Saturday's game marks JMU's eighth road game of the season and is the third of four straight road games. After Monday's game, the Dukes will remain in Arkansas to take on the Arkansas State Red Wolves on Saturday, Jan. 3., at 3 p.m. ET (2 p.m. CT)

JMU guard Bradley Douglas finished with a season-high 27 points against his former team - Georgia Southern - on Saturday, Dec. 20. Through 12 games played (12 starts), the graduate student has four 20-point games and is averaging 14.6 points and 4.6 assists per game.

JMU has won two of its last three games against ranked opponents - dating back to a 72-61 win over fifth-seeded Wisconsin in the First Round of the 2024 Division I NCAA Men's Basketball Championship on March 22, 2024 and a road win at No. 4 Michigan State on Nov. 6, 2023.

Two Dukes eclipsed 2,000 career points against Norfolk State, as Bradley Douglas scored six points and Gabe Newhof totaled five to both surpass the career milestone. Douglas has played in 153 games across six seasons, while Newhof has played in 101 games at Spring Arbor and JMU.

James Madison welcomes 13 new players to its roster for the 2025-26 season, bringing in 11 transfer players and two freshmen. Eddie Ricks III and Justin Taylor are the lone returnees for the Dukes.

JMU tallied 25 offensive rebounds in its win against FIU on Nov. 24, tying a school record. The Dukes collected the most rebounds (56) in a game against a Division I opponent since the 2018 season. The Dukes also had 25 offensive rebounds vs. UNCW on March 4, 1989.

80

JMU has scored 80 or more points five times this season, holding a 4-1 record in those contests. Under second-year Head Coach Preston Spradlin, the Dukes are 12-2 when scoring 80 or more points, with both losses coming in overtime.

DUKES CLASH WITH NO. 18 ARKANSAS MONDAY			
<ul style="list-style-type: none">James Madison men's basketball looks for a marquee road win on Monday, Dec. 29, as the Dukes will take on the nationally-ranked Arkansas Razorbacks from the Southeastern Conference at 8 p.m. (ET).JMU enters this game with a 7-6 record after dropping a pair of road games at Old Dominion and Georgia Southern to begin Sun Belt Conference play. The Dukes are in the midst of a four-game road stretch that concludes with a game at A-State on Jan. 3.The Razorbacks, led by Hall of Fame Head Coach John Calipari, sit at 9-3 and are No. 18 in the latest Associated Press Top 25 poll. Arkansas has played a tough non-conference slate, with its three losses coming to No. 9 Michigan State, No. 6 Duke, and No. 8 Houston.			
FULL CIRCLE FOR COACH P AND COACH CAL			
<ul style="list-style-type: none">JMU will wrap up the 2025 calendar year with a matchup at Southeastern Conference opponent Arkansas on Dec. 29.The Razorbacks, led by Hall of Famer John Calipari, reached the Sweet 16 of the 2025 Division I Men's Basketball Championship and were picked to finish fifth in the preseason SEC Coaches' Poll.Spradlin previously served under Calipari at the University of Kentucky from 2009-14. He served as a graduate assistant from 2009-11 and then was Director of Basketball Operations from 2012-14.Spradlin was on the Wildcats' staff in 2012 when they defeated Kansas 67-59 for the National Championship.The two coaches have faced off twice while Spradlin was the head coach at Morehead State - an exhibition in 2017 and a regular-season bout in 2020.			
LAST TIME OUT			
<ul style="list-style-type: none">JMU fell, 96-92, in overtime against Georgia Southern at the Jack and Ruth Ann Hill Convocation Center on Saturday, Dec. 20.Bradley Douglas led JMU (7-6, 0-2 Sun Belt) with a season-high 27 points as five Dukes reached double figures.Despite trailing for most of the game, Georgia Southern (10-5, 2-0) won its seventh straight game on the heels of 25 points from Nakavieon White.Along with Douglas, Eddie Ricks III finished with 16 points and 10 rebounds, tallying his second double-double of the season. Cliff Davis also recorded 16 points, while Gabe Newhof chipped in 13 points and seven rebounds along with a career-high four blocks.Aiding in the scoring effort for the Eagles was Spudd Webb, who finished with 22 points and six rebounds. Tyren Moore (16) and Alden Applewhite (15) also finished in double figures.			
MCBRIDE BREAKING OUT AS A JUNIOR			
<ul style="list-style-type: none">Through the first two months of the season, JMU junior forward Justin McBride leads the Dukes and is third in the Sun Belt with an average of 17.2 points per game.McBride has scored in double figures in 12 of 13 games, including five 20-point outings and a 33-point performance against Norfolk State on Dec. 6.McBride has been wildly efficient, shooting 53.1			
percent from the floor and 47.9 percent from behind the arc (23-48). He is also averaging 5.8 rebounds per game and has recorded seven or more in three straight.			
<ul style="list-style-type: none">McBride was named the Sun Belt Player of the Week on Dec. 2, following a pair of 20-point games against FIU and Omaha. He is the first JMU player since Bryce Lindsay in November 2024 to take home the award.As of Friday, Dec. 26, McBride is third in the Sun Belt in scoring behind Southern Miss' Tylik Weeks (17.8) and Victor Caldes (17.7) of Troy.His 20-point games include 21 against Towson (11/18), 26 against FIU (11/24), and 24 against Omaha (11/25), along with his 33 points against Norfolk State.

- The Dukes are searching for their first true road ranked win since defeating No. 4 Michigan State on Nov. 6, 2023 and first ranked win overall since taking down No. 23 Wisconsin in the First Round of the 2024 NCAA Tournament.

DUKES EARN PAIR OF WINS IN MIAMI

- JMU picked up a pair of wins at the FIU MTE on Nov. 24-25, downing FIU 80-72 and Omaha 88-77.
- The Dukes picked up their first true road win of the season on Nov. 24, downing the FIU Panthers 80-72.
- Justin McBride scored a career-high 26 points, and James Madison men's basketball held FIU to 1-of-14 shooting in the final minutes to pull away for the win the Panthers.
- The Dukes secured 25 offensive rebounds, tying a school record set in 1989. JMU outrebounded FIU 56-41 for the game, its most rebounds since finishing with 65 against Keystone on Dec. 3, 2023.
- Along with McBride's 26 points, Bradley Douglas added 11 points on 9-of-10 free throw shooting. Christian Brown tallied a career-high 11 rebounds and blocked a shot, and Eddie Ricks III pitched in eight points and seven rebounds.
- Against Omaha on Nov. 25, JMU tied a school-record 17 made threes and shot 32-of-58 (.552) from the floor to earn the 88-77 win over the Mavericks.

JMU finished with 28 assists on 32 made field goals while tying a program record 17 three-pointers. The Dukes led 48-32 at halftime and extended the lead over Omaha by as many as 22 points in the second half, and cruised the rest of the way to their third straight win.

LOCKING DOWN THE BANK

- The Atlantic Union Bank Center has been the home of James Madison men's and women's basketball since the 2020-21 season.
- JMU's win over Towson on Tuesday, Nov. 18, was the 60th win for the Dukes inside the AUBC since the building opened. JMU took down Norfolk state on Dec. 6 to improve to 5-0 this season at home.
- JMU is now 62-16 (.794) at home overall and 32-3 (.914) against non-conference foes after the win against Norfolk State.
- The Dukes are 22-5 (.814) against Sun Belt opponents in the same span.
- Last year, JMU's lone loss at home to a non-conference team came to George Mason (66-61) on Nov. 29.
- JMU finished the 2024-25 campaign with a 13-2 record inside the Atlantic Union Bank Center, only losing to George Mason (66-61) on Nov. 29 and App State (58-50) on Jan. 18.
- In 2023-24, JMU finished 14-1 at home, its only loss coming to App State (59-55) on Jan. 13, 2024.

NEWHOF, DOUGLAS ECLIPSE 2K POINTS

- A pair of JMU players recently reached the 2,000-point mark in their respective careers last weekend, as Gabe Newhof and Bradley Douglas each surpassed the milestone against Norfolk State.
- Newhof has played in 101 career games across four seasons at Sprng Arbor (2022-25) and JMU (2025-26). He has a career average of 20 points per game - scoring 1,911 points at Spring Arbor and 105 so far at JMU.
- Douglas, a fifth-year guard from Eustis, Fla., has scored 175 points (14.6 per game) this season after totaling 1,868 across his previous stops. Through 12 games played, Douglas also leads the Dukes in assists with an average of 4.6 per game.

SETTING RECORDS IN FLORIDA

- JMU had a record-setting two-game stretch at the FIU MTE in Miami Nov. 24-25, tying three single-game program records.
- The Dukes had 25 offensive rebounds against FIU on Nov. 24, tying the school record. JMU also had 25 offensive rebounds on March 4, 1989 against UNCW.
- JMU also tied a school-record 17 made threes against Omaha on Tuesday. The Dukes also made 17 threes against Carlow on Nov. 10, 2021, and against Kent State on Nov. 9, 2023. The 17 threes against Omaha was the first time the Dukes have made that many in regulation against a DI team.
- JMU also had 28 assists against the Mavericks on Tuesday, doing so on 32 made field goals. The Dukes also had 28 assists against William & Mary on Feb. 14, 1987, and Mount St. Mary's on Dec. 18, 1991.

BROWN THE SHOT BLOCKER

- JMU freshman Christian Brown has been a force around the rim in the first 13 games of the season for the Dukes.
- Brown has registered 25 blocks, which is second in the Sun Belt behind Marshall's Matt Van Komen (40) as of Dec. 27.
- Against George Mason on Nov. 29, Brown finished with three blocks - his fourth game with three or more blocks this season.
- The 6-foot-8 freshman opened his career with a seven-block performance against Akron on Nov. 3 - tied for the third most for a JMU player in a game in program history.
- The seven blocks against Akron tied the JMU freshman record, sharing the mark with Alvin Brown, who also had seven blocks against Longwood on Feb. 22, 2010.
- Brown also had four blocks against Washington & Lee (11/5) and three against Coppin State (11/9).

BIG SHOT BRAD

- JMU fifth-year guard Bradley Douglas has played in 12 games this year, averaging 14.6 points and 4.6 assists per game for the Dukes.
- Douglas, a preseason First Team All-Sun Belt selection, has fourgames with 20 or more points this season after recording 27 against Georgia Southern on Dec. 20. He also scored 22 against Longwood, Towson, and George Mason.

JMU GAME NOTES

- Douglas had a stretch with five or more assists in six straight games before finishing with just one against the Eagles. Douglas had season-high eight assists against Omaha on Nov. 25.
- Against Towson, Douglas went 6-for-7 from the three-point line, marking the fourth game in his Division I career he has made six or more three-pointers.
- Douglas joined the Dukes after a season at Georgia Southern in 2024-25 - averaging 12.6 points for the Eagles.
- With his four 20-point games, he now has 12 games with 20 or more points as a Division I player (since 2023-24). The eight assists against Omaha are the most for Douglas as a Division I player.

CHAMPIONSHIP DNA

- In his first season as head coach of James Madison men's basketball, Preston Spradlin continued his winning ways as a head coach.
- Spradlin led the Dukes to a 20-12 overall record and a share of the regular-season Sun Belt Conference title with a 13-5 record in league play.
- After starting conference play with a 3-4 record, JMU rattled off 10 straight wins in league play before dropping the regular-season finale at Texas State in double overtime.
- For Spradlin, the regular-season crown marked his third consecutive, going back to his final two seasons at Morehead State and his first at JMU. He also won the Ohio Valley Conference tournament in 2020-21 and 2023-24 during his tenure with the Eagles.
- During his time at Morehead State, Spradlin accumulated a 140-109 (.562) record. In his last four seasons, he guided his teams to a 94-40 overall record and a 58-16 conference mark, along with regular-season and tournament success.
- He led MSU to its second appearance in the Division I Men's Basketball Championship in 2023-24, their second appearance in the NCAA Tournament in the past four seasons under Spradlin's leadership.
- The Eagles finished with 22 or more wins in his final four seasons, a first for the Morehead State program that began in 1929.

13 NEWCOMERS MAKE UP 2025-26 ROSTER

- James Madison' 2025-26 men's basketball roster features 13 new players - 10 transfers and three first-year players.
- Paul Jones III joins JMU following a year at Winthrop, where he was named to the Big South All-Freshman team while averaging 7.6 points per game.
- Bradley Douglas is an experienced guard with stops at Georgia Southern (2024-25) and Little Rock (2023-24), along with three years in the junior college ranks.
- Cliff Davis, a high-volume shooter, played at UTRGV last season and is a career 38.5 percent shooter from behind the arc and also spent two seasons at the JUCO level before spending a season at Northwestern State (2023-24) along with UTRGV.
- Paul Lewis - the brother of former JMU guard Matt Lewis - joins the Dukes after a season at UTSA and two at Vanderbilt.
- Kose Egbule and Gabe Newhof join JMU from

the NAIA ranks, as both were named Third Team All-Americans following the 2024-25 season at Dickinson State (N.D.) and Spring Arbor, respectively.

- Josh Stephen played the first three years of his career at Shenandoah University and will have one year of eligibility remaining.
- Justin McBride (Nevada), Ike Cornish (Nicholls), and Eli Wilborn (Duquesne) round out the portal class for JMU.
- Christian Brown and Preston Fowler join the Dukes as first-year players. Brown and Fowler were highly-touted recruits out of high school.

JAMES MADISON: BASKETBALL SCHOOL

- Both James Madison basketball programs won at least a share of the Sun Belt regular-season championship during the 2024-25 season.
- In the preseason Sun Belt Conference Coaches Polls, both the JMU men and women were picked to finish atop the conference for the second time in the past three seasons. For the women, it is the third straight year they have been picked to finish first in the SBC.
- Under Head Coach Sean O'Regan, the women's basketball team went an undefeated 18-0 in Sun Belt play. Combined with the men's 13-5 record, the two teams finished 33-5 (.868) in the regular season against the league.
- Including postseason games, the two teams finished with a combined record of 50-18 (.735). They are one of eight schools in the country with 50 or more wins in each of the past two seasons, joining Creighton, Drake, Grand Canyon, Gonzaga, Norfolk State, Texas, and UConn.

DUKES PICKED SUN BELT FAVORITES

- JMU was voted as the preseason favorite in the Sun Belt Conference preseason poll on Oct. 20.
- In total, eight different teams received first-place votes in the Sun Belt preseason poll.
- South Alabama led the way with four tallies while Arkansas State (3) and Old Dominion (2) also picked up multiple first-place votes.
- Despite just one first-place vote, JMU tallied 175 total points, 19 more than Arkansas State (154) in second. Other teams to pick up a first-place vote include Troy, Marshall, App State, and Louisiana.

DOUGLAS SELECTED FIRST TEAM ALL-SBC

- JMU guard Bradley Douglas was the Dukes' lone representative on the preseason All-Sun Belt teams, as the transfer from Georgia Southern was voted First Team All-Sun Belt.
- In 2024-25, Douglas appeared in 33 games while starting nine for Georgia Southern, averaging 12.6 points, 3.9 rebounds, and 2.3 assists per game for the Eagles.
- Douglas had a pair of 30-point games - 31 vs. Gardner-Webb on Dec. 17, 2024 and 30 against ULM on Jan. 2.
- Douglas began his career at Santa Fe College in 2020-21 and 2021-22 before transferring to Florida Southwestern State for the 2022-23 season.
- He scored 1,120 points during his junior college career before moving up to the Division I ranks at Little Rock

- Douglas was joined on the First Team by Robert Davis Jr. (Old Dominion), Thomas Dowd (Troy), Tyren Moore (Georgia Southern), and Jalen Speer (Marshall). Davis Jr. was voted the league's preseason Player of the Year.

THE STANDARD IS THE STANDARD.

- James Madison men's basketball notched its third straight 20-win season in 2024-25, finishing 20-12 with a share of the Sun Belt Conference regular-season championship.
- The Dukes 20 wins marks the first time since the 1992-94 seasons with three straight 20-win campaigns.
- In the past three seasons since joining the Sun Belt, the Dukes are 76-30 (.720) overall, the most wins and best winning percentage among their league peers.
- The regular-season championship was the program's first since 2021 since the Dukes were competing in the Colonial Athletic Association (CAA).
- It is JMU's 11th regular-season title in program history and first as a member of the Sun Belt. Since joining the league, the Dukes are 40-14 (.740) in conference games.

COACH P CONTINUES WINNING WAYS

- In 2024-25, Preston Spradlin became just the second first-year coach in program history to win at least 20 games, joining Matt Brady, who won 21 games in the 2008-09 season.
- As a head coach, Spradlin has won 20 or more games in each of the last five seasons, dating back to his time at Morehead State.
- Since the 2020-21 season, Spradlin is 114-51 (.690) overall with three regular-season conference championships (2 OVC, 1 Sun Belt) and two conference tournament titles (2020-21, 2023-24).
- With the Dukes clinching at least a share of the Sun Belt regular-season title last season, Spradlin has now won three straight regular-season crowns dating back to his time at Morehead State.
- Along with the regular-season title, he took the Eagles to the NCAA tournament twice; winning the OVC Tournament in 2020-21 and 2023-24.

A LITTLE BIT OF EVERYTHING

- James Madison added players from Division III, Junior College, Club basketball, and the NAIA levels to fill out its 2025-26 roster.
- Josh Stephen spent the first three seasons of his career at nearby Division III Shenandoah, playing in 72 career games and averaging 9.9 points per contest for the Hornets.
- Bradley Douglas and Cliff Davis began their careers at the junior college level. Douglas spent two seasons at Santa Fe College and one at Florida Southwestern State, while Davis played two seasons at Chipola College in Florida.
- Kose Egbule and Gabe Newhof were both named NAIA Third Team All-Americans following the 2024-25 season. Egbule starred at Dickinson State in North Dakota while Newhof played three years at Spring Arbor University in Michigan.

LEWIS CONTINUING FAMILY LEGACY

- JMU signed transfer guard Paul Lewis on May 9, 2025. Lewis is the younger brother of former JMU guard Matt Lewis, the 2020-21 CAA Player of the Year.
- Paul spent two seasons at Vanderbilt (2022-24) and a year at UTSA (2024-25) before joining JMU for this season with two years of eligibility.
- "We are thrilled to welcome Paul and his family back to JMU," Head Coach Preston Spradlin said following his signing. "The history between JMU and the Lewis family has been full of success, and we are excited for the pride that Paul brings to JMU! He brings valuable experience from the SEC, along with his ability as a scoring and playmaking guard."
- Matt Lewis finished his JMU career third on the career leaderboard in points (1,928) and eighth in assists (341). He was the First JMU player to ever be named All-CAA in three different seasons.

JMU ROSTER BREAKDOWN

- James Madison's roster features 15 players from eight different states.
- The most common state is Virginia, which features five: Paul Jones III, Chance Lundy, Justin Taylor, Paul Lewis, and Josh Stephen.
- Christian Brown and Eddie Ricks III hail from Tennessee while Preston Fowler and Eli Wilborn are from Connecticut.
- Other states represented are Florida (Bradley Douglas), Georgia (Cliff Davis), Maryland (Ike Cornish), and Gabe Newhof (Michigan).
- Per class, the roster features two freshmen, one sophomore, four juniors or redshirt juniors, and eight seniors, redshirt seniors, or graduates.

2025-26 SCHEDULE NOTES

- JMU's 2025-26 schedule includes 30 regular-season games: 12 non-conference and 18 conference matchups.
- The Dukes will play four teams that were picked as their respective conference favorites in the preseason: Akron (MAC), LIU (NEC), Towson (CAA), and Norfolk State (MEAC).
- Three of those four games will be road games for JMU, with the lone home matchup coming against Towson on Nov. 18.
- Six of the nine scheduled games for JMU in the month of November will come away from the Atlantic Union Bank Center: five road games, three home, and one neutral.
- Overall, JMU will play just five home games in the calendar year 2025 as opposed to nine road contests. The Dukes will go a little over a month without a home game (Norfolk State, Dec. 6 to Marshall, Jan. 7).
- The longest home stand of the season will be a four-game stretch from Feb. 4-14 against Louisiana (Feb. 4), a MAC opponent to be determined (Feb. 7), Georgia State (Feb. 12), and App State (Feb. 14).
- The Dukes will play six of their final eight games inside the Atlantic Union Bank Center, as the regular season closes with a Friday, Feb. 27 tilt against Coastal Carolina.

SUN BELT COMMISSIONER KEITH GILL BEGINS TERM AS NCAA MEN'S BASKETBALL SELECTION COMMITTEE CHAIR

- Sun Belt Conference Commissioner Keith Gill's term as Chair of the NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Committee for the 2025-26 season is underway following the group's annual summer meeting in Savannah, Ga.
- Gill's term at the helm will mark the fifth and final year of his five-year tenure on the Committee which began during the 2021-22 season. He served as Vice Chair of the Committee during the 2024-25 campaign.

HEAD COACH PRESTON SPRADLIN

JAMES MADISON (2024-PRESENT)

- Hired as the head coach at James Madison on March 29, 2024, signing a six-year contract
- Defeated Ohio 88-78 in his first game as JMU's head coach on Nov. 4, 2024 in the MAC-SBC Challenge
- Led Dukes to a 10-game conference winning streak for just the third time in program history and second season in a row
- Picked up the 20th win of the season at ULM on Feb. 25, the third-straight 20-win season for the program and his fifth straight overall
- Secured a share of the Sun Belt regular-season championship with a win at ULM on Feb. 25

MOREHEAD STATE (2014-24)

- Spent two years as an assistant (2014-16) at Morehead State before taking over as head coach in 2016
- Compiled a record of 140-109 (.562) during his time with the Eagles, including two Ohio Valley Conference Championships and appearance in the NCAA tournament (2021, 2024) and a berth in the National Invitational Tournament (NIT) in 2023.
- MSU's only four losses in non-conference play in 2023-24 came to Power Five opponents Purdue, Alabama, Penn State and Indiana as his non-conference strength of schedule ranked 54th nationally. Spradlin's squad posted by far the best NET rating in the OVC at 106 with the next best mark at 182.
- In past five seasons, compiled a record of 94-40 overall and 58-16 in league games in the Ohio Valley Conference.

- The Eagles finished top three in the league in each of the last four seasons, including regular season champions in 2022-23 and 2023-24. They earned a No. 14 seed in the NCAA Championship in both 2021 and 2024, falling to No. 3 seeds West Virginia and Illinois, respectively.
