## **GAME NOTES**

- » **QB Taylen Green** became the first Arkansas QB to hit the 1,000-yard mark during the fourth game of the season since Brandon Allen in 2015. Green eclipsed the 1,000-yard mark courtesy of a 15-yard pass to TE Jaden Platt with 2:05 on the clock in the second guarter.
- » Arkansas scored 28 points in the first half for the fourth straight game this season. It is the first time Arkansas has done so in each of its first four games since at least 1992.
- » TE Rohan Jones hauled in two receptions for a career-high 102 receiving yards in addition to registering five rushing yards and a rushing touchdown. He became the first Arkansas TE to record 100+ receiving yards in a game since 2023. It also marked Jones' first career 100-yard receiving game.
- » WR Raylen Sharpe has caught at least one pass in 33 consecutive games dating back to Sept. 24, 2022, while at Missouri State. His 33-game reception streak is tied for the fourth-longest mark nationally.
- » DL Quincy Rhodes Jr. registered his fourth and fifth sacks of the season, collecting his second multisack game this season. He became the first Razorback with multiple multi-sack games in a season since LB Drew Sanders in 2022.
- » The Razorbacks' 203 consecutive extra-points made streak, which began on Dec. 5, 2020, is the second-longest such streak nationally based on date, behind Northwestern (Oct. 24, 2020).
- » QB Taylen Green's 62-yard TD pass to TE Rohan Jones with 13:50 on the clock in the first quarter was the longest TD pass for Arkansas since Green connected with Isaac TeSlaa on a 75-yard pass in the game's opening drive on Sept. 28, 2024, in a loss to Texas A&M. The reception by Jones was the longest TD reception by an Arkansas TE since Cheyenne O'Grady's 62-yard TD reception on Sept. 14, 2019, in a win over Colorado State.
- » With a five-yard rush at the 7:41 mark of the second quarter, TE Rohan Jones became the first Arkansas TE to rush for a touchdown since Austin Cantrell did so during a 39-38 win over Coastal Carolina on Nov. 4, 2017.
- » OL Fernando Carmona Jr. started his 41st consecutive game on the offensive line dating back to his redshirt freshman season at San Jose State in 2022.
- » DB Miguel Mitchell registered his third career interception and second as a Razorback when he picked off Memphis WR CJ Smith on a trick play in the second quarter.
- » Arkansas has scored a touchdown on the opening drive in three games this season, which is the most through the first four games of a season in the Sam Pittman era (2020-present).
- » TE Rohan Jones is the first Arkansas TE with both a receiving touchdown and a rushing touchdown in a game since at least 1997.

## ARKANSAS QUOTES

## Sam Pittman, Arkansas Head Coach

### **Opening Statement:**

"Congratulations to Memphis. They played a very physical and good game. They outrushed us and outscored us. They had more yards than we did. Coming into the game I thought we could have had an advantage there but their defense did a nice job on us. Their offense did about whatever they wanted to in the run game with two guys over 100 yards ... We did not tackle well. We were not fit well. It is the second week in a row we came down with a chance to win and had a turnover. It is disappointing for our guys that we did not win the game, but I am going to give Memphis credit. They played a really good game. They are well coached."

#### On two-minute drive at the end of the game:

"We knew we had three timeouts ... At the two-minute mark, we wanted to get the first down because we wanted to get him out of his timeouts, but we were not gonna score at that particular time in the game. We had a chance to do that later on, once he got out of his timeouts, but when we fumbled, I think he only used one of them. We were trying to get a first down and then we were going to decide whether he was going to let us score or if we were going to kneel it out and kick a field goal but we needed another first down to get him out of his timeouts and as you seen he went 95 (yards) on us in no time before so we were trying to take all the clock we possibly good. Unfortunately, we fumbled, and the game was over."

## Cam Ball, Arkansas DL

#### On the game:

"It was very devastating. This is not what we expected. We did not go into this game with the mindset of this outcome."

### Taylen Green, Arkansas QB

#### On the final drive:

"Just taking things one play at a time. Doing my job. Making sure everyone is lined up. When the ball came out, everyone was waiting and watching the replay on the last drive. Mike Washington Jr. fumbled, but at the same time that whole drive, we were feeding Mike. Just the things that he has done, not throughout the game but throughout these four weeks, have been amazing."
