



THE MATCHUP:

Series History

- Vanderbilt leads the all time 19-15-8 in a series that began in the Commodores inaugural season of 1987 and marked a 2-1 overtime
- The programs last met in 2024 in Nashville when the Razorbacks were the No. 2 team in the country and shutout the Dores 2-0
- Vandy's last win over Arkansas came in 2020 that resulted in a 3-1 Commodore win in Music City. The Dores will be searching for their first win in Fayetteville since 2012

The Opponent

- Arkansas enters the match 3-2-2 overall, coming off a 3-2 win over Florida in the conference opener in Gainesville
- The Razorbacks fell to #3 Duke in a 2-0 decision earlier in the season before taking down #11 BYU 1-0 in open September

• Kyndal Ewertz has a team-high tying five points off two goals and one assist so far this season

- Kennedy Ball also has five points off three assists and a goal, was named to the 2025 SEC Preseason Watchlist
- Zoe Susi, also named to the 2025 SEC Preseason Watchlist has posted five points off two goals and an assist so far this year, including the equalizer to earn a 2-2 draw over #2 Notre Dame
- Forward Vailana Tu'ua a freshman from Redondo Beach, Calif., scored her first collegiate goal in the 34th minute to put the Hogs up 2-0 over Florida, and followed that up with her second just 55 seconds later. Her second goal ended up being the game-winner and earning SEC Freshman of the Week. She is the first Razorback to record a brace this season

STORYLINES:

Player of the Week Sweep

- No. 25 Vanderbilt soccer had two players tabbed for SEC honors this week highlighted by Ally Bollig, who was named offensive player for the first time of her career after Vandy's 1-0 win over #16 Georgetown
- Bollig, a senior from Aiken, South Carolina, delivered one of the biggest moments of the season so far for Vanderbilt, scoring the decisive goal in a 1-0 win over No. 16 Georgetown on Thursday night. After being sidelined for three years due to injury, her first career goal came when she buried the game-winner just before halftime to give the Commodores their first top-25 victory of the season
- On the defensive end, Sara Wojdelko was named SEC Defensive Player of the Week as she anchored the Commodores' back line in a pair of shutout victories over 16th-ranked Georgetown and at Middle Tennessee. Against the Hoyas, Wojdelko recorded nine saves in a 1-0 victory. Time and again she denied quality chances, including multiple stops in the second half that preserved the Commodores' lead and sealed the program's first top-25 win of the fall. She followed that performance with another shutout on the road at Middle Tennessee, playing all 90 minutes in a 1-0 victory

Last Time Out

- No. 13 Vanderbilt soccer played to a scoreless draw with LSU in its SEC opener Friday night at the Vanderbilt Soccer Complex, extending its shutout streak to three matches and recording its sixth clean sheet of the season
- The Commodores (6-1-1, 0-0-1 SEC) held 51 percent of possession and out shot the Tigers 15-9, including eight attempts on frame. Senior Maci Teater and junior Courtney Jones each registered multiple shots on target, but LSU's 38 years keeper Audur Scheving made seven saves to secure the clean sheet
- LSU (5-3-1, 0-0-1 SEC) created early pressure with four corner kicks, three in the opening 15 minutes. Sara Wojdelko answered with three saves to notch her third straight shutout and fourth of the year
- · Vanderbilt nearly found the breakthrough in the closing minutes while up a player following an LSU red card, earning a corner in the 90th minute but was unable to convert

Nine Scorers, Eight Dishers

- So far this season the Commodores have had nine individuals find the back of the net, five of which have on multiple occasions
- Sydney Watts leads the pack with four goals, while Courtney Jones and Olivia Stafford each of three. Transfers Adysen Armenta and Susanna Soderman each have at least two
- The Dores have dished 12 assists this year, with eight different getters
 - Freshman Reagan Pentz leads the way with eight while senior Maci Teater has dished two

Vandy Firsts

- Opening weekend with was filled with plenty of first for those in black and gold
 - · Adysen Armenta, Reagan Pentz, Brooke Dardano, Margo Matula, and Olivia Stafford each clocked their first starts for the black and gold against Austin Peay
 - Armenta, Susanna Soderman and Vicky Pugh scored their first career and Commodore goals
 - Grace Freeman, Pentz and Stafford dished their first career assists
- In the Dores second match of the year against Louisville, freshman Olivia Stafford scored her first career goal off a long ball from Mary Beth McLaughlin, which was later credited as the game winner in the 2-0 victory over Louisville

Reagan Pentz Machine

- In her freshman debut against Austin Peay, Regean Pentz dished three assists, which were the most by a Commodore since Grace Jackson achieved the feat in 2019 against Jacksonville State
- Regean joins an elite list of Dores who have recorded three-plus assists in a match

Preseason Nods

- The Commodores placed six student-athletes on the SEC Preseason Watchlist, the conference announced on Tuesday afternoon. Commodores included on the list are Courtney Jones, Hannah McLaughlin, Mary Beth McLaughlin, Maci Teater, Sydney Watts and Sara Wojdelko
- Jones, a midfielder out of Orlando, Florida, started all 21 contests for the Dores during the 2024 season. The junior registered a career-best 14 points off five goals and four assists as the Commodores reached the Sweet 16 for the first time in program history
- Hannah McLaughlin, a defender out of Cummings, Georgia, made 19 starts for the black and gold in 2024. The senior was named first-team All-SEC and United Soccer Coaches fourth-team all-region after anchoring a defense that allowed only 19 goals in the season and posted nine shutouts.
- Mary Beth McLaughin, a defender out of Cummings, Georgia, appeared in 16 matches, making four starts and logging over 580 minutes of play during her rookie season. The sophomore dished her first career assist in the 2024 conference opener at Auburn and was named SEC All-Freshman Team.
- Teater, a midfielder out of St. Louis, started in all 21 matches for Vanderbilt in 2024 and dished a team-high-tying six assists. The senior scored her first career goal in the opening round of the NCAA Tournament against Lipscomb and helped control a midfield that took down reigning national champion Florida State to advance to the Sweet 16.
- Watts, a junior out of Lenexa, Kansas, led the team with nine goals last season and dished an assist to register a career-best 19 points. The forward posted the second brace of her career in the opening round of the NCAA Tournament against Lipscomb, with her first brace coming earlier in the season against Saint Mary's (Calif.)
- Wojdelko, a graduate out of Northville, Michigan, is back in goal after leading the Commodores to a historic season in 2024. The shot stopper made 14 saves in Vanderbilt's penalty kick win over Florida State to advance to the program's first Sweet 16 appearance. Her 14 stops were the most in a single game since Christy Barringer in 1992

New Staff

- Vanderbilt's soccer staff has welcomed three new faces ahead of the 2025 season:
- Jennie Clark joins the program as an assistant after spending the last two seasons as an assistant at Northwestern, has earned a B license and a scouting license through the US Soccer Federation. Clark served as the first assistant coach for Minnesota Aurora FC, helping lead the squad to a perfect regular season and berth in the quarterfinals of the USL W League playoffs. Before joining the pros, Clark was an assistant at Utah Tech for two seasons, helping the program transition from Division II to



Division I while coaching seven All-Western Athletic Conference honorees during her stint

- Calum Langdale also joins the Commodores coaching staff as an assistant and goalkeeper coach. Langdale joins the black and gold after spending one season at Arkansas State as an assistant, where he served primarily as a goalkeepers coach. During the 2024 campaign at Arkansas State, Langdale helped the Red Wolves to a top-70 national ranking in all major goalkeeping categories, including save percentage, saves per game, shutout percentage and goals-against average
- In the director of operations role, **Rachel Biddle** joined the program in March after spending a large part of her career as general manager at several boutique fitness studios in Nashville, combining her passion for sports and wellness. Some of her responsibilities included overseeing daily operations, driving sales, community outreach and programming.

New Year, New Faces

- This year, Vanderbilt welcomes eight new freshman to campus: Alexis Smith, Reagan Pentz, Caitlin Chase, Olivia Stafford, Foley Robertson, Vicky Pugh and Ava Sherrer ahead of the 2025 campaign
- Vanderbilt was ranked #13 in top recruiting classes for 2025

Splash in the Portal

- Ahead of 2025, Vanderbilt welcomed three transfers who bring a lot of experience to the squad
- Brooke Dardano joins the black and gold after four years at Louisville where she appeared in 49 matches (32 starts). At midfield, she posted three goals and dished 11 assists to tally 17 points. Dardano missed the 2023 season due to injury
- Grace Freeman joins the Commodores after spending her three years at Ole Miss. She appeared in 37 matches, making 32 starts and scored one goal and dished two assists. Freeman missed the majority of the 2022 season due to injury
- Susanna Soderman joins Vandy after her time at Villanova where she was an All-BIG EAST First Team selection in her senior season while appearing in 51 games and making 34 starts
