THE OPENING TIP

Michigan State's men's basketball team plays its second-straight home game to open the 2025-26 regular season, hosting No. 14/14 Arkansas at the Breslin Center on Saturday, Nov. 8 (7 p.m., FOX) ... The matchup with Arkansas is the highest ranked matchup at the Breslin Center in the first month of the season since 2018, when No. 3 Michigan State hosted then No. 5 Notre Dame (Nov. 30) ... The Spartans opened the season with an 80-69 win over Colgate on Monday, with Jaxon Kohler (16 points, 15 rebounds) and Jeremy Fears Jr. (12 points, 10 assists) each registering double-doubles ... The Spartans played a pair of exhibition games ahead of the season opener, beating Bowling Green, 75-66, at home on Oct. 23, before falling to preseason No. 4 UConn, 76-69, on Tuesday in Connecticut ... The Spartans finished the 2024-25 season with a 30-7 overall record and won the Big Ten title with a 17-3 record ... MSU was selected to the NCAA Tournament for the 27th-straight season, officially recognized by the NCAA as the longest streak in Division I, and advanced to the Elite Eight for the 11th time under Head Coach Tom Izzo.

THE STARTING FIVE

1. Spartans Victorious in Season Opener

Four players scored in double figures and No. 22 Michigan State used a run late in the second half to open a 14-point lead and went on to an 80-69 win over Colgate in the season opener for both schools at the Breslin Center Monday night ... Senior forward Jaxon Kohler led Michigan State with a double-double, scoring 16 points and grabbing 15 rebounds, while redshirt sophomore guard Jeremy Fears Jr. had a double-double with 14 points and tying his career-high with 10 assists while setting a career-best with five steals ... Junior forward Coen Carr finished with 12 points and four rebounds and senior center Carson Cooper added 10 points and six rebounds.

2. Izzo Enters 31st Season at Michigan State

Michigan State Head Coach Tom Izzo enters his 31st season at the helm of the program he has been with for more than 40 years, including his time as an assistant coach ... In the last four years, Izzo has continued to add to his legacy with landmark wins ... When the Spartans beat Maryland on March 6, 2022, the win gave Izzo 663 overall wins for his career, passing Bob Knight of Indiana for the most overall wins by a Big Ten Head Coach ... On Jan. 30, 2024, the Spartans beat rival Michigan, 81-62, as Izzo became the first Big Ten head coach to reach the 700-win milestone at one school and the 38th Division I coach to reach 700 wins ... And on Feb. 15, 2025, MSU beat Illinois, 79-65, on the road for Izzo's 354th Big Ten Conference win, passing Knight for the most conference wins in league history ... In addition to leading the Spartans to a record 27-straight NCAA Tournament appearances, Izzo has guided MSU to eight Final Four appearances, 11 Big Ten regular season championships and six Big Ten Tournament titles.

3. Winningest Coaches in College Basketball Meet in Second Game

While the game with Arkansas features a pair of Top 25 teams, patrolling the sidelines will be two of the all-time winningest coaches in Division I basketball ... John Calipari is third all-time among active coaches in wins (836) and Tom Izzo is ninth (738) ... The two have combined for 1,574 wins.

3. About the Spartans

Michigan State finished the 2024-25 season with a 30-7 overall record, including a 17-3 mark in the Big Ten Conference, winning the league's regular season title by three games ... It was the 11th time Big Ten regular season title under Head Coach Tom Izzo ... The Spartans were selected to the NCAA Tournament for the 27th-straight season and advanced to the Elite Eight of the NCAA Tournament for the 11th time, finishing the year ranked No. 7 in the Associated Press Top 25 ... The Spartans will look to replace three starters and four letterwinners who accounted for 63.5 percent of the team's scoring last year, 41.8 percent of the team's rebounds and 52.3 percent of the team's assists ... Notable losses included guards Jaden Akins (All-Big Ten Third Team, All-Defensive Team) and Jase Richardson (All-Big Ten Third Team, All-Freshman Team) ... The cupboard is not bare, by any stretch, as the team welcomes back senior forward Jaxon Kohler and redshirt sophomore point guard Jeremy Fears Jr., as well as a talented group of returning players and newcomers.

4. MSU Welcomes Six Newcomers

MSU added four transfers in the off-season – senior guard Trey Fort (Samford), junior forward Kaleb Glenn (Florida Atlantic), sophomore guard Divine Ugochukwu (Miami) and graduate guard Denham Wojcik (Harvard) – and two freshmen ... Fort started all 33 games at Samford last year, led the team in scoring (14.6 ppg) and was a Second Team All-Southern Conference selection ... Ugochukwu transferred from Miami, where he started 16 of 28 games as a freshman, averaging 5.3 points and 2.3 assists ... Wojcik, the son of MSU associate head coach Doug Wojcik, played three years at Harvard before sitting out last year following off-season surgery ... Glenn, who was an American Athletic Conference Second Team All-Conference pick at FAU, suffered an injury during summer workouts and is expected to miss the season ... A pair of freshmen from the Washington, D.C. area are expected to contribute right away, forward Jordan Scott (Reston, Va.) and forward Cam Ward (Largo, Md.) ... Ward, the No. 50 player in the class of 2025 per 247Sports.com, was the two-time Gatorade Player of the Year in Maryland and broke the state's scoring record as a senior ... Scott, the No. 86 prospect in the ESPN Top 100, helped lead South Lakes to back-to-back state titles in Virginia and was selected to play in the Capital Classic All-Star Game and the Allen Iverson Classic.

ABOUT THE RAZORBACKS

- » Arkansas closed the 2024-25 season with a 22-14 overall record, including an 8-10 mark in the SEC, and reached the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament.
- » The Razorbacks, who opened the season with a 109-77 win over Southern University and beat Cincinnati (89-61) and Memphis (99-75) in exhibition play, are ranked No. 14 in the Associated Press preseason poll.
- » Arkansas was picked to finish in fifth place in the SEC this year and had three players earn preseason honors from the media and coaches.
- » Junior guard D.J. Wagner, a third team All-SEC preseason pick by the league's media and coaches, averaged 11.2 points and 3.6 assists last year and sophomore forward Karter Knox, also a third team preseason pick, averaged 8.3 ppg and 3.3 rpg in 2024-25.
- » Freshman guard Darius Acuff Jr., a Detroit native who was a third team preseason pick by the league's coaches, had 22 points and four rebounds in the season opener.

AGAINST ARKANSAS

- » Saturday's game with Arkansas is the first of a two-year, home-and-home series with the Razorbacks.
- » Michigan State and Arkansas have met two times, with the Spartans winning both games ... This will be the first meeting in East Lansing and the first meeting between the teams at a non-neutral floor.
- » The Spartans won the first meeting between the teams, 86-71, in the championship game of the Maui Invitational on Nov. 27, 1991.
- » MSU won the second meeting, 75-72, topping then-No. 25 Arkansas in the Great Eight in Auburn Hills during Tom Izzo's first season as Head Coach at Michigan State.

SPARTANS VS. THE SEC

- » The game against Arkansas will be the 91st all-time for Michigan State against a team that currently makes up the Southeastern Conference.
- » The Spartans have an all-time record of 57-33 record against teams from the SEC. ... The game with Arkansas will be the first of two against teams from the SEC, including a matchup with Kentucky in the Champions Classic on Nov. 18 in New York City.
- » Tom Izzo has an all-time record of 23-8 against teams from the SEC.

IZZO VS. CALIPARI

- » The game against Arkansas on Saturday will be the seventh head-to-head meeting between teams coached by Tom Izzo and John Calipari.
- » Izzo and Calipari each have three wins in their head-to-head series.

- » All six previous meetings have been played on neutral floors and five of the six were played in November, including four games from 2013-22 in the Champions Classic when Calipari coached Kentucky.

WHAT'S BACK

- » The Spartans will look to replace three starters and four letterwinners who accounted for 63.5 percent of the team's scoring last year, 41.8 percent of the team's rebounds and 52.3 percent of the team's assists ... Notable losses included guards Jaden Akins (All-Big Ten Third Team, All-Defensive Team) and Jase Richardson (All-Big Ten Third Team, All-Freshman Team).
- » The cupboard is not bare, by any stretch, as the team welcomes back senior forward Jaxon Kohler and redshirt sophomore point guard Jeremy Fears Jr., as well as a talented group of returning players and newcomers.
- » Kohler started 34 of 37 games last year, averaging 7.8 ppg and was among the top-10 in rebounding in the Big Ten (7.5 rpg), while Fears started 36 times, averaging

Michigan State Head Coach Tom Izzo

On practices this week and Arkansas...

Our next practice was today, today was okay. It's kind of strange because we have a lot day in between this time of year. It's good for us. It's hard on them, practicing, practicing, practicing. YOU're going to see, I think, one of the better teams that have played in here in years. I'm not trying to make them out to be the best. Cal will say that they're not very good. On film, they beat Cincinnati pretty good, who beat Michigan. On film, this is an athletic team, they shoot the ball, they've got great guard play, big size and eight deep of really good players. This is going to be a great test for us. If we're not at our best ... we could be in trouble.

On playing a team that can really drive the ball...

Is it a good thing for my health, or you're writing? I don't know if it's a good thing this early, because we're going to have some issues with it. But we have spent a lot of time on transition. They score almost 70 percent of the time in transition, that's really big for them. We're going to have to defend it, keep them out of the paint, rebound the ball and run ourselves.

On Izzo usually liking a track meet...

Put it this way, they're a better track team than we are right now but that's something that we have to keep working. But if we rebound the ball and score the ball, the track meet goes down. They're just very good at it. Both those guards are two of the better guards in the country, so they can bring it.

On the two freshmen ...

I know Acuff because he's from our state and he's done a good job. Thomas came from Overtime Elite and he might be the best for a freshman. I don't know how long he was down there, but he can shoot it, he can guard it, he can put it on the floor. I've been really impressed with him. I really like his team, I told John that, I really like his team.

On MSU's post defense in the Arkansas game...

It's different. They don't really pound the ball inside, so they're going to have guard some guys on the perimeter a bit more. Those guys just gotta play better. Like I said as I watched that film 10 times (Colgate), that team played really good that night. If they play as good as they did that night, they're going to be a force to be reckoned with. We need more out of Coop (Carson Cooper), we need more out of Coen (Carr).

On Coen Carr trying to become more of a leader...

Everybody wants to be the man, until you get to be the man and then there's pressure on you. I worry about him and Coop in that way. But they've both played enough basketball, they'll find themselves. But it's not going to happen right away and with the schedule, it's got to happen sooner rather than later. So yeah, I think Coen knows that he's got, and we've got to work on our defense and we have to get better defensively. He is a good defender and if you remember, Jaden (Akins) was not and give him credit, he just grew and grew and grew and he became our best defender and hopefully the same happens with Coen.

On Trey Fort's becoming better defensively...

Trey and, what we've questioned most is the 2 spot, as far as which one of those guys, we keep rotating guys in there to play with different people. Trey's athletic enough to do it so he just has to put his mind to guarding. If he guards better, his offense will come.



7.2 ppg, was third in the Big Ten in assists (5.4 apg) and was No. 8 nationally in assist rate (38.9%).

» The Spartans also welcome back junior forward Coen Carr, one of the most athletic players in all of college basketball ... He averaged 8.1 ppg and 3.6 rpg last year, along with senior center Carson Cooper, who added 5.0 ppg and 5.2 rpg.

» Sophomore guard Kur Teng and redshirt freshman forward Jesse McCulloch are expected to play significant minutes in the rotation this coming year.

» Teng appeared in 19 games last year as a freshman, averaging 3.1 minutes per contest, while McCulloch was a key part of MSU's scout team during the run to the Elite Eight.

WHAT'S NEW

» While the Spartans return just two starters (Jeremy Fears Jr. and Jaxon Kohler) from last year, the team does enter the season with experienced players on the team.

» A pair of transfers – guards Trey Fort, Divine Ugochukwu and Denham Wojcik and forward Kaleb Glenn – come to East Lansing with a combined 222 games played and 88 starts.

» Fort has more career starts than any player on the roster (40), including 33 last year at Samford when he averaged 14.6 ppg and shot hit 80 shots from 3-point land.

» Glenn, who will miss the season following a summer injury, was an American Athletic Conference (AAC) Second Team All-Conference selection, after averaging 12.4 ppg and 5.4 rpg, while shooting 53.3% from the floor.

» Ugochukwu started 16 of 28 games at Miami as a freshman, averaging 5.3 ppg and 2.3 assists, while Wojcik, the son of associate head coach Doug Wojcik, appeared in 64 games and started 16 during three years at Harvard.

MSU IN NOVEMBER

» Michigan State has an all-time record of 161-47 in games played in the month of November ... This includes a 105-4 mark at home.

» When James Madison beat MSU in the season opener of the 2023-24 season (79-76 in overtime), it was the first loss at home since 1986, when a David Robinson-led Navy squad that bested the Spartans, 91-90, in overtime on Nov. 29, 1986.

» Head Coach Tom Izzo is 83-1 all-time at home in November, 126-43 for the month overall.

» The Spartans went 6-2 in November last year.

ANYONE, ANYWHERE

» Tom Izzo has consistently played one of the toughest schedules in America ... With a willingness to play at home, on the road or a neutral site, his list of regular-season non-conference opponents reads like a who's who of top college basketball programs.

» The 2025-26 schedule is no different.

» The 2025-26 home schedule is arguably the best in program history ... With home non-conference games against Arkansas (Nov. 8) and Duke (Dec. 6) in addition to 10 Big Ten contests, Michigan State will host 12 power conference opponents for the first time in the Izzo Era.

» The Spartans will also play at Connecticut in an exhibition game (Oct. 28), play Kentucky in the Champions Classic at Madison Square Garden in New York City (Nov. 18) and will play North Carolina on Thanksgiving Day (Nov. 27) in the Fort Myers Tip-Off.

IZZO NAMES TEAM CAPTAINS

» Michigan State Head Coach Tom Izzo announced the team's captains on the first official day of practice in late September.

» Seniors Carson Cooper and Jaxon Kohler, as well as junior forward Coen Carr and redshirt sophomore guard Jeremy Fears Jr. will serve as the team's captains.

» This is just the fifth time (1998-99, 2004-05, 2005-06), and the first since 2009-10, that the Spartans will have four captains in Izzo's 31 seasons at the helm of the MSU program.

COEN CARR NAMED TO JULIUS ERVING AWARD PRESEASON WATCH LIST

» Junior forward Coen Carr was one of 20 Division I men's basketball players selected to the watch list for the 2026 Julius Erving Award, announced by the Naismith Basketball Hall of Fame on Oct. 29.

» The annual Julius Erving Award, named after the Class of 1993 Hall of Famer and 17-year professional basketball player, celebrates its 12th year by recognizing the top small forwards in Division I men's college basketball.

» One of the team's quad-captains, Carr appeared in all 37 games last season, when the Spartans won the Big Ten regular season title and reached the Elite Eight of the NCAA Tournament ... He finished fourth on the team in scoring with 8.1 points per game, while adding 3.6 rebounds (fourth on the team), was second on the team with 28 blocked shots and fifth in the team in minutes played (77.1, 20.8 per game).

» Carr, who scored in double figures 12 times, shot 61.1 percent from the floor (113-of-185), including 33.3 percent (5-of-15) from 3-point land and hit 70.1 percent of his free throws (68-of-97). He averaged 7.2 points and 2.8 rebounds in Big Ten games.

» During the team's postseason run, Carr averaged 10.2 points and 5.7 rebounds while shooting 55.0 percent from the floor (22-of-40), including 11.3 points and 5.5 rebounds while shooting 59.3 percent from the floor (16-of-27) during the NCAA Tournament ... He scored a career-high 18 points and grabbed nine rebounds with two assists and a block against Bryant (3/21) in the first round of the NCAA Tournament.

» Carr was one of seven players from the Big Ten Conference selected to the watch list.

AGENT 99

» When the NCAA allowed players to wear jersey numbers that featured numbers higher than 5, college basketball started to see unique jerseys.

» Last year, the Spartans had a roster that included No. 7 Gehrig Normand and No. 8, Frankie Fidler.

» This year, sophomore guard Divine Ugochukwu, a transfer from Miami, is wearing No. 99.

» Per my research, Ugochukwu becomes the first player in Michigan State history to wear No. 99 (that wasn't hard), but he is one of only four players at the Division I level to sport double 9's, joined by Devin McGlockton (Vanderbilt), Jordan Burks (UCF) and Iaroslav Niagu (Jacksonville State).

» Further, Ugochukwu is one three players from a Power Four program to wear a number in the 90s, including Houston Mallette from Alabama (95).

OH, BROTHER

» Per research from Ryne Rickman, the men's hoop SID at UT-Martin (give credit where credit is due), Michigan State brothers Brennan & Colin Walton are one set of 16 brothers playing Division I basketball this season.

» The Walton brothers, from nearby Okemos, are just one of six sets of twins playing at the Division I level.

Coach Izzo

In his 31st year, Tom Izzo (Northern Michigan, '77) is 738-302 (.710), and 360-173 (.675) in the Big Ten, as the head coach of the Michigan State basketball program. He ranks as the winningest coach in Michigan State history, having passed his mentor, Jud Heathcote, with his 341st career victory on Nov. 28, 2009. In his 30-plus seasons as a head coach, Izzo has captured eight National Coach of the Year awards, including the Clair Bee Award in 2005 and NABC honors in 2001 and 2012. In 1999, Izzo was named National Coach of the Year by Basketball Times, while earning similar honors from The Associated Press, Basketball News and the USBWA in '98. He also earned National Coach of the Year accolades from CBSSports.com in 2012. He earned Big Ten Coach of the Year honors in 1998, 2009, 2012 and 2025. Izzo was enshrined in the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame on September 9, 2016, cementing his status as one of the game's all-time greats.

Among The Big Ten's Best

Tom Izzo's .675 winning percentage in Big Ten games ranks fourth all-time among league coaches with at least 10 years of service, behind former Wisconsin coach Bo Ryan (.717), former Indiana coach Bob Knight (.700), and former Purdue coach Ward Lambert (.685). In all games, Ohio State's Thad Matta ranks first at .748, followed by Ryan (.737), Knight (.734), Wisconsin's Walter Meanwell (.712), Izzo (.710) and Lambert (.709). Michigan State won at Illinois, 79-65, on Feb. 15, 2025, giving Izzo his 354th conference victory, moving him past Knight for the all-time lead. When MSU beat Maryland on March 6, 2022, Izzo reached 663 wins, passing Knight (662) for most overall wins as a head coach at a Big Ten school, and 700 wins when the Spartans beat Michigan on Jan. 30, 2024.

Izzo Among Best Ever

Through his first 30 seasons, Tom Izzo won 737 games, ranking fourth in college basketball history for most wins by a college coach in his first 30 years.

Final Fours

Tom Izzo led MSU to eight Final Four appearances between 1999 and 2019, becoming just the fourth school in college basketball history to do it in any 21-year span, including just the third since the tournament field expanded to 64 teams in 1985. Izzo's eight Final Fours are the most by any coach since his first season in 1996 and he ranks fifth all-time, including third among active coaches. The eight Final Fours are also the most by any Big Ten coach.
