ON-COURT SUCCESS

A "players-first" coach whose biggest goal is helping people reach their dreams, John Calipari, a Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Famer, is fast approaching 900 career wins while guiding six teams to the Final Four, including a national championship in 2012, and helping 62 players earn selection in the NBA Draft during his 33-year college coaching career with his pros amassing over \$5.5 billion in contracts.

Calipari took UMass to the Final Four in 1996, guided Memphis to the National Championship game in 2008 and led Kentucky to four Final Fours - including the 2012 National Championship, to become only the second coach in NCAA history to lead three different schools to the Final Four. He has racked 877 on-court victories, 24 NCAA Tournament appearances, six Final Fours and numerous National Coach of the Year honors.

In his first year at Arkansas, Calipari led the Razorbacks to a Sweet 16 appearance, his 16th as a head coach, and became just the third coach in NCAA history to take four programs to the Sweet 16. Also, after beating Kansas and St. John's to reach the 2025 Sweet 16, Calipari pushed his NCAA Tournament wins total to 59, tying for sixth all-time.

At every collegiate stop, Calipari's career has been successful throughout, but his 10-year stretch at Kentucky (2009-19) was among the best decades in NCAA history, reaching four Final Fours (with a 2012 championship and 2014 national runner-up), seven Elite 8 berths and nine trips to the Sweet 16.

The 2015 campaign was highlighted by Coach Cal directing the first ever college basketball team to own a 38-0 record (before falling in the Final Four) and became one of just three coaches to make four Final Fours in a five-year span. At the end of that 2015 season, Calipari became the 96th coach to join the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame.

Coach Cal has **led three teams to an NCAA-record 38 wins on the court in a season** (once at Memphis and twice at Kentucky), led the NCAA in wins six times (at least once at UMass, Memphis and Kentucky) and tallied 30, 20-win seasons (including 11 30-win campaigns). With his sustained success, Coach Cal received the John R. Wooden Award Legends of Coaching honor in 2024.

While building a program out of obscurity at UMass and returning Memphis and Kentucky to national contenders, he has totaled the second-most wins in NCAA history in the first 20 years of a college coaching career.

PLAYER SUCCESS

In his goal to lead a players-first program, he has helped **77 players realize their dreams by being drafted or playing in the NBA**. Calipari's NBA players have **amassed over \$5.8 billion in contracts**, which does not include endorsements nor players that have played overseas. He has had four No. 1 overall picks, tying for most overall, among his **62 players drafted and 43 first-round picks**, both ranking second-most all-time. In 2010, he had a record five first-round draft picks. Two years later, six of his players heard their names called at the 2012 draft, the most in the two-round draft era. Then in 2015, Cal would have six picks again, including a record-tying four lottery selections.

Calipari's players have entered the league NBA-ready. His players have garnered 43 All-Star selections, including a record-breaking seven in 2024, with Anthony Davis winning the game's MVP honor in 2017. Derrick Rose was named NBA MVP in 2011 and Shai Gilgeous-Alexander was voted NBA MVP in 2025 to make Cal just the third person to coach two NBA MVPs in college (with John Wooden and Dean Smith). Nine of his players have been tabbed All-NBA (a combined 21 times), three have been named NBA Rookie of the Year and 18 players have made the NBA All-Rookie teams. He is the only coach in history to have a player win each of the NBA's major honors: MVP (twice), Rookie of the Year.

Much like he did at UMass, where his players graduated at nearly 80%, Calipari has stressed academics. Seventeen of his last 20 seniors at Memphis earned their bachelor's degrees, and all 31 players at UK who were eligible to graduate by the end of their senior years walked away with a diploma in hand, including five players who earned their degree in just three years. Calipari's teams routinely have posted a combined team grade-point average of 3.0 or better.

COMMUNITY SUCCESS

Calipari has raised millions of dollars to help the lives of those in need. He has had a particular passion to assist those impacted by natural disasters. For instance, in 2010, he used a telethon to raise more than \$1 million for victims of the devastating earthquake in Haiti. He followed that up with telethons in 2012, raising \$1 million for victims of Superstorm Sandy, in 2017 for victims of Hurricane Harvey, played a leading role in the "Kentucky United" efforts that generated more than \$5 million for victims of devastating tornadoes in Western Kentucky in 2021, and raised nearly \$4 million with the Kentucky Flood Relief Telethon and open practice at Rupp Arena in 2022. In his second month on the job at Arkansas, Cal helped with cleanup efforts after tornadoes hit the state. He has continued the Suits & Sneakers Gala in NW Arkansas and continued his tradition of helping families at Christmas with food, presents and paying for rent.

Calipari launched his **THE CALIPARI FOUNDATION** in 2012 and has worked with several key partners to donate more than \$1.5 million, a figure that does not include matching funds that have been contributed from individuals and corporations. In 2013, Calipari initiated hosting an annual alumni weekend around his basketball fantasy experience with the intent to raise money for charity. After generating \$350,000 for selected organizations and charities during the inaugural game, the weekend has generated millions of dollars for charity since its inception.

In 2019, when federal workers were without pay due to a government shutdown, he, his wife and his foundation assisted workers with financial help and grocery gift cards. He and his wife, Ellen, teamed up with Fayette County Public Schools to help families in need during the COVID-19 pandemic.

Additional efforts include spearheading the creation of the JOHN McLENDON MINORITY LEADERSHIP INITIATIVE, a nationwide coach-driven initiative to provide minorities a jump-start to their careers through practical experiences, opportunities to build their network and instilling the values of John McLendon: integrity, education, leadership and mentorship. Participants in the initiative will be known as MILEILING Leaders

He was awarded the Jefferson Award for Outstanding Public Service in Sports by Multiplying Good in 2022. For more than 50 years, Multiplying Good has honored those who put others first. Those receiving the Jefferson Award are empowered to do more, while their stories of extraordinary public service inspire others to action. It is an award that underscores impact. He earned the Race Amity Medal of Honor in 2023

In 2017, Coach Cal was named the head coach of the 2017 USA Basketball Men's U19 World Cup Team, which finished third at the 2017 FIBA U19 World Cup in Cairo. Also, he won gold as head coach of the 2012Dominican Republic team at the Centrobasket Championship.

Author of five books, including the New York Times Best Seller "Players First: Coaching from the Inside Out," Calipari is a master of communication and maximizing talent. He lives by the motto that "it's never a matter of how far you have fallen, but instead it's about how high you bounce back."

Razorbacks Ready for Year Two Calipari Era

- Naismith Hall of Fame coach John Calipari, who has led six teams to the Final Four, enters his 34th season as a collegiate head coach and second at Arkansas.
- He is 23 wins from 900 career on-court wins and is onpace to be the second or third-fastest coach to reach 900 wins.
- Calipari became the fourth-fastest coach to 800 oncourt wins ever at 1,037 games. Only Adolph Rupp (972 games), Roy Williams (1,012 games) and Dean Smith (1,029 games) did it faster.
- Of the 32 NCAA Tournaments held during his collegiate coaching career, he has led 24 teams to the NCAA Tournament, including 16 trips to the Sweet 16, 12 appearances to the Elite 8, six Final Four births, three national title games and a national championship. (Note, in 2019-20, Kentucky was 25-6 and won the SEC with a 15-3 record but the NCAA canceled the tournament due to COVID-19.)
- Calipari is one of two coaches in NCAA history to take three different programs to the Final Four and just is one of three coaches to lead four different schools to the Sweet 16.
- His teams have won an NCAA-record 38 games three times - twice at UK ('12 & '15) and once at Memphis ('08).

Recapping Last Year

- Arkansas finished 22-14 overall and 8-10 to tie for 9th in the SEC.

Hogs To Play Two Exhibitions vs DI Opponents

- For the second time in program history and second consecutive year, Arkansas will play two charity exhibition games versus NCAA Division I programs.
- The Hogs will host Cincinnati and play at Memphis.
 Ironically, the last time Arkansas faced both teams was on the same date, Nov. 23 in 2021 for
- Cincinnati and in 2023 for Memphis.

 First, Arkansas will host Cincinnati on Oct. 24.
- Arkansas trails 2-3 all-time in the series versus the Bearcats. However, Arkansas won the last meeting, 73-67, on Nov. 23, 2021, in the championship game of the Hall of Fame Classic, played in Kansas City, Mo.
- Later, Razorback head coach John Calipari will make his return to the FedEx Forum to play at Memphis on Oct. 27 in the Hoops for St. Jude Tip Off Classic.
- The all-time series between Arkansas and Memphis is tied at 11-11 as the Tigers won the last meeting, 84-79, in the semifinals of the Battle for Atlantis on Nov. 23, 2023.
 The last time Arkansas played in Memphis was the 2002-03 season, which was Coach Cal's first year as

Hall of Famers Square Off

- Arkansas, led by 2015 Naismith Hall of Fame inductee John Calipari, and Michigan State, led by 2016 Naismith Hall of Fame inductee Tom Izzo, are set to play a homeand-home series. The series is set to begin this fall on Nov. 8 (Saturday) in the Spartans' Breslin Center.
- The programs have only met on two previous occasions
 on neutral courts with Michigan State winning both.
- ^The first meeting came in the 1991 Maui Classic championship game when the second-ranked Razorbacks fell to Michigan State, 86-71, on Nov. 27.
- ^ The teams faced off again nearly four years to the date later (Nov. 28, 1995) as part of the Great Eight Tournament, played at The Palace in Auburn Hills. Michigan State edged the #25 Razorbacks, 75-72. That game came in Izzo's first year as the Spartans' head coach (his fourth game) and was his second career victory (first versus a Division I opponent as Michigan State beat Chaminade in the Maui Classic opener to start the season).
- While Arkansas and Michigan State's history is limited, the teams' head coaches have played in several high profile matchups – all on neutral courts – with Calipari holding a slight 3-2 advantage over Izzo. Coach Cal was 2-2 at Kentucky and 1-0 at Memphis versus Izzo's Snartans

- This is the second-straight year, and fourth overall, that Arkansas has opened SEC play versus the Vols. Arkansas is 2-1 all-time when starting SEC play versus Tennessee. Arkansas is 2-0 when opening SEC play versus Tennessee in Bud Walton Arena.
- Under the new scheduling format, this will be the second-straight year Arkansas will face both LSU and Missouri twice as SEC-designated "permanent opponents." Auburn is the third team Arkansas will play both home and away.
- Arkansas and LSU have met for a home-and-home series in all but two seasons since the Razorbacks joined the SEC (1991-92). The Razorbacks and Tigers only met once in 2013 (in Baton Rouge) and just once in 2015 (in Fayetteville). Arkansas leads the Tigers 40-32 since the Razorbacks joined the SEC. Since Arkansas joined the SEC, the Tigers are the Razorbacks' most common SEC opponent with 72 meetings followed by Mississippi State (61), Alabama (60), Auburn (60) and Ole Miss (59).
- Arkansas and Missouri will be playing a home-andhome series for the 14th consecutive year. The streak coincides with the number of years since the Tigers ioined the SEC (2012-13). Arkansas leads the all-time series with Missouri, 36-28, and leads 17-10 since Mizzou joined the SEC, including wins in eight of the last 10.
- The last time Arkansas and Auburn met twice during the regular season was the 2017-18 campaign. Auburn upset the #22 Razorbacks in the first meeting, 88-77 on Jan. 6, 2018 in Auburn, and Arkansas returned the favor with a 91-82 victory over #14 Auburn in Bud Walton Arena.
- Arkansas will make its first trip to Norman since the 2011-12 season. The Sooners won that meeting, 78-63. Overall, Arkansas is just 3-8 in games played in Norman. However, the teams have only meet a total of five times in Norman since the 1998-99 season, a span of 27 years.
- For just the second consecutive year and the fourth time since Texas A&M joined the SEC (2012-13), Arkansas and the Aggies will meet just once in the regular season. Texas A&M is Arkansas' most common opponent with 170 games played in the series since the Hog's first year of basketball (1923-24). Arkansas leads the all-time series with the Aggies, 108-62, and own a 13-11 advantage since A&M joined the SEC. The home team has dominated the series over the last 14 seasons as Arkansas is 10-1 versus the Aggies at home and Texas A&M is 8-3 versus the Razorbacks in College Station.
- If history is an indicator, the home schedule sets up well for Arkansas. The Razorbacks are 23-6 all-time versus Auburn in Fayetteville, 8-10 versus Kentucky, 25-8 versus LSU. 21-10 versus Missouri. 12-6 versus South Carolina. 12-5 versus Tennessee, 47-22 versus Texas, 62-15 versus Texas A&M and 16-5 versus Vanderbilt.
