CONFERENCE NOTES

Player of the Week

• Madison Booker helped Texas to a 2-0 week, including a win over South Carolina to break the Gamecocks 57-game SEC win streak. Against South Carolina, Booker recorded her fifth double-double of the season with 20 points and 11 rebounds. It was the 11th time this season Booker has scored 20 or more points in a game. Earlier in the week in a win over Vanderbilt, Booker stuffed the stat sheet with 20 points, six rebounds, four assists, two blocked shots and one steal. Booker has scored in double figures in 20 games this season and the last eight in a row. For the week, Booker averaged 20 points, 8.5 rebounds, 3.5 assists, 1.0 blocks and 1.5 steals.

Freshman of the Week

• Mikayla Blakes scored 22 points, pulled down four rebounds, and collected three steals at No. 4/6 Texas last Thursday. Blakes extended her double-digit scoring streak to 10 games with a 22-point performance at No. 4/6 Texas. The guard shot 57.1 percent from the field and went a perfect 6-of-6 from the free throw line. Blakes pulled down four rebounds, tallied three steals, and dished out two assists against the Longhorns. The Somerset, New Jersey, native posted her 15th game of the season with 20 or more points. Blakes is averaging 22.8 points in five games vs. ranked opponents this season. Her 22-point performance marked the freshman's seventh SEC game in which she scored 20-plus points.

Around the League

• The SEC has had at least seven teams ranked all 15 weeks of this season's polls. This week the conference has the most teams ranked of any conference. In total, nine of the SEC's 16 teams have been ranked at some point this season.

• The SEC leads the nation with three teams (1. South Carolina, 3. Texas, 9. LSU) ranked in the Top 10 of the NCAA's NET rankings with eight total in the Top 20 (12. Tennessee, 13. Ole Miss, 16. Oklahoma, 17. Alabama, 19. Kentucky).

• SEC teams have won 81% of their non-conference games this season, including 41-26 (.612) against the ACC (19-13 -

.594), Big Ten (9-6 - .600), Big 12 (7-5 - .583), and Big East (6-2 - .750). The final regular season non-conference game is on Sunday (UConn at South Carolina).

• In her 145th career game, Madison Scott officially became the most experienced player in Ole Miss history. She passed Rebel legend Peggie Gillom-Granderson for most games played donning an Ole Miss jersey. She shined in her history-making day, scoring a team-leading 22 points while adding six rebounds and two blocks to lead Ole Miss to its 31st program top-10 win and second in the Coach Yo era.

• Sarah Ashlee Barker helped aid in Alabama's back-to-back road wins this week as she collected two-consecutive double-doubles.

• Georgia freshman forward Mia Woolfolk recorded her second career double-double and led the Lady Bulldogs with a team-high 16 points and a team-best 10 rebounds in a win against Arkansas. Woolfolk has now scored in double figures four times in the last five games, leading her team in both scoring and rebounding during this current five-game stretch.

2025 SEC TOURNAMENT

Beginning with its inception and through 1986, the tournament was held at campus sites. The tournament was then sent to Albany, Ga., which served as the site for six years from 1987-92. The tournament then moved to Chattanooga, Tenn., where it was held from 1993-2000, with the exception of 1998 when the tournament moved to Columbus, Ga.

Since 2001 the tournament has enjoyed many new sites, including Memphis (2001), Nashville (2002, 2004, 2008, 2011, 2012, 2018, 2022), Little Rock, Ark. (2003, 2006, 2009, 2015), Greenville, S.C. (2005, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021, 2023, 2024, 2025), Duluth, Ga. (2007, 2010, 2013, 2014) and Jacksonville, Fla. (2016).

The conference announced a three-year extension with Greenville, S.C. to host the SEC Women's Basketball Tournament in 2026, 2027 and 2028.

The winner of the tournament receives the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament.

The event has helped set the stage for SEC teams in the NCAA Tournament, as 31 of the conference tournament champions have advanced to at least the Sweet 16. Four of the last 14 SEC Tournament champions have gone on to win the national championship. The SEC Tournament Champion has failed to win at least one NCAA Tournament game only twice.

Tennessee leads the league with 17 SEC Tournament titles. South Carolina is second with eight, Vanderbilt has six, while Auburn, Georgia, each have four. LSU has two with Kentucky, Mississippi State and Texas A&M having each won one SEC Tournament championship.

WOMEN'S BASKETBALL LEADERSHIP COUNCIL

- The council consists of one women's basketball student-athlete from each of the SEC's 16 institutions. The goal of the leadership council is for student-athletes to serve as a conduit of communication from their teams to the conference office on issues related to student-athlete experience, student-athlete wellness, and to provide feedback on proposed rules governing the SEC and NCAA.

BY THE NUMBERS

- In regular season games, the SEC has compiled a 6176-1789 (.775) record against other conferences. In the postseason, SEC teams are 560-293 (.657) against non-conference teams. Overall, teams are 6736-2082 (.764).
- The league has recorded 150+ wins in 29 seasons and has recorded a non-conference winning percentage below .700 only once.
- Since the SEC began to sponsor women's basketball in the 1981-82 season, it has failed only six times to place at least five members in each of the final polls (the USA Today/ESPN poll began in the 1985-1986 season).
- The most SEC teams in the final AP poll is seven, which the league has done five times (1995, 1996, 1997, 2003, and 2018).
- Overall, the league teams have been ranked every week except for the very first poll in 1976.
- The league has had the top three teams in the AP Poll twice. In week three in 2005 and in week eight in 1989.
- SEC schools have produced 53 Team USA Olympians since 1976, with 49 coming since the SEC began sponsoring women's basketball. In addition, 10 have played for other countries in the Olympics.
- In 2023, a total of 1,146,341 fans passed through SEC turnstiles during home games and conference tournament action. Overall, the league has five of the Top 10 total attendance seasons.
