Weekly Honors

• SEC CO-PLAYERS OF THE WEEK presented by Allstate:

Raegan Beers starred last week as the Sooners won twice, earned a ranked win and extended their winning streak to 10 games. She averaged 24.0 points on 67% shooting, 13.5 rebounds, 3.0 assists, 2.0 steals and 1.0 block per game. Beers opened the week with a dominant 26-point, 15-rebound double-double in 23 minutes against Little Rock in a 55-point OU win, adding a career-high five assists. Against No. 23 Oklahoma State in an in-state rivalry matchup, she finished with 22 points on 10 of 14 shooting while adding 12 rebounds, two blocks and two steals in a 22-point Sooner victory. Beers now leads the nation with nine double-doubles, including a nation-high seven with at least 20 points. She has recorded eight double-doubles in her last nine games.

Madison Booker led Texas to a mark of 2-0 on the week and the Longhorns improved to 12-0 on the season. The win over Baylor was the fifth ranked win of the season for Texas. Against UTRGV Booker secured her first triple-double and became the fifth player in Texas women's basketball history with a triple-double when she scored 28 points and added 10 rebounds and 10 assists. With her two games of 20+ points, Booker now has scored 20 or more points 31 times in her career. Booker shot 26-of-36 (72.2 percent) from the field over her two games for the week and averaged 9.0 rebounds per game.

• SEC CO-FRESHMEN OF THE WEEK presented by Allstate:

Aaliyah Chavez led the Sooners to a pair of wins last week, including a victory over in-state rival Oklahoma State. The guard averaged 17.5 points, 5.0 rebounds, 3.5 assists and 3.0 steals per game. Against Little Rock to open the week, Chavez shot 82% from the floor while scoring 20 points to go along with three steals, three rebounds, one block and one assist. On Saturday against No. 23 Oklahoma State, Chavez totaled 15 points and posted career highs in rebounds (7) and assists (6) while matching a career best with three steals.

Mia Pauldo recorded a career high in points for the second straight game and tacked on career bests of 10 assists and four steals, helping the Lady Vols defeated Winthrop, 112-40. Pauldo tallied 18 vs. the Eagles and carded her first collegiate double-double. She did so after running her tally of dimes over the past two contests to 11 with zero turnovers. She also matched her season best by knocking down a team-leading four three-pointers, as the Big Orange combined for 16 treys and tied for the second highest single-game total

in school history. Pauldo was ready from the opening tip vs. Winthrop, making three of five field goal attempts in the opening quarter, including two of four from beyond the arc, and all four free throws to score 12 points.

Around the League

- The SEC has a nation-leading 36 non-conference wins over A4 opponents.
- The SEC has a nation-leading nine non-conference wins over opponents ranked in the AP Top 25 at the time of game.
- The SEC and Big Ten are tied for the national lead with seven wins over opponents currently ranked in the AP Top 25.

SEC vs Everyone Else

- The SEC has compiled a 159-19 (.893) non-conference record during the 2025-26 season.

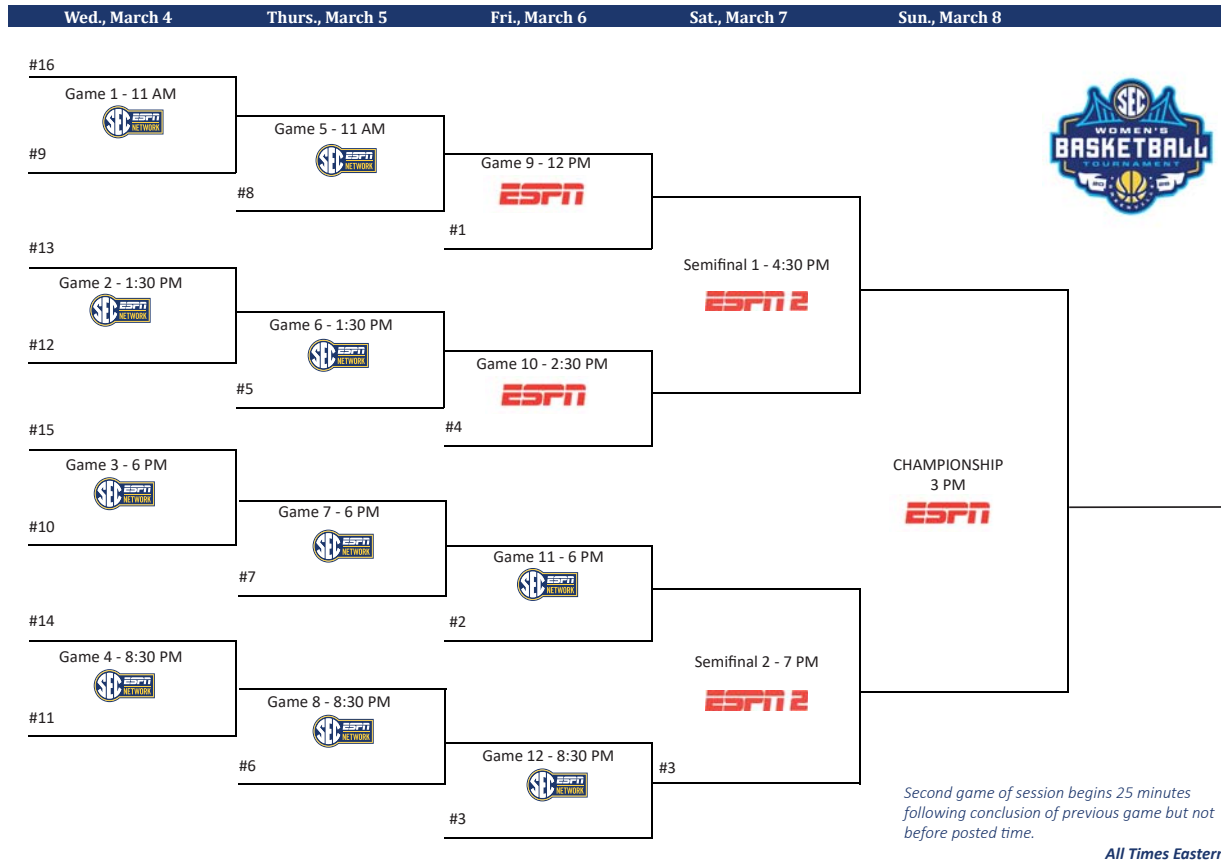
- Against the other A4 conferences, the SEC is 22-4 (.846) versus the ACC, 6-5 (.545) against the Big 12 and 8-5 (.615) against the Big Ten.

- In regular season games, the SEC has compiled a 6335-1809 (.778) record against other conferences. In the post-season, SEC teams are 579-303 (.656) against non-conference teams. Overall, teams are 6914-2111 (.766).

- The league has recorded 150+ wins in 30 seasons and has recorded a non-conference winning percentage below .700 only once.

2026 SEC TOURNAMENT

SEC Tournament

Beginning with its inception and through 1986, the tournament was held at campus sites. The tournament was then sent to Albany, Ga., which served as the site for six years from 1987-92. The tournament then moved to Chattanooga, Tenn., where it was held from 1993-2000, with the exception of 1998 when the tournament moved to Columbus, Ga.

Since 2001 the tournament has enjoyed many new sites, including Memphis (2001), Nashville (2002, 2004, 2008, 2011, 2012, 2018, 2022), Little Rock, Ark. (2003, 2006, 2009, 2015), Greenville, S.C. (2005, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021, 2023, 2024, 2025, 2026), Duluth, Ga. (2007, 2010, 2013, 2014) and Jacksonville, Fla. (2016).

The conference announced a three-year extension with Greenville, S.C. to host the SEC Women's Basketball Tournament in through 2028.

The winner of the tournament receives the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament.

The event has helped set the stage for SEC teams in the NCAA Tournament, as 32 of the conference tournament champions have advanced to at least the Sweet 16. The SEC Tournament Champion has failed to win at least one NCAA Tournament game only twice.

Tennessee leads the league with 17 SEC Tournament titles. South Carolina is second with nine, Vanderbilt has six, while Auburn, Georgia, each have four. LSU has two with Kentucky, Mississippi State and Texas A&M having each won one SEC Tournament championship.

Tie-Break Procedures

Teams will be seeded No. 1 through No. 16 in the SEC Women's Basketball Tournament bracket based upon the final regular season Conference standings.

Teams that finished No. 1 through No. 4 in the final regular season standings shall receive first and second-round byes and teams that finish No. 5 through No. 8 will receive first-round byes.

For the purpose of seeding, if an institution is precluded from participating in the tournament, such institution will automatically be seeded last. The No. 9 seed will then receive a bye. However, for the purpose of breaking ties, that team will remain where it finished in the regular-season standings BEFORE being seeded last.

1. Two-Team Tie: The following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken:

- A. Won-lost results of head-to-head competition between the two teams.
- B. Won-lost percentage of the two teams versus the highest seed (and proceeding through the lowest seed, if necessary).
- C. Won-lost results in road Conference games.
- D. Head-to-head point differential (points scored minus points allowed) between the two tied teams.
- E. Winning percentage against all Quad 1 Division I opponents.
- F. Winning percentage against all Quad 2 Division I opponents.
- G. NCAA NET ranking (most recent available NET ranking before the conference tournament).

2. Three-Team Tie (or more): When three or more teams are tied, the following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken. If two teams remain tied after a tiebreaker provision, the two-team tiebreaker formula will be used:

- A. Best winning percentage of games played among the tied teams (Example: Team A is 3-1, Team B is 2-2 and Team C is 1-3 – Team A would be seeded highest, Team B second-highest and Team C lowest of the three).
- B. Best winning percentage of the tied teams versus the highest seed (and proceeding through the lowest seed, if necessary).
- C. Won-lost results in road Conference games.
- D. Head-to-head point differential (points scored minus points allowed) between the two tied teams.
- E. Winning percentage against all Quad 1 Division I opponents.
- F. Winning percentage against all Quad 2 Division I opponents.
- G. NCAA NET ranking (most recent available NET ranking before the conference tournament).

SEC SUCCESS

The Nation's Best Coaches

- Seven current SEC coaches have both played and coached in the NCAA Tournament (Katie Abrahamson-Henderson, Jennie Baranczyk, Kellie Harper, Kim Mulkey, Dawn Staley, Joni Taylor and Shea Ralph).
- In addition, Abrahamson-Henderson and Harper have both taken four different teams to the tournament, while Kristy Curry has taken three different teams to the tournament.
- Jenni Baranczyk, Kenny Brooks, Yolett McPhee-McCuin, Kim Mulkey, Vic Schaefer, Dawn Staley and Joni Taylor have made the tournament with two different teams.

The Nation's Best Players

- The SEC has had at least one student-athlete named as a First-Team All-America selection in each of the last 17 seasons.
- All-Americans were first named in women's basketball in 1975. Since that time, league schools have had 83 players named first team a total of 182 times.
- The league has had eight Honda Sports Awards winners in Katrina McClain, Georgia (1987); Bridgette Gordon, Tennessee (1989); Chamique Holdsclaw, Tennessee (1997 and 1998); Candace Parker, Tennessee (2007 and 2008); A'ja Wilson, South Carolina (2018) and Aliyah Boston, South Carolina (2022).
- Nine Naismith Player of the Year winners have come from the SEC. They include Saudia Roundtree, Georgia (1996), Chamique Holdsclaw, Tennessee (1998 and 1999), Tamika Catchings, Tennessee (2000), Seimone Augustus, LSU (2005 and 2006), Candace Parker, Tennessee (2008); A'ja Wilson, South Carolina (2018) and Aliyah Boston, South Carolina (2022).
- The SEC has had 178 former players play in the WNBA.
- Since the inaugural WNBA draft in 1997, the SEC has had 204 former players drafted for the professional league, including eight No. 1 picks.
- The league has had a first round pick every year except one (2014).

Women's Basketball Leadership Council

- The council consists of one women's basketball student-athlete from each of the SEC's 16 institutions. The goal of the leadership council is for student-athletes to serve as a conduit of communication from their teams to the conference office on issues related to student-athlete experience, student-athlete wellness, and to provide feedback on proposed rules governing the SEC and NCAA.

Academics

- A total of 149 women's basketball students were named to the 2024-25 SEC Academic Honor Rolls for having a grade point average of 3.00 or above for either the preceding academic year or a cumulative grade point average of 3.00 or above.
- The conference has had 38 women's basketball players named Academic All-American.
- Four Women's Basketball Academic All-America of the Year hail from the SEC. They are Candace Parker, UT (2007 & 2008); Aliyah Boston, SC (2021 & 2022).

By The Number

- Since the SEC began to sponsor women's basketball in 1982, it has failed only six times to place at least five members in each of the final polls (the USA Today/ESPN poll began in 1986).
- In 2025, the most SEC teams in the final AP poll was eight, a record for the conference. Up until last season, seven was the most, which the league has done five times (1995, 1996, 1997, 2003, and 2018).
- Overall, the league teams have been ranked every week except for the very first poll in 1976.
- The league has had the top three teams in the AP Poll twice. In week three in 2005 and in week eight in 1989.
- SEC schools have produced 48 Team USA Olympians since 1976, with 44 coming since the SEC began sponsoring women's basketball. In addition, 11 have played for other countries in the Olympics.
