CONFERENCE NOTES

Weekly Honors

• **SEC PLAYER OF THE WEEK presented by Allstate:** Florida's Liv McGill has already established single-game career highs this season in points (38), made three-pointers (6), and made field goals (13), and tied her career high of seven steals, all against Chattanooga. Her 38 points against Chattanooga were the most in a home game in Florida women's basketball history. She became just the 6th player in NCAA Division I Women's Basketball history since the 1999-2000 season to record a game of 38+ points, and 10+ assists. She leads the SEC in scoring average, is tied for fourth in assists per game, while ranking second in steals per game, and tied for second in made three-pointers per game. McGill was named one of the USBWA's National Players of the Week.

• **SEC FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK presented by Allstate:** Bonnie Deas was vital to Arkansas getting off to a 3-0 start to the 2025-26 season. Deas made her collegiate debut against Louisiana Tech on Nov. 4 and dropped 25 points with five rebounds, three assists and three steals. Against UA-Pine Bluff, she notched her first double-double with 12 points and 11 rebounds. She also tallied six assists in the 52-point victory. Deas closed out week one with her second-straight double-double on 18 points and 12 rebounds in the comeback win against Central Arkansas on Monday night. Deas leads Arkansas in scoring average (18.3) and steals (6). League-wide, Deas ranks sixth overall in scoring and first among SEC freshmen. On a national scale, Deas is the only freshman in the country averaging 18.0+ points per game and 9.0+ rebounds per game through the first three games of the season, per Stathead.

Around the League

• Tonie Morgan tied the school record for assists in a game with 16 as Kentucky cruised past USC Upstate 90-30. Morgan, who had a double-double with 11 points, tied the school record of Patty Jo Hedges, who had 16 assists against Cincinnati on Jan. 15, 1982.

• In the 94-44 win over Southern, Ole Miss' Christeen Iwuala paced the field with career high marks in points with 22 and rebounds with 11. Her frontcourt partner, Cotie McMahon, recorded 18 points and 10 rebounds, marking her 11th double-double of her career.

• Vanderbilt's Mikayla Blakes continued her double-digit games with 26 in the 75-65 win over Austin Peay. She has scored 10+ points in 35 of her 36 collegiate games.

• In the win over Charlotte, LSU had seven players in double figures, Kate Koval earned a double double with 10 points and 12 rebounds while MiLaysia Fulwiley led the Tigers with 22 points on eight-of-11 shooting, five three-pointers and three steals. MiKaylah Williams earned a season high of 18 points on five-of-seven shooting along with six rebounds from the offensive board. Flau'Jae Johnson had 16 points and Amiya Joyner had 15 points. Grace Knox and ZaKiyah Johnson both earned 10 points.

• Oklahoma freshman Aaliyah Chavez scored 29 points on nine-of-13 shooting to lead the Sooners over Kansas City, 89-61.

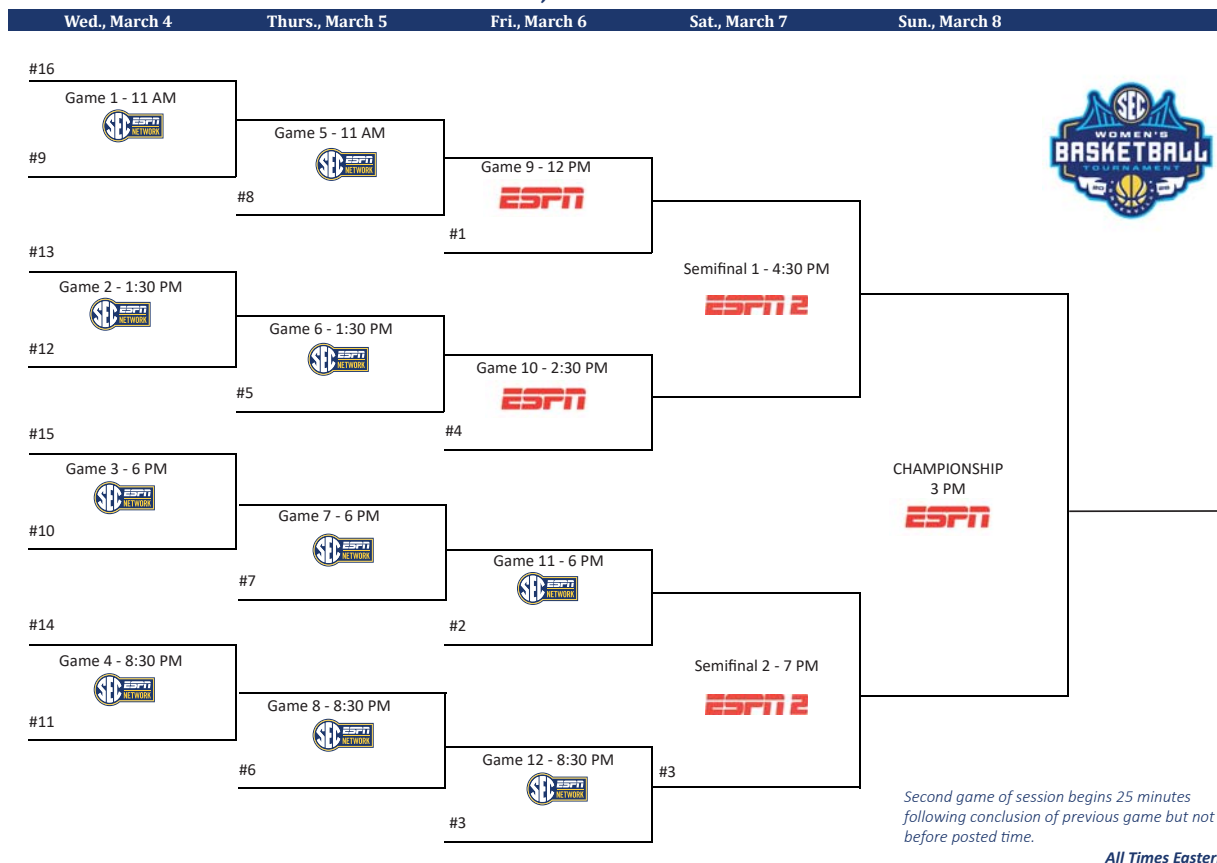

SEC vs Everyone Else

- The SEC has compiled a 46-2 (.958) non-conference record during the 2025-26 season.
- Last season, SEC teams went 159-52 (.782) against all other conferences.
- Against the other A4 conferences, the SEC went 23-13 (.639) versus the ACC, 9-6 (.600) against the Big 12 and 14-12 (.560) against the Big Ten.
- In regular season games, the SEC has compiled a 6222-1792 (.776) record against other conferences. In the post-season, SEC teams are 579-303 (.656) against non-conference teams. Overall, teams are 6801-2094 (.764).
- The league has recorded 150+ wins in 30 seasons and has recorded a non-conference winning percentage below .700 only once.

SEC Tournament

Beginning with its inception and through 1986, the tournament was held at campus sites. The tournament was then sent to Albany, Ga., which served as the site for six years from 1987-92. The tournament then moved to Chattanooga, Tenn., where it was held from 1993-2000, with the exception of 1998 when the tournament moved to Columbus, Ga.

Since 2001 the tournament has enjoyed many new sites, including Memphis (2001), Nashville (2002, 2004, 2008, 2011, 2012, 2018, 2022), Little Rock, Ark. (2003, 2006, 2009, 2015), Greenville, S.C. (2005, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021, 2023, 2024, 2025, 2026), Duluth, Ga. (2007, 2010, 2013, 2014) and Jacksonville, Fla. (2016).

The conference announced a three-year extension with Greenville, S.C. to host the SEC Women's Basketball Tournament in through 2028.

The winner of the tournament receives the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament.

The event has helped set the stage for SEC teams in the NCAA Tournament, as 32 of the conference tournament champions have advanced to at least the Sweet 16. The SEC Tournament Champion has failed to win at least one NCAA Tournament game only twice.

Tennessee leads the league with 17 SEC Tournament titles. South Carolina is second with nine, Vanderbilt has six, while Auburn, Georgia, each have four. LSU has two with Kentucky, Mississippi State and Texas A&M having each won one SEC Tournament championship.

Tie-Break Procedures

Teams will be seeded No. 1 through No. 16 in the SEC Women's Basketball Tournament bracket based upon the final regular season Conference standings.

Teams that finished No. 1 through No. 4 in the final regular season standings shall receive first and second-round byes and teams that finish No. 5 through No. 8 will receive first-round byes.

For the purpose of seeding, if an institution is precluded from participating in the tournament, such institution will automatically be seeded last. The No. 9 seed will then receive a bye. However, for the purpose of breaking ties, that team will remain where it finished in the regular-season standings BEFORE being seeded last.

1. Two-Team Tie: The following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken:

- A. Won-lost results of head-to-head competition between the two teams.
- B. Won-lost percentage of the two teams versus the highest seed (and proceeding through the lowest seed, if necessary).
- C. Won-lost results in road Conference games.
- D. Head-to-head point differential (points scored minus points allowed) between the two tied teams.
- E. Winning percentage against all Quad 1 Division I opponents.
- F. Winning percentage against all Quad 2 Division I opponents.
- G. NCAA NET ranking (most recent available NET ranking before the conference tournament).

2. Three-Team Tie (or more): When three or more teams are tied, the following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken. If two teams remain tied after a tiebreaker provision, the two-team tiebreaker formula will be used:

- A. Best winning percentage of games played among the tied teams (Example: Team A is 3-1, Team B is 2-2 and Team C is 1-3 – Team A would be seeded highest, Team B second-highest and Team C lowest of the three).
- B. Best winning percentage of the tied teams versus the highest seed (and proceeding through the lowest seed, if necessary).
- C. Won-lost results in road Conference games.
- D. Head-to-head point differential (points scored minus points allowed) between the two tied teams.
- E. Winning percentage against all Quad 1 Division I opponents.
- F. Winning percentage against all Quad 2 Division I opponents.
- G. NCAA NET ranking (most recent available NET ranking before the conference tournament).

SEC SUCCESS

The Nation's Best Coaches

- Seven current SEC coaches have both played and coached in the NCAA Tournament (Katie Abrahamson-Henderson, Jennie Baranczyk, Kellie Harper, Kim Mulkey, Dawn Staley, Joni Taylor and Shea Ralph).
- In addition, Abrahamson-Henderson and Harper have both taken four different teams to the tournament, while Kristy Curry has taken three different teams to the tournament.
- Jenni Baranczyk, Kenny Brooks, Yolett McPhee-McCuin, Kim Mulkey, Vic Schaefer, Dawn Staley and Joni Taylor have made the tournament with two different teams.

The Nation's Best Players

- The SEC has had at least one student-athlete named as a First-Team All-America selection in each of the last 17 seasons.
- All-Americans were first named in women's basketball in 1975. Since that time, league schools have had 83 players named first team a total of 182 times.
- The league has had eight Honda Sports Awards winners in Katrina McClain, Georgia (1987); Bridgette Gordon, Tennessee (1989); Chamique Holdsclaw, Tennessee (1997 and 1998); Candace Parker, Tennessee (2007 and 2008); A'ja Wilson, South Carolina (2018) and Aliyah Boston, South Carolina (2022).
- Nine Naismith Player of the Year winners have come from the SEC. They include Saudia Roundtree, Georgia (1996), Chamique Holdsclaw, Tennessee (1998 and 1999), Tamika Catchings, Tennessee (2000), Seimone Augustus, LSU (2005 and 2006), Candace Parker, Tennessee (2008); A'ja Wilson, South Carolina (2018) and Aliyah Boston, South Carolina (2022).
- The SEC has had 178 former players play in the WNBA.
- Since the inaugural WNBA draft in 1997, the SEC has had 204 former players drafted for the professional league, including eight No. 1 picks.
- The league has had a first round pick every year except one (2014).

Women's Basketball Leadership Council

- The council consists of one women's basketball student-athlete from each of the SEC's 16 institutions. The goal of the leadership council is for student-athletes to serve as a conduit of communication from their teams to the conference office on issues related to student-athlete experience, student-athlete wellness, and to provide feedback on proposed rules governing the SEC and NCAA.

Academics

- A total of 149 women's basketball students were named to the 2024-25 SEC Academic Honor Rolls for having a grade point average of 3.00 or above for either the preceding academic year or a cumulative grade point average of 3.00 or above.
- The conference has had 38 women's basketball players named Academic All-American.
- Four Women's Basketball Academic All-America of the Year hail from the SEC. They are Candace Parker, UT (2007 & 2008); Aliyah Boston, SC (2021 & 2022).

By The Number

- Since the SEC began to sponsor women's basketball in 1982, it has failed only six times to place at least five members in each of the final polls (the USA Today/ESPN poll began in 1986).
- In 2025, the most SEC teams in the final AP poll was eight, a record for the conference. Up until last season, seven was the most, which the league has done five times (1995, 1996, 1997, 2003, and 2018).
- Overall, the league teams have been ranked every week except for the very first poll in 1976.
- The league has had the top three teams in the AP Poll twice. In week three in 2005 and in week eight in 1989.
- SEC schools have produced 48 Team USA Olympians since 1976, with 44 coming since the SEC began sponsoring women's basketball. In addition, 11 have played for other countries in the Olympics.
