Kentucky and Texas.
  - **His play should not come as a surprise. Remember, last year, Wagner:**
    - ^ was an All-Southeastern Conference Freshman Team selection ... A three-time SEC Freshman of the Week honoree
    - ^ ranked seventh in the SEC in assists/turnover ratio (2.23) and 12th in assists per game (3.3)
    - ^ recorded 20 games with three or more assists

## Billy The Kid

- Razorback freshman Billy Richmond III isn't putting up big numbers. However, his worth cannot be measured in stats.
- Prior to the Texas game, **Adou Thiero told ESPN's Alyssa Lang that Richmond is the unsung hero.** He brings a ton of energy off the bench and is perhaps Arkansas' best defender.
- After the LSU game, **Coach Cal praised Richmond saying his energy and effort "changed the game."**
- **at KENTUCKY:** Only played 10:21, but made an impact as he was +10 .. Had a steal and a dunk in the first half.
- **at TEXAS:** Only played nine minutes, but made a big impact in the win as he was +5 ... With Arkansas up seven and 23 seconds left, blocked a layup that led to a Razorback rebound and two free throws made ... Then, provided the 78-70 final score by making two free throws with eight seconds left.
- **vs ALABAMA:** Scored nine points (4-of-6 FG), including a big dunk in the 19-4 run late in the game .... Added four rebounds and two steals ... Played 25:41, his most playing time since logging 32 minutes versus Illinois.
- **vs LSU:** Scored four points (in the Hogs' best 6-0 run to go up 10) and **tied his career-high with four assists** (with zero turnovers.)
- **at TEXAS A&M:** Tied for the team lead with six rebounds, which is an SEC best and tied his overall season high.
- **at Auburn:** Scored eight points on 4-of-5 shooting (with two dunks) while adding four rebounds.

## Just a Minute ... Or 30-Plus

- **D.J. Wagner ranks second the SEC at 34:07 minutes per game**
  - Wagner has ranked first or second in the SEC in minutes played all season.
  - Wagner has played over 30 minutes in 22 of 26 games with the exceptions being UMES, at Missouri, vs LSU and at Texas A&M.
  - Played a career-high 38:49 vs Ole Miss and 38:48 vs Florida

## ON-COURT SUCCESS

A "players-first" coach whose biggest goal is helping people reach their dreams, John Calipari, a Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Famer, has guided six teams to the Final Four, led one to a national championship and helped 58 players earn selection in the NBA Draft during his 32-year college coaching career.

Calipari took UMass to the Final Four in 1996, guided Memphis to the National Championship game in 2008 and led Kentucky to four Final Fours - including the 2012 National Championship, to become only the second coach in NCAA history to lead three different schools to the Final Four. He has racked up more than 850 on-court victories, 23 NCAA Tournament appearances, six Final Fours and numerous National Coach of the Year honors.

At every collegiate stop, Calipari's career has been successful throughout, but his 10-year stretch at Kentucky (2009-19) was among the best decades in NCAA history, reaching four Final Fours (with a 2012 championship and 2014 national runner-up), seven Elite 8 berths and nine trips to the Sweet 16.

The 2015 campaign was highlighted by Coach Cal directing the first ever college basketball team to own a 38-0 record (before falling in the Final Four) and became one of just three coaches to make four Final Fours in a five-year span. At the end of that 2015 season, Calipari became the 96th coach to join the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame.

Coach Cal has led three teams to an NCAA-record 38 wins on the court in a season (once at Memphis and twice at Kentucky), led the NCAA in wins six times (at least once at UMass, Memphis and Kentucky) and tallied 29, 20-win seasons (including 11 30-win campaigns). With his sustained success, Coach Cal received the John R. Wooden Award Legends of Coaching honor in 2024.

While building a program out of obscurity at UMass and returning Memphis and Kentucky to national contenders, he has totaled the second-most wins in NCAA history in the first 20 years of a college coaching career.

## PLAYER SUCCESS

Quite honestly, though, Calipari's on-court success overshadows a much more significant picture.

In his goal to lead a players-first program, he has helped 61 young men realize their dreams by earning NBA Draft selections. He has had four No. 1 overall picks, which are more than any other coach, and a total of 43 first-round picks. In 2010, he had a record five first-round draft picks. Two years later, six of his players heard their names called at the 2012 draft, the most in the two-round draft era. Then in 2015, Cal would have six picks again, including a record-tying four lottery selections.

Calipari's players have entered the league NBA-ready. His players have garnered 39 All-Star selections, including a record-breaking seven in 2024, with Anthony Davis winning the game's MVP honor in 2017. Derrick Rose was named NBA MVP in 2011. Nine of his players have been tabbed All-NBA (16 times), three have been named NBA Rookie of the Year and 18 players have made the NBA All-Rookie teams. He is the only coach in history to have a player win each of the NBA's major honors: MVP, Rookie of the Year, Most Improved Player, Sixth Man of the Year and Clutch Player of the Year.

While producing top-notch talent, Calipari has stressed academics at each of his stops. At UMass, nearly 80% of his players graduated. Seventeen of his last 20 seniors at Memphis earned their bachelor's degrees. All 33 players at UK who were eligible to graduate by the end of their senior years walked away with a diploma in hand, including five players who earned their degree in just three years. Calipari's teams routinely have posted a combined team grade-point average of 3.0 or better.

## COMMUNITY SUCCESS

Calipari has raised millions of dollars to help the lives of those in need. He has had a particular passion to assist those impacted by natural disasters. For instance, in 2010, he used a telethon to raise more than \$1 million for victims of the devastating earthquake in Haiti. He followed that up with telethons in 2012, raising \$1 million for victims of Superstorm Sandy, in 2017 for victims of Hurricane Harvey, played a leading role in the "Kentucky United" efforts that generated more than \$5 million for victims of devastating tornadoes in Western Kentucky in 2021, and raised nearly \$4 million with the Kentucky Flood Relief Telethon and open practice at Rupp Arena in 2022.

Calipari launched his **THE CALIPARI FOUNDATION** in 2012 and has worked with several key partners to donate more than \$1.5 million, a figure that does not include matching funds that have been contributed from individuals and corporations. In 2013, Calipari initiated hosting an annual alumni weekend around his basketball fantasy experience with the intent to raise money for charity. After generating \$350,000 for selected organizations and charities during the inaugural game, the weekend has generated millions of dollars for charity since its inception.

In 2019, when federal workers were without pay due to a government shutdown, he, his wife and his foundation assisted workers with financial help and grocery gift cards. He and his wife, Ellen, teamed up with Fayette County Public Schools to help families in need during the COVID-19 pandemic.

Additional efforts include spearheading the creation of the **JOHN MCLENDON MINORITY LEADERSHIP INITIATIVE**, a nationwide coach-driven initiative to provide minorities a jump-start to their careers through practical experiences, opportunities to build their network and instilling the values of John McLendon: integrity, education, leadership and mentorship. Participants in the initiative will be known as MLI Future Leaders.

He was awarded the Jefferson Award for Outstanding Public Service in Sports by Multiplying Good in 2022. For more than 50 years, Multiplying Good has honored those who put others first. Those receiving the Jefferson Award are empowered to do more, while their stories of extraordinary public service inspire others to action. It is an award that underscores impact. He earned the Race Amity Medal of Honor in 2023.

## OTHER SUCCESS

In 2017, Coach Cal was named the head coach of the 2017 USA Basketball Men's U19 World Cup Team, which finished third at the 2017 FIBA U19 World Cup in Cairo. Also, he won gold as head coach of the 2012 Dominican Republic team at the Centrobasket Championship.

Author of five books, including the New York Times Best Seller "Players First: Coaching from the Inside Out," Calipari is a master of communication and maximizing talent. He lives by the motto that **"it's never a matter of how far you have fallen, but instead it's about how high you bounce back."**
