SETTING THE SCENE

- Thursday will be SMU's second season participating in the ACC/SEC Challenge as the team faced Mizzou last year. The Challenge begins on Wednesday, November 3, with seven games and concludes on Thursday, November 4, with nine matchups. The ACC is 13-17 in the two seasons of the ACC-SEC Challenge.
- The Mustangs will look to extend their current winning streak to three after defeating Southern Miss 83-70 last time out. Zahra King led SMU with 23 points while Mirima Ibezim recorded her first double-double of the season.
- Seven games into the season, the Mustangs have four players averaging over nine points per game: Tyi Skinner (14.8), Zahra King (14.6), Sahnja Jah (9.0) and Kyla Deck (9.3).
- King leads SMU in points scored with 117 total points and is coming off scoring a career high of 23 against Southern Miss. She has scored in double figures in six of the team's eight games this season, including three straight 14-point or more outings.
- King has been incredibly efficient, shooting 56.1% from the field. Her field goal percentage ranks sixth in the ACC, and her 46 made field goals rank eighth in the conference.
- After missing a couple of games to begin the season, Tyi Skinner scored her first 20-point game of the season as she dropped 27 points against Winthrop. She followed that outing with an 18-point, five-assist performance against Southern Miss. Skinner ranks 10th in the ACC in points per game (14.8).
- SMU's defense has been causing havoc for other teams this season as the Mustangs rank second in the ACC / 53rd in the NCAA in steals per game at 11.5. SMU also ranks fifth in the ACC / 39th in the NCAA in blocks per game (4.9) and fifth in the ACC in turnovers forced per game (19.38).
- On offense, SMU ranks third in the ACC in offensive rebounds per game (15.3) and sixth in the ACC in bench points per game (27.5.) SMU has had four games with 30+ points off the bench and four games with over 30 points in the paint.
- Kyla Deck has made quite an impact on both sides of the court to start the season. Not only is she third on the team in points per game, but she also leads SMU in total assists with 18.
- Deck is third in the ACC in total steals with 29 (7th in the NCAA) in steals per game at 3.63 (15th in the NCAA). Deck is coming off her second six-steal game of the season against Winthrop.
- SMU has recorded double-digit steals in all but two game this season. The Mustangs' six games with double-digit steals are already the most in a single season since the 2023-24 year (9), and the team's 84 steals in the first seven games was the most since the team had 89 during the 2012-13 season. The Mustangs are fourth in the ACC in total steals with 92.
- The Mustangs forced 22 turnovers against Winthrop, the fifth time this season they have forced 20 or more. It is the fifth straight season with five games achieving the feat, and if the team were to get one more, it would be the most games with 20 or more turnovers forced since the 2019-20 season (12).
- SMU is 3-5 under head coach Adia Barnes. Barnes, a former WBCA Coach of the Year Finalist and Naismith Coach of the Year Semifinalist, was named Head Women's Basketball Coach at SMU on April 5.
- As SMU enters year two in the ACC, it will do so with an entirely new roster and coaching staff, signing 15 new players ahead of the 2025-26 season. Of the 15, eight players transferred in from a P4 institution. The Mustangs will also be one of the more experienced teams in the nation, having added eight seniors/graduate students to the roster this season.

SMU WOMEN'S BASKETBALL GAME NOTES

LAST TIME OUT

DALLAS (SMU) – The SMU women's basketball program used a dominant half to close out an 83-70 victory over Southern Miss on Monday inside Moody Coliseum.

SMU (3-5, 0-0 ACC) scored 45 points in the second half to take control of the game, leading by as much as 19 points. The Mustangs outscored Southern Miss (6-3, 0-0 Sun Belt) 19-12 in the third quarter and iced the game with a 10-0 run in the fourth to cruise to the win.

SMU shot 46% from the field in the game and had four players in double figures for the third time this season. The Mustangs were dialed in at the line, making 23-of-28 free throw attempts. SMU out-rebounded the Golden Eagles 40-28 and also held the advantage on bench points scored (19-7).

Leading the way for the Mustangs was Zahra King, who continued her hot streak, scoring a career-high 23 points, 14 of which came in the second half. King shot 8-of-14 from the field and was a perfect 3-of-3 from beyond the arc, tying her career high for most made in a game. The sophomore was also 4-of-5 from the line and had two steals.

Coming off a 27-point performance last game, Tyi Skinner picked up right where she left off, scoring 18 points and totaling a season-high five assists. Skinner was 7-of-8 from the line and scored 11 points in the second half.

Miriam Ibezim recorded her first double-double of the season and the second of her career as she totaled 10 points and 10 rebounds. Ibezim was a perfect 5-of-5 from the field in the game.

Kyla Deck finished her night with 11 points, going 4-of-4 from the line, and had two steals. Anaya Brown also chipped in nine points and seven rebounds.

Up four at the break, SMU came out swinging in the second half, looking to take control of the game. The Mustangs pushed the lead to nine after five straight points from King to start the third.

After trading buckets, SMU increased the lead to double digits after a Brown corner three. The Mustangs continued to push the pace and went on a 6-0 run late in the third, highlighted by an Ibezim tough layup to go up 14 points.

Heading into the fourth up 11, SMU was ready to put the game out of reach and did just that. Behind six points from Skinner and four from Deck, the Mustangs went on a 10-0 run halfway through the fourth to go up 19 points. Southern Miss cut the lead to 12 with one minute to go, but four made foul shots from King put the finishing touches on the Mustangs' second win in a row.

// THE MATCH UP

- Thursday's game will be the 29th time SMU and Arkansas have faced each other and the first since 2021.
- The former Southwest Conference opponents haven't met since 2021, with Arkansas winning the last two matchups. SMU last victory over Arkansas came in 2010 when the Mustangs defeated Arkansas 76-71 in Moody Coliseum.
- Arkansas enters the game with a record of 7-2 after falling 69-51 to Harvard at home last time out. SMU enters the game on a two-game winning streak and is 2-2 at home.
- Arkansas also played at the Music City Classic in Nashville over the Thanksgiving break.

// [ACC]OMPLISH GREATNESS

- ACC teams have combined to register 98 victories this season.
- The ACC has played 19 games against AP Top 25 opponents this season, the most of any Division I conference (next closest is the Big Ten with 16).
- Three ACC teams are in the latest Associated Press (AP) Poll: North Carolina (No. 11), Notre Dame (No. 18) and Louisville (No. 22). NC State and Stanford are receiving votes.
- Four ACC teams appear in the latest USA Today Coaches Poll: North Carolina (No. 10), Notre Dame (No. 19), Louisville (No. 21) and NC State (No. 25). Duke and Stanford are receiving votes.
- The ACC currently has nine teams in the top 50 of the NET: North Carolina (No. 12), Louisville (No. 14), Stanford (No. 22), Notre Dame (No. 33), Virginia (No. 34), NC State (No. 39), Syracuse (No. 44) and Miami (No. 49). Duke and Virginia Tech are just outside the top 50 at No. 51 and No. 53, respectively.

// DYNAMIC DUO

- Zahra King and Tyi Skinner have been on a tear recently, averaging 14.8 and 14.6 points per game, respectively. The duo is one of two ACC schools to have two or more players average over 14 points per game (Notre Dame, Hannah Hidalgo / Cassandre Prosper).
- King has scored in double figures in three straight games, including scoring a career high 23 points last time out, and is averaging over 18 ppg in the stretch.
- Skinner scored 27 points against Winthrop. It was her 34th career 20-point game as she made five 3-pointers and currently leads SMU in 3-pointers made with 12. She is also 14-of-15 from the line over her last three games.

// OFFENSIVE PRODUCTION

- SMU has had three games with four or more players reaching double figures.
- The Mustangs had five players reach double figures in the team's win over Grambling State, a feat only achieved twice last season. SMU defeated GSU 96-70, the most points scored in a game since SMU scored 96 against Alabama State in 2023.

// DOMINATE DEFENSE

- SMU has forced 137 turnovers this season and has forced 20 or more in six games this season.
- Against Winthrop, SMU forced 22 turnovers and had 10 steals, while Kyla Deck led the way with six. It was her third game with five or more steals this season.
- Deck ranks third in the ACC in total steals with 29 (7th in the NCAA) and in steals per game at 3.86 (15th in the NCAA). Deck has recorded 195 steals in her career.
- The Mustangs forced a season high 24 turnovers and recorded a season high 16 steals against GCU. Four mustangs finished with three steals in the game.
- Deck recorded six steals against Grambling State, which was tied for the most by any ACC player in their team's season-opening game.

// IT'S A BLOCK PARTY

- SMU has totaled 39 blocks this season, the third most in the ACC. The team's 4.8 blocks per game ranks fifth in the conference.
- SMU had seven blocks against Grambling State, six against GCU and five versus North Texas. Anaya Brown leads the team in total blocks with 12.
- Brown has three games this season with three blocks and has totaled 19 career games with three or more. She has now totaled 145 blocks in her career. Her 13 blocks this season rank fifth in the ACC, and her 1.6 blocks per game rank fifth in the conference.

// LETTING IT FLY

- SMU knocked down a season high 11 three pointers against Texas Tech. The team was 11-33 from behind the arc. The 33 attempts are tied for the second most in program history.
- The Mustangs have made 49 three-pointers this season, while Tyi Skinner leads the team with 12 made. Zahra King is shooting 50% from beyond the arc this season.

// GETTING TO THE LINE

- The Mustangs have made it a point of emphasis to get to the line recently. The team was 23-of-28 (82%) from the line against Southern Miss. Tyi Skinner (7-8), Zahra King (4-5) and Kyla Deck (4-4) led the way at the stripe.
- SMU got to the line a lot against Grambling and was 28-37 from the stripe in the game. The Mustangs' 28 made free throws are the most since the team made 40 at Memphis during the 2023-24 season.

// ACTIVE CAREER LEADERS

- Tyi Skinner ranks among the highest among multiple active career leaders in NCAA Division 1.
- Skinner career rankings: 2nd in field goal attempts (1,620), 4th in 3-point attempts (734), 4th in total points (1,773), 5th in made 3-point field goals (245), 5th in games played (124), 13th in made free throws (359), 13th in made field goals (583).

// SMU SURGES PAST SOUTHERN MISS

- SMU shot 46% from the field in the game and had four players in double figures for the third time this season en route to an 83-70 win over Southern Miss.
- The Mustangs were dialed in at the line, making 23-of-28 free throw attempts. SMU out-rebounded the Golden Eagles 40-28 and also held the advantage on bench points scored (19-7).
- Zahra King, scored a career-high 23 points, 14 of which came in the second half. King shot 8-of-14 from the field and was a perfect 3-of-3 from beyond the arc, tying her career high for most made in a game. The sophomore was also 4-of-5 from the line and had two steals.

// MUSIC CITY CLASSIC IN NASHVILLE

- After dropping their first game of the Music City Classic to Saint Louis 70-67, the Mustangs bounced back with an 84-61 victory over Winthrop. Tyi Skinner and Zahra King combined for 45 points and were 16-20 from the field in the game.
- Skinner knocked down five three-pointers (5-of-8) and shot 8-of-12 from the floor to record her 34th career 20-point game. Skinner was also a perfect 6-of-6 from the line and finished with a plus-minus of +24. She scored 14 of her season-high point total in the first half.
- King turned in an elite shooting performance, going 8-for-8 from the field, tying her career high for makes, and finishing with 18 points.

// STARTING THE SEASON RIGHT

- SMU started the season 1-0 after a 96-70 win over Grambling State last time out. In front of the largest season-opening crowd since the 2016-17 season, the Mustangs played fast and scored often in the game, knocking down 10 three pointers and scoring 26 fast-break points while holding Grambling to only eight fast-break points. SMU finished the game shooting 50% from the floor and had 17 assists on 28 made baskets. The Mustangs held the Tigers to just 33.8% from the floor and only allowed five made three pointers (GSU – 5-24 3pts).
- The Mustangs had five players reach double figures against Grambling. Leading the way on offense was Sanyah Jah, who scored a game-high 19 points, all of which came in the second half, as she was 6-of-9 from the floor and 7-of-8 from the line, both career highs. In total, SMU was 28-37 from the stripe in the game. The win was also head coach Adia Barnes' first win as a Mustang

// A NEW ERA BEGINS

- SMU Women's Basketball enters a new era under Head Coach Adia Barnes.
- Barnes came to the Hilltop after nine seasons as the helm at Arizona, where she built Arizona Women's Basketball into a fixture on the national stage of college basketball while developing her reputation as one of the top coaches in the sport.
- Under Barnes, the program ascended to new heights - reaching the national championship game, signing elite recruiting classes and cementing deep connections with the local community. She led UA to six straight post-season appearances and five straight 20-win seasons, highlighted by an impressive run to the NCAA Championship Game in 2021.
- Barnes was the first coaching hire by new SMU Athletic Director Damon Evans, who called the SMU women's basketball program "a sleeping giant."

// ROSTER OVERHAUL

- SMU hit the portal hard this offseason, adding 12 transfers and bringing in three freshmen.
- Paulina Paris, Sahnya Jah and Mailien Rolf all played at Arizona last season
- Elizaveta Filchagina, Jazzy Gipson, and Roxy White are the three freshmen on this year's roster. Filchagina appeared in both exhibition games.
- The Mustangs were named one of the top-10 portal winners by ESPN for its 2025-26 portal class.

// THE COACHING STAFF

- Head Coach Adia Barnes brought her entire coaching staff over from Arizona with her. The four assistant coaches include Salvo Coppa, Barnes' husband, Bett Shelby, Anthony Turner and Kamiko Williams.
- This exact core of experienced staff has been together for the past two seasons with Williams joining in 2024, Turner in 2023, Shelby in 2022 and Coppa since Barnes took over at Arizona.

// SHOW-STOPPING SKINNER

- A native of Washington D.C., Tyi Skinner transferred to the Hilltop after three years at Arizona State. After missing the 2023-24 season, Skinner bounced back and earned All-Big 12 honorable mention honors last season, averaging 16.8 points per game and shooting 39.8% from the field. During the 2022-23 season, Skinner earned All-Pac-12 honorable mention honors for her play, averaging over 19 points per game.
- Skinner has recorded 33 games scoring 20 or more points in her career.
- "Tyi is a really good shooter," Barnes said. "She's a fun player to watch. She loves to drive and collapse the defense and kick out the shooters. She's a great person, too. I think once the fans get to know her, they fall in love with her. Her personality is amazing and super contagious."

// A TEXAN THROUGH AND THROUGH

- After beginning her career at SFA, the Frisco, Texas native, senior Kyla Deck transferred to SMU after one season at North Texas. Last season, Deck averaged 10.4 points per game and was third in the American with 63 steals with the Mean Green. She led UNT to the second round of the WNIT.
- "She can also play on both ends of the court. She can play denial defense, is athletic and can shoot," Barnes said. Barnes also pointed out that Deck is one of the toughest Mustangs.

// BOW DOWN TO THE KING

- One of the youngsters on a roster that leans heavily towards upperclassmen (10 of 15) is sophomore guard Zahra King, a transfer from Cal. As a freshman on a packed Golden Bears team, she played in 19 games and averaged 2.8 points, 2.4 rebounds and dished 10 assists.
- "Zahra is a lefty, really athletic, and her handles are on a string," Barnes said. "She shoots the ball well. She has these amazing moves, like 'Wow! Where did that come from?' She's also a super high-IQ student, really smart. She's in the Cox Business School, which is really hard to get into. You can be a 4.0 student and not get in. She's the total package."

// A DOUBLE-DOUBLE MACHINE

- After dominating the last three seasons at UT Martin, Anaya Brown transferred to SMU, looking to take the next step in her career. The forward has recorded 16 doubles in her career and 13 20-point games. She has the most career double-doubles on this year's roster.
- Named All-OVC First Team after averaging 15.3 points, 5.7 rebounds, 1.3 steals and 1.5 blocks in 28.3 minutes per game at UT Martin last season.
- She shot 44.2% from the field, 31.8% from beyond the arc and 75.1% from the free throw line...Ranked among OVC leaders in scoring (third), field goal percentage (fifth), and blocks (fourth).
- Scored in double figures 26 times with eight games of 20 points or more including a career high 29 points at Tennessee Tech and recorded six double-doubles on the year.

// JZANIYA UP TOP

- Another guard in the mix is senior Jzaniya Harriel, a transfer from Stanford. She shot almost 40% from the field and 43% from beyond the 3-point line last season. On the floor, she is “really calm, poised, super analytic, understands the game, has a very high basketball IQ and is from a winning program,” Barnes said.

// THERE IS ANOTHER PARIS IN TEXAS

- One of three Arizona players to transfer to SMU, Paulina Paris has been one of the early leaders on the team.
- “Paulina is playing at a really high level,” Barnes said. “She’s doing a good job running our team. I think she’s been one of our most consistent players as far as shooting the ball. She’s improved her mid-range game. She’s improved significantly defensively, like night and day. She knows our system, and I think she’ll have a great year.”

// JAW DROPPING JAH

- Sahnja Jah transferred to SMU from Arizona and has already shown flashes of being an impact player
- “She’s taking care of the basketball right now,” Barnes said. “She’s shooting the three better. She’s just improved so much. She’s playing a lot more in control with purpose, playing inside now, playing multiple positions for us. I think she’s going to have a great year, too.”

// HAIL TO HALL

- Grace Hall, a senior forward who transferred from Penn State, shot nearly 46% from the floor last season. She is another experienced player, who Barnes said has “an extremely high basketball IQ, makes our offense flow and is really good at distributing the ball from the post. She knows the right reads.”

// EXCELLENT EXHIBITIONS

- The Mustangs had two public exhibitions to prepare for the upcoming season.
- SMU defeated West Texas A&M, who defeated Arizona in its next game, 81-69. Four Mustangs were in double figures as Kyla Deck led the way with 17 points shooting 7-of-10 from the floor. Sahnja Jah and Paulina Paris each had 14 points, while Grace Hall led the team in rebounds with eight.
- In the second exhibition against Cal State LA, SMU cruised to an 84-49 victory.
- The Mustangs went on a 23-0 run that started halfway in the second quarter and ended early in the third. The team had multiple 10-0 runs, forced 22 turnovers and had 18 assists on 33 made baskets
- Zahra King led SMU with 15 points on 5-of-8 from the floor and 4-of-5 from the line, while also having three assists.
- SMU scored 30+ points of turnovers in both games.

// THE NON-CONFERENCE SLATE

- SMU’s non-conference slate consists of 12 games, with seven home games to be played inside Moody Coliseum. The schedule is highlighted by matchups with Kansas State on November. 8, Arkansas on December 4 as part of the ACC/SEC Challenge and a trip to Nashville to compete in the Music City Classic the week of Thanksgiving.

// 50 YEARS OF SMU WOMEN'S BASKETBALL

- SMU is excited to celebrate the 50th season of women’s basketball on the Hilltop throughout the upcoming 2025-26 campaign.
- SMU women’s basketball played its first season as a varsity team in 1976-77. Since then, the program has amassed over 700 victories, 23 winning seasons, five conference championships, seven NCAA Tournament appearances, 57 All-Conference selections, five All-Americans and 25 1,000+ point scorers. 50 years of dedication, strength, passion and a continued pursuit of excellence have defined the SMU women’s basketball legacy.

// CEDAR COVER RETREAT

- To prepare for the season, the team used a weekend retreat at Cedar Cove Ranch to grow the team’s chemistry and strengthen their bonds. The three-day retreat featured multiple outdoor activities, including fishing, hiking, a scavenger hunt and sitting by the campfire.

// MUSTANGS ON TV

- Fans will be able to tune into all 30 of SMU’s games this season, with the majority of the games on ESPN’s family of networks. The Mustangs will have six games on prime time TV, with five on ACCN and one on The CW.

- On Dec. 5, 2018, SMU named the Moody Coliseum court after David B. Miller, alumnus and current chair of the Board of Trustees. He was a three-year starter on the basketball team and a member of the 1971-72 Southwest Conference Co-Championship team. Throughout his lifetime, Mr. Miller and his wife, Carolyn Lacy Miller, have committed over \$100 million to SMU, including more than \$50 million to the Cox School of Business, \$20 million toward the expansion and renovation of Moody Coliseum and \$10 million to the ACC Competitiveness Campaign as a member of the First Week Society

Barnes also has international experience as she was an assistant coach on the 2021 gold-winning USA AmeriCup team.

Prior to returning to her alma mater as head coach in April of 2016, Barnes spent four seasons at Washington. After three seasons on staff, Barnes was promoted to recruiting coordinator, where she handled all aspects of recruiting including budget, compliance and planning, in addition to her role in player development.

A three-time all-conference selection and '98 graduate of Arizona, Barnes was voted USBWA first-team All-American and Pac-10 player of the year in 1997-98. Her 2,237 career points currently rank ninth on the Pac-12's all-time scoring list. Following her collegiate career, Barnes played professionally for 12 seasons in the WNBA and overseas. She won a WNBA Championship with the Seattle Storm in 2004, was named to the Storm's All-Decade Team, and also played for Cleveland, Minnesota and Sacramento. Her overseas career included stops in the Ukraine, Israel, Turkey, Russia and Italy.

In addition to her playing and coaching career, Barnes has been extremely active in the community through the Adia Barnes Foundation, which mentors underserved youth and conducts charitable events and community service projects such as school supply drives. Barnes spent 10 years as the Seattle Storm's TV analyst for NBA TV and FOX Sports Northwest and also spent time as the color commentator for Storm radio broadcasts.

A native of San Diego, Calif., Barnes is married to Salvo Coppa, who coached for 14 seasons prior to arriving at Arizona, including 10 professionally in Italy and with three separate national teams. She is also the mother of one son, Matteo and one daughter, Capri.

- SMU, a Carnegie Research One private university in Dallas, is a center for global research and teaching that serves approximately 7,000 undergraduates and 5,000 graduate students through eight degree-granting schools.
- SMU ranks in the top 25% of universities by U.S. News and World Report, with top 50 graduate programs in business (34), law (43) and education (49).
- SMU attracts high-achieving students from all 50 states and over 85 countries, with incoming first-year students averaging a 32 ACT score and a 3.7 GPA. Sixty-eight percent of first-year students receive scholarships or grants, and 73% of undergraduates graduate without debt.
- Within six months of graduation, 90% of graduate students and 84% of undergraduates are employed, enrolled in further education, pursuing military service or volunteering. The median starting salary for undergraduates is \$73,500 and \$88,000 for graduates.
- Ninety-two percent of SMU student-athletes earn degrees, and 76% graduate with a GPA of 3.0 or higher. SMU's Life after Ball program supports their career readiness by providing networking and internship opportunities, as well as basic professional development assistance.
- Known for sophisticated high-performance computing, top-tier analytics and big impacts, SMU research fosters interdisciplinary collaboration across such fields as earth hazards and national security; education and technology; data science and urban studies.
- SMU faculty members are elected to prestigious groups such as the National Academy of Sciences, National Academy of Engineering, National Academy of Education, and Arnold and Mabel Beckman Foundation Scholars. They are also fellows of organizations like the National Endowment for the Humanities, American Academy of Arts and Sciences, and John Simon Guggenheim Memorial Foundation, American Council of Learned Societies, National Humanities Center and Harvard Society of Fellows - Junior Fellows.
- SMU graduate students receive prestigious awards like the National Science Foundation Graduate Research Fellowship, National Science Foundation Doctoral Dissertation Research Improvement Grant, Boren Fellowship, and the Federal Highway Administration Dwight D. Eisenhower Transportation Fellowship. They also earn competitive dissertation and career advancement awards, including the Newcombe Doctoral Dissertation Fellowship, Louisville Institute Dissertation Fellowship, PEO Scholar Award, ACLS Emerging Voices and Leading Edge Fellowships.
- SMU undergraduates are regularly selected for competitive national awards and include 32 Goldwater Scholars, three Marshall Scholars, 15 Truman Scholars and two Schwarzman Scholars. In the last five years, 31 students were awarded Fulbright scholarships.
- Entrepreneurship opportunities across disciplines abound at SMU - through majors and minors ranging from business and engineering to the arts - as well as academic centers offering mentoring, funding, competitions and support to students.
- SMU is home to the George W. Bush Presidential Center, Bush Library and Museum, Bush Foundation, and Bush Institute, attracting over 2.1 million visitors since opening in 2013. SMU is Dallas' university, located in a dynamic city that hosts 21 Fortune 500 companies.
- Dallas was named the No. 1 best sports business city by Sports Business Journal, recognized for the city's thriving professional and collegiate teams, premier annual events, and world-class athletic facilities. In 2026, the Metroplex will also host nine matches during the FIFA World Cup - more than any other U.S. city.
