Game Story Lines

For the sixth time ever and the first time since 2016, Hawai'i will play in the NCAA Tournament.

The Rainbow Warriors were also a No. 13 seed in its last appearance in 2016 and upset No. 4 Cal for their first-ever NCAA win that year.

The 'Bows advanced to the NAAs after capturing the Big West Championship on March 14 with a 71-64 win over UC Irvine.

It was the program's final Big West game after 14 years in the league. The 'Bows move to the Mountain West starting next season.

UH is one of only two schools nationally (Duke) to win both a football bowl game and a men's basketball conference tournament this year.

This will be just the third all-time meeting between Hawai'i and Arkansas and the first since 1977 when the Razorbacks won a pair of games in Honolulu on consecutive nights.

UH's 24 wins is its most since Eran Ganot's debut season in 2015-16 when the program won a school-record 28 games and won the Big West title.

Hawai'i is led by Isaac "Big Fish" Johnson. The 7-0 center was a first team All-Big West selection and leads the team in scoring (14.1), blocks (34) and free throw percentage (88.5%).

Hawai'i In The NCAAs

Hawai'i has made five previous NCAA Tournament appearances (1972, 1994, 2001, 2002, and 2016), holding an all-time tournament record of 1-5.

Here are some fun facts and highlights from the Rainbow Warriors' in the Big Dance:

► **The first trip:** The legendary "Fabulous Five" squad led UH to its first-ever NCAA Tournament in the 1971-72 season, ultimately falling to Weber State 91-64. The team finished that season with a No. 12 national ranking, which remains the highest in school history.

► **The first win:** The program's first and only NCAA Tournament victory came during their most recent appearance in the 2015-16 season. Playing as a 13-seed, the Rainbow Warriors upset Jaylen Brown and the No. 4 seed California, 77-66, in the first round before falling to No. 5 seed Maryland in the second round.

► **Syracuse deja vu:** Hawai'i's second and third tournament appearances (in 1994 and 2001) both ended in first-round defeats to the exact same opponent: the Syracuse Orange.

► **Individual scoring highs:** Predrag Savovic holds the UH NCAA Tournament single-game scoring record with 26 points (including 10 field goals made), achieved against Xavier in 2002. Trevor Ruffin holds the record for most 3-pointers in an NCAA game, draining 7 of them against Syracuse in 1994.

► **Coaching leaders:** Head coach Riley Wallace led the program to the most NCAA Tournament appearances with three (1994, 2001, and 2002), Eran Ganot has led UH to two NCAA bids (2016, 2026), while Red Rocha led UH to its first NCAA Tournament appearance in 1972.

vs. Nationally-Ranked Squads

Hawai'i holds an all-time record of 19-107 against nationally ranked (Top 25) teams.

Here is a breakdown of the Rainbow Warriors' history against ranked opponents:

► **By Location:** The program is 2-10 on a neutral court.

► **Against the Upper Echelon:** UH is 3-43 against Top 10 teams and 2-19 against Top 5 teams. They are 0-2 all-time against the No. 1 ranked team in the country, with both losses coming against North Carolina in 1986 and 1994.

► **Highest Ranked Win:** The biggest upset in school history came on December 30, 1997, when UH defeated No. 2 Kansas 76-65 in the championship game of the Rainbow Classic.

► **Most Recent Win:** The last time Hawai'i defeated a ranked opponent was during the first round of the 2016 NCAA Tournament, where they upset No. 23 California 77-66.

► **Most Recent Matchup:** Their last game against a ranked team resulted in a 87-69 loss to No. 10 North Carolina on November 22, 2024.

► **Streaks:** The team's longest winning streak against ranked opponents is two games, a feat they have achieved three times (most recently in 2001). Their longest losing streak against ranked opponents lasted 23 games from 1950 to 1971.

All-Time vs. Arkansas

Hawai'i will meet Arkansas on the hardwood for the third time and first time in nearly 40 years.

► **Let's Play Two:** The teams first two meetings took place in Honolulu on consecutive days during the 1977-78 season. Arkansas defeated UH 79-60 on Dec. 1, 1977 then followed that up with a 78-53 win the very next day at the Neal S. Blaisdell Center.

All-Time vs. The SEC

Hawai'i holds a combined total all-time record of 11-25 against current Southeastern Conference (SEC) teams.

► **UH's last matchup** against an SEC team was against Vanderbilt on Dec. 22, 2021 in the Hawaii Airlines Diamond Head Classic. The Commodores defeated the 'Bows, 68-54 in the opening round of the tournament.

► **UH's last win** against an SEC team was a 79-67 Christmas Day victory over Auburn in the third place game of the 2015 Hawaiian Airlines Diamond Head Classic.

INTERVIEW POLICY

All interviews must be coordinated through the UH Sports Media Relations office. Remote interviews will be conducted as long as it does not interfere with the student-athlete's class schedule. Post-game interviews, for UH student-athletes, will be conducted in the Stan Sheriff Center Green Room only, following a brief cooling off period. Visiting team interviews will be conducted outside the opponent locker room.

A UH Win Would...

Give UH its second-ever win in seven game in the NCAA...advance the Rainbow Warriors to the second round for the second straight time...give UH its first win in three meetings against Arkansas.

A UH Loss Would...

Drop UH to 1-6 all-time in the NCAAs...drop UH to 0-3 all-time against Arkansas...give UH its sixth straight loss to a nationally-ranked team dating back to 2016.

The Oregon Trail

▶ UH started the regular-season with a tight 60-59 loss to Oregon in Eugene and now heads back to the state for the postseason.
▶ UH is 6-16 all-time in the state of Oregon.
▶ Beside Oregon (0-4), UH has played at Lewis & Clark (1-2) Oregon State (0-7), Portland (2-2), Portland State (0-1), Southern Oregon (1-0) and Willamette (2-0).

NCAA Experience

▶ Just two current UH players boast NCAA Tournament experience.
▶ Isaac Johnson was a part of three Utah State squads that were in the Big Dance.
▶ As a sophomore, Johnson scored a then-career-high 19 points with four blocks for the Aggies in an upset win over TCU in the first round of 2024 NCAAs.
▶ Johnson appeared in all 35 games for the Aggies that season, tied for third most single-season games played in school history
▶ Hunter Erickson also went to the NCAAs as a member of the 2020-21 BYU squad.
▶ Erickson appeared in eight games as freshman for the Cougars that year but did appear in the teams 2021 NCAA first-round loss to a UCLA squad that ultimately advanced to the Final Four.

Recapping The Big West Championship

▶ Hawai'i won its second Big West Tournament title with wins over Cal State Fullerton (78-63) and UC Irvine (71-64).
▶ The Rainbow Warriors were the No. 2 seed in the tournament and earned a double-bye into the tournament semifinal.
▶ In the semifinals against Cal State Fullerton, the league's top scoring offense at 83 points per game, UH held the Titans to just 36 percent shooting and nearly 20 points below its scoring average.
▶ They also tied a season-high with 53 rebounds, out-rebounding Fullerton by 27.
▶ Defense also ruled in UH's title game win over UC Irvine as the 'Bows held the Anteaters to just 36 percent shooting for the game while blocking 10 shots, its second-highest total of the season.
▶ Isaac Johnson had a game-high 22 points in the win to snag Tournament MVP honors.
▶ Harry Rouhliadoff had 15 points and a career-high 12 rebounds to also earn a spot on the all-tournament team along with Dre Bullock who had 15 points and four steals.

'Bow Bits

▶ The 'Bows are averaging 79.6 points per game, the highest scoring average since 2013-14 (80.0) The highest average prior to that came in 1972-73 (85.8).
▶ UH ranks in the top 30 in the NCAA in 6 categories - defensive rebounds (11th), 3FG% defense (25th), FT attempts (25th), FTs made (25th), rebound margin (26th) and rebounds per game (28th).
▶ UH has allowed only three opponents in 32 games this year to shoot 50 percent or better. Arkansas averages 50% shooting for the season.
▶ Harry Rouhliadoff posted double-doubles in back-to-back games in the Big West Championship. Prior to that, Rouhliadoff had one double-double in 44 previous starts.
▶ UH will play in the Moda Center, home of the Portland Trailblazers. This will be UH's first game in an NBA arena since falling to Utah, 79-66, on Nov. 30, 2023 at the Delta Center, home of the Utah Jazz.
▶ Current Rainbow Warrior Hunter Erickson was a Utah Ute in that game and scored a then-career 15 points against the 'Bows.
▶ The 'Bows are 7-1 coming off a loss this season and have lost back-to-back games this season just once.
▶ Eran Ganot has led UH to four 20-win seasons, including three in the last four years.
▶ UH finished 16-3 at home this season. It was the program's best home record since the 2015-16 squad went 17-3 in Eran Ganot's debut season.
▶ The Big West achieved its highest-ever ranking in KenPom as the 11th ranked conference in the nation. UH was the highest ranked BW team earlier this year when it peaked at 87.
▶ UH is 9-1 when Dre Bullock leads the team in scoring.
▶ Fourteen of UH's 24 wins this year have come by double-digits, including seven of its 14 Big West regular-season victories.
▶ Nine of the team's 24 wins have come by 20 or more points.
▶ UH has led at halftime in 21 of 32 games. The 'Bows are 20-1 when leading at half and 3-7 when trailing at the break.
▶ UH's has led from wire-to-wire four times this season.
▶ UH has scored 86 points or more in 14 games and 90 or more in five contests.
▶ UH is 14-0 this season when scoring 80 or more points.

Shut 'Em Down

▶ Defense has been a big factor in UH's 24-8 record this season.
▶ The Rainbow Warriors rank 25th in 3PT FG percentage defense (.304) and 37th in FG percentage defense (.411).
▶ The 'Bows have held six opponents to under 60 points this year and 16 of its 32 opponents to under 40 percent shooting.
▶ UH is 17th in effective FG% defense (.464).

- ▶ UH's opponents are averaging just 9.3 assists per game, which leads the nation.
- ▶ Opponents assist on just 38.3% of its made field goals, a rate which ranks third nationally.
- ▶ UH is also 26th nationally in rebound margin (+6.4) and 11th nationally in defensive rebounds (28.2).

Pick Your Poison

- ▶ An offensive trademark of Eran Ganot's teams has been balanced scoring and this season is no different.
- ▶ UH has had five or more players score in double-digits in eight different games.
- ▶ Seven players scored in double-figures in UH's win over HPU on Nov. 24 with the high scorer being Isaac Johnson with 16.
- ▶ The astounding thing was it was the second time in the first seven games that type of scoring has happened.
- ▶ UH also had seven players in double-digits in their home opener versus East Texas A&M on Nov. 9 in which Dre Bullock and Hunter Erickson were the high scorers at 15.
- ▶ For the season, three different players are averaging in double-digits – Isaac Johnson (14.1), Dre Bullock (13.5), and Harry Rouhliadef (10.8) while Gytis Nemeikša (9.3) is not far off.
- ▶ Nine different players on the roster have scored in double-digits at least once in a game this season, seven have led the team in scoring at least once and five have scored better than 20 points in a game.

Big Fish in the Middle of the Pacific

- ▶ UH has reeled in quite a catch with Isaac "Big Fish" Johnson who became UH's first All-Big West first team selection since 2019-20 and the first NABC all-district pick since 2015-16.
- ▶ The 7-0 transfer from Utah State leads the team in scoring (14.1 ppg) and blocks (34), and is second in rebounding (5.8) while doing it in just 21.1 minutes per game.
- ▶ He is shooting 50% from the field and a team-leading 89% from the free throw line, including a school-record 38 straight made earlier this season.
- ▶ Johnson has posted three double-doubles this season, highlighted by a career-high 25 points and 11 rebounds in a 30-point blow-out of Manhattan.
- ▶ He was named the MVP of the Big West Championship after averaging 20.5 ppg while leading UH to its first tournament title in a decade.
- ▶ He was also named the Most Outstanding Player of the OUTRIGGER Rainbow Classic to start the season.

Two-Way Dre

- ▶ Senior Dre Bullock has provided inspired play on both offense and defense.
- ▶ Bullock, who earned all-Big West second team honors, is the team's second-leading scorer (13.5). while leading the team in rebounding (5.8) and steals (54).

- ▶ He has led the team in scoring in 10 games – all but one resulting in a UH win.
- ▶ That includes a team-high six 20-point performances, highlighted by a 27-point masterpiece at Cal State Fullerton that was punctuated by his game-winning three-pointer at the buzzer.
- ▶ The native of Franklinton, N.C. has had multiple steals in 15 games this year, including a career-high six in UH's 20-point road win at Cal Poly.

Captain Australia

- ▶ Team captain Harry Rouhliadef, a senior and the team's only four-year player, has been leading by example.
- ▶ He is currently third on the team in scoring (10.8 ppg) and second in 3FGM (34), while shooting a team-best 53% from the field and 40% on threes.
- ▶ The native of Brisbane, Australia has led the team in scoring in five games and had back-to-back double-doubles in UH's two wins in the Big West Championship.
- ▶ For his efforts he was named to the all-tournament team.
- ▶ The 6-8 forward was also instrumental in UH's win versus UTEP, helping UH overcome a 14-point deficit for a 66-61 win.
- ▶ Rouhliadef tied his career high with 22 points – including seven straight clutch points for UH down the stretch – while playing a career-high 35 minutes.
- ▶ Rouhliadef has played 119 career games – all as a Rainbow Warrior.

Full-Grown Adults

- ▶ The Rainbow Warriors are experienced and mature with the infusion of six DI transfers.
- ▶ The six transfers played a combined 513 games (an average of 86 games each) at their previous stops.
- ▶ The average age of the squad is 23 years old and 3 months when the regular-season starts in early November.
- ▶ 7 of UH's 12 players are 23 years or older.
- ▶ The eldest of the team is Hunter Erickson, who turned 26 in September. He is amongst the oldest players in college hoops.
- ▶ Five Rainbow Warrior players, Erickson included, are married. The list also includes Tanner Cuff, Isaac Finlinson, Isaac Johnson and Gytis Nemeikša.
- ▶ There is even a father in the bunch as Cuff and his wife Jessica welcomed a daughter, Halo, this past October.

Beehive Ballers

- ▶ This year's Rainbow Warrior squad will have a distinct Utah feel with a total of four players – nearly a third of the team – from the Beehive state.
- ▶ They include Tanner Cuff (American Fork), Hunter Erickson (Provo), Isaac Finlinson (St. George) and Isaac "Big Fish" Johnson (American Fork).
- ▶ All four players were recruited by assistant coach and former Rainbow Warrior player Gibson Johnson who hails from Centerville.
- ▶ Johnson previously coached Finlinson at

▶ Graduate transfer and point guard Tanner Cuff is a well-connected guy.
 ▶ The Utah native has already been teammates with four fellow UH newcomers spanning his high school, junior college and Division I career.
 ▶ Cuff most recently played a season (2023-24) with Yacine Toumi at Evansville.
 ▶ He also spent a season at Salt Lake CC with Hunter Erickson (2022-23).
 ▶ Finally, Cuff spent his high school career as teammates with both Isaac Finlinson (Dixie HS) and Isaac Johnson (American Fork) with all three players being coached under the tutelage of Tanner's father, Ryan Cuff.
 ▶ Cuff injured his knee less than a week before UH's regular-season opener at Oregon and is sidelined for the 2025-26 season.

General (Manager) Mills

▶ Former NBA champion and five-time Olympian Patty Mills joined the Rainbow Warriors basketball program this past June as the team's new General Manager.
 ▶ Mills will support student-athlete mentorship and development, while contributing to key areas including recruiting, fundraising, and community engagement.
 ▶ The Australian native has lived on Oahu's North Shore during the NBA off-season for more than a decade and married his wife Alyssa in Waimea Valley.
 ▶ Mills and head coach Eran Ganot's rela-

tionship dates back to their shared history at Saint Mary's College, where Mills was a two-time all-conference guard and Ganot spent nearly a decade on the coaching staff.

▶ This summer Mills initiated the Roots & Reach program to create team unity and initiate community outreach.

▶ Among the activities that Mills organized was shark diving, taro patch farming, life-guard training and ocean navigation education.

Big West Swan Song

▶ This marks the 14th and final season for Hawai'i men's basketball in the Big West.

▶ The 'Bows have been a member of the Big West since 2012-13.

▶ Starting in the 2026-27 season, UH will be a full-time member of the Mountain West.

▶ The Rainbow Warriors have won one regular-season title (2015-16) and two tournament titles (2016, 2026).

▶ UH has finished the regular-season with a losing record just once (last season) in 14 years in the Big West.

▶ UH finished 118-106 all-time in Big West regular-season games (19 wins vacated in 2013 & '14 due to NCAA sanctions).

▶ UH was 66-42 all-time in Big West regular-season home games (record following 12 vacated wins), including 8-2 this year.

▶ UH was 52-64 all-time in Big West regular-season road games (record following 7 vacated wins), including 6-4 this season.

▶ Prior to joining the Big West in 2012, UH was a member of the Western Athletic Conference for more than three decades.

MILESTONES & RECORDS

▶ UH's 14 3-pointers made at Cal State Fullerton was a season high and the most 3-pointers in a conference game since UH hit 15 at Long Beach State on Jan. 8, 2022.

▶ UH (14) and Cal State Fullerton (11) combined for 25 three-pointers in all, the most ever in a UH game, eclipsing the 24 combined in a February 2018 game between UH (14) and UC Riverside (10).

▶ UH's 39 three-point attempts tied a school record set versus Washington in the 2019 Diamond Head Classic and were the most ever attempts in a conference game.

▶ With 17 points against CSU Bakersfield on Jan. 22, senior Dre Bullock surpassed 1,000 points in his Division I collegiate career.

▶ UH's 88-45 win on Jan. 1 at UC Riverside was its largest margin ever (+43) in a road contest eclipsing the previous record of 30 at Air Force in 1990 (88-58).

▶ It was also the largest margin of victory ever in conference play, spanning more than four decades in the WAC and Big West, eclipsing a 31-point win over UCR in 2014.

▶ UH held UC Riverside 45 points, the lowest total allowed since Dec. 2019 (41 vs. Hawai'i Pacific) and tied for the lowest ever against a Big West opponent (45 vs. Cal Poly, Jan. 2018).

▶ UH's 52-point margin of victory (98-46) over Hawai'i Hilo on Dec. 10 was the third largest in school history and the largest since a 57-point win over Redlands on January 28, 1972.

▶ Isaac Johnson made 38 straight free throws, breaking the school record of 34 set by Brocke Stepteau during the 2018-19 season. The streak started in UH's second game vs. East Texas A&M on Nov. 9 and ended in the 2H vs. Cal State Fullerton on Dec. 6.

▶ In its win over East Texas A&M on Nov., 9, UH hit 100 points for the first time since a 114-107 overtime win over Long Beach State in January 2017.

▶ It was he first time UH hit 100 in regulation since a 100-69 win over UC Riverside in January 2014.

▶ UH broke a program record with 54 free throw attempts vs. East Texas A&M, a record that stood since January 1970 when UH shoot 52 free throws vs. Linfield.

▶ The 'Bows also set a new mark for free throws made (37), eclipsing the 36 that UH made just this past January in a 95-86 win at Cal State Fullerton.

▶ CSUB's Dalian Smith set records for free throws made and attempted by a UH opponent when he went 20-of-25.

▶ The previous record was more than four decades old, held by UNLV's Earl Evans on Jan. 19, 1974 after going 19-of-24.





A Winning Culture

- ▶ Holds the best win percentage (.607) of any UH coach in the collegiate era.
- ▶ Ranks second all-time at UH in career wins (195).
- ▶ Led UH to seven straight winning seasons, the second longest streak in program history.

The 1971-72 squad, famously nicknamed the "Fabulous Five," captivated the state by finishing the season with a 24-3 record and the program's first trip to the NCAA Tournament. The team played before sold-out crowds at the Neal S. Blaisdell Center, where it won all 19 games, including consecutive victories over nationally ranked Florida State. UH opened the NCAA Tournament with a 91-64 loss to Weber State. Bob Nash led the team in scoring (18.2) and rebounding (14.3), becoming the first Rainbow to average a double-double for the season. Coupled with a 23-5 record and an NIT appearance in 1970-71, the Fabulous Five posted the best two-year record (49-8) in school history.



The 1993-94 team overcame an 0-4 start by winning the program's first WAC Tournament. The team failed to score more than 50 points in its first three games and lost by an average of 42 points at the Great Alaska Shoot-out. But the Rainbows rebounded and won seven of their first eight WAC games. In the WAC Tournament, UH squeaked out wins over Colorado State (66-61) and New Mexico (61-58) before upsetting in-state favorite Brigham Young (73-66) for the title. Making their first NCAA Tournament in 22 years, the Rainbows hung tough against Syracuse before falling 92-78 in first-round action. Guard Trevor Ruffin led the team in scoring (20.8) while center Tony Maroney was the team leader in rebounding (9.8).

Guard Predrag Savovic led the team in scoring (17.6) while Troy Ostler was the team leader in rebounding (5.8).

At one point during the season, the team won 14 of 15 games. The team easily swept through the WAC Tournament, winning all three games by 14 or more points. The 2015-16 squad set a new mark with a 28-6 record. The team captured the program's first-ever Big West regular-season and tournament titles since joining the league in 2012. Mired by the cloud of impending NCAA sanctions, the 'Bows persevered and won 14 of their first 16 games and rolled to a 13-3 Big West regular-season mark. In its first appearance in 14 years, the team entered the NCAA Tournament as a 13-seed and upset No. 4 seed Cal for UH's first-ever win in the Big Dance. UH fell to Maryland in the second round and at season's end, received votes in the final Coaches Poll. Forward Stefan Jankovic was named Big West Player of the Year, just the second conference Player of the Year in UH history, and was also an AP honorable mention All-American.
