OPENING TIP

► Oklahoma (11-9, 1-6 SEC) starts a two-game homestand when it hosts No. 15/16 Arkansas (15-5, 5-2) on Tuesday at 6 p.m. CT at Lloyd Noble Center in Norman.

► Tuesday's game will be televised by ESPN with **Tom Hart** (play-by-play) and **Dane Bradshaw** (analyst) announcing. It will air on the Sooner Sports Radio Network (KRXX 107.7 FM in Oklahoma City; KTBZ 1430 AM in Tulsa; Varsity Radio App) with **Toby Rowland** and **Kevin Henry** on the call.

► OU is 8-2 at home this season, with six of its top seven scorers shooting over 50% from the field in those games (the other is shooting 45%). It is outshooting opponents 50%-42% from the field and 38%-33% from 3-point range in the 10 contests. Arkansas is 1-3 in true road games.

► Junior guard **Xzayvier Brown** has scored at least 18 points in nine of the last 11 games, including five times in seven SEC outings (23 vs. Ole Miss, 24 vs. Florida, 21 vs. Alabama, 22 at South Carolina and 19 at Missouri). Since Dec. 13, Brown ranks sixth in the SEC with his 19.2 points per game and seventh with his .504 field goal percentage.

► **Nijel Pack**, a first-year Sooner who is in his sixth year overall (only played nine games last season at Miami), is one of just three active players with 2,000 career points (2,058; Gonzaga's Graham Ike has 2,284 and Indiana's Tucker DeVries has 2,278 through Sunday. Pack is coming off a 25-point, five-assist game at Missouri on Saturday. He ranks fourth in the SEC with his 3.1 treys per game and .422 3FG%.

► OU's 83.7 scoring average is its highest through a season's first 20 games since 2017-18 and fifth highest in the last 32 years. Similarly, OU's 9.7 3-pointers per game are its third most through 20 contests in the 40-year 3-point era.

► Oklahoma has committed single-digit turnovers 10 times, already its most such outings for an entire season in six years (11 times in 2019-20). It averages just 10.1 turnovers per contest.

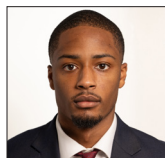

SATURDAY'S OU-MISSOURI RECAP

► On the verge of a big road win, Oklahoma fell victim to a pair of buzzer-beating 3-pointers — the first at the end of regulation and the second in overtime — in an 88-87 loss to Missouri on Saturday afternoon.

► After **Tae Davis** hit two free throws to give OU an 81-78 lead with 5.6 seconds left in the second half, Missouri's Trent Pierce hit a 37-footer with no time left to force overtime. It was Pierce's only field goal of the day.

► In overtime, the Sooners took an 87-85 advantage on an **Xzayvier Brown** shot in the lane with 4 seconds remaining, but MU forward Mark Mitchell dribbled up the floor and made a 3-pointer at the horn for the one-point win. OU didn't trail in OT until Mitchell's 3.

► Oklahoma outshot Missouri 48%-45% from the field and 44%-29% from 3-point range (12 makes to six) but was outrebounded 41-29 and outscored 19-3 in second-chance points. The Tigers grabbed 17 offensive boards to OU's five and attempted 11 more shots.

► Guards **Nijel Pack** (25) and Brown (19) accounted for more than half of the team's points and 11 of its 12 assists. Pack broke out of a mini offensive slump by going 8 for 13 from the field, 5 for 8 from 3-point range and 4 for 4 from the free throw line. Brown was 5 for 11 from the floor, hit a pair of triples, was 7 for 9 from the foul line and handed out a game-high six assists.

► The Sooners also got double-digit points from forward **Derrion Reid** (12) and guard **Jadon Jones** (10). Center **Kirill Elatontsev** played a season-high 26 minutes off the bench and contributed nine points and a team-high-tying five rebounds. Davis also scored nine points.

SCENE SETTERS

► Even though this is just Oklahoma's second year in the SEC, OU and Arkansas have played each of the last four years, with the Sooners winning three of those contests under head coach **Porter Moser**. The first three of those four games were played in Tulsa in the Crimson and Cardinal Classic (OU won 88-66 in 2021-22 and 79-70 in 2023-24; Arkansas won 88-78 in 2022-23). The Sooners were also 65-62 victors last year in Fayetteville. Moser is 3-1 all-time against Arkansas as a head coach.

► OU is the only SEC team and one of just seven out of 361 nationally to start the same lineup every game this season. Its starters have been guards **Xzayvier Brown** and **Nijel Pack**, forwards **Tae Davis** and **Derrion Reid** and center **Mohamed Wague**. Arkansas has started five different lineups.

► Pack scored a game-high 22 points for Miami (Fla.) against Arkansas on Dec. 3 last season in Coral Gables. The Razorbacks won 76-73 in the SEC/ACC Challenge game, but Pack was 9 for 16 from the field, 3 for 7 from deep and logged six rebounds and a game-high-tying six assists.

► Arkansas is in its second year under head coach **John Calipari**, who spent the previous 15 seasons at Kentucky and led the Wildcats to three Final Fours (2011, '12 and '15) and the 2012 national title. The Razorbacks went 22-14 last season and advanced to the NCAA Tournament's Sweet 16 as a No. 10 seed (beat Kansas and St. John's; lost to Texas Tech).

► Tuesday will mark Calipari's second game as a head coach in Norman. As a 34-year-old in 1993-94, he directed No. 18 UMass to an 84-83 season-opening win over **Billy Tubbs'** Sooners behind 28 points from **Donta Bright** (13 for 15 on field goals) and 27 from **Lou Roe**. **Ken Conley** paced OU with 21 points and 10 boards. OU led 52-39 at halftime.

► Moser and Calipari are two of the six SEC head coaches who have coached in at least one Final Four. The others are Tennessee's Rick Barnes, Ole Miss' Chris Beard, Florida's Todd Golden and Alabama's Nate Oats.

SERIES HISTORY

► Although it trails Arkansas 17-15 in the overall series, Oklahoma has won 10 of the last 15 meetings. The Sooners hold a 9-3 advantage in games played in Norman and have won the last five matchups there (by an average of 17.0 points) and nine of the last 10. Arkansas' last victory in Norman came in the 1977-78 season (64-53). Its other two wins there came in the series' first two games on back-to-back days in December 1938 (39-31 and 36-30).

► Fourteen of Oklahoma's 15 wins over Arkansas have been by at least nine points, 12 have been by double digits, seven have been by at least 15 points and three have been by at least 20 points. OU's average victory margin is 14.3 points. Arkansas' average victory margin in the series is 7.5 points (only four wins have been by double digits and only one by more than 11 points).

► At 32 games, Arkansas is Oklahoma's most common opponent among current SEC programs the Sooners never shared a conference with before joining the SEC (Alabama is next at 12 meetings). OU has faced former conference mates Missouri 215 times, Texas 107 times and Texas A&M 45 times.

LAST YEAR VS. THE RAZORBACKS

► In a back-and-forth game on Jan. 25 last year in Fayetteville, Oklahoma built a 33-20 first-half lead, fell behind 50-44 midway through the second half and used a 21-12 run over the final 9:33 to win 65-62 over Arkansas. It broke OU's three-game losing streak at Bud Walton Arena and was its first victory there since the 2001-02 Final Four squad won 69-54.

► Freshman guard **Jeremiah Fears** finished with an OU-high 16 points (was 7 for 7 on free throws), five rebounds and three assists. Senior forward **Jalon Moore** scored in double figures for the 14th straight game, tallying 13 points, including a game-clinching dunk in the final second. He added six rebounds.

► OU entered the game ranked 15th out of 16 teams in league play with its -6.2 rebounding margin, but outboarded UA 35-29. The Sooners outscored the Razorbacks 13-7 in second-chance points.

OU'S RICH HOOPS HISTORY

Oklahoma's storied men's basketball history is the envy of most SEC programs. The Sooners' five Final Four appearances are exceeded in the SEC by only Kentucky (17), Arkansas (6) and Florida (6). OU, which played in the 1947 and 1988 national title games, has participated in 34 NCAA Tournaments and has played in the postseason in 36 of the last 43 years.

Oklahoma has also generated 18 first-team All-Americans, including Hollis Price, Blake Griffin, Buddy Hield and Trae Young since the turn of the century. Griffin and Hield were consensus national players of the year. OU has produced two of the six Wooden Award winners from current SEC schools (Kentucky/Texas two each).

► Oklahoma held Arkansas to .370 field goal shooting, including a .333 mark in the second half. The Razorbacks' .370 field goal mark was the lowest by an OU opponent since the season opener.

OU's 'X' FACTOR

► Junior guard **Xzayvier Brown** has scored at least 18 points in nine of the last 11 games and is averaging 19.2 in those 11 contests on 50% field goal, 40% (23-for-57) 3-point and 92% (48-for-52) free throw shooting. Included were four 20-point games in SEC play (23 in a win over Ole Miss, a season-high 24 against No. 19 Florida, 21 vs. No. 18 Alabama and 22 at South Carolina).

► Brown's four 20-point games in SEC play are one shy of the lead (Kentucky's Otega Owhe has five).

► In OU's three SEC home games, Brown is averaging 22.7 points. He is 8 for 14 (.571) from 3-point range and has committed just four turnovers.

► Brown leads the SEC by shooting 91% from the free throw line (72 for 79). His streak of 27 makes ended Jan. 13 vs. Florida but he has made 50 of his last 54 attempts (93%).

► After scoring at least 20 points in 14 of 35 games last year at Saint Joseph's (40%), Brown has a team-high nine games of 20-plus in 20 outings this season (45%; **Nijel Pack** ranks second with four such efforts). Brown has 29 career games of at least 20.

PACK MENTALITY

► First-year Sooner guard **Nijel Pack** surpassed the 2,000-point mark Jan. 11 at Texas A&M and now has 2,058 for his career to rank third nationally among active players.

► Pack ranks fourth in the SEC with his 3.1 3-pointers per game and with his .422 3-point FG percentage.

► Pack has made at least one 3-pointer in 18 of 20 games, at least three in 12 contests and at least four in nine outings. He buried at least three treys in six consecutive games between Nov. 11 and Dec. 2, the first Sooner to accomplish the feat since consensus national player of the year **Buddy Hield** during OU's 2015-16 Final Four campaign.

► A sixth-year collegian, Pack spent his first two seasons at Kansas State (he was a first-team All-Big 12 pick as a sophomore when he averaged 17.4 points and made 95 3-pointers and shot a league-high .436 from behind the arc) and the last three at Miami, Fla. (he helped the Hurricanes to their first Final Four his junior season and was named the Midwest Region Most Outstanding Player). He has started 141 of his 142 career games.

ELATONTSEV MAKING AN IMPACT

► OU announced Dec. 28 the signing of 23-year-old **Kirill Elatontsev** (pronounced kee-REEL EE-el-uh-tahn-suv), a center from Russia who is averaging 5.5 points and 2.9 rebounds in 15.5 minutes per contest over his eight games. He is shooting 62% from the field, 64% (7 for 11) from 3-point range and 69% (11 for 16) from the free throw line. He has made at least one 3-pointer in each of the last four games.

► On Jan. 13 vs. No. 19 Florida, Elatontsev scored 17 points on 4-for-4 field goal shooting (all 3-pointers) after totaling two points over OU's first three league games. Over the last four contests he is averaging 9.0 points on 10-for-14 (71%) field goal and 7-for-10 (70%) 3-point shooting and has six steals.

► From Krasnoyarsk, Russia, the 6-11, 240-pound Elatontsev has one semester of eligibility remaining. He most recently played for Lokomotiv Kuban in the VTB United League, which is regarded as the top tier of Russian professional club basketball. In February 2024 he was called up to the Russian National Team.

MORE OU NOTES AND NUGGETS

► Oklahoma has scored at least 85 points in 11 of its 20 games (55%), already its most 85-point efforts in a season since 2017-18. For comparison, OU's last four teams scored 85-plus a combined 21 times in 133 games (16%; nine times last year, six in 2023-24, two in 2022-23 and four in 2021-22).

► OU's top four scorers are all transfers in their first year in the program. **Xzayvier Brown** averages a team-high 16.5 points per game, while **Nijel Pack** (15.7), **Tae Davis** (13.0) and **Derrion Reid** (11.8) also average double figures. **Mohamed Wague** rounds out the starting five with his 6.8 per contest.

► Reid's seven highest-scoring games of his career have come in his last 15 outings, as he tallied 16 points against Alcorn State, 15 vs. Marquette, 18 at Wake Forest, 15 vs. Kansas City, a career-high 22 against Stetson, 19 at Texas A&M (to go along with a career-high 11 rebounds) and 16 vs. No. 18 Alabama (with nine boards).

► Wague (3.0) and Davis (2.8) rank fourth and sixth in the SEC in offensive rebounds per game. Davis had 11 offensive boards against Arkansas-Pine Bluff, OU's most in a contest since at least the 1995-96 season. He surpassed 1,000 career points and 500 rebounds this season (has 1,142 and 555).

► Davis went 3 for 27 (11%) from 3-point range and 41 for 66 (62%) from the free throw line over OU's first 17 games, but is 3 for 6 (50%) and 10 for 11 (91%), respectively, over the last three.

► Wague's three highest career point totals have come this season (16 in the opener vs. Saint Francis, 20 vs. Oral Roberts and 15 vs. Stetson), as have his two highest rebound totals (14 at Wake Forest and 15 vs. Ole Miss in the SEC opener).

► Redshirt freshman forward **Kuol Atak** ranks third on the team with his 26 3-point makes (shooting 39%) despite averaging just 12.1 minutes over his 17 games. He is 19 for 39 (49%) from long distance in home contests, including 10 for 19 (53%) over his last three outings at Lloyd Noble Center. He has played in just one of the last three games (one minute at South Carolina).

► Long Beach State transfer **Jadon Jones**, who is in his second year with OU and first year playing, provides 6.2 points per game off the bench in an average of 21.6 minutes over his 16 outings. He has also drawn 10 fouls while attempting a 3-pointer. Jones missed all of last season and this year's first four games due to injury. The 2021-22 Big West Conference Defensive Player of the Year has 10 steals and seven blocks over the past three games.

► Nine of the 15 players on OU's roster are new in 2025-26, and three more were on last year's team but redshirted.

HEAD COACH PORTER MOSER

SIX POSTSEASON APPEARANCES ■ 2018 NCAA FINAL FOUR ■ 2021 NCAA SWEET 16 ■ 12 ALL-CONFERENCE SELECTIONS

Praised for his ability to create culture and his never-tiring energy, University of Oklahoma head men's basketball coach Porter Moser is in his fifth season leading the Sooners in 2025-26. Moser was hired on April 3, 2021, becoming the 15th head coach in program history after a stellar 10-year run as head coach at Loyola Chicago that included NCAA Final Four and Sweet 16 appearances.

The 2024-25 season was Moser's most successful at OU, guiding his team to a 20-14 record and a No. 9 NCAA Tournament seed. The Sooners, who won their first 13 games and climbed to as high as No. 10 in the Coaches poll and No. 12 in the AP version, played one of the nation's toughest schedules, with 14 games against AP top-25 opponents and 22 of 34 contests against teams that made the NCAA Tournament. OU went 3-0 to win the Battle 4 Atlantis tournament in the Bahamas in November before navigating its first season in the rugged Southeastern Conference, a league that placed a record 14 teams in the NCAA Tournament. The Sooners also set a program record with their .795 free throw percentage, obliterating the previous mark of .767 by the 2001-02 Final Four team.

Point guard Jeremiah Fears was named to the 2024-25 SEC All-Freshman Team and was selected No. 7 overall in the 2025 NBA Draft by the New Orleans Pelicans to become Moser's highest draft pick. Fears was one of just three Power Four conference players (the only one in the SEC and the only freshman) to average at least 17.0 points, 4.0 rebounds, 4.0 assists and 1.5 steals per contest.

In 2023-24, Moser guided OU to a 20-12 mark, ranking as high as seventh in the AP poll. The Sooners reached 20 regular season wins for the first time since 2015-16 and began the season 10-0, tying the 1991-92 and 2003-04 seasons for the seventh-best start in program history. OU bested Iowa and USC at the Rady Children's Invitational, claiming its second consecutive midseason tournament title, and Javian McCollum and Jalon Moore earned All-Big 12 honorable mention accolades.

Moser completed his second season in Norman in 2022-23, recording four AP Top-25 victories and winning the 2022 ESPN Events Invitational. Tanner Groves became only the second two-time College Sports Communicators (formerly CoSIDA) Academic All-American in program history, receiving third-team honors in 2023 and first-team accolades in 2022. In addition to the Sooners' success in the classroom, Milos Uzan was named to the Big 12 All-Freshman Team. Grant Sherfield and Jalen Hill received All-Big 12 Honorable Mention acclaim.

In 2021-22, Moser led the Sooners to a 19-16 mark and five victories over teams ranked in the top 25 at the time of competition. Oklahoma was selected as a No. 1 seed in the National Invitation Tournament, earning an opening-round victory over Missouri State at Lloyd Noble Center.

Umoja Gibson, Jordan Goldwire, Groves and Elijah Harkless earned All-Big 12 honorable mention honors, and C.J. Noland earned a spot on the Big 12 All-Freshman Team. In addition to the on-court success, Groves was tabbed a Senior CLASS Award Finalist and named to the CoSIDA Academic All-America First Team.

Moser received the keys to the Oklahoma men's basketball program as one of the most successful coaches of the prior half-decade. He has been entrenched in creating and developing team culture at all his stops.

Before his time in Norman, Moser led the Loyola Ramblers to remarkable success during his 10-year run as head coach, including a run to the Final Four in 2018 and Sweet Sixteen in 2021.

He amassed 188 wins (188-141, .571), including five seasons with 20-plus victories. He led Loyola to the postseason every year it was available from 2017-21, winning the 2017 CBI title and qualifying for the 2019 NIT. The 2020 postseason was canceled due to COVID-19.

In addition to his team success, he coached 12 all-conference selections, two Missouri Valley Player of the Year honorees, two Associated Press Honorable Mention All-Americans, two Academic All-Americans, a MVC Defensive Player of the Year, two MVC Sixth Man of the Year honorees and a pair of MVC Freshman of the Year selections.

Moser was one of three coaches in Loyola's history to record 150-plus wins. He guided the 2017-18 squad to a school record 32 victories and an appearance in the Final Four – Loyola's first appearance since winning the 1963 NCAA Championship.

After assembling a 25-5 regular season record (15-3 in MVC play), Moser guided Loyola to seven straight postseason wins, claiming the 2018 Missouri Valley tournament title and making a historic run to the pinnacle event of college basketball as a No. 11 seed.

The Ramblers were just the fourth No. 11 seed to advance to the Final Four, beating Miami, Tennessee, Nevada and Kansas State.

Loyola finished the 2017-18 season ranked No. 7 in the final USA Today Coaches Poll. Moser was named the Missouri Valley Conference (MVC) Coach of the Year and the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) District 16 Coach of the Year.

The 2017-18 team ranked second nationally in personal fouls per game (just 13.9), third in field goal percentage (.507) and sixth in scoring defense (62.6 ppg).

During the 2017-18 season, Rambler guard Clayton Custer was named MVC Player of the Year and earned Associated Press (AP) Honorable Mention All-America honors, becoming the first player in Loyola history to receive both in the same season.

Cameron Krutwig earned MVC Freshman of the Year honors and Ben Richardson was named MVC Defensive Player of the Year. In addition to his on-court success, Custer was named CoSIDA Academic All-District. He is in his fourth year working with the Sooners and second as an assistant coach in 2024-25 after two seasons as the director of video operations and player development from 2021-23.

Moser boasts six NCAA Tournament wins from 2018-21 – tied for the seventh most nationally in that time frame. Loyola, Gonzaga and Houston were the only teams outside major conferences to reach two Sweet 16s during the three-year run.

In his final season at Loyola (2020-21), Moser led the Ramblers to a 26-5 record and Missouri Valley Conference regular season and tournament titles. As an eighth seed in the NCAA Tournament, his squad upset No. 1-seed Illinois in the second round to advance to the Sweet 16 for the second time since 2018.

The 2020-21 Rambler squad ranked second in adjusted defensive efficiency (KenPom.com), allowing only 87.0 points per 100 possessions. Loyola's 16-2 record in MVC play set a program record for most wins in conference action.

After 19 wins during the 2014-15 season, the Ramblers earned a bid to the College Basketball Invitational (CBI), advancing to Loyola's first postseason appearance since the 1985 season. Loyola made the most of its chance at postseason play, winning the CBI Championship over Louisiana-Monroe with back-to-back victories in the best-of-three championship series.

After rebuilding during the 2013-14 season, Moser led the Ramblers to a 24-13 mark next season. The 24 victories were the most by a Moser led team and the most for Loyola since 1985.

In the early stages of building Loyola to a mid-major powerhouse, Moser led the Ramblers to an eight-game improvement in the win column from his first season at the helm to his second in 2012-13. The improvement was the most by a coach from his first year to his second in program history.

Owner of a 359-287 (.556) career record, Moser was hired for his first head coaching job in 2000 at Arkansas-Little Rock. In three seasons with the Trojans, Moser took over a program that went 4-24 during the season before his hiring and went 18-11 just one year later.

The Trojans ranked last in the conference in several defensive categories before his tenure. Moser turned the program around in one season, finishing with the Sun Belt's best field goal percentage defense and second-best scoring defense.

He steered the Trojans to a 54-34 overall record before heading to Illinois State in 2003.

After his 2003-04 squad notched a 10-19 record, Moser improved to 17-13 in 2004-05 despite being picked to finish last in the league in the preseason poll.

Following four years at Illinois State, Moser worked under legendary coach Rick Majerus at Saint Louis as an assistant coach from 2007 through 2011. He returned to a head coaching role by being named Loyola's head coach before the 2011-12 season.

A Chicago area native, Moser grew up in Naperville, Ill. He was a two-year starter at Creighton and helped lead the Jays to the 1989 Missouri Valley Conference title and a berth in the NCAA Tournament. He graduated in 1990 with a degree in business management.

Immediately following his collegiate playing career, Moser began his path in coaching at his alma mater as a graduate assistant. He left Creighton for an assistant coach role at Texas A&M for four seasons followed by a year at Wisconsin-Milwaukee. Moser returned to Texas A&M for two more seasons (1996-98) on the Aggies' bench, then served as an assistant coach at Little Rock for two years before his promotion to head coach.

Moser and his wife, Megan, have four children – Jordan, a former OU's women's basketball player, Jake, a former OU men's player, and Max and Ben.
