- Four different freshmen earned at least one point in on 8/23/ vs. Campbell
- Ella Bach** and **Reagan Thompson** each netted their first career goals, Bach at 39:53 and Thompson at 72:08
- Natalie Scobie**, **Sadie Peterson**, and **Ella Bach** each picked up an assist as well, earning their first career points.
- Ella Bach** is tied with **Taylor Leib** for the team lead with three points this season

Nothing Gets Past Nona

- Graduate **Nona Reason** was named ACC Co-Goalkeeper of the Week for the first week of matches in the 2026 season. She is the first Clemson player to win a weekly award since Makenna Morris in October 2023 and the first goalkeeper since Halle Mackiewicz in September 2023.
- Reason had two shutouts and eight saves (led the ACC in week one) across the Tigers first two matches. She is now up to 10 saves on the season.
