GAME NOTES

- » **LB Stephen Dix Jr.** led Arkansas with 11 tackles, including one tackle for loss. It marked the second time Dix had led the Razorbacks in tackles this season. He previously accomplished the feat in a loss at Ole Miss on Sept. 13. It marked his fourth career double-digit tackle game and his third as a Razorback. His 11 tackles were also a season-high.
- » **WR Raylen Sharpe** has caught at least one pass in 35 consecutive games dating back to Sept. 24, 2022, while at Missouri State. His 35-game reception streak is tied for the fourth-longest mark nationally.
- » **RB Mike Washington Jr.** eclipsed the 100-yard rushing mark for the fifth time in his career and second time since joining the Razorbacks with 131 yards on 19 carries. He is the eighth Arkansas player to rush for 100 yards against Tennessee and the first to do so since RB Alex Collins and RB Raleigh Williams III in 2015.
- » The Razorbacks' 208 consecutive extra-points made streak, which began on Dec. 5, 2020, is the second-longest such streak nationally based on date, behind Northwestern (Oct. 24, 2020).
- » **OL Fernando Carmona Jr.** started his 43rd consecutive game on the offensive line, dating back to his redshirt freshman season at San Jose State in 2022.
- » Through six games this season, Arkansas has scored on the opening drive in five games which matches last season's total.
- » **WR Raylen Sharpe** set a season-high in both receptions and receiving yards, leading Arkansas with seven catches for 74 yards.
- » **WR Kam Shanks** scored his first receiving touchdown as a Razorback on a 12-yard pass from Taylen Green with 2:55 on the clock in the fourth quarter.

ARKANSAS QUOTES

Bobby Petrino, Arkansas Interim Head Coach

Opening Statement:

"I thought our players really competed hard. We were well prepared for the game. We played physical, played tough. They are a really good football team. Offensively, they know how to move the ball. We gave up some plays but we kept our poise and our players stuck together. We came up with some huge stops that gave us an opportunity to win the game. Offensively, I liked the way we started. They made some good adjustments in the third quarter that hurt us to continue to run the ball. I was too stubborn with it because I wanted to keep them on the sideline. Then we came out and started throwing it around and did a really good job of throwing and catching ... Obviously the turnovers ended up killing us and I made the decision to go for it instead of kicking a field goal and that ended up killing us too."

On message after the game:

"I told them to keep their heads up. We came in here to show that we were going to compete. We were well prepared. We played physical and tough and never gave in. We wanted to play one play at a time and find a way to win in the fourth quarter. I was proud of the way the defense stuck together and kept competing. Obviously, we gave up some things but we also made plays to give us a chance to win. Now we have to stick together and continue to practice and prepare the way we did this last week. We are right there we just have to find a way to get over the hump."
