Arkansas defeats Oregon 3-2 to win the Stephens Cup

Fall Notes and Recaps

→ Arkansas finished the fall with a 31-2 record in stroke play and a 1-0 record in match play.

→ For the second year in a row, Arkansas started its season with a runner-up finish at the Carmel Cup. Also for the second-straight year, Maria José Marin, who posted the low round of the final day with a 67, was the individual runner-up while Kendall Todd recorded her second career top-five finish, tying for fourth.

→ Arkansas started its win streak at the Blessings Collegiate Invitational. The Hogs finished the event 12-under par and had a comfortable 32-shot margin over second-place finisher No. 16 Mississippi State. The squad has now won four of the last five BCI team titles and set a new tournament record for the lowest women's team score (852) in the process. Maria José Marin also went back-to-back and added her second career individual title. The sophomore set a BCI record for the lowest individual score (-11) and bested her 2023 score of -10. The Razorbacks were the only team to finish under par and occupied 4 of the leaderboard's top 5 spots.

→ The Hogs picked up win No. 2 at the Dale McNamara Invitational in October with a 21-stroke margin. Junior Reagan Zibilski (-6) was crowned the individual champion, her first collegiate win, and senior Kendall Todd (-2) added her fourth career runner-up finish. Zibilski made history after shooting a program-low 63 and dropped two eagles on the par-5 No. 5 and the par-4 No. 12 holes. Along with Zibilski and Todd, two other Hogs finished in the top 15 after completing the 54-hole tournament. Freshman Clarisa Temelo (+5) finished T-7th for the second straight event and reigning SEC Golfer of the Week Maria José Marin (+8) sat at No. 14 in the leaderboard.

→ Arkansas, by now ranked No. 1 in Scoreboard by Clippd's collegiate golf ranking, extended its streak at the Jackson T. Stephens Cup with a match play victory over No. 13 Oregon. The Hogs finished behind the Ducks in the stroke play portion but advanced to the championship match after finishing 9 strokes ahead of No. 17 Wake Forest. The Hogs lead in all 5 matches on the front 9 before giving up leads in 3 matches heading into the final few holes. After José Marin, the top-ranked women's college golfer, wrapped up her match against Suvichaya Vinijchaitam, 4&3, the two teams were tied 2-2 with just 1 pairing remaining. Freshman Natalie Blonien, up against reigning WGCA Co-Freshman of the Year Kiara Romero, made her collegiate match play debut as Arkansas' anchor. The Altus, Okla. native got out to an early 2-hole lead on the front 9 and fell behind by 2 holes going into the 15th hole. On the par-3 15th, Blonien sunk her first birdie since No. 8 and ended a stretch of 5 bogeys. With the lead cut to 1 hole, the pair tied No. 16. Despite a tee shot into the rough on hole 17, Blonien's second shot managed to fall within 5 feet of the hole and pressured Romero into conceding the after her attempt from the rough resulted in a lengthy putt for birdie. Headed into the 18th, the match was tied for the first time since No. 12. Both players found the fairway to begin the par 4 and followed up with both of their second shots on the green, with Blonien's closer at roughly 25 feet out from the pin. Romero, first to putt, missed her long-range attempt for birdie and put Blonien in position to win the team title for Arkansas with a made birdie putt. The freshman did just that when her 25-footer slowed up and made a slight curl to the right before dropping in the hole. "Going into 18, there was definitely some pressure," Blonien said. "I just took a deep breath, which is something I worked on the last three holes to stay calm and keep myself in it. I hit a really good shot into 18, and we picked out a great spot, so all it needed was speed, and it was dead in the heart of the cup. I struggled a little in stroke play earlier in the week, but today was a fresh day and I knew I had to help my team any way I could."
