CONFERENCE NOTES

Weekly Honors

• **SEC CO-PLAYERS OF THE WEEK** presented by Allstate:
Rori Harmon led Texas to wins over No. 3 UCLA and No. 2 South Carolina and was named the MVP of the Players Era Championship this week. Texas is the first team in at least 25 years to have wins over two top-three teams on back-to-back days. Against UCLA Harmon shot 9-of-15 from the field and scored 26 points. In the win over South Carolina Harmon recorded nine assists and broke the Texas career assist record that was set by Kamie Ethridge 40 years go. Harmon hit the game-winning jumper with 0.7 seconds remaining to lift Texas to the 66-64 win over No. 2 South Carolina. With her seven steals this week Harmon moved into the top-five at Texas in career steals and currently is fifth in program history with 301.

Mikayla Blakes won Island Division MVP honors at the 2025 U.S. Virgin Islands Paradise Jam, averaging 31.0 points, 5.0 assists, 4.0 rebounds and 3.0 steals per game. She scored a season-high 35 points and dished out four assists in the win against Oregon State in Game 1 at the Paradise Jam. She shot 54.5 percent from the field, going 12-of-22 from the floor, and made a season-high nine free throws in the win over the Beavers. She extended her double-digit scoring streak to 27 games dating back to last season, with a 27-point performance in an 84-71 come-from-behind win over BYU. The Doreas erased their largest deficit under head coach Shea Ralph, as Vanderbilt trailed the Cougars by 16 in the early stages of the second quarter collecting the 13-point victory over BYU to win the Island Division on the Paradise Jam. The guard also dished out a game-high six assists in the win over the Cougars.

• **SEC FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK** presented by Allstate:
Aaliyah Chavez helped lead the Sooners to the GEICO Coconut Hoops Classic title, averaging 21.5 points and 4.5 assists while knocking down nine 3-pointers (45%) across two wins. She opened the event with 14 points and three assists in a 54-point semifinal victory over Coppin State. Chavez then delivered a breakout performance in the championship game vs. Florida State, pouring in 29 points with seven made threes (7 of 14) and a team-high six assists as OU rolled to an 18-point win. Her stat line against the Seminoles made her the first freshman nationally since Caitlin Clark in 2021 to post 29 points, seven 3-pointers and six assists in a single game. The 29 points rank as the ninth most by a Sooner freshman in program history, and her seven threes

match the third-most in a game by an OU first-year player.

Around the League

• This year's ACC/SEC Challenge will see multiple ranked teams in action. Highlights include No. 3 South Carolina at No. 22 Louisville, No. 11 North Carolina at No. 2 Texas and No. 18 Notre Dame at No. 13 Ole Miss.

• The challenge is in its third year, the conferences tied 7-7 in year one and last year the SEC took the challenge, 10-6.

• In the first published NET rankings, the SEC has 12 teams in the top-50 with all 16 in the top-83. Four teams are ranked in the top-10 with LSU at No. 1, Texas at No. 3, South Carolina at No. 6 and No. 9 Kentucky.

SEC vs Everyone Else

• The SEC has compiled a 116-12 (.906) non-conference record during the 2025-26 season.

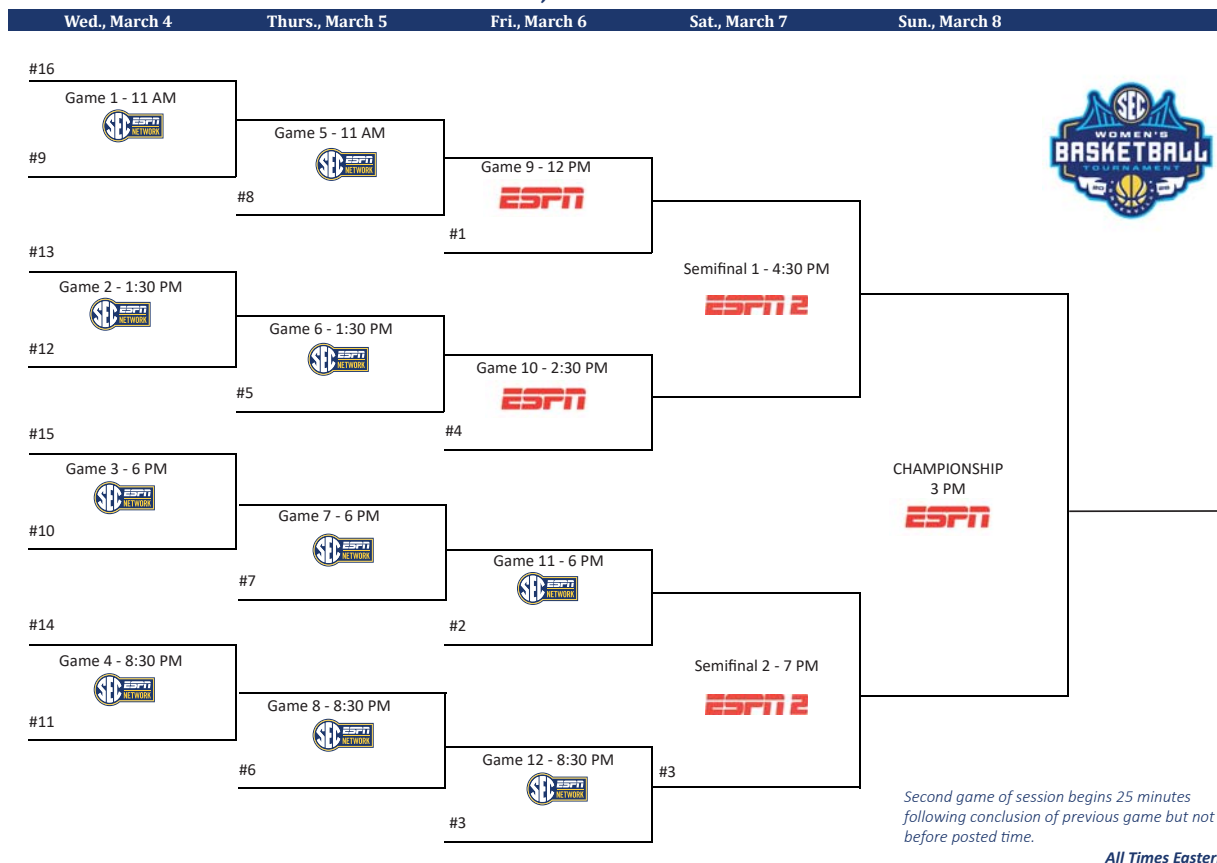
• Last season, SEC teams went 159-52 (.782) against all other conferences.

• Against the other A4 conferences, the SEC went 23-13 (.639) versus the ACC, 9-6 (.600) against the Big 12 and 14-12 (.560) against the Big Ten.

• In regular season games, the SEC has compiled a 6292-1802 (.777) record against other conferences. In the post-season, SEC teams are 579-303 (.656) against non-conference teams. Overall, teams are 6871-2104 (.766).

• The league has recorded 150+ wins in 30 seasons and has recorded a non-conference winning percentage below .700 only once.

2026 SEC Women's Basketball Tournament March 4-8 • Greenville, S.C. • Bon Secours Wellness Arena



SEC Tournament

Beginning with its inception and through 1986, the tournament was held at campus sites. The tournament was then sent to Albany, Ga., which served as the site for six years from 1987-92. The tournament then moved to Chattanooga, Tenn., where it was held from 1993-2000, with the exception of 1998 when the tournament moved to Columbus, Ga.

Since 2001 the tournament has enjoyed many new sites, including Memphis (2001), Nashville (2002, 2004, 2008, 2011, 2012, 2018, 2022), Little Rock, Ark. (2003, 2006, 2009, 2015), Greenville, S.C. (2005, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021, 2023, 2024, 2025, 2026), Duluth, Ga. (2007, 2010, 2013, 2014) and Jacksonville, Fla. (2016).

The conference announced a three-year extension with Greenville, S.C. to host the SEC Women's Basketball Tournament in through 2028.

The winner of the tournament receives the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament.

The event has helped set the stage for SEC teams in the NCAA Tournament, as 32 of the conference tournament champions have advanced to at least the Sweet 16. The SEC Tournament Champion has failed to win at least one NCAA Tournament game only twice.

Tennessee leads the league with 17 SEC Tournament titles. South Carolina is second with nine, Vanderbilt has six, while Auburn, Georgia, each have four. LSU has two with Kentucky, Mississippi State and Texas A&M having each won one SEC Tournament championship.

Tie-Break Procedures

Teams will be seeded No. 1 through No. 16 in the SEC Women's Basketball Tournament bracket based upon the final regular season Conference standings.

Teams that finished No. 1 through No. 4 in the final regular season standings shall receive first and second-round byes and teams that finish No. 5 through No. 8 will receive first-round byes.

For the purpose of seeding, if an institution is precluded from participating in the tournament, such institution will automatically be seeded last. The No. 9 seed will then receive a bye. However, for the purpose of breaking ties, that team will remain where it finished in the regular-season standings BEFORE being seeded last.

1. Two-Team Tie: The following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken:

- A. Won-lost results of head-to-head competition between the two teams.
- B. Won-lost percentage of the two teams versus the highest seed (and proceeding through the lowest seed, if necessary).
- C. Won-lost results in road Conference games.
- D. Head-to-head point differential (points scored minus points allowed) between the two tied teams.
- E. Winning percentage against all Quad 1 Division I opponents.
- F. Winning percentage against all Quad 2 Division I opponents.
- G. NCAA NET ranking (most recent available NET ranking before the conference tournament).

2. Three-Team Tie (or more): When three or more teams are tied, the following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken. If two teams remain tied after a tiebreaker provision, the two-team tiebreaker formula will be used:

- A. Best winning percentage of games played among the tied teams (Example: Team A is 3-1, Team B is 2-2 and Team C is 1-3 – Team A would be seeded highest, Team B second-highest and Team C lowest of the three).
- B. Best winning percentage of the tied teams versus the highest seed (and proceeding through the lowest seed, if necessary).
- C. Won-lost results in road Conference games.
- D. Head-to-head point differential (points scored minus points allowed) between the two tied teams.
- E. Winning percentage against all Quad 1 Division I opponents.
- F. Winning percentage against all Quad 2 Division I opponents.
- G. NCAA NET ranking (most recent available NET ranking before the conference tournament).

SEC SUCCESS

The Nation's Best Coaches

- Seven current SEC coaches have both played and coached in the NCAA Tournament (Katie Abrahamson-Henderson, Jennie Baranczyk, Kellie Harper, Kim Mulkey, Dawn Staley, Joni Taylor and Shea Ralph).
- In addition, Abrahamson-Henderson and Harper have both taken four different teams to the tournament, while Kristy Curry has taken three different teams to the tournament.
- Jenni Baranczyk, Kenny Brooks, Yolett McPhee-McCuin, Kim Mulkey, Vic Schaefer, Dawn Staley and Joni Taylor have made the tournament with two different teams.

The Nation's Best Players

- The SEC has had at least one student-athlete named as a First-Team All-America selection in each of the last 17 seasons.
- All-Americans were first named in women's basketball in 1975. Since that time, league schools have had 83 players named first team a total of 182 times.
- The league has had eight Honda Sports Awards winners in Katrina McClain, Georgia (1987); Bridgette Gordon, Tennessee (1989); Chamique Holdsclaw, Tennessee (1997 and 1998); Candace Parker, Tennessee (2007 and 2008); A'ja Wilson, South Carolina (2018) and Aliyah Boston, South Carolina (2022).
- Nine Naismith Player of the Year winners have come from the SEC. They include Saudia Roundtree, Georgia (1996), Chamique Holdsclaw, Tennessee (1998 and 1999), Tamika Catchings, Tennessee (2000), Seimone Augustus, LSU (2005 and 2006), Candace Parker, Tennessee (2008); A'ja Wilson, South Carolina (2018) and Aliyah Boston, South Carolina (2022).
- The SEC has had 178 former players play in the WNBA.
- Since the inaugural WNBA draft in 1997, the SEC has had 204 former players drafted for the professional league, including eight No. 1 picks.
- The league has had a first round pick every year except one (2014).

Women's Basketball Leadership Council

- The council consists of one women's basketball student-athlete from each of the SEC's 16 institutions. The goal of the leadership council is for student-athletes to serve as a conduit of communication from their teams to the conference office on issues related to student-athlete experience, student-athlete wellness, and to provide feedback on proposed rules governing the SEC and NCAA.

Academics

- A total of 149 women's basketball students were named to the 2024-25 SEC Academic Honor Rolls for having a grade point average of 3.00 or above for either the preceding academic year or a cumulative grade point average of 3.00 or above.
- The conference has had 38 women's basketball players named Academic All-American.
- Four Women's Basketball Academic All-America of the Year hail from the SEC. They are Candace Parker, UT (2007 & 2008); Aliyah Boston, SC (2021 & 2022).

By The Number

- Since the SEC began to sponsor women's basketball in 1982, it has failed only six times to place at least five members in each of the final polls (the USA Today/ESPN poll began in 1986).
- In 2025, the most SEC teams in the final AP poll was eight, a record for the conference. Up until last season, seven was the most, which the league has done five times (1995, 1996, 1997, 2003, and 2018).
- Overall, the league teams have been ranked every week except for the very first poll in 1976.
- The league has had the top three teams in the AP Poll twice. In week three in 2005 and in week eight in 1989.
- SEC schools have produced 48 Team USA Olympians since 1976, with 44 coming since the SEC began sponsoring women's basketball. In addition, 11 have played for other countries in the Olympics.
