### Softball Gears Up for LA Tech Classic

HATTIESBURG, Miss.-Southern Miss Softball (2-5, 0-0 SBC) he La. to compete in the Louisiana Tech Classic, facing the Bulld Arkansas Razorbacks on Saturday and Sunday.

The Golden Eagles are reeling off of a historic 2-1 home opene against Ole Miss on Thursday night. With two outs and a two-strike count in the bottom of the tenth inning, senior outfielder Natalie Taylor delivered the game-winning single through left field, driving in Shelby Allen to secure Southern Miss' first victory over Ole Miss since 2018 and its first against the Rebels at the Southern Miss Softball Complex since Feb. 24, 2016.

# To The Top Tidbits

- Southern Miss senior pitcher and designated player Jana Lee earned NFCA Division I Leadoff Classic All-Tournament Team honors after her standout performance over the weekend. Building on her success as a 2024 Second Team All-Sun Belt selection, Lee picked up right where she left with two dominant outings in the circle for Southern Miss. The Albany, Ga., native pitched complete games versus Marshall and No. 20 Northwestern, registering a 1.00 ERA with only two earned runs allowed to a total of 11 strikeouts in 14 innings pitched.
- Southern Miss clinched a postseason berth in the Sun Belt Tournament for the second straight season, marking the first consecutive conference tournament appearances since 2012-2013.
- The Golden Eagles finished the 2024 home slate with a 10-6 record, marking the third consecutive season the team has recorded a .500 or above standing at the Southern Miss Softball Complex, the longest streak since 2008-2010.
- The Golden Eagles feature a squad of 30 student-athletes, comprising of 15 returners and 15 newcomers. Nine first-year players are on the roster, the most for the program since the 2014 season.



# PREVIEW

The Golden Eagles battled a historic performance from Ole Miss freshman pitcher Miali Guachino, who set a program record with 19 strikeouts in a complete-game effort with nine innings thrown and 181 total pitches.

In the circle for Southern Miss, Jana Lee and Kayla Giardina combined for 131 pitches and eight strikeouts. Giardina took over in relief, delivering a career-high five strikeouts across five shutout frames on the way to earning her first career win.

Southern Miss' game versus Ole Miss lasted three hours and three minutes, marking the Golden Eagles' longest match since a 14-inning loss on March 18, 2017, versus Louisiana Tech. The game also goes down as the second-longest match in the Southern Miss-Ole Miss series, ranking only behind an 11-inning loss on March 29, 2000.

#### **Scouting the Competition**

Arkansas is led by Courtney Deifel, who is in her tenth season with the Razorbacks. Deifel has led the program to two SEC regular season championships, one SEC Tournament Championship and seven consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances from 2017-2024.

For the sixth time in program history, Arkansas started 5-0 with a sweep in the Texas State Tournament in San Marcos, Texas, outscoring opponents 40-4. Arkansas set a program record for most runs scored in a game with a 23-0 shutout of Lipscomb.

Senior first baseman Bri Ellis leads the team with six hits, nine RBI, three home runs, four walks and five runs scored. Her 51 career home runs are the most among active Division I players.

Freshmen pitchers Payton Burnham and Cam Harrison each recorded eight strikeouts in their first career starts. Arkansas' bullpen recorded a 0.66 ERA in the opening weekend, allowing just three earned runs with 37 strikeouts.

Arkansas leads the all-time series 5-3, last meeting in Fayetteville, Ark. on March 7, 2010. The Golden Eagles last beat the Razorbacks on Feb. 7, 2009, in a 9-7 victory at the Southern Miss Softball Complex.

Louisiana Tech is led by fourth-year head coach Josh Taylor, who has led the program to three consecutive 30-plus win seasons, and won the Conference USA Coach of the Year award in 2022 and 2024.

The Bulldogs opened their season last weekend at the Puerto Vallarta College Challenge, finishing with a 2-3 record. Louisiana Tech defeated No. 4 Oklahoma State at the tournament, earning its first win against a top-ten team in 17 years.

Allie Floyd and Nicole Hammoude were selected to the Puerto Vallarta College Challenge All-Tournament Team. Floyd posted a 3.29 ERA with 12 strikeouts in 17 innings pitched, leading the Bulldogs to both of their wins at the tournament. Hammoude logged seven hits in 14 at-bats. Senior infielder Claire Raley also finished the tournament with a .533 batting average, collecting eight hits.


Louisiana Tech leads the all-time series 34-18 with four consecutive wins. The Golden Eagles last won against the Bulldogs on May 2, 2021.

# 2024 HIGHLIGHTS

- The Golden Eagles picked up series wins at home against Marshall, a sweep of Georgia State and a win at home versus No. 24 Texas State, which was the program's first victory against a nationally ranked opponent since beating No. 4 Florida on March 2, 2022.
- Two Golden Eagles earned all-conference honors last season, including returner Jana Lee's Second Team All-Sun Belt selection and former graduate student catcher Hannah Borden's First Team All-Sun Belt and Third Team NFCA South Region Team selections. The one-two duo accounted for 100 hits on the season, including 24 doubles and 23 home runs for a combined 77 RBI.
- Hannah Borden started all 50 games in her final season as the Golden Eagles' catcher, leading the team in nearly every offensive category; she recorded the team's 12th 60-hit season in program history, posted a conference-best .775 slugging percentage, and sailed into the record books with a single-season record and conference-leading 18 home runs, which also helped shatter Southern Miss' all-time home run record with 50 career homers. Borden also finished her career at Southern second in all-time hits (208), RBI (150) and walks (107).
- Lee looks to build on a career-high season in 2024, in which she recorded 39 hits, the third most on the team, in only 40 games, batting at .320 with a .566 slugging percentage. Lee's season total of 15 home runs ranked fourth in the Sun Belt and the Albany, Ga. native also appeared in 26 games in the circle, leading the team's pitching staff with nine wins and 40 strikeouts in 95 innings pitched, earning six wins in conference play. She became the first Southern Miss player to earn the Sun Belt's Player of the Week honor in the second week of conference play, producing eight hits with four consecutive multi-hit performances.
- The Golden Eagles finished the 2024 home slate with a 10-6 record, marking the third consecutive season that the team has recorded a .500 or better standing at the Southern Miss Softball Complex, the longest streak since 2008-2010.

# HEAD COACH NATALIE POOLE



Poole enters her third season as the head coach of Southern Miss Softball, having guided the Golden Eagles to back-to-back conference tournament appearances for the first time since the 2012 and 2013 seasons.

During the 2024 season, Poole oversaw Southern Miss' first conference series win at home in the Sun Belt and its first conference series sweep. The Golden Eagles also secured its first victory against a nationally ranked opponent since 2022 with a win at home against No. 24 Texas State.

With a 10-6 home record, Poole led the team to its third consecutive season with a .500 or better standing at the Southern Miss Softball Complex, the longest streak since 2008-2010.

Poole mentored two All-Sun Belt players in 2024, including Jana Lee's Second Team selection and Hannah Borden's First Team selection. Borden sailed into the program's record books with a single-season record and conference-leading 18 home runs, shattering Southern Miss' all-time home run record with 50 career homers.

In her debut campaign, Poole led the Golden Eagles to a 22-24 finish and their first conference postseason appearance since 2019.

Poole came to Southern Miss after spending the last 11 years as the head coach at Memphis. She served as the second head coach in that program's history.

During her tenure at Memphis, Poole mentored 11 all-conference selections, including three first-team picks, to go along with Kyler Troslcair Klatt, who earned the American Athletic Conference Rookie of the Year in 2015.

Trosclair Klatt set plenty of records, including career hits (249), career stolen bases (78), and career runs scored (138). Trosclair Klatt was a two-time All-Conference performer, earning First-Team in 2017 and Second-Team in 2018.

The program also produced two All-Freshman selections over the final two years of Conference USA, before having two make AAC All-Rookie team accolades during their tenure in that league.

In addition to success on the field, Poole's importance

on academics helped push one of its student-athletes to CoSIDA First Team Academic All-District honors and later enjoyed a program-record 15 NFCA All-America Scholar-Athlete selections in 2021. In all, the Tigers produced 82 NFCA All-America Scholar-Athletes during Poole's years at Memphis.

During her time at Memphis, Poole was selected as the NCAA Division I representative for the National Fastpitch Coaches Association Board of Directors and also currently serves on the NCAA Softball Selection Committee.

Poole went to Memphis after spending three seasons leading the helm at McNeese State. She guided the Cowgirls to three-straight 30-win seasons, including a school-record 38 wins in 2010. Poole led McNeese State to two Southland Conference (SLC) Tournament championship games, winning the tournament title in 2010 and advancing to the NCAA Regional Tournament.

Poole compiled a 100-84 overall record and went 55-35 in conference play during the three years.

Poole was named the Southland Conference Coach of the Year in her first season at McNeese State in 2009 after leading the Cowgirls to a second-place finish in the league. The team finished the year with a 31-28 record, marking the Cowgirls' first winning season in 11 years.

In her three years at McNeese State, 20 players earned All-Southland Conference honors. In 2011, outfielder Claire Terracina became the first Cowgirl since 2008 selected to the All-SLC first team. In addition, Alanna DiVittorio was named the Louisiana Sports Writers Association co-Freshman of the Year in 2011.

Poole led McNeese State to a 31-29 record in 2011 and a third-place finish at the Southland Conference Tournament. Seven players were named to both the All-SLC and All-Louisiana teams.

In her three years at McNeese State, 20 players earned All-Southland Conference honors. In 2011, outfielder Claire Terracina became the first Cowgirl since 2008 selected to the All-SLC first team. In addition, Alanna DiVittorio was named the Louisiana Sports Writers Association co-Freshman of the Year in 2011.

Poole led McNeese State to a 31-29 record in 2011 and a third-place finish at the Southland



Conference Tournament. Seven players were named to both the All-SLC and All-Louisiana teams.

Prior to returning to her alma mater, Poole served as the head coach for seven seasons at Georgia Southern, where she compiled a 212-215 career record. The Eagles went 71-53 in the Southern Conference under Poole's tutelage and earned a trip to the NCAA Tournament in 2006. She was named the SoCon Coach of the Year in 2002, her first year as a head coach.

During her time at Georgia Southern, the Eagles had just one losing conference season and finished outside the top-four only once. The program set more than 15 single-season records, and four of the top six all-time home run seasons came in Poole's tenure.

She coached the 2006 and 2008 SoCon Players of the Year and three SoCon Freshmen of the Year. During her time with Georgia Southern, 17 players earned All-SoCon honors, including a school-record eight in 2008. In 2006, Poole led Georgia Southern to the program's first NCAA Tournament appearance after winning the SoCon Tournament with six-straight victories. The SoCon title was just the second in school history.

The Eagles nearly repeated as SoCon champions in 2007, falling in the conference tournament championship game.

Poole began her collegiate coaching career at McNeese State. She joined the Cowgirls staff as a graduate assistant in 1998 and served as an assistant coach from 1999-2001.

As a college athlete, Poole was a standout catcher for Mc-Neese State from 1994-97. She was a three-time All-Southland Conference pick (1995-97) and a two-time All-South Region selection (1996-97). Poole also earned All-Louisiana honors in 1996. As a freshman, she helped the Cowgirls to a Southland Conference title and the school's first NCAA Tournament appearance. Poole was named McNeese State's Most Valuable Player her senior year and concluded her playing career with a .296 batting average.

In the classroom, Poole was a three-time CoSIDA Academic All-District VI selection (1995-97) and was a 1997 Academic All-American. She graduated with a bachelor's degree in painting from McNeese State in 1998 and earned her master's degree in instructional technology from the school in 2000. In 2017, Poole earned her Doctorate in Education in Higher Ed Administration. A native of Baton Rouge, La., Poole has one daughter, Isabella Grace.
