CONFERENCE NOTES

Weekly Honors

• **SEC PLAYER OF THE WEEK** presented by Allstate: Clara Strack is coming off her fifth straight double-double – but her sixth in seven games this season – after 17 points and 13 rebounds in the dominating win over Purdue followed by 17 and 10 in the in-state rivalry win at No. 21/19 Louisville. She remains the nation's lone leader with her six double-doubles on the season, and in the process, she also is first in the league and fourth in the nation in rebounds per game (12.1). Also following five blocks against Purdue and two blocks at UofL, she is second in the league and eighth in the nation in blocks per game (3.14). Her combined 34 points this week came off 53.8 percent shooting. She also had 23 rebounds, five assists, seven blocks and two steals for the week. She is one of two DI women's basketball players in the nation to have at least 575 points, 375 rebounds, 75 assists, 75 blocks and 25 steals since the start of 2024-25.

• **SEC CO-FRESHMEN OF THE WEEK** presented by Allstate: Alabama's Ace Austin earned a career-high 21 points in UA's 39-point victory over Samford, scoring all her points off the bench in 30 minutes of action. Austin also dished out a team-high five assists with three steals. She played a part in Alabama's bench production against Alabama A&M, when the UA reserves outscored its counterparts 23-16, led by Austin's nine points. During the Tide's first game in the Baha Mar Pink Flamingo Championship, Austin secured her second consecutive double-figure game with 17 points in her 26 minutes of play as a reserve. She became the first UA freshman to have back-to-back double-digit games since Essence Cody during the 2023-24 season. Austin is just one of three UA players who are currently averaging double figures in scoring as the freshman sits with 13.8 points per game through five games.

Vanderbilt's Aubrey Galvan matched the Vanderbilt freshman single-game record for assists and steals in the same contest to cap off a three-win week for the Commodores, as the point guard collected 15 assists and had nine steals in a win over Tennessee State on Sunday afternoon. Galvan's 15 helpers vs. TSU matched Ashley Smith's Vanderbilt freshman record for most assists in a game, which she set on Nov. 29, 1998, against Hampton. Her nine steals equaled Deborah Denton's freshman single-game record for steals set against New Mexico State on Jan. 4, 1987. She averaged 10.3 assists, 7.7 points, 3.7 steals and 3.3 rebounds for the week. The guard dished out eight or more assists in all three

contests. Her career-high of 15 assists is the most by an NCAA Division I freshman against a D-I opponent this season, while it is tied for the second-most by an NCAA player nationally.

Around the League

• LSU continued its NCAA record streak with the eighth consecutive 100-point game Saturday night, routing Washington State 112-35 in the Reef Division championship game at the Paradise Jam tournament.

• With the win over Butler, Georgia improved to 9-0 for the first time since 2014 and for just the 10th occasion in program history.

• Florida's Liv McGill established single-game career highs in free throws made (13) and attempted (14) in the win over Georgia Tech.

• The Rebels are undefeated through seven games for the first time since 2008-09, the first time in head coach Yolett McPhee-McCuin's tenure at the helm. It's only the third time since the 2000-01 season that Ole Miss has begun a season this hot and 13th time ever.

• Grace Slaughter scored a career-high 33 points and surpassed 1,000 career points as Missouri topped Northwestern 85-70, delivering Kellie Harper her 400th career win.

• Vanderbilt posted its largest comeback under head coach Shea Ralph, erasing a 16-point deficit to collect an 84-71 come-from-behind victory against BYU to win the Island Division at the 2025 U.S. Virgin Islands Paradise Jam.

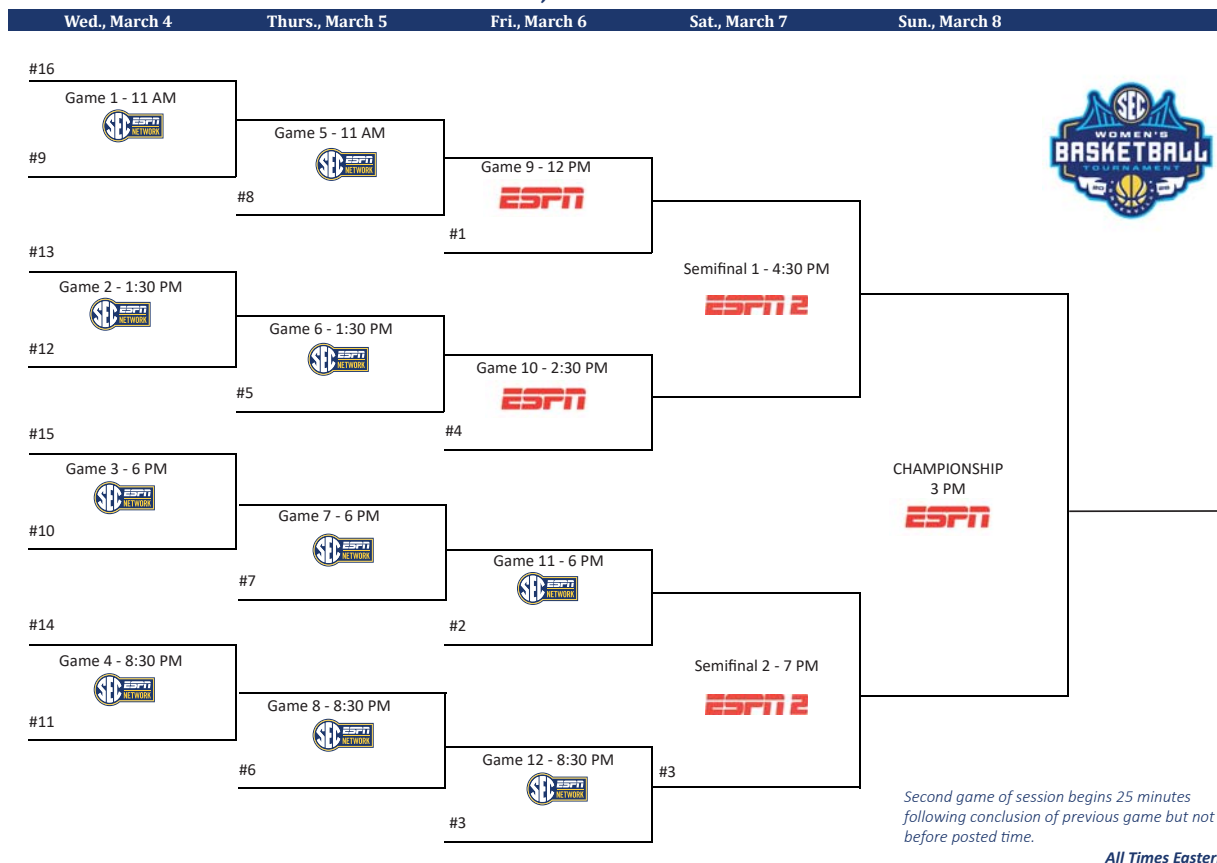

SEC vs Everyone Else

- The SEC has compiled a 112-9 (.926) non-conference record during the 2025-26 season.
- Last season, SEC teams went 159-52 (.782) against all other conferences.
- Against the other A4 conferences, the SEC went 23-13 (.639) versus the ACC, 9-6 (.600) against the Big 12 and 14-12 (.560) against the Big Ten.
- In regular season games, the SEC has compiled a 6288-1799 (.778) record against other conferences. In the post-season, SEC teams are 579-303 (.656) against non-conference teams. Overall, teams are 6867-2101 (.766).
- The league has recorded 150+ wins in 30 seasons and has recorded a non-conference winning percentage below .700 only once.

SEC Tournament

Beginning with its inception and through 1986, the tournament was held at campus sites. The tournament was then sent to Albany, Ga., which served as the site for six years from 1987-92. The tournament then moved to Chattanooga, Tenn., where it was held from 1993-2000, with the exception of 1998 when the tournament moved to Columbus, Ga.

Since 2001 the tournament has enjoyed many new sites, including Memphis (2001), Nashville (2002, 2004, 2008, 2011, 2012, 2018, 2022), Little Rock, Ark. (2003, 2006, 2009, 2015), Greenville, S.C. (2005, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021, 2023, 2024, 2025, 2026), Duluth, Ga. (2007, 2010, 2013, 2014) and Jacksonville, Fla. (2016).

The conference announced a three-year extension with Greenville, S.C. to host the SEC Women's Basketball Tournament in through 2028.

The winner of the tournament receives the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament.

The event has helped set the stage for SEC teams in the NCAA Tournament, as 32 of the conference tournament champions have advanced to at least the Sweet 16. The SEC Tournament Champion has failed to win at least one NCAA Tournament game only twice.

Tennessee leads the league with 17 SEC Tournament titles. South Carolina is second with nine, Vanderbilt has six, while Auburn, Georgia, each have four. LSU has two with Kentucky, Mississippi State and Texas A&M having each won one SEC Tournament championship.

Tie-Break Procedures

Teams will be seeded No. 1 through No. 16 in the SEC Women's Basketball Tournament bracket based upon the final regular season Conference standings.

Teams that finished No. 1 through No. 4 in the final regular season standings shall receive first and second-round byes and teams that finish No. 5 through No. 8 will receive first-round byes.

For the purpose of seeding, if an institution is precluded from participating in the tournament, such institution will automatically be seeded last. The No. 9 seed will then receive a bye. However, for the purpose of breaking ties, that team will remain where it finished in the regular-season standings BEFORE being seeded last.

1. Two-Team Tie: The following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken:

- A. Won-lost results of head-to-head competition between the two teams.
- B. Won-lost percentage of the two teams versus the highest seed (and proceeding through the lowest seed, if necessary).
- C. Won-lost results in road Conference games.
- D. Head-to-head point differential (points scored minus points allowed) between the two tied teams.
- E. Winning percentage against all Quad 1 Division I opponents.
- F. Winning percentage against all Quad 2 Division I opponents.
- G. NCAA NET ranking (most recent available NET ranking before the conference tournament).

2. Three-Team Tie (or more): When three or more teams are tied, the following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken. If two teams remain tied after a tiebreaker provision, the two-team tiebreaker formula will be used:

- A. Best winning percentage of games played among the tied teams (Example: Team A is 3-1, Team B is 2-2 and Team C is 1-3 – Team A would be seeded highest, Team B second-highest and Team C lowest of the three).
- B. Best winning percentage of the tied teams versus the highest seed (and proceeding through the lowest seed, if necessary).
- C. Won-lost results in road Conference games.
- D. Head-to-head point differential (points scored minus points allowed) between the two tied teams.
- E. Winning percentage against all Quad 1 Division I opponents.
- F. Winning percentage against all Quad 2 Division I opponents.
- G. NCAA NET ranking (most recent available NET ranking before the conference tournament).

SEC SUCCESS

The Nation's Best Coaches

- Seven current SEC coaches have both played and coached in the NCAA Tournament (Katie Abrahamson-Henderson, Jennie Baranczyk, Kellie Harper, Kim Mulkey, Dawn Staley, Joni Taylor and Shea Ralph).
- In addition, Abrahamson-Henderson and Harper have both taken four different teams to the tournament, while Kristy Curry has taken three different teams to the tournament.
- Jenni Baranczyk, Kenny Brooks, Yolett McPhee-McCuin, Kim Mulkey, Vic Schaefer, Dawn Staley and Joni Taylor have made the tournament with two different teams.

The Nation's Best Players

- The SEC has had at least one student-athlete named as a First-Team All-America selection in each of the last 17 seasons.
- All-Americans were first named in women's basketball in 1975. Since that time, league schools have had 83 players named first team a total of 182 times.
- The league has had eight Honda Sports Awards winners in Katrina McClain, Georgia (1987); Bridgette Gordon, Tennessee (1989); Chamique Holdsclaw, Tennessee (1997 and 1998); Candace Parker, Tennessee (2007 and 2008); A'ja Wilson, South Carolina (2018) and Aliyah Boston, South Carolina (2022).
- Nine Naismith Player of the Year winners have come from the SEC. They include Saudia Roundtree, Georgia (1996), Chamique Holdsclaw, Tennessee (1998 and 1999), Tamika Catchings, Tennessee (2000), Seimone Augustus, LSU (2005 and 2006), Candace Parker, Tennessee (2008); A'ja Wilson, South Carolina (2018) and Aliyah Boston, South Carolina (2022).
- The SEC has had 178 former players play in the WNBA.
- Since the inaugural WNBA draft in 1997, the SEC has had 204 former players drafted for the professional league, including eight No. 1 picks.
- The league has had a first round pick every year except one (2014).

Women's Basketball Leadership Council

- The council consists of one women's basketball student-athlete from each of the SEC's 16 institutions. The goal of the leadership council is for student-athletes to serve as a conduit of communication from their teams to the conference office on issues related to student-athlete experience, student-athlete wellness, and to provide feedback on proposed rules governing the SEC and NCAA.

Academics

- A total of 149 women's basketball students were named to the 2024-25 SEC Academic Honor Rolls for having a grade point average of 3.00 or above for either the preceding academic year or a cumulative grade point average of 3.00 or above.
- The conference has had 38 women's basketball players named Academic All-American.
- Four Women's Basketball Academic All-America of the Year hail from the SEC. They are Candace Parker, UT (2007 & 2008); Aliyah Boston, SC (2021 & 2022).

By The Number

- Since the SEC began to sponsor women's basketball in 1982, it has failed only six times to place at least five members in each of the final polls (the USA Today/ESPN poll began in 1986).
- In 2025, the most SEC teams in the final AP poll was eight, a record for the conference. Up until last season, seven was the most, which the league has done five times (1995, 1996, 1997, 2003, and 2018).
- Overall, the league teams have been ranked every week except for the very first poll in 1976.
- The league has had the top three teams in the AP Poll twice. In week three in 2005 and in week eight in 1989.
- SEC schools have produced 48 Team USA Olympians since 1976, with 44 coming since the SEC began sponsoring women's basketball. In addition, 11 have played for other countries in the Olympics.
