NOTABLES

- TWO OLD RIVALS BACK TOGETHER:** Former rivals in the old Southwest Conference (until Arkansas departed for the SEC prior to the 1991-92 season), Texas will play host to the Razorbacks in Austin for the first time since the 2010-11 season.
- OFFENSIVE DISPLAY:** Texas set team highs in SEC play in scoring (89 points), FG percentage (.563), three-point FG percentage (.476) and assists (20) during Saturday's 31-point win at LSU.
- SHEDRICK SEES DOUBLE:** Graduate F **Kadin Shedrick** recorded his second double-double of the season and seventh of his collegiate career with his 16-point, 10-rebound effort while adding three assists and three steals in 29 minutes during Saturday's victory at LSU.

ARKANSAS SERIES INFO

- Arkansas holds an **87-68** lead in the all-time series that dates back to a 30-26 Texas victory in Fayetteville on Feb. 26, 1924.
- Following Arkansas' departure from the Southwest Conference prior to the 1991-92 season, the two teams did not meet on the hardwood from 1991 until 2007.
- Between 2007 and 2011, the two former rivals played a four-game series with the Longhorns winning three of the four meetings.
- In the most recent matchup between the two schools, Texas earned a 73-71 overtime win on Nov. 9, 2018 at the Armed Forces Classic in El Paso, Texas.

BLESS THE MOOD, YEAR THREE

- Texas is **40-8 (.833)** all-time in games played in Moody Center.
- UT is **4-3** all-time against AP Top 10 foes and **9-5** against AP Top 25 opponents in Moody Center.
- Texas is **25-1** in non-conference games in Moody Center.
- The Longhorns have averaged **10,794** fans per game during the arena's first **48** games. Moody Center's official capacity is 10,763, but there is a standing-room only area in the upper concourse for UT students used as overflow for the Corral.
- The \$375 million world-class arena opened for concerts in April 2022.
- Moody Center is named in honor of a \$130 million grant to The University of Texas at Austin from the Moody Foundation, the single-largest gift from a foundation in the university's history. The Moody Foundation has supported museums, libraries, universities and hospitals throughout the state of Texas for over 75 years.

THE CORRAL

- Prior to the 2022-23 season, UT Athletics and Matthew McConaughey joined forces to launch the new official student section for Texas Men's Basketball, **the Corral**.
- UT students get the best seats for games at Moody Center, 270-degrees around the court. The seating capacity for the Corral is 1,000.
- There is also an overflow standing-room only section (the Upper Corral) in the upper concourse that can fit approximately 550 students.

HORNS HAVE WON THREE OF THEIR LAST FOUR

- After starting SEC play with a 1-4 mark, Texas enters Wednesday's game with **wins in three of its last four** contests. The stretch includes an impressive pair of **back-to-back** victories against ranked opponents.
- The Longhorns earned a 61-53 home victory over **No. 22/24 Missouri** (Jan. 21) and followed with a 70-69 home win against **No. 13/13 Texas A&M** (Jan. 25).
- After a hard-fought 72-69 loss at No. 23/23 Ole Miss last Wednesday (Jan. 29), Texas responded with an 89-58 victory at LSU on Saturday (Feb. 1).

- The 31-point win against LSU marked the **largest margin of victory by Texas in a road conference game** since a 31-point victory (83-52) at Texas Tech on Jan. 11, 2011.
- Texas is currently No. **25** in the latest NET rankings (Feb. 2) and owns a 4-6 mark in Quad 1 games and a 2-1 record in Quad 2 contests. The Longhorns have also climbed to No. **29** in the most recent KenPom ratings (Feb. 2).

STRENGTH OF SCHEDULE

- Texas opened SEC action by playing **SEVEN** ranked opponents in its first eight league contests. This stretch included hosting the No. 2 (Auburn) and No. 1 (Tennessee) teams in the nation at the time in consecutive games.
- The only **non**-ranked opponent for Texas through its opening eight league games was a 77-73 win on the road at rival Oklahoma. The Sooners went 13-0 to start the year and were ranked No. 12 in The AP poll on Dec. 30.

IN THE POLLS

- Texas was ranked No. 19 in the preseason AP poll and No. 19 in the preseason USA TODAY Sports Coaches poll.
- UT dropped out of both polls on Nov. 11 following its season-opening loss to Ohio State.
- The Longhorns have made 21 appearances in school history in The AP preseason poll, including each of the last five years.

LSU RECAP

- The Longhorns converted 56.3-percent (36-64) from the floor, including a 47.6-percent mark (10-21) from three-point range, on the night.
- Texas set team highs in SEC play in scoring (89 points), FG percentage (.563), three-point FG percentage (.476) and assists (20).
- UT recorded an 18-6 advantage in points off turnovers, a 40-26 margin in points in the paint and a 16-6 edge in second-chance scoring.
- Texas registered 20 assists against just seven turnovers and limited LSU to five assists while forcing 15 turnovers.
- The Longhorns posted a plus-12 rebound margin (35-23), including a 10-4 edge on the offensive glass.
- Leading 31-25 at the break, Texas recorded a 58-33 scoring margin in the second half. The Longhorns converted 68.6-percent (24-35) from the floor, including a 6-of-11 (.545) mark from three-point range, over the final 20 minutes.
- Tre Johnson** reached double figures in scoring (18 points) for the 19th time in his career (20 games). He set his career high in assists (5) while committing just one turnover in 30 minutes.
- Arthur Kaluma** reached double figures in scoring (10 points) for the 17th time this year (21 games) and 85th time in his career (122 games).

- **Tramon Mark** set season highs in scoring (18 points) and field goals made (7-12) and tied his season high in assists (4). Mark reached double figures in scoring for the 10th time this year (18 games) and 68th time in his career (125 games).
- **Devon Pryor** set his career high in rebounds (6), including four on the offensive glass. He tied his career highs in field goals made (4-6) and minutes (21).
- **Kadin Shedrick** recorded a double-double (16 points, 10 rebounds) for the second time this year (22 games) and seventh time in his career (130 games). He set his season highs in points and assists (3) and tied his season highs in field goals made (6-11), three-point field goals made (1-2) and steals (3). Shedrick reached double figures in scoring for the ninth time this year and 42nd time in his career. He reached double digits in rebounds for the third time this season and eighth time in his career. Shedrick registered a team-best plus-minus total of plus-35 in 29 minutes.

OUR GUY, RT - YEAR THREE

- **Rodney Terry** was named the 26th head coach in Men's Basketball program history at The University of Texas on his 55th birthday - March 27, 2023. Terry was tabbed Acting Head Coach a few hours prior to the Dec. 12, 2022 home game against Rice. He was named Interim Head Coach for the remainder of the 2022-23 season on Jan. 5.
- A former head coach at Fresno State and UTEP for a combined 10 years, he sports an overall head coaching record of **221-184 (.546)** in **13** seasons.
- Terry was tabbed the **2023 Sporting News National Coach of the Year**, becoming the first coach in program history to earn the prestigious honor. He also was named the Clarence "Big House" Gaines College Basketball Division I Coach of the Year by the National Sports Media Association (NSMA).
- Terry, who has 29 years of collegiate coaching experience including nine as an assistant previously with the Longhorns from 2002-11, was in his second year as Associate Head Coach at Texas prior to being named Interim Head Coach.
- He spent three years (2018-21) as head coach at UTEP and posted a 37-48 (.435) mark, including a 29-27 record in his final two seasons. In his second year in El Paso (2019-20), the Miners went 17-15 to post their first winning season in four years and claim nine more wins than the previous season.
- Terry worked for seven years (2011-18) as the head coach at Fresno State, guiding the Bulldogs to a 126-108 (.538) mark. He posted 20-win seasons in four of his last five years and double-digit win totals in Mountain West Conference play in each of his last four years.
- During the 2015-16 season, Terry led the Bulldogs to a 25-10 record and the MWC Tournament title. Fresno State advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2001, and the 25 wins marked the third-most in school history.
- Terry spent nine seasons (2002-11) as an assistant coach under Rick Barnes at The University of Texas. The Longhorns posted an overall record of **232-80 (.744)** and made nine NCAA Tournament appearances, including four trips to the Sweet 16 (2003, 2004, 2006 and 2008), three Elite Eights (2003, 2006 and 2008) and one Final Four (2003). Texas also claimed two Big 12 Conference regular-season titles (2006 and 2008).
- A total of **10** McDonald's All-Americans made their way to the UT campus during Terry's time.

- The Longhorns claimed two National Player of the Year winners (T.J. Ford in 2003 and Kevin Durant in 2007) and 13 players drafted by the NBA in the nine years under Terry, including nine first-round selections and five lottery picks.

TERRY AT TEXAS

- Now in his third year as the head coach at Texas, **Rodney Terry** has guided the Longhorns to a **58-28 (.674)** record.
- Terry has posted a **4-2 record in NCAA Tournament contests** as head coach of the Longhorns.
- Texas is **15-9** under Terry in games decided by five points or less OR in overtime.
- Terry has registered **13** victories against AP Top 25 opponents during his time at Texas.

HEAD COACHING EXPERIENCE ON THE STAFF

- **FOUR** members of the Texas coaching staff have a combined **48** years of **Division I collegiate head coaching** experience.
- Head Coach **Rodney Terry** has **13** years of Division I head coaching experience. He served as head coach at UTEP for three years (2018-21) and head coach at Fresno State for seven seasons (2011-18) in addition to his three years at Texas.
- Assistant Coach **Frank Haith** has **18** years of Division I head coaching experience. He served as head coach at Miami (Fla.) for seven seasons (2004-11), Missouri for three years (2011-14) and Tulsa for eight seasons (2014-22).
- Assistant Coach **Steve McClain** has **14** years of Division I head coaching experience. He served as head coach at the University of Illinois at Chicago (UIC) for five years (2010-15) and head coach at Wyoming for nine seasons (1998-2007).
- General Manager **Chris Ogden** has **three** years of Division I head coaching experience. Ogden served as the head coach at UTA for three seasons (2018-21).

TEXAS IN THE BIG DANCE

- Texas has made a total of **38** all-time appearances in the NCAA Tournament (40-41 record).
- UT has made **four**-consecutive trips to the NCAA Tournament (2021-22-23-24). This is the longest streak by the Longhorns since they made **14**-straight NCAA tourney appearances from 1999-2012.
- Texas is one of **six** schools to appear in at least 30 of the last 35 NCAA tourneys.
- UT is one of **seven** schools to appear in at least 22 of the last 25 NCAA tourneys.
- The Longhorns have advanced to the Final Four **three** times in program history (1943, 1947 and 2003), the Elite Eight a total of **eight** times and the Sweet 16 a total of **14** times.

THREE-STRAIGHT TRIPS TO THE NCAA ROUND OF 32

- Texas has advanced to at least the NCAA Tournament Round of 32 in **each** of the last three seasons, including making a run to the NCAA Elite Eight in Rodney Terry's first year as head coach in 2022-23.
- This marks the first time the Longhorns have accomplished the feat since UT won **four**-straight NCAA First-Round games from 2006-09 (2006 Elite Eight, 2007 Second Round, 2008 Elite Eight, 2009 Second Round).
- The Longhorns are one of just **EIGHT** programs nationally to advance to at least the NCAA Tournament Round of 32 in each of the last three years, joining Baylor, Creighton, Gonzaga, Houston, Kansas, Michigan State and Tennessee.

REACHING 20 WINS ... IN THE REGULAR SEASON

- UT has reached the 20-win plateau a total of **35** times in its previous 118 seasons of basketball.
- Texas has reached the 20-win mark during the **regular season** in **each of the last three years**. Prior to this current streak, the Longhorns had not reached the 20-win mark in the regular season since the 2015-16 season.

INDIVIDUAL HONORS

- **Tramon Mark** and **Tre Johnson** were each named to the men's basketball coaches' preseason All-SEC Third Team.
- **Tramon Mark** was named to the Preseason All-SEC Third Team by the league's media.
- **Tre Johnson** is one of 50 preseason candidates for the Jersey Mike's Naismith Trophy Men's College Player of the Year Watch List presented by AXIA Time.
- **Tre Johnson** is one of 25 midseason Watch List candidates for the John R. Wooden Award.
- **Tre Johnson** is one of 20 players on the preseason watch list for the Jerry West Shooting Guard of the Year Award.

COMEBACK FOR THE AGES

- The Longhorns rallied for a dramatic 70-69 home victory over No. 13/13 Texas A&M (Jan. 25).
- Texas A&M led by as much as 22 points (51-29) at the 17:07 mark of the second half. The 22-point comeback ties for the largest comeback by Texas since at least the start of the 1998-99 season.
- The Longhorns trailed by 22 points (67-45) with 7:54 remaining in regulation before rallying for a 92-86 overtime victory against Oklahoma on Feb. 27, 2013.
- During this year's comeback, UT posted a 45-26 scoring margin in the second half. The Longhorns converted 50-percent (13-26) from the floor, including a 5-of-11 (.455) mark from three-point range, and 14-of-16 (.875) free throws in the final 20 minutes. Texas limited A&M to 26 points on 34.5-percent (10-29) shooting from the floor in the second half.

HISTORICAL WEEK IN AUSTIN

- Texas faced No. 2/2 Auburn (lost 87-82 on Jan. 7) and No. 1/1 Tennessee (lost 74-70 on Jan. 11) in consecutive home games earlier in January.
- This marked the **first time in Texas program history** that the Longhorns had faced the No. 1 **AND** No. 2 teams in The AP poll in **consecutive** contests.
- *Courtesy ESPN research:* This marks just the **sixth** time in the last **30 seasons** that a team had faced The AP No. 1 AND AP No. 2 team in a single calendar week. The previous occurrences were: Tennessee in 2023-24 (No. 1 Kansas, No. 2 Purdue), Marquette in 2023-24 (No. 1 Kansas, No. 2 Purdue), K-State in 2019-20 (No. 1 Kansas, No. 2 Baylor), West Virginia in 2015-16 (No. 1 Kansas, No. 2 Oklahoma) and St. John's in 1998-99 (No. 1 UConn, No. 2 Duke).
- Texas became the **FIRST** team to **host** the AP No. 1 AND No. 2 teams in the same poll week since Missouri in 1997. The Tigers beat No. 1 Kansas and lost to No. 2 Wake Forest.

2024 UKG LEGENDS CLASSIC CHAMPS

- Texas claimed the championship at the four-team 2024 UKG Legends Classic on Nov. 21-22 at Barclays Center in Brooklyn.
- This marked the **first regular-season neutral-site MTE (multi-team event) title** since the 2020 Maui Invitational. That event was contested in Asheville, N.C. due to COVID-19.
- UT posted a 70-66 win over Syracuse in the semifinals. The following night, the Longhorns trailed 52-51 with 5:29 remaining before closing the contest on a 16-6 run to post a 67-58 win over Saint Joseph's in the championship game.
- Both Tre Johnson and Arthur Kaluma earned spots on the five-person All-Tournament Team. Johnson received MVP recognition as he averaged a team-best 16.5 ppg and converted 9-of-10 (.900) free throws in the two games. Kaluma averaged 15.0 ppg, 7.0 rpg, 4.0 apg and 2.0 bpg while hitting 10-of-21 (.476) field goals and 8-of-10 (.800) free throws.

GET OLD AND STAY OLD

- The 2024-25 Texas roster includes **five** players who have already earned their undergraduate degrees: Cole Bott, Jayson Kent, Julian Larry, Tramon Mark and Kadin Shedrick.
- **Six** individuals have **played** in at least **100** career games.
- **Five** players have already surpassed the **1,000-career point mark: Arthur Kaluma** (1,518), **Tramon Mark** (1,372), **Jordan Pope** (1,221), **Julian Larry** (1,062) and **Jayson Kent** (1,027).
- The **12** players who brought previous collegiate experience to this year's roster have combined career totals of **1,010** games played (**607** starts).

GETTING OFFENSIVE

- Texas is averaging **78.9** points per contest while converting **48.2**-percent (613-1272) from the floor, including a **37.2**-percent mark (170-457) from three-point range, and **75.4**-percent (338-448) from the free throw line on the season.
- Texas has converted at least 50-percent from the floor **nine** times in its first 22 contests. UT has hit at least 40-percent from three-point range in **nine** of its first 22 games.
- UT has had **11** different players reach double figures in scoring in at least one game this season.
- **Three** different individuals have recorded at least **30** points in a game for Texas this year (42 by Jordan Pope vs. New Orleans; 34 by Arthur Kaluma vs. No. 2/2 Auburn; 30 by Tre Johnson vs. No. 13/13 Texas A&M).
- The Longhorns have averaged just **9.5** turnovers per contest.

NEED TO UPDATE THE RECORD BOOK

- Texas posted a 121-57 victory over Arkansas-Pine Bluff on Dec. 15 in Moody Center.
- The 121 points marked the **eighth** most points scored in UT program history and most since Texas scored 122 against Sam Houston State in a 122-71 home win on Nov. 24, 2003.
- The 64-point margin of victory marked the **ninth** largest in program history and largest since a 72-point home win (110-38) against Prairie View A&M on Dec. 30, 2005.
- The Longhorns set Moody Center records for most points scored (121) and largest margin of victory (64 points). UT's previous highs were 103 points in a 116-103 loss to K-State on Jan. 3, 2023 and a 51-point win (82-31) against Houston Christian on Nov. 10, 2022.
- The 66 points scored by Texas in the first half marked the fifth-highest total in a first half in school history and most since the Longhorns scored 67 against Sam Houston State on Nov. 24, 2003.

JOHNSON'S IMPRESSIVE START

Freshman G **Tre Johnson** has recorded some impressive numbers during his first **20** collegiate contests. Johnson has reached double figures in **19** of his 20 games played, topped the 20-point mark **seven** times and eclipsed the 30-point mark **once**.

- Johnson is averaging a team-best (and SEC-best) **19.0** ppg while converting **45.0**-percent (134-298) from the field, including a **37.7**-percent mark (49-130) from three-point range, and 62-of-70 (**.886**) free throws this season. He also leads the team in minutes (32.6 mpg) and ranks second in assists (46, 2.3 apg) and third in steals (19).
- His 19.0 ppg is the **highest scoring average by a Texas player since J'Covan Brown** averaged 20.1 ppg during the 2011-12 season.
- Johnson was named **SEC Freshman of the Week** (Feb. 3) for the second-straight week and **third** time this season for his efforts in the two road games at No. 23/23 Ole Miss (Jan. 29) and LSU (Feb. 1). He averaged 20.0 ppg, 4.0 apg, 3.0 rpg and 1.5 spg while converting a perfect 10-of-10 from the free throw line.
- He registered 18 points (7-13 FG, 2-4 threes, 2-2 FT), a **career-high five assists** against just one turnover, four boards and two steals in 30 minutes at LSU (Feb. 1).
- Johnson posted a game-high 22 points (8-8 FT) and three assists in 33 minutes at No. 23/23 Ole Miss (Jan. 29).

Senior F **Arthur Kaluma** has played in **122** career games (**120** starts) during his four years at Texas (2024-25), Kansas State (2023-24) and Creighton (2021-23). He owns four-year collegiate career totals of **1,518** points and **786** rebounds. Kaluma has converted 44.5-percent (526-1181) from the floor and 73.6-percent (320-435) from the free throw line in his career. He has reached double figures in scoring **85** times, topped the 20-point mark **12** times and surpassed the 30-point mark **once** in his career. Kaluma has reached double digits in rebounds **16** times while recording **13** career double-doubles.

Pope has converted 43.9-percent (433-986) from the floor, including a **37.3**-percent mark (167-448) from three-point range, and **85.8**-percent (188-219) from the free throw line in his career. He has reached double figures in scoring **65** times, topping the 20-point mark **15** times and hitting the 30-point plateau **three** times.

- Through the first 22 games (22 starts), Pope leads the team in steals (26) and ranks third in scoring (11.6 ppg), fourth in assists (38, 1.7 apg) and minutes (25.4 mpg). Pope has registered a **1.81 assist-to-turnover (38-21) ratio** this season.

Graduate G **Tramon Mark** (first name pronounced: truh-Mon) has played in **125** career games (**84** starts) during his five years at Texas (2024-25), Arkansas (2023-24) and Houston (2020-23). He received a medical redshirt for the 2021-22 season while at Houston. Mark owns collegiate career totals of **1,372** points, **487** rebounds, **221** assists and **129** steals. He has reached double figures in scoring **68** times, topped the 20-point mark **16** times and hit the 30-point mark **twice** in his career. Mark has reached double digits in rebounds **once** and recorded **one** career double-double. He earned his undergraduate degree from Arkansas in Summer 2024.

- He missed the team's opening **four** contests this season with a right ankle injury.
- Mark has played in 18 games (15 starts) and ranks fourth on the team in scoring (9.6 ppg) and rebounding (3.5 rpg) and fifth in minutes (24.6 mpg). Graduate F **Kadin Shedrick** (first name pronounced: KAY-den) has played in **130** career games (**67** starts) during his six years at Texas (2023-25) and Virginia (2019-23). He owns six-year collegiate totals of **888** points, **550** rebounds and **184** blocks. Shedrick has converted **61.4**-percent (323-526) from the floor and **72.1**-percent (235-326) from the free throw line in his career. He has reached double figures in scoring **42** times, including **two** 20-point efforts, and double digits in rebounds **eight** times in his career and registered **seven** career double-doubles. A two-time All-ACC Academic Team selection (2022 and 2023), Shedrick earned his BS in Commerce from Virginia in Spring 2023 and is pursuing his master's degree in Strategic Communication at Texas.

Graduate G **Julian Larry** has played in **152** career games (**108** starts) during his five years at Texas (2024-25) and Indiana State (2020-24). He owns five-year collegiate career totals of **1,062** points, **490** assists, **416** rebounds and **184** steals. Larry has converted **49.2**-percent (368-748) from the floor, including a **39.4**-percent (89-226) mark from three-point range, and 79.3-percent (237-299) from the free throw line in his career. He also sports an impressive **1.98** assist-to-turnover ratio (490-247) during his career. Larry has reached double figures in scoring **48** times in his career, including **two** 20-point efforts. He has also reached double digits in assists **twice** and recorded **two** career double-doubles (points-assists). Larry earned his undergraduate degree from Indiana State in Spring 2024.

- Through the first 22 games, Larry leads the team in assists (84, 3.8 apg) and ranks fifth in steals (16) and seventh in scoring (5.0 ppg) in 21.7 mpg.
- He has converted **31-of-35 (.886)** free throws this season. Larry also sports a **2.21** assist-to-turnover ratio (84 assists, 38 turnovers) this year.
- Larry registered a **career-high 13 assists** against just two turnovers and added 11 points (3-5 threes) in 25 minutes against Arkansas-Pine Bluff (Dec. 15). This marked his first double-double as a Longhorn and second of his collegiate career. His 13 assists marked the most by a Texas player since T.J. Ford had 13 in the 2003 NCAA Semifinals against Syracuse (April 5, 2003).
- He posted 12 points (3-4 FG, 2-2 threes, 4-4 FT), three boards, two assists and one steal in 23 minutes against St. Joe's (Nov. 22). All 12 of his points came in the second half. With his driving layup at the 7:26 mark of the second half, **Larry reached the 1,000-point mark in his collegiate career.**
- Larry recorded a season-high 13 points (5-7 FG, 3-3 FT), four assists, three boards and one block in 26 minutes against Mississippi Valley State (Nov. 16).
- He tallied 10 points (4-8 FG, 2-2 FT), four assists and three rebounds in 24 minutes against Chicago State (Nov. 12).
- Last year at Indiana State, he claimed All-Missouri Valley Conference (MVC) Third Team and MVC All-Defensive Team honors.
- Larry led the team in assists (188, 4.8 apg), steals (59) and minutes (34.4 mpg) while ranking fifth in scoring (11.0 ppg) and helped lead Indiana State to a 32-7 record (17-3 MVC) and advance to the NIT Championship Game.

KENT BACK WHERE IT ALL STARTED

Graduate F **Jayson Kent**, who was born in Austin when his father (Jason) was the head coach at Huston-Tillotson University and his mother (Anna) worked in the UT Athletics Department, has played in **138** career games (**63** starts) during his five years at Texas (2024-25), Indiana State (2022-24) and Bradley (2020-22). He owns five-year collegiate career totals of **1,027** points and **517** rebounds. Kent has converted **50.0**-percent (371-742) from the floor and **76.9**-percent (193-251) from the free throw line in his career. He has reached double figures in scoring **51** times in his career, including **five** 20-point efforts. Kent has reached double digits in rebounds **12** times in his career and recorded **10** career double-doubles. He earned his undergraduate degree from Indiana State in Spring 2024.

- Kent has appeared in 14 games (one start) this season and ranks eighth on the squad in scoring (4.1 ppg) in 15.9 mpg.
- He returned to the court against Northwestern State (Dec. 29) after **missing the previous eight games** with a right wrist injury. Kent tallied nine points (3-4 FG, 1-2 threes, 2-2 FT), two boards, one block and one assist in 18 minutes. With his free throw at the 5:31 mark of the second half, **Kent reached the 1,000-point mark in his collegiate career.**
- Kent recorded 10 points (3-5 FG, 2-3 threes), five rebounds (four offensive) and two steals in 18 minutes against Houston Christian (Nov. 8).
- Last year at Indiana State, he played in 38 of 39 games (37 starts) and led the team in rebounding (8.1 rpg) and ranked second in blocks (20) and fourth in scoring (13.5 ppg) in 30.3 mpg.
- Kent posted a career-high 35 points (11-12 FG, 2-2 threes, 11-12 FT) against SMU in the 2024 NIT First Round (Mar. 20). He also grabbed a career-best 20 rebounds last year against Drake.

PRYOR IS ONE TO WATCH

Sophomore F **Devon Pryor** (first name is pronounced: duh-VONN) has played in **19** career games during his two years at Texas (2023-25).

- Despite battling ankle injuries during the early part of the season, Pryor has seen action in **12** games this year and is averaging 3.9 ppg and 2.3 rpg in 11.0 mpg.
- Over the **last three contests**, he has seen his role in the rotation increase and has averaged 6.3 ppg and 4.0 rpg in 16.9 mpg while converting 9-of-13 (.692) field goals.
- Pryor posted nine points (4-6 FG, 1-1 threes), a **career-high six rebounds** (four offensive) and one assist while tying his career high in minutes (21) at LSU (Feb. 1).
- He recorded a career-high 10 points (4-5 FG, 2-3 threes), three rebounds, three assists and two steals in 21 minutes against Arkansas-Pine Bluff (Dec. 15).
- Pryor reclassified academically to join the Longhorns for the 2023-24 season and enrolled at Texas in the fall of 2023. He saw action in seven games last year.

JUST CALL HIM 'BIG Z'

Senior F **Ze'Rik Onyema** (pronounced: ZAIR-eck own-YEMM-ah) has played in **107** career games (**35** starts) during his five years at Texas (2023-25) and UTEP. (2020-23). He owns five-year collegiate totals of **446** points and **295** rebounds. Onyema has converted **58.0**-percent (182-314) from the floor during his career. He has reached double figures in scoring **16** times and double digits in rebounds **three** times while recording **three** career double-doubles.

- Through the first 22 games this season, he is averaging 3.9 ppg and 2.7 rpg in 11.0 mpg.
- Onyema recorded his **first double-double of the season** and third of his collegiate career with 12 points (4-7 FG, 4-4 FT) and a season-high 10 rebounds in a season-best 25 minutes at No. 5/4 Florida (Jan. 18). He also set a career high in assists (3).
- He tallied eight points (2-2 FG, 4-6 FT) and five boards in 16 minutes against Northwestern State (Dec. 29).
- Onyema registered 10 points (3-3 FG, 4-4 FT), two rebounds, one assist, one block and one steal in 15 minutes against New Mexico State (Dec. 12).
- He posted a Texas career-high 18 points (7-8 FG, 4-4 FT), six rebounds (three offensive), two steals, one assist and one blocked shot in 21 minutes against Chicago State (Nov. 12).
- Onyema played in 23 games (three starts) last season at Texas and ranked fourth on the team in blocks (16) while averaging 3.3 ppg and 2.2 rpg in 9.1 mpg. He converted 54.5-percent (30-55) from the floor last year.
- He played in 61 games (32 starts) over his three years at UTEP (2020-23). Onyema redshirted in 2020-21 when Rodney Terry was the head coach at UTEP.
- Onyema celebrated his 23rd birthday on Halloween (Oct. 31).

CODIE CRACKING THE ROTATION

Freshman F **Nic Codie** has seen action in 13 of the last 18 contests since being cleared to play.

- In his 13 games played this season, Codie is averaging 2.5 points and 1.1 rebounds in 6.2 minutes per game while hitting **77.8**-percent (14-18) from the floor, including 2-of-2 threes, and 2-of-3 free throws.
- He had a breakout performance in the home win over Arkansas-Pine Bluff (Dec. 15). **Codie posted a career and game-high 20 points (8-10 FG, 2-2 threes, 2-2 FT), two rebounds and one assist in 16 minutes.**
- He was the top-ranked player in the state of Texas in the Class of 2024 by 247 Sports Composite. Codie was the No. 55-ranked player nationally in the Class of 2024 by Rivals, No. 58 in the 247 Sports Composite, No. 71 by 247 Sports, No. 73 by On3 and No. 76 by ESPN.
- Codie averaged 14.1 ppg and 8.4 rpg in just 14 games during his senior season at Newman Smith HS (Carrollton, Texas) before suffering a right knee injury in January 2024. He averaged 16 points and nine rebounds per game in his junior season.

VINSON EARNS A LOOK

Freshman F **Jamie Vinson** has caught the coaching staff's attention during preseason workouts and early in the regular season.

- Vinson has played in eight games and is averaging 2.5 points and 1.3 rebounds in 5.2 minutes per contest. He has converted 81.8-percent (9-11) from the floor this season.
- He posted six points (3-3 FG) and one rebound in seven minutes against Mississippi Valley State (Nov. 16).
- Vinson played his junior and senior seasons at Oak Hill Academy (Mouth of Wilson, Va.) and was ranked as the No. 26 center prospect nationally by Rivals and the No. 36 center by ESPN in the class of 2024.
- Born and raised in Austin, he played at St. Michael's Catholic Academy (Austin, Texas) during his freshman and sophomore seasons.

IMPRESSIVE THREE-POINT STREAK

- The last time Texas did NOT convert a 3-pointer in a contest came on Dec. 18, 1990, in an 87-84 overtime victory at UC Santa Barbara. The Horns were 0-of-2 from beyond the arc that day.
- **The Longhorns enter Wednesday's contest having hit at least one 3-pointer in 1,148 consecutive games.**
- UT has converted at least one 3-pointer in 1,276 of 1,284 games since the 3-pointer was introduced prior to the 1986-87 season.
- The Horns have failed to ATTEMPT at least one 3-pointer just one time in school history (Feb. 24, 1988 in a 69-55 win at TCU).

HORNS IN THE NBA

- A total of 10 former University of Texas players appeared on NBA rosters when the league opened the 2024-25 regular season.
- In addition to the 10 former Longhorns on NBA rosters, Royal Ivey is an assistant coach for the Houston Rockets and Matt Hill is an assistant coach with the Charlotte Hornets.

DID YOU KNOW ...

- **Cole Bott** earned his bachelor's degree in Finance in Spring 2024 (in just three years) from the prestigious McCombs School of Business at Texas. He is pursuing his master's degree in Strategic Communications. Bott is the first player in UT program history to wear jersey No. 7.
- **Preston Clark** is the first player in UT program history to wear jersey No. 8. Preston's father, Jim, was a walk-on football player at Texas in the mid-1990s.
- **Nic Codie** wears jersey No. 10 to pay tribute to his late friend, Deshawn Jagwan. Jagwan wore No. 10 at Woodrow Wilson HS and passed away in 2022 in a car crash. Nic's father, Nakia, played football at Baylor (1994-98) before spending one year with the Detroit Lions and three years with the Pittsburgh Steelers in the NFL.
- The full name of **Tre Johnson** is Richard Earl Johnson III (he goes by "Tre" since he is Richard III). Tre's father, Richard, played basketball at Baylor (1995-97) and Midwestern State (Wichita Falls, Texas). Richard scored 1,009 points in two years at Midwestern State and is inducted in the school's Athletics Hall of Honor. Tre wears jersey No. 20 to pay tribute to his father, who wore the number during his playing career.
- **Arthur Kaluma** lived in Boston, Los Angeles and Dallas during his childhood before moving to Glendale, Ariz., when he was 16 prior to his junior year of high school. Both of his parents (Patrick and Saira) are from Uganda. Arthur received his Ugandan citizenship in 2020 and has twice played for the Ugandan National Team. His older brother, Adam Seiko, played basketball at San Diego State (2017-23).
- **Jayson Kent** was born in Austin and lived in the city until he was four years old. His father, Jason, was the head coach at Huston-Tillotson University in Austin from 2001-04. His mother, Anna, previously worked in the UT Athletics Department. His younger sister, Janae, is a sophomore on the women's basketball team at Texas A&M. Jayson wears jersey No. 25 in memory of his late AAU coach DeMarco Minor.
- **Julian Larry** played football (quarterback/cornerback) at Lone Star High School (Frisco, Texas) until his senior year.
- **Tramon Mark** has an uncle, Vernon Crawford, who played football (linebacker) at Florida State and went on to play three seasons with the New England Patriots in the NFL.
- **Ze'Rik Onyema** has previously lived in Savannah, Ga.; Houston; Germany; El Paso; San Antonio; and Hawaii. His father, Kingsley, is a native of Owerri, Nigeria. Kingsley works in logistics for the U.S. Army and is based at the Pentagon. His mother, Mary, is an eighth-grade teacher. He wears jersey No. 21 to pay tribute to his mother's birthday (April 21) and his parents' anniversary (June 21).
- **Jordan Pope** lost his mother, Chantay Pope, four days prior to his fourth birthday from breast cancer. His father, Rodney Sr., has since remarried and Jordan has four siblings. Jordan began wearing jersey No. 0 in the seventh grade.
- **Devon Pryor** wears jersey No. 22 to honor his father, Alfred, who wore the same number when he played.
- **Kadin Shedrick** has a younger sister, Kari, who plays softball at Charlotte. He played baseball as his primary sport until the age of 15. Kadin grew from 6-2 to 6-8 between his freshman and sophomore year of high school. His mother, Cindy, competed for the club Rowing team at the University of Cincinnati.
- **Chendall Weaver** wears jersey No. 2 to honor the memory of his best friend, Nevaeh Lopez who passed in 2020 (she attended Mansfield Timberview HS and wore jersey No. 2). His older sister, Chennedy Carter, played basketball at Texas A&M (2016-19) and was the No. 4 pick of the 2020 WNBA Draft by the Atlanta Dream. She played two seasons with the Atlanta Dream (2020-21), one season with the Los Angeles Sparks (2022) and spent the 2024 season with the Chicago Sky.
