QUICK STORYLINES

- The Crimson 2025-26 season will be comprised of 13 non-conference and its annual 14-game lvy League slate. Harvard will play nine of its non-conference games in November and eight of them will take place outside of Cambridge, Mass.
- Harvard will play its final non-conference road contest this Sunday, November 30 at 1:30 p.m. ET/12:30 p.m. CT against Arkansas in Fayetteville.
- Most recently, Harvard went 0-2 at the Baha Mar Hoops Pink Flamingo Championship, falling to Alabama, 80-60, and South Florida, 56-54.
- By averaging 14.0 points, 8.0 rebounds, and 4.5 assists Saniyah Glenn-Bello was named to the Baha Mar Hoops Pink Flamingo Championship All-Tournament Team.
- While having a career-year already White ranks first in field goal percentage (58.0%), eighth in scoring (14.2), and
 10th in steals (1.7) in the lvy League. Abigail Wright is also putting up career numbers and ranks sixth is scoring (15.1),
 seventh in rebounding (6.7), and 10th in assists (2.6) in the conference. Gabby Anderson is continuing her gritty play,
 ranking third in rebounding (6.9) and 10th in steals (1.7). Lastly, Katie Krupa Saniyah Glenn-Bello are currently the
 second- and fifth-best shot blockers in the league with 1.1 and 1.0 blocks per game, respectively.
- Following the opening week of action, Olivia Jones was named the first Ivy League Rookie of the Week by averaging 7.5
 points and 5.5 rebounds.
- Prior to the season, the Crimson elected juniors White and Wright as captains of the 2025-26 Harvard women's basketball team.
- Harvard is coming off arguably its best season in program history in 2024-25 as it accumulated a program-record 24
 wins, won its first Ivy League Tournament Championship in program history, and returned to the NCAA Tournament
 for the first time since 2007.
- Harvard graduated its two top scorers, Harmoni Turner and Elena Rodriguez, who were the only Crimson players to
 average in double figures last season. Despite losing two historic players, the Crimson still welcomed back 11 players
 from its championship roster and added five first-years in a highly touted recruiting class.
- Jones, Aubrey Shaw, Maya Nahar, Ava Krumweide, and Sam Wills make up Harvard's Class of 2029. Prior to arriving
 in Cambridge, Shaw was a top-65 recruit out of Blue Valley North High School in Kansas.
- As a part of its returners, the Crimson will be led by its trio of seniors in Anderson, Glenn-Bello, and Krupa. The senior
 class brings experience, scoring, defensive prowess, and All-Ivy accolades from their first three years with Harvard.
- Moore has continued to lead the Crimson back into the national spotlight and build her legacy at the helm of the
 program. With a victory over Penn on January 20, Moore became the fastest coach to 50 wins in program history.
 Also in her third year at the helm, Moore recorded her first ranked win as a head coach and led the Crimson to a program-high three total power conference wins.
- Prior to this season, Carrie Moore was named to the preseason watch list for the 2026 Kathy Delaney-Smith Mid-Major Coach of the Year Award. Moore was one of the five finalists for the award last season.
- In the first Mid-Major Top 25, Harvard ranked second in the poll while receiving six first-place votes. In the most recent poll, Harvard remains in the top 10, checking in at ninth.

 The Crimson was picked to finish third in the lvy League Preseason Poll, receiving 126 points, including one first-place vote. Harvard trailed only Princeton (163) and Columbia (147).

THE LAST TIME OUT

- The Crimson went 0-2 at the Baha Mar Hoops Pink Flamingo Championship. falling to Alabama, 80-60, and South Florida, 56-54.
- In the first game Harvard led heading into the lockeroom, holding the Crimson Tide to 26 points in the first half.
- Abigail Wright and Katie Krupa each tallied 16 points to pace the Crimson's offense.
- Wright shot 7-of-15 from the field to record her sixth game of the season in double figures.
- Krupa registered her season high by shooting 71.4% (5-of-7 from the field and going 5-for-6 at the charity stripe. The senior also dished out four assists and recorded two blocks against the Crimson Tide.
- Saniyah Glenn-Bello stuffed the stat sheet for the second consecutive game with her first career double-double. The senior tallied 11 points, 10 rebounds, seven assists, and two steals against the Crimson Tide.
- Alayna Rocco contributed 11 points, going 4-for-4 from the field with three triples in the first half.
- The Crimson tallied 16 assists on 22 made field goals in Monday's contest.
- The Harvard defense forced the Crimson Tide into its second-highest turnover total of the season with 17.
- Two days later, the Crimson dropped a heartbreaker against the Bulls of South
- Glenn-Bello scored a career-high 17 points while also recording six boards, two assists, and a block.
- By averagin 14.0 points, 8.0 rebounds, and 4.5 assists the senior was named to the Baha Mar Hoops Pink Flamingo Championship All-Tournament Team.
- Wright also notched 10 points on 4-of-8 shooting to join Glenn-Bello in double figures.
- Gabby Anderson paced the Crimson on the galss with a season-high 11 boards. Overall, Harvard outrebounded the Bulls 41-36.

TRENDING IN THE WRIGHT DIRECTION

- Abigail Wright is in the midst of a breakout season averaging a career-best for points (14.9), rebounds (6.6), and assists (2.6).
- The junior captain is currently leading the Crimson and ranking inside the top
- 10 in the league for each of the statistical categories.
 Wright set a new career-high for single game scoring this season, tallying 23 points in back-to-back games against Cal and Boston College.
- Also, against the Eagles Wright recorded her first career double-double with her 23 points and a career-best 13 rebounds.

WHITE HOT

- Karlee White has smoothly transitioned into her leading role, averaging 14.2 points, 4.7 rebounds, and 1.7 steals.
- Not only is White averaging a career-best for scoring but she is also doing so at an efficient rate, shooting 58.0% from the field.
- White's shooting percentage is the best in the Ivy League currently.
- The junior has reached double figures in five of the first six games after having doné so just five times total in her first two seasons. Most recently, she set a new career-high with 18 points against Cal.

League Rookie of the Week honor.

- In the two games this past weekend, Jones averaged 7.5 points and 5.5 rebounds.
- Against a ranked Michigan team, Jones scored a career-best 11 points while also grabbing six boards.
- In the win over St. John's, Jones played an important role including hitting two free throws with 10 seconds left to put Harvard up three.

AMONG THE LEAGUES BEST

- Abigail Wright and Karlee White both rank inside the top 10 in the league in scoring. The junior duo are each averaging career-highs with 15.1 and 14.2 points per game, respectively.
- Wright is also creating for others, averaging 2.6 assists per game to rank 10th in the conference.
- White is averaging her career best while being incredibly efficient. The junior has the best shooting percentage in the Ivy League by shooting 58.0% from the field.
- Wright and Gabby Anderson lead the way on the glass for the Crimson, both ranking inside the top 10 for rebounding in the conference. With her career-best 6.7 rebounds per game average, Wright ranks seventh in the conference and Anderson lead by ranking third with her 6.9 rebounds per game.
- On the offensive glass, Anderson and Wright have grabbed a combined 56 boards in eight games.
- White and Anderson are pacing the Crimson's defense averaging 1.7 steals per game. The averages are the 10th best in the conference.
- Katie Krupa and Šaniyah Glenn-Bello are currently the second and fifth best shot blocker in the league with their averags of 1.1 and 1.0 blocks per game.

THE SEASON AT A GLANCE

- The Crimson's season will be comprised of 13 non-conference games and its annual 14-game lvy League slate.
- Harvard will play nine games in the month of November and all will take place on the road outside of its season opener against St. John's.
- The Crimson could play up to six power conference opponents in the opening month. Match ups with No. 13 Michigan, Boston College, Alabama, and Arkansas are already set.
- Harvard will compete at two prominent tournaments in the month of November, the Raising the B.A.R. Invitational hosted by the University of California and the Baha Mar Hoops Pink Flamingo Championships in Nassau, The Bahamas.
- The Crimson will begin its quest back to Ivy Madness on Saturday, January 3 against Dartmouth in Hanover, N.H.
- Harvard will play Columbia, Yale and Brown in Lavietes Pavilion during the first half of the Ivy season followed by the Big Green, Cornell, Penn, and Princeton during the month of February.

BACK FOR MORE

- Harvard brings back 11 players from last year's championship roster.
- This season the Crimson will be led by its trio of seniors, Gabby Anderson, Saniyah Glenn-Bello, and Katie Krupa.
- Glenn-Bello is poised to step into a leading role this season. The New York native was the third leading scorer a season ago averagin 6.4 points per game while playing more than 25 minutes a game. As a junior, Glenn-Bello also tal-

lied 105 rebounds, 29 steals, and a team-best 23 blocks.

In her first full season, Anderson started all 29 games and recorded 112 points, 130 rebounds, and 29 assists. As one of the key pieces of the Crimson's defense, Anderson also tallied 50 steals in 2024-25.

Krupa has been a fixture in the Crimson's lineup for her entire time in Cambridge, having appeared in 87 contests in three years. As a sophomore, the Illinois native earned honorable mention All-Ivy and started all 28 games.

Abigail Wright, Karlee White, and Mary Hollensteiner round out the Harvard upperclassmen.

Wright and White both had breakout performances near the end of the 2024-25 seasons, playing key roles in Harvard's title run.

Lastly, the Crimson returns its five first-years from last season, Lydia Chatira, Alayna Rocco, Nina Emnace, Hana Belibi, and Asani Ceaser.

THE NEW FACES IN CAMBRIDGE

Harvard welcomes five first-years to the roster in its Class of 2029. Olivia Jones, Aubrey Shaw, Maya Nahar, Ava Krumwiede, and Sam Wills comprise the highly touted recruiting class.

Shaw comes to Cambridge as a top-100 recruit, ranking No. 61 in the ESPN top-100 for the Class of 2025.

The Kansas native joins Hana Belibi as the top-100 recruits on the Crimson's roster.

MOORE HISTORY

In just three years at the helm, Carrie Moore has brought the Crimson back to the national spotlight.

Last season Moore led the Crimson to its first top-25 win in 25 years to mark her first ranked win as a head coach.

Coach Moore has tallied 60 wins in her three seasons with the Crimson, the most in the first three seasons for a head coach in Harvard women's basketball history.

With a win over Penn last season at the Palestra, Moore collected her 50th win at the helm, becoming the fastest coach to the mark in program history.

Last season, the Harvard head coach was named a finalist for the 2025 Kathy Delaney-Smith Mid-Major Coach of the Year Award. This season she added the preseason watch list for the award to her resume.

HARVARD HISTORY

 The Crimson had arguably the best season in program history in 2024-25 as it totaled a program record 24 wins, won its first Ivy League Tournament championship in program history, returned to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2018, and defeated three power conference opponents.

CALM IN THE MADNESS

- Harvard won its first Ivy Madness title in program history and was the first non-No. 1 seed to win the tournament last season.
- It was a Harmoni Turner masterclass in the semifinals as she recorded a tournament and program record 44 points to lift Harvard over Princeton, 70-67.
- The Crimson trailed by as many as 13 midway through the third quarter but eventually took its first lead since the first quarter at 62-61.
- After pulling in front again at 66-64 with 2:45 remaining, Harvard never again relinquished its lead.
- The following day, Harvard took down the top-seed Columbia in a 74-71 thriller.
- The Crimson received contributions from all down its lineup as eight different players added points to the box score.
- Turner was named the Most Outstanding Player with another show-stopping performance of 24 points, four assists, and three steals against the Lions. Elena Rodriguez (13) and Karlee White (12) also added double-digit points in the contest.
- The Crimson hold the only three upsets by seed in the tournament's history.
 Outside of its two upsets last season, Harvard also knocked off Columbia as a three-seed in 2022-23.

THE RETURN TO THE BIG DANCE

- After winning the Ivy League Tournament, Harvard retiurned to the big dance for the seventh time in program history and first time since 2007.

- The Crimson battled against [7] Michigan State in Raleigh, N.C. but ultimately fell 64-50 in the opening round.

DEFENSE IS THE DIFFERENCE

- The Crimson had not only one of the best defenses in the Ivy League but in the nation last season.
- Harvard ranked first in the conference and fifth nationally for scoring defense.
 holding opponents to just 52.9 points per game.
- The Crimson's improvement was drastic as it gave up an average of 63.4 points per game the season prior.
- Additionally, Harvard caused an averaged of 20.3 turnovers per game including 10.66 steals per game. In 2023-24, Harvard forced 15.2 turnovers per game and averaged 7.07 steals per game.
- In its first game this season, Harvard picked up right where it left off forcing 24 turnovers and securing 14 steals.

NATIONAL RECOGNITION

- Following a host of dominant victories and wins over power conference opponents the Crimson began to receiving recognition in the AP Top 25 poll.
- In total, the Crimson received votes in the poll 17 total times last season including at the conclusion of the season.
- Prior to last season, the Crimson had never received votes or been ranked in the AP Top 25.

NOTHING BUT NET

- Harvard had the top NET Ranking in the Ivy League throughout nearly the entirety of the season last year.
- At the end of 2024-25, the Crimson ranked 38th and reached as high as 32nd during the season.

NOT SO "MID"-MAJOR

- In the preseason poll for the College Insider Mid-Major Top 25, Harvard ranked second and is receiving six first place votes.
- · Eight games into the season, the Crimson now sits at No. 9 in the poll.
- Last season, Harvard received the top spot in the poll for the first time in the program's history.

THE IVY MEDIA HAS SPOKEN

- Ahead of the 2025-26 season, the media selected Harvard to finish third in the lvy League.
- Harvard received 126 points and one first-place vote.

- Most recently, the Razorbacks went 2-0 at the Music City Classic, defeating Drake and Southern Illinois.
- The Razorbacks currently has four players averaging in double figures led by Taleyah Jones averaging 17.1 points per game. Bonnie Deas (13.4), Jenna Lawerence (10.5), and Emily Robinson (10.4) are also all averaging over 10 points.

HARVARD-ARKANSAS HISTORY

- The Crimson and the Razorbacks have faced off twice in history. The first meeting between the two teams came in the NCAA Tournament Round 32 following Harvard's historic win over Stanford as a No. 16 seed. The two teams last faced off 25 years ago and the Razorbacks won 87-48.
- Harvard is looking for its first ever win versus a SEC opponent as it is currently 0-13 all-time.

CARRIE MOORE

The Kathy Delaney-Smith Friends of Harvard Women's Basketball Head Coach, The Ragatz Family Harvard Coach of Excellence Fourth season at Harvard 63-34 Overall | 29-13 Ivy League

Carrie Moore was named The Kathy Delaney-Smith Head Coach For Harvard Women's Basketball, Erin McDermott, The John D. Nichols '53 Family Director of Athletics, announced on Wednesday, April 6, 2022. Moore, the fourth head coach in program history, arrives in Cambridge from Michigan where she helped the Wolverines to the Elite 8 round of the 2022 NCAA tournament.

In her third year as the leader of Harvard women's basketball Moore led the Crimson to historic new heights. The Crimson won a program-best 24 games, won its first Ivy League Tournament Championship, and returned to the NCAA Tournament for the first time in 18 years. As part of its 24 wins in 2024-25, the Crimson defeated three power conference opponents including its second win in 20 years over a ranked opponent with its 72-68 overtime victory over No. 25 Indiana. On January 20, Moore's first ever win inside the Palestra also marked win No. 50 as the head coach. With the 73-44 win over the Quakers Moore became the fastest head coach to 50 wins in program history. After battling for a title each of Moore's first two seasons the Crimson were crowned champions at the 2025 Ivy League Tournament. In the semifinal game against Princeton Harvard erased a 13-point deficit to defeat the Tigers 70-67. The following day Harvard battled to a 74-71 victory over the top-seed Columbia Lions to win the title. With the conference crown, the Crimson punched its ticket to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2007. Making even more history, Harvard received its lowest seed in program history, entering March Madness as a 10-seed. The Crimson historic season ultimately came to a close in the opening round of the tournament, falling to the seven-seed Michigan State Spartans. Moore established a defensive identity in 2024-25, coaching the Crimson to become one of the best defensive teams in the nation. Through many weeks in the season Harvard was the top scoring defense in the country and ultimately finished the season as the fifth best by holding opponents in 52.9 points per game. Individually, Moore was named the 2025 World Exposure Report Mid-Major Coach of the Year and a semifinalist for the 2025 Kathy Delaney-Smith Mid-Major Coach of the Year. Moore's 60 total wins throughout her first three seasons marks the most in program history through any coaches' opening three years.

In year two under Moore, the Crimson finished 16-12 overall and 9-5 in conference play. Harvard once again earned a spot in the Ivy League Tournament as the three-seed before falling to Columbia on the Lions home court, 63-61. Moore helped lead three players to All-Ivy honors including Harmoni Turner who earned First-Team All-Ivy for the second straight season and Lola Mullaney and Katie Krupa who both received Honorable Mention All-Ivy. Moore's 36 total wins throughout her first two seasons marks the most in program history through any coaches' opening two years.

In her first season at the helm in Cambridge, Moore led the Crimson to historic heights. The team compiled a record of 20-12 overall, a win total that was a program best for a first-year head coach. Following a third-place finish in the Ivy League regular season, the Crimson defeated two-seed Columbia, 72-65, to advance to the Ivy League Tournament Championship game. Despite falling in league play, the Crimson went on to the WNIT where it would go on a historic run to the fourth round, the Great 8. In 2023, Moore coached three players to All-Ivy accolades including Harmoni Turner who earned First-Team All-Ivy, Lola Mullaney (Second-Team All-Ivy), and Elena Rodriguez (Honorable Mention All-Ivy)

In her one season as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator in Ann Arbor, Moore guided Michigan to a 25-7 record (13-4 Big Ten) and a No. 3 seed in the NCAA tournament. The Wolverines entered the postseason ranked 12th in the Associated Press Top 25 Poll, marking the program's highest regular-season-ending ranking in school history.

At the individual level, Moore helped Naz Hillmon become Michigan's first player to garner AP All-America First-Team honors, while coaching five All-Big Ten selections in 2021-22.

Prior to returning to her home state of Michigan, Moore spent two seasons at North Carolina, serving as the program's assistant coach and recruiting coordinator. During her time in Chapel Hill, she guided the Tar Heels to the 2021 NCAA tournament and signed a pair of highly regarded recruiting classes. Her 2019 class was considered the 10th-best nationally, while the 2020 group was ranked third as it featured three McDonald's All-Americans.

Along her path to Harvard included two different stints at Ivy League member Princeton. Before heading to UNC, Moore was an assistant coach for the Tigers, coaching Princeton to back-to-back Ivy regular-season and tournament titles (2017-18, 2018-19) en route to a pair of NCAA appearances, and a berth in the 2017 WNIT. She also served as the Tigers' director of operations for two seasons (2008-09, 2009-10), with the 2009-10 team capturing the Ivy championship and reaching the NCAA tournament.

In between her stints at Princeton was a five-year run at Creighton. As an assistant from 2010-15, Moore helped the Bluejays reach the postseason each year, including consecutive trips to the NCAA tournament in 2012 and 2013, a feat that had never been accomplished in program history.

Before embarking on a successful coaching career, Moore was a standout player at Western Michigan, where she scored a school-record 2,216 points. As a senior in 2006-07, she was named the Mid-American Conference Player of the Year after leading the nation in scoring at 25.4 points per game, marking the first time a MAC player won the Division I scoring title. In addition to her efforts on the court, which included her setting nine school records and four league records, Moore was a star in the classroom, collecting Academic All-America Second-Team accolades and landing on the nominee list for the Senior CLASS Award. She graduated magna cum laude from WMU in 2007, with a degree in journalism.

Once her time as a Division I player was up, Moore signed WNBA free agent contracts with the Phoenix Mercury and Chicago Sky, and then played professionally for one season in Poland.
