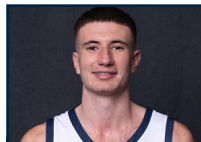

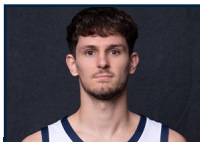
- The Samford Bulldogs travel to take on Arkansas in the second game of a three-game road trip.
- The Samford Bulldogs and the Razorbacks are meeting for the fourth time in program history.
- Arkansas leads the all-time series 3-0, and the two sides haven't met since the 2017-18 season.
- The Bulldogs are coming off a 93-90 overtime victory at Texas Southern on Wednesday night.
- Once again, Jadin Booth led the Bulldogs in scoring for the third straight contest. The graduate guard scored a season-low 23 points on 6-of-14 shooting. He also led the Dogs with nine rebounds against the Tigers.
- Booth is 18-of-37 from three, and is shooting 48 percent from the floor and over 91 percent from the line.

- Booth is the leading scorer in the country, averaging 27.7 points per game on the season.
- Starting point guard Keaton Norris had his best performance in a Bulldog uniform as he finished with 22 points, 8 rebounds, and 5 assists.
- Freshman Isaiah Campbell-Finch had his breakout game, scoring a career-high 21 points on 8-of-13 shooting in 37 minutes off the bench.
- The Bulldogs have hit double-digit threes in every game this season as they knocked down 11 in their win over the Tigers.
- Booth and Dylan Faulkner were selected to the Preseason SoCon Team. Faulkner joins Samford after spending two seasons playing for coach Acuff at Lipscomb.

PROJECTED STARTING FIVE *Based of previous game



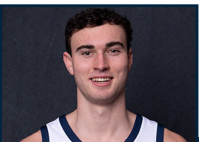

- Samford will once again rely heavily on the transfer portal this season. Dalion Humphrey (Bowling Green), Jadin Booth (Florida Southern), Keaton Norris (Wright State), Judson Bjornstad (Union), Cade Norris (Illinois State), Kam Martin (Long Beach State), Dylan Faulkner (Lipscomb), Jaxon Pollard (Queens), Zach Lamey (Lipscomb), and Will Shaver (UAB) all transferred to Samford for this season.

THE OPPOSITION

- Arkansas enters the game with a 2-1 record on the season.
- The Razorbacks are coming off a 93-56 win over Central Arkansas on Tuesday night.
- Their line defeat came at #22 Michigan State 69-66 last Saturday.
- Head coach John Calipari is in his second-season with the Razorbacks and in his 34th season overall.
- The Razorbacks were picked fifth in the SEC Preseason Coaches Poll.
- Three Arkansas players are averaging double-figures on the season, led by Darius Acuff Jr who is scoring 19.7 ppg.

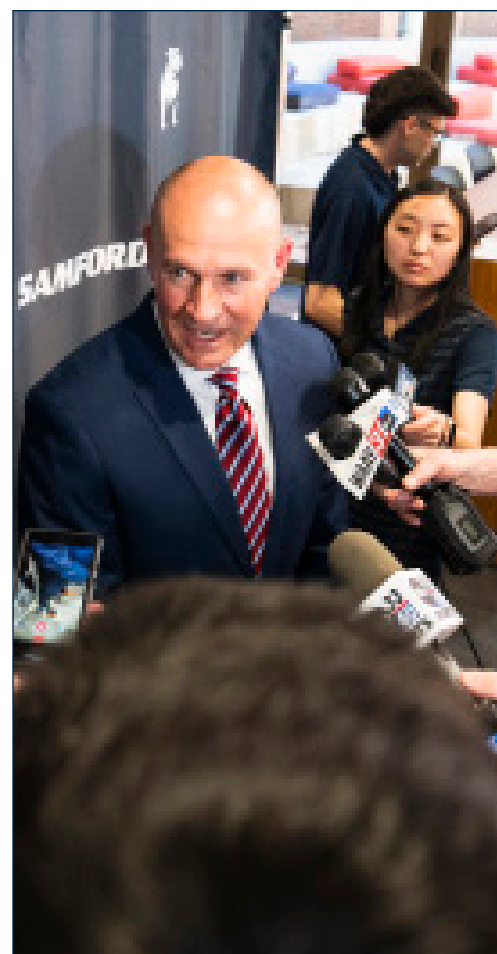

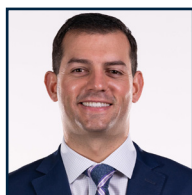

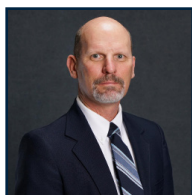
