#### SAINT LOUIS EARNS FIRST NCAA TOURNAMENT BERTH

- After claiming their first Atlantic 10 Conference Championship title, the Saint Louis Billikens (34-22) are making their first NCAA Tournament appearance.

- SLU joins Belmont, Mercer, North Florida and Santa Clara as first-time NCAA participants.

- The Billikens came close to making the NCAA field three times prior to winning the 2025 A-10 tournament crown, finishing as runner-up in 2007, 2014 and 2024.

- The A-10 Championship triumph is SLU softball's second league championship. The Billikens captured the 2023 regular-season title.

#### BILLIKENS VS. 2025 TOURNAMENT TEAMS

- Santa Clara (Tucson Regional) is the only 2025 NCAA Tournament qualifier Saint Louis faced this season. The Billikens played the Broncos twice at Hawaii's season-opening Paradise Classic, winning the first game 4-3 and falling 6-4 in the second.

#### SERIES RECORDS VS. FAYETTEVILLE REGIONAL FIELD

- Arkansas holds an 8-0 series lead over Saint Louis. The series' first three games were played in Fayetteville (2008, 2013 twice), the next two were neutral-site games (2015), and the most recent three were played in St. Louis (2017, 2018 twice).

- Indiana leads SLU 5-3 in a series that dates to 1980. In the teams' most recent meeting in 2015, the Billikens edged the Hoosiers 2-1 in a tournament at Kennesaw State.

- Saint Louis and Oklahoma State have never met in softball.

#### HOW SLU GOT HERE: PLENTY OF A-10 TOURNEY DRAMA

- Saint Louis should be prepared for any close games that occur in the NCAA Tournament as all five of the Billikens' A-10 Championship games were decided by one run.

- SLU finished second in the Atlantic 10 regular-season standings to earn a bye in the six-team A-10 Championship for a third consecutive year.

- In their tournament opener, the Bills led Fordham three different times before a pair of fifth-inning runs gave the Rams a 6-5 lead that proved to be the final score.

- In their first elimination game, the Bills trailed Saint Joseph's 2-0 after one inning but took a 3-2 lead in the third. Starting pitcher **Taylor Hochman** made that score stand up, completing a five-hitter by stranding two Hawks runners in the seventh.

- Regular-season champion and archrival Dayton was up next. In an extra-innings pitchers' duel that saw sophomore left-hander **Isabel Royle** register a two-hitter with a career-high 12 strikeouts, **Karsen Jany's** home run in the top of the 10th sent SLU to Championship Saturday to meet Fordham again.

- In game one, Saint Louis answered Fordham's fifth-inning run with a pair of its own in the bottom half on **Abby Mallo's** two-run home run. The Rams pulled even with two outs in the seventh, but Hochman again stranded two. In the eighth, Jany produced more late-innings magic with a walk-off RBI double.

- The deciding game saw Fordham grab a 1-0 first-inning lead. Mallo's two-out, bases-clearing double in the fifth put SLU on top 3-1. The Rams plated two in the sixth for a 3-3 deadlock but left two on base against Royle. The Billikens loaded the bases with one out in the seventh for Mallo; her hard-hit grounder handcuffed the shortstop, making the throw home too late to prevent the winning run from scoring.

#### MALLO LEADS BILLIKENS ON ALL-TOURNAMENT TEAM

- Abby Mallo** was selected the Most Outstanding Player of the Atlantic 10 Championship and was joined on the All-Tournament team by **Natalie Sullivan**, **Isabel Royle**, **Taylor Hochman** and **Kendall Johnson**.

- Mallo batted .385 (5-for-13) with a home run, a triple, a double and seven RBIs. She drove in all four runs in the tournament's deciding game.

- Sullivan was 9-for-19 (.474) with a triple and three stolen bases.

- Royle posted a 3-0 record, one shutout, a 1.02 ERA, a 1.11 WHIP, a .189 opponents' batting average and 19 strikeouts in 20 2/3 innings.

- Hochman went 1-1 with a 3.82 ERA, with her win coming against Saint Joseph's in SLU's first elimination game.

- Johnson was 4-for-17 (.235) at the plate and error free at third base in 18 chances, including a team-high-tying 13 assists.

## SAINT LOUIS SOFTBALL NOTES – NCAA REGIONAL

### BILLIKENS ACHIEVE SCHOOL-RECORD WINNING STREAKS

- Prior to its May 2 loss to Massachusetts, Saint Louis registered three school-record winning streaks.

- The Billikens won 15 straight games overall, 16 straight conference games and 12 consecutive home games. All three were among the top three active streaks in NCAA Division I.

- The streaks were part of SLU's 25-6 record over its last 31 games, following a 9-16 start to the season, and contributed to the second-highest win total (34) in program history.

### BILLIKENS ENJOYING LIGHTS-OUT PITCHING

- Over the last 22 games (19-3 record), Saint Louis has experienced an outstanding pitching performance.

- In those 22 games, the Billikens have nine shutouts, a 1.95 ERA and a 1.33 WHIP. SLU hurlers have allowed only 2.9 walks and 6.4 hits per seven innings and have yielded just four home runs.

- Taylor Hochman** is 9-1 with a 1.90 ERA and five shutouts; **Isabel Royle** is 7-1 with a 2.31 ERA and four shutouts; and **Anna Christ** is 3-1 with an 0.89 ERA in that span.

### DEFENSE ALSO EXCELLENT DOWN THE STRETCH

- Defense has played a major role in SLU's recent success.
- The Billikens have committed just six errors (.991 fielding percentage) and have recorded 15 of their 25 double plays in the last 22 games.

### WHO'S HOT FOR THE BILLIKENS

- Abby Mallo** has hit safely in 27 of her last 33 games. In those 33 games, Mallo is batting .423 (44-for-104) with 12 home runs, nine doubles, 60 RBIs, a .504 on-base percentage, 16 multi-RBI games and 14 multi-hit games.

- Natalie Sullivan** has hit safely in seven straight (team's longest current hitting streak) and 15 of her last 17 games, batting .456 (26-for-57) with 11 RBIs, four doubles, a .529 on-base percentage, 18 runs and 13 stolen bases in 13 attempts. Sullivan also has SLU's longest current streak, and longest streak of the season (21 games), of reaching base by hit, walk or hit-by-pitch.

- In her last 18 appearances (17 starts), **Taylor Hochman** has a 10-2 record, a 1.95 ERA and six shutouts. Hochman has won nine of her last 10 decisions.

- Isabel Royle** owns a 4-1 record, a 1.73 ERA and two shutouts in her last six appearances (four starts).

- Anna Christ** has been strong in relief over her last 10 outings, compiling a 4-1 record, a 0.83 ERA, a 0.95 WHIP and a .209 opponents' batting average. Christ has issued only six walks in 25 1/3 innings in those 10 games.

- Kendall Johnson** is 12-for-35 (.343) in her last 11 games. Since beginning the season (first 19 games) with a .154 batting average, Johnson is hitting .291 (30-for-103).

### SAINT LOUIS BREAKING, FLIRTING WITH SCHOOL RECORDS

- Saint Louis has set two single-season school records, tied another and is closing in on three more.

- The Billikens' 236 walks broke the previous record of 219 set in 2015.

- SLU's 17 sacrifice flies surpassed the previous mark of 14 (2014).

- The Bills' 25 double plays match the school record (2023).

- Saint Louis' current .978 fielding percentage would easily break the school record of .971 (2003).

- The Billikens' 34 wins and 11 shutouts are nearing the school standards of 36 (2015) and 13 (2010, 2011).

### OFFENSIVE PRODUCTION RAMPS UP

- In its first 21 games, SLU posted a .244 batting average, a .360 on-base percentage, 4.2 runs per game and 6.2 hits per game. Extra-base hits comprised 24 percent of SLU's total hits, and the Billikens struck out 6.4 times per game.

- In the 35 games since then, the Bills have a .283 batting average, a .396 on-base percentage, 5.6 runs per game and 7.5 hits per game. Their rate of extra-base hits in those 35 games is 33 percent, and the strikeout total is 4.5 per game.

### MALLO ONE OF TOP SLUGGERS IN SAINT LOUIS HISTORY

- This season, **Abby Mallo** has set school records for career home runs (42), home runs in a season (19), RBIs in a season (80; she set the previous record of 54 as a freshman) and total bases in a season (136).

- Mallo's 80 RBIs are tied for the Atlantic 10 Conference record, while her 19 home runs are one shy of the conference mark.

- With 164 career RBIs, Mallo needs just 10 more to break the Saint Louis record.

- Mallo is in position to set the school record for slugging percentage. With one season remaining, her .641 mark tops the established record of .634.

### SULLIVAN IS SLU'S "IRON WOMAN"

- Natalie Sullivan** has been the starting left fielder in every game (215) SLU has played during her four seasons, setting the school record for consecutive starts.

- Assuming she is in the lineup for each of the Billikens' remaining games, Sullivan also would own the school record for starting every team game during a career. The established record is 207.

- Sullivan has a school-record 132 career walks, and her 37 free passes this season are a record for a SLU senior.

- With 164 career runs, Sullivan needs just six more to break the Saint Louis record. Her 53 runs this year are a record for a Billiken senior and just three shy of the overall school standard.

### HOCHMAN ENDING CAREER ON A HIGH NOTE

- Following a difficult first two years, **Taylor Hochman** established herself as one of the Atlantic 10's top pitchers over the past two seasons.

- Hochman has turned in a 31-17 record, a 2.46 ERA and 10 shutouts in her junior and senior campaigns combined.

- The right-hander enjoyed the best season of her career vs. conference opponents in 2025, going 9-3 with a 1.77 ERA, six shutouts and a .225 opponents' batting average.

- Hochman's seven shutouts this season rank sixth in the nation and are just one shy of the school record of eight.

### BILLIKENS AMONG NCAA DIVISION I ACTIVE LEADERS

- Natalie Sullivan** ranks among NCAA Division I active career leaders in three categories. Sullivan is 10th in walks (132), 22nd in runs (164) and 25th in triples (11).

- Abby Mallo** is 27th in RBIs (164) and 32nd in home runs (42).

- Taylor Hochman** ranks 31st in starts (82) and 33rd in innings (522 2/3).

- Chloe Rhine** ranks 21st in walks (112).

### ULSAS REGISTERS BILLS' LONGEST HIT STREAK OF SEASON

- Abby Ulsas** put together Saint Louis' longest hitting streak of the season so far, 11 games, from late March to early April.

- Ulsas batted .462 (18-for-39) with six multiple-hit games and seven RBIs during the streak.

### ONE-RUN GAMES TRENDING IN BILLIKENS' FAVOR

- Saint Louis lost seven of its first 10 one-run decisions this season but has rebounded to go above .500 in such games.

- The Billikens have won four straight (all in the A-10 Championship) and seven of their last nine one-run games to improve to 10-9.

### TWO-OUT MAGIC

- The Billikens have had considerable success scoring runs with two outs this season. Of SLU's 284 runs, 128 have scored with two outs – 45 percent.

- In the A-10 Championship, eight of Saint Louis' 16 runs scored with two outs.

### SLU ONE OF NCAA'S BEST IN HOME CONFERENCE PLAY

- Saint Louis produced one of the nation's top home records in conference play this season.

- The Billikens were 13-1 at home against Atlantic 10 opponents, tying Liberty and South Florida for the second-most victories behind College of Charleston (14).

- SLU's .929 home winning percentage against conference foes was third highest.

•**Abby Mallo** was named A-10 Player of the Week and was included on the NFCA's "Selected Top Performances" list and in Michella Chester's NCAA "Lineup of the Week" for March 31-April 6 and April 21-27.

•Mallo earned the A-10 and NFCA honors for Feb. 24-March 2. She also was the A-10 Player of the Week for April 7-13.

•**Scout Gallagher** was selected A-10 Rookie of the Week for Feb. 24-March 2 and March 24-30.

•**Taylor Hochman** earned a spot on the NFCA's "Selected Top Performances" list for Feb. 3-9 and April 14-20.

•**Natalie Sullivan** made the NFCA's "Selected Top Performances" list for April 14-20.

•Hochman and Sullivan were chosen to the Paradise Classic All-Tournament team.

## **SAINT LOUIS SOFTBALL NOTES – NCAA REGIONAL**

### **MALLO NAMED ATLANTIC 10 CONFERENCE CO-PLAYER OF THE YEAR**

#### ***Rhine, Connoyer Also Earn Major Postseason Awards***

Saint Louis University junior catcher **Abby Mallo**, who established herself as one of the nation's top power hitters this season, was named Atlantic 10 Conference softball co-Player of the Year. Mallo is the first player in program history to earn an A-10 Player of the Year award and is one of six Billiken softball student-athletes to garner 2025 A-10 postseason accolades.

Mallo earned the second All-Conference honor of her career with her selection to the first team. Saint Louis has placed at least one player on the A-10 first team every year since 2013 except for the pandemic-shortened season of 2020, when the conference did not hand out postseason awards.

Junior shortstop **Chloe Rhine** and head coach **Christy Connoyer** also were recipients of major awards. Rhine was named Defensive Player of the Year, while Connoyer claimed Coach of the Year plaudits for a second time in three seasons.

Senior left fielder **Natalie Sullivan** and senior pitcher **Taylor Hochman** were voted to the All-Conference second team. Sullivan collected A-10 postseason laurels for a fourth consecutive season (All-Conference in 2023, 2024 and 2025, All-Rookie in 2022). Hochman's selection is her first All-Conference nod and second postseason honor (All-Rookie in 2022).

Redshirt-freshman pitcher **Anna Christ** and freshman designated player **Scout Gallagher** landed on the All-Rookie team, giving Saint Louis at least two All-Rookie choices for a fourth consecutive year.

SLU tied the school record for A-10 All-Academic selections as Sullivan (marketing major, 3.954 GPA), Hochman (education and mathematics major, 3.770 GPA) and Mallo (biomedical engineering major, 3.42 GPA) were chosen to the 10-member list. Hochman and Sullivan are repeat selections from 2024. SLU has placed at least two student-athletes on the All-Academic team 13 times in 20 years of A-10 membership, including each of the past five seasons.

CHRISTY CONNOYER  
Head Coach • 15th Season at SLU  
University of Notre Dame (1994)

As she guides the Saint Louis University softball program in the 2025 campaign – her 15th at the helm – Christy Connoyer is the longest-tenured head coach in team history.

Connoyer, who this year was inducted into the Metro St. Louis Softball Hall of Fame, also is Billiken softball's winningest coach. She owns a 387-370 record as the Saint Louis mentor and a 418-400 career mark. Connoyer's 400th career win was a 3-0 victory over George Washington on April 6 of this year.

Saint Louis softball made history this season by capturing its first Atlantic 10 Conference Championship title and earning its first NCAA Tournament bid. The A-10 Championship appearance was SLU's 11th in 12 seasons, and the Bills earned a first-round bye for a third straight year.

Connoyer, who earned a second A-10 Coach of the Year award, has guided the 2025 Billikens to 34 wins, second most in program history and a total that includes a school-record 15-game winning streak. It is the third consecutive 30-win season for Saint Louis, a program first.

In 2024, the Billikens finished as the A-10 Championship runner-up for a second time during Connoyer's tenure.

The veteran skipper was named 2023 A-10 Coach of the Year after steering SLU to the A-10 regular-season championship, the first league title in program history. Saint Louis' 20 victories and .800 winning percentage in conference play set school records.

Connoyer spent one season as head coach at Tulsa. She also has been an assistant on the Southern Illinois and Purdue coaching staffs, and she has served on the coaching staff for USA Athletes International teams that competed in Australia and the Netherlands.

In addition, Connoyer has been heavily involved in collegiate softball off the field. She served on the National Fastpitch Coaches Association All-America Selection Committee as the Mid-Atlantic Region voting representative from 2013-16, and she was Chair of the All-America Committee from 2015-16. Since 2017, Connoyer has been the A-10's representative on the NFCA Head Coach Committee. She also has been a frequent presenter at NFCA coaches' clinics.

A shortstop in her playing days, Connoyer was a four-time first-team All-Conference selection at the University of Notre Dame. She received team Most Valuable Player honors in 1993 and was voted team captain in 1994.
