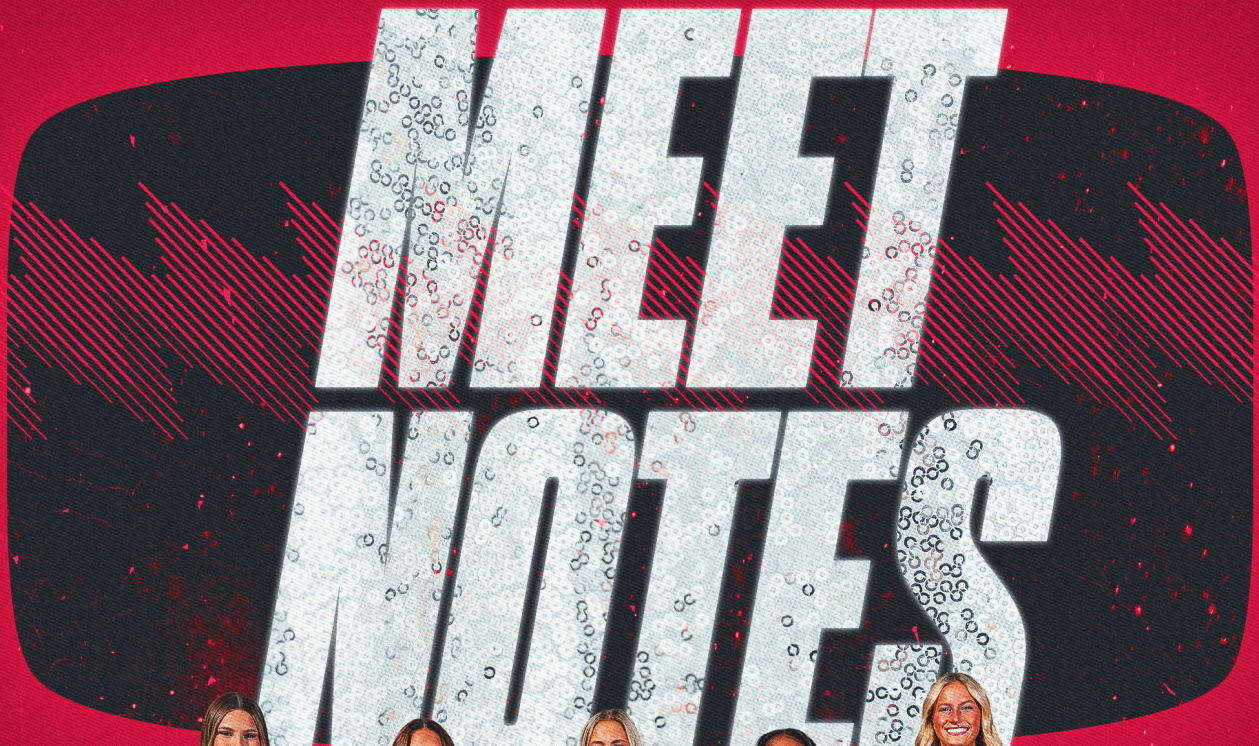

GYMBACK NOTABLES

Arkansas Bested by Mizzou on the Road

It was a tight battle all the way through, but ultimately No. 7 Missouri took down No. 8 Arkansas in March 1's SEC dual, 197.425-197.225. There was plenty for the Gymnastics to be proud of in the meet, starting with the all-around performance of freshman Allison Cucci. She earned a new career high of 39.500, good for the all-around crown and the third-highest of any freshman in the nation this season. Cucci also tied for first on vault (9.875) and got second on beam (9.925). Redshirt junior Lauren Williams had a fantastic outing as a floor specialist and scored a 9.875 on vault and 9.925 on floor. Both marks were good for a share of first place on the events. Senior Morgan Price earned a big 9.925 at bars anchor, which tied for first on the event. The last two events of the day kept Arkansas in contention with Mizzou, as the Gymnastics went 49.425 on both floor and beam, the latter a season high.

Morgan Price Records First-Ever Perfect 10 in Program History, Gymnastics Tie Wildcats

After 8,442 days and 24 competition seasons later, Arkansas gymnastics finally saw perfection rewarded in its scores as senior Morgan Price earned the first 10 in program history, on vault, in the No. 7 Gymnastics' 197.125-197.125 tie against No. 24 Kentucky. Price's 10 was the second of her career, as she also attained perfection last season on bars at Fisk University. Continuing her streak as a trailblazer, she has now scored the first perfect 10 in HBCU history and the first ever for the Gymnastics. Morgan's 10 earned her the vault title, and she won all-around with a score of 39.575. Those were two of five titles on the night for Arkansas: Joscelyn Roberson took the beam crown with her sixth 9.950 on the event in eight meets. Roberson and Lauren Williams also tied for the title on floor with matching 9.950 marks. Despite the meet ending in a draw, Arkansas outscored Kentucky on vault and floor and tied the Wildcats on beam. The Gymnastics' 49.600 was a season high and ties for the fourth-highest floor mark in program history.

Arkansas Falls to No. 3 Alabama on the Road

The No. 8 Gymnastics had a huge SEC road test on Feb. 13 and fell to the No. 3 Alabama Crimson Tide 197.950-196.900. The home team outscored Arkansas on each event, but the Gymnastics did claim at least a share of a top three position on all of them. Hailey Klein had a great night in the all-around with a score of 39.450, which placed third and was a new career high. Morgan Price came in fourth all-around with a score of 39.300. Klein took third on vault as well with a score of 9.900, and she and Morgan Price shared the beam title with a matching mark of 9.900. Morgan scored 9.925 on bars in the first rotation, which held on for a third-place finish. Lauren Williams' 9.900 on floor was good for a tie in third place. The Gymnastics are now 5-4 on the season and are 2-2 in SEC competition.

Gymnastics Take Second at Metroplex Challenge with New Team Season and Vault Program Highs

Propelled by three individual program records and a new program vault record, No. 10 Arkansas gymnastics scored a season high 197.700 on Feb. 8 and took second in this season's Metroplex Challenge. The No. 1 Oklahoma Sooners took the team title with a score of 198.175, No. 31 Arizona came in third with 195.825 and No. 55 TWU placed fourth with a score of 195.025. Hailey Klein and Lauren Williams both scored 9.975 to share second place on vault, the second time that each of them have matched the program individual score record of 9.975 on the event. The Gymnastics ultimately came away with a 49.675 on vault, a new program record and the team's highest team vault score since 2024. Morgan Price earned a 9.975 on bars for the event title, a new season high. The mark is Arkansas' program best, and it was the first time since 2024 that any Gymnastics has earned a 9.975 on bars. Price joins Reese Drotar and Hailey Garner as one of three Arkansas gymnasts ever to reach the score. Joscelyn Roberson scored her fifth 9.950 on beam in six meets, which earned her the event title on her birthday. Arkansas registered seven more 9.900+ scores on the day: Roberson on bars (9.900) and floor (9.900), Leah Smith on vault (9.900) and floor (9.900), Morgan Price on vault (9.925) and beam (9.900) and Allison Cucci on vault (9.900). The Gymnastics are now 5-3 on the season with an average team score of 197.092. -->

Arkansas Upsets Georgia at BWA

The No. 10 Gymbacks returned to Bud Walton Arena on Feb. 6 and pulled off an upset over No. 6 Georgia, 197.450-197.050. Arkansas outscored Georgia on vault, bars and beam on the night and notched a season high of 49.450 on bars. It was Arkansas' second straight win over Georgia in Fayetteville and the team's ninth against the Bulldogs in Jordyn Wieber's tenure. The Gymbacks claimed the individual titles on each of those events as well: Lauren Williams on vault (9.925), Morgan Price on bars (9.950) and Joscelyn Roberson on beam (9.950). Joscelyn Roberson made her return to the all-around for the first time since last season and registered a 39.550 to win the title, the third-highest all-around score of her collegiate career. Arkansas had its second-highest attendance of the season with 6,839 fans at Bud Walton Arena to watch the big win.

Gymbacks Fall to Gators in First SEC Road Meet

The No. 6 Gymbacks had their first SEC road test on Jan. 30 and came up short to the No. 3 Florida Gators, 198.050-195.975. While Arkansas struggled throughout the night, the Gymbacks continued to show up on vault, where they scored a 49.350. Arkansas hasn't scored lower than 49.250 so far this season on vault and didn't count a score lower than 9.825 on the event on Friday. Senior Morgan Price did take the vault crown in the meet, with a season high 9.925. She also scored 9.900 on bars, Arkansas' highest score on the event and tied for fourth overall.

Arkansas Posts Team, Floor Season Highs in Victory Over SEMO

A change in the schedule didn't faze the No. 8 Gymbacks at all on Jan. 23 as they came away with a 197.475-192.675 victory over SEMO. Arkansas' team score is a season high and ties for the sixth-highest score in program history. The floor squad put on quite the show to close out the meet and notched an event score of 49.525, their best in the 2026 slate. The Gymbacks won every event: Morgan Price on vault (9.900), Morgan Price and Leah Smith on bars (9.875), Joscelyn Roberson on beam (9.950), and Frankie Price, Roberson and Lauren Williams in a three-way tie on floor (9.925). Morgan Price took the all-around crown with a score of 39.600, a new personal best. Hailey Klein came in second with a total of 39.350, also a career high. Allison Cucci placed third on the day with a 39.200.

Williams Gets SEC Specialist of the Week Nod

After a record performance in Arkansas' first home meet of the season, Lauren Williams has been named SEC Co-Specialist of the Week, the conference announced on Jan. 20. Williams competed vault and floor in the No. 8 Gymbacks' contest against No. 11 Auburn and both appearances helped propel Arkansas to its first victory of the season. The redshirt junior started her day on vault, where she delivered a stuck Yurchenko 1.5 that scored 9.975, a new career high and good for the event title. The score also ties the individual program record and Williams is just one of five Gymbacks to ever hit the mark on vault. Through two meets, Williams' vault average sits at 9.938, which puts her at No. 1 in the national rankings. Behind her at No. 2 is Olympic gold medalist and UCLA star Jordan Chiles, whose vault average is 9.933 this season, including a Perfect 10. It's the second time in Lauren's career she's been ranked No. 1, the last a No. 1 ranking on floor in week two of the 2024 season, which she shared with teammate Frankie Price. The Rogers native made her season debut on floor against Auburn after not competing the event in over a year. She put up a solid routine that went 9.850, which tied for fourth place. The weekly honor is the third of Williams' career. She previously won Specialist of the

Week on March 12, 2024, which was also the last weekly nod for Arkansas. On Jan. 23, 2023, she was named SEC Freshman of the Week.

Arkansas Gets First Win of the Season Against Auburn

The No. 10 Gymbacks opened their 2026 home slate on Sunday and came out on top over No. 6 Auburn, 197-250-196.075. Arkansas won at least a share of all the event titles, save for floor. The day began on a very high note as redshirt junior Lauren Williams scored a 9.975 on vault, which tied for the program individual record. Freshman Allison Cucci continued her solid start to her collegiate career and tied for the bars title with a score of 9.900. Sophomore Joscelyn Roberson delivered her standard excellence on beam with a 9.950 for the event crown. In her second Arkansas all-around performance, Morgan Price tallied a 39.475, good for first place and just .025 off her career high, 39.500. Hailey Klein also competed all-around and scored 39.225, her new career high and good for third place. Redshirt senior Frankie Price returned to the floor lineup for the first time since sustaining an ankle injury in the regional semifinals last spring, and she earned a 9.875, Arkansas' highest floor score of the day.

Gymbacks Fall to Minnesota in Season Opener

While the Gymbacks weren't able to pull out a victory over Minnesota, they did open the season with a strong 196.700 team score, the second-highest for a first meet in program history. The day was highlighted by Arkansas' three all-arounders: freshman Allison Cucci, Hailey Klein and Morgan Price. It was the first time since the 2020 season that three all-arounders competed for Arkansas in the same meet, and first time ever that three Gymbacks made their Arkansas all-around debut in the same day. Cucci claimed the all-around crown with a score of 39.350, with no scores under 9.800. Her best mark of the day came on vault with a 9.900, which also secured her a share of the vault title, split with teammate Lauren Williams. Arkansas also claimed at least a share of first on every other event: Leah Smith on bars (9.875), Joscelyn Roberson on beam (9.950) and Price on floor (9.875).

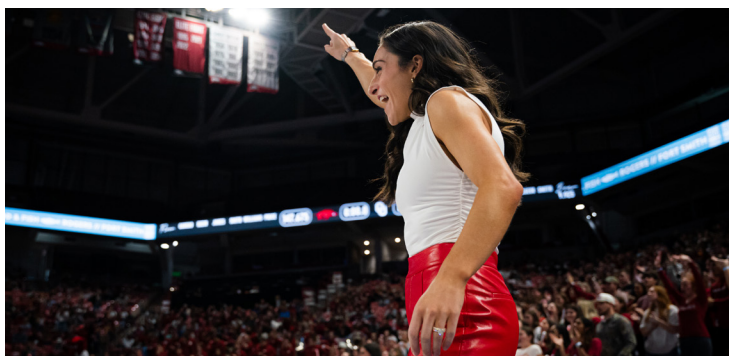

JORDYN WIEBER

SEVENTH-YEAR HEAD COACH



Olympic gold medalist Jordyn Wieber was introduced as the head coach of the Arkansas Women's Gymnastics program on Wednesday, April 24, 2019, by Vice Chancellor and Director of Athletics Hunter Yurachek.

Following a historic slate in 2024, the Gymbacks kept up the consistency in 2025 as they finished No. 12 in the nation and had four top 10 wins on the season. Wieber coached standout freshman and Olympic alternate Joscelyn Roberson to All-SEC honors, and Roberson qualified for NCAA Championships as an individual competitor. In Fort Worth, Roberson scored a 39.425, the best-ever mark by an Arkansas freshman at nationals, and she also earned All-American honors on beam.

The 2025 season was Arkansas' first to have all home meets hosted at Bud Walton Arena. The Gymbacks saw a new average attendance record of 7,915, a total single season record of 39,575, and a new season ticket holder record.

Season five in 2024 was the best yet for Wieber in her tenure, as she led the Gymbacks to their first NCAA Championships team appearance in six years in 2024. Arkansas finished seventh of eighth to conclude the season ranked No. 7, the highest final rank for the team since 2012. The season was filled with milestones for the program, including five of the top 11 program high scores for Arkansas, including a new best of 198.100 set on March 15. The Gymbacks set and broke their program score record two other times, and finished 2024 with 11 marks of 197+, the most in a single season by six. Arkansas has now earned all of its top program team scores in Wieber's tenure, and in 2024, five athletes matched the program-high 9.975 individual scores across all four events: Hailey Klein on vault, Reese Drotar on bars, Priscilla Park on beam and Maddie Jones and Frankie Price on floor.

In Fort Worth, Drotar earned First Team All-America honors on bars with a sixth place finish and matched the program NCAA Championships bars record with a score of 9.925. Leah Smith and Cami Weaver garnered Second Team honors on vault as they tied for 13th overall with matching scores of 9.8875. Wieber has now coached six athletes to 10 All-America honors over the last five years, at least one each season dating back to 2021.

Arkansas began the 2024 postseason at SEC Championships, where the Gymbacks placed sixth with a score of 197.050, the first time ever scoring 197+ at the event and a new program best at SECs. Six athletes earned All-SEC honors: Lauren Williams on vault, Hailey Klein and Cami Weaver on beam, and Maddie Jones, Frankie Price and Leah Smith on floor. Six ties the program record for Gymbacks on the All-SEC list in a single season, and is the most under Wieber so far.

The Gymbacks compiled an 8-6-1 regular season record and 15-15-1 record overall, the most wins for the program since 2012. Arkansas went 4-2-1 in SEC competition, the most conference victories in eight years, another high for Wieber in her fifth season at the helm.

During her fourth season in 2023, Wieber guided the Gymbacks to their 19th consecutive regional appearance. The team set a then-one new regional team score record of 197.275, and a new regional floor record of 49.500. The team finished the year ranked 17th in the country, maintaining the program's 18-year streak in the top 20.

Graduate transfer Norah Flatley and freshman Lauren Williams both earned berths to the NCAA Championships as individuals, extending Wieber's unblemished national appearance streak in each eligible year. Flatley earned her fourth All-American honor at the event on balance beam with a score of 9.9375, which is the best-ever score by a Gymback as an individual beam qualifier.

Arkansas' 196.825 at SEC Championships in 2023 and placed seventh. Five Gymbacks earned All-SEC or All-SEC Freshman honors at the meet: Norah Flatley (VT, FX, AA), Lauren Williams (VT, FX), Reese Drotar (UB), Frankie Price (VT) and Cami Weaver (VT).

The Gymbacks continued to grow their fanbase with new single meet (11,031), home single season (36,619), and average attendance (7,324) records in 2023, the latter two ranking sixth and seventh in the country. Arkansas also sold out Barnhill Arena for the first time in program history on Jan. 27, when 7,147 fans were in the building to watch the Hogs take down the LSU Tigers.

Wieber has coached five regular-season All-Americans in Sophia Carter (2020), Maggie O'Hara (2021), Kennedy Hambrick (2020, 2021), Frankie Price (2024) and Joscelyn Roberson (2025).

Hambrick became the new all-around score record holder (39.750) during the 2021 season, a record that had gone unbroken for seven years prior. Under her guidance in and out of the gym, the Gymbacks were awarded the Arkansas Athletics Lee Spencer Cup for the first time ever in 2022, which is awarded to the team that earns the most points in the areas of personal and career development, community engagement, and academic and athletic excellence. Arkansas also saw its first SEC Scholar-Athlete of the Year in 10 years in 2022 with Bailey Lovett.

The Gymbacks earned their first-ever spot in the SEC night session in 2021 and advanced to the NCAA regional final after scoring a 197.250 on day one. In total, Arkansas registered five scores of 197.000 or better in 2021, for the first time in program history.

In 2020, the Gymbacks ranked as high as fourth in the nation on floor and finished the season ninth in the nation. Arkansas scored a 49.00 or higher in 14 of 16 events over the course of four home meets, nearly 90 percent of all events.

The Razorbacks' success on floor helped them lock in back-to-back SEC wins against No. 20 Missouri and No. 10 Georgia midway through the season. The consecutive wins marked the first time since 2017 that Arkansas won two-straight conference meets and consecutive meets against a ranked opponent.

Arkansas saw six Gymbacks wrap up the 2020 season ranked in the top 100 by Road to Nationals in at least one event, with four Hogs finishing with multiple top 100 rankings. With Wieber's lead, Arkansas won 27 event titles through 10 meets. Hambrick finished the season with the most individual titles among the Gymbacks, securing 11 event titles including a team-high four all-around titles.

The first home meet of the Wieber era was held on Jan. 17 against No. 3 Denver, bringing a then-record crowd of 6,714 fans to Barnhill Arena. On Feb. 21, Coach Wieber and her Arkansas squad hosted Auburn for a Women's Empowerment Meet, the first of its kind in NCAA gymnastics and now an annual tradition for the Gymbacks.

Wieber wrapped up her third season as a volunteer assistant coach at UCLA and her sixth with the program in 2019, assisting the team in a variety of roles during her first three years in Westwood following her Olympic career. Wieber coached the Bruins on floor exercise, an event in which UCLA finished the 2018 and 2019 regular seasons ranked No. 1 in the nation. In 2019, the Bruins recorded scores of 49.5 or better in 11 of 14 meets, averaging a national-best 49.604 on floor. Four Bruins earned regular season All-America honors in the event - Katelyn Ohashi, Kyla Ross, Gracie Kramer and Felicia Hano. At the 2019 NCAA Championships, Wieber coached future Arkansas assistant Ross to the individual floor title with a score of 9.950, the program's second in as many years. After winning their semifinal session with a 197.650, UCLA finished third overall in the finals.

The 2018 Bruins scored 49.4 or higher in 11 meets and 49.6 or higher in three meets, including a national season-high of 49.775 set on Feb. 25. She and her fellow UCLA coaches were named the 2018 West Region Assistant Coaches of the Year, as they helped lead the Bruins to Pac-12, NCAA regional and NCAA national titles.

Wieber, who has been a vocal advocate for safe sport, has won many awards in the past several years, including the Arthur Ashe Courage Award at the ESPYs, the Rising Star Award by the Los Angeles Business Journal, and the Giant Steps A Hero Among Us Award.

A member of the "Fierce Five" United States squad that won team gold at the 2012 Olympics, Wieber was a two-time U.S. all-around champion (2011 and 2012) and the 2011 World all-around champion. Her illustrious elite career included three medals (all-around and team gold, beam bronze) at the 2011 World Championships, four U.S. senior national titles (all-around, bars and floor in 2011 and all-around in 2012). She was also the 2008 U.S. junior all-around, vault and floor exercise champion and the American Cup all-around champion in 2009, 2011 and 2012. She dominated the competition at the 2010 Pacific Rim Championships, winning four gold medals (all-around, uneven bars, floor exercise, team) and one silver (vault). In her first international competition at the 2007 Junior Pan American Championships, she won gold medals on uneven bars and balance beam, silver in the all-around and bronze on floor exercise. Wieber officially retired from competitive gymnastics in 2015.

Wieber, from DeWitt, Mich., graduated from UCLA in 2017 with a degree in Psychology. She was a 2016 inductee into the Greater Lansing Sports Hall of Fame, a 2021 Michigan Sports Hall of Fame Inductee and is also a member of the USA Gymnastics Hall of Fame.
